

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"A CINEMATIC INSULT" By Rev. Al Sharpton

The multi-nominated film "The Color Purple" is the most well-produced cinematic insult to Black Americans in recent history. For Steven Spielberg and Alice Walker to so arrogantly stereotype Blak males as sex animals and our families as incestridden is historically inaccurate and a social distortion.

One (can) argue that "there are white films showing depraved behavior among white people." Certainly there are, but there are scores of white films showing all sides of white culture.

No other Black film in the history of Hollywood has received 11 Academy Award nominations. To raise this film up as the cinematic view of Black America is to believe that Blacks are inferior, that Black men are just animals and brutes, and that Black women must try to tame the savage beast (Black men).

The film is a blatant attempt to transfer blame from the victimizer to the victim. The problem of the Black woman wasn't the beastly nature of her father or husband, but the brutal, savage actions perpetuated on her and her children by white men. Just the difference in skin complexion of Blacks is a testimony to white rape, not Black incest. Hollywood is the world's capital of fantasymaking, but Hollywood cannot be allowed to excuse the truth and fabricate a lie to clean up America's wretched past.

Apologists have tried to justify this film, (saying) it was well-done. But there were beautifully-built plantations and that doesn't justify slavery. Secondly, we are told that (the movie) employed a lot of Black actors and actresses. This is no excuse either. In slavery all Blacks had a job. They just had no way of expressing self-dignity and self-respect. The same is so for the employees of this movie.

If Hollywood wants to do epic versions of the Black experience, it should put out good films with true stories.

A VICTORY IN ITS DEFEAT

The three front-runners as the night approached were "Purple", "Out of Africa" and "Prizzi's Honor." It lost to distinguished company.

I also think that what's very important to note here is that in discussing voting for the film, I rarely heard anyone say, "It's a great BLACK FILM",...What was said was, "It's a great film. As ironic as it may seem,

I don't think anyone felt compelled to vote for it or against it because it was a black film. Isn't that the pinnacle of progress? The film was treated as all the other films...as a piece of cinematic excellence...which just didn't pick up any Oscars.

as he entered the Dorothy Chandler Pavillion. At one time, in the not so distant past, that would have been the extent of the black participation in this event.

But the Academy has grown up. There were so many black faces on and off stage, perhaps it's unnecessary to count them. Doesn't that alone prove the point?

As to losing, for the nominated ladies (Whoopi Goldberg, Margaret Avery, Oprah Winfrey) there'll be other times.

No, Quincy didn't win a producing Oscar. But no one, least of all Quincy, is likely to complain about the kind of year this extraordi-nary man is having. After laboring long, he's finally being recognized as the superstar he is.

Quincy did present the special Oscar to composer Alex North. Michael Winslow was the presenter for the sound effects trophy. They weren't chosen because they are black: Q, because he's written so many wonderful film scores and Michael, because he can make sounds few other humans can. Lionel didn't win because he's black or even because he's 'outrageous.'

For the record, isn't that what it's all about?

LIONEL RICHIE WINS BEST ORIGINAL SONG; JOHN BARRY WINS BEST ORIGINAL SCORE



Los Angeles: Lionel Richie had two opportunities to win an Academy Award last week one for his co-writing on "Sister (Miss Celie's Blues)" from the film "The Color Purple" and for "Say You, Say Me," an original song that was used in "White Nights," although not released as part of the movie's soundtrack LP.

Nights, although not released as part of the movie's soundtrack LP. Richie's win for "Say You, Say Me" may well have helped him to avoid the sense of defeat experienced by the other nominees from "The Color Purple," which was nominated in 11 categories, but failed to garner one trophy.

John Barry, who copped an Oscar for Best Original Score for the film "Out Of Africa," was part of a winning camp.

Barry was sedate in his acceptance of the Oscar. He thanked all the right people and quietly went to the interview room backstage at the Dorothy Chandler Pavilion.

Richie, employing his trademark response, called his winning the Oscar "outrageous," and said that it was a "dream come true."

For Quincy Jones, the dream has been deferred for now. As "The Color Purple" co-producer, Quincy would have won an Oscar if the film had been selected as Best Picture; he was also nominated for Best Original Score and Best Original Song for his "...Purple" efforts.

Jones and the other nominees from the film drew blanks in every category; in many categories, they went head to head with the night's big winner, "Out of Africa."

Richie, who recently won a best song Grammy for his contribution to "We Are The World," which Jones produced, said backstage that he was honored and felt "out of my league."

RIAA REPORTS SHIPMENT DOLLARS HOLD STEADY IN 1985


New York: The dollar volume of the U.S. Manufacturer Net Shipments of discs and prerecorded tapes remained steady in 1985. Calculated at suggested list price, dollar volume increased by only 0.4% over 1984. Compact discs continued to show substantial growth; shipments gained by 291% in 1985. In 1985, 653 million total

In 1985, 653 million total units were shipped, compared to 680 million units in 1984, according to the Recording Industry Association of America (RIAA). Shipments in 1985 were valued at \$4.3 billion in 1984.

Showing a 18% decrease last year were LP/EP shipments. Shipments of singles decreased by 8%.

According to the RIAA Market Research Committee, the continued success of the compact disc helped level out the declines in other configurations.

FIRST ANNUAL NATIONAL RAP MUSIC AWARDS SHOW SET

Cleveland: Run D.M.C., L.L. Cool J, Whodini, Doug E. Fresh, Roxanne Shante and others will perform and present awards during the first annual National Rap Music Awards show, set at the Music Hall here for May 25.

The awards program is being presented by the National Rap Music Assn., which is based in Cleveland because it is felt radio here airs more of the music than any other market.

In addition to top-ranking rap artists, non-rap music performers such as Andre Cymone, Richard "Dimples" Fields, Rene & Angela, Lisa Lisa, Full Force, the Dazz Band, Yarbrough & Peoples, Paul Lawrence, Pennye Ford and others will be on hand to present awards and perform.

Some 31 awards will be given out, including Entertainer of the Year, 12" Single of the Year, LP of the Year, Best Female, Best, Male, Best Group, Best Video, Best Lyrics, Best Instrumental, etc. Winners will receive the

Winners will receive the "Herc Award," named after Kool Herc, who is credited with creating the idiom. Winners will be selected

Winners will be selected from ballots mailed out to radio station program directors and major record retail chain store managers.

Ballots will be sent back to the Price Waterhouse accounting firm which will tally the votes and hold the winners' names until the awards show. The special "Russell Award," named after Rush Productions' management mogul Russell Simmons, will be given to an individual who has contributed to the spreading of rap music's fortunes.

Simmons, along with Sylvia Robinson of Sugarhill Records, DJ Mr. Magic, concert promoter Rick Walker, and west coast record distributor Don McMillan will all receive special awards during the presentations. The National Rap Music

The National Rap Music Awards show will be produced by New York-based Unitel Production Services.

The two-hour show is expected to be syndicated throughout the US.

"WE ARE THE WORLD/ HANDS ACROSS AMERICA" SONGS TO BE SIMULCAST ON MARCH 28TH

Los Angeles: To commemorate the first anniversary of last year's Good Friday nationwide broadcast, radio stations across the U.S. will simulcast USA for Africa's "We Are the World" followed by the debut of the song, "Hands Across America," in a live, 30-minute radio program on Good Friday, March 28 at 10:15AM (EST).

The simulcast will be fed to radio stations via satellite on the United Stations Radio Network, as well as other major radio networks. National Public Radio will also assist local stations in receiving the programming.

To date, USA For Africa has raised \$44.5 million from sales of the "We Are the World" single, LP and ancillary products.

soned politician who likens his drive for more substantial ARBitron numbers to that of a rookie candidate in an election race.

"I really didin't know much about this market before I came here," he told BRE recently, "But I knew that this station existed."

The station is more than a decade old, and has, in the past, boldly billed itself as Denver's station for "Universal R&B."

But since 1984, when Calvin Booker, another veteran of Southern market radio, came to top-ranking manage-ment there, it has gone more towards a mainstream format.

Booker hired Johnson 15 months ago, and since then, the station has gone from 1.4 ARB rating to 2.7, nearly a 100% jump.

Johnson said that he has concentrated on developing a 'generic" approach to programming, "given the fact that this is the only black station in town, and

there's just not that many black people in Denver."

He said, "Without playing just top 40 hits, black contemporary hits, we pro-gram a mixture of this music, along with blues, the right kind of progressive jazz, and other things that attract a wide listener base.'

Acts such as Michael Franks, Frankie Beverly with Maze, Jeffrey Osborne, Sheena Easton, B.B. King, the Miami Sound Machine, and Tierra share the airwaves at KDKO.

In order to bring elements of the listenership together in the community sense, Johnson said that "generic" public affairs programs like "Community Talk" are offered, along with more specialized programming, especially for the large Latin community - for ex-ample, "Chicano Update."

For three years, the station's "Career Fair" each year has attrcted a broad cross-section of the community. "It reflects how successful we've been, and continue to be in attracting a broad audience."

Johnson asserts that other community events, i.e., an Easter egg hunt and a "Picnic in the City," are all generic and involve many demographic segments of the city.

The Henderson, NC native said that for an AM station to build upon the potential of a broad audience is "indeed a challenge" in 1986.

Johnson started his career at 22-years-old, right out of the service, at Warrenton. NC station WARR in 1972.

He held several position between 1972 and 1978 before moving to Baton Rouge, where he took up programming chores at WYLD.

Shortly thereafter, Johnson moved on to assist Barry Richards in programming WAIL. He was at that station for nearly three years.

Hot on the heels of success that MCA Records has had with major acts like New Edition, Patti LaBelle and Ready For the World, are its next wave of hitmakers: The Jets, The Controllers and Colonel Abrams.

With the catchy hit, "I've Got A Crush On You" to its credit, The Jets are MCA's latest entry on the teenidol scene.

Ranging in age from 11 to 19, the group is comprised of eight of Mike and Vake Wolfgramm's 13 children. Originally from Tonga, a Polynesian kingdom, the Wolfgramms played the hotel lounge circuit throughout the Midwest and Canada with their South Seas revue.

In 1981, they decided to concentrate on pop music (Mom retired from the group) and the band members - consisting of Roy, 19; Eddie, 18; Gene, 17; Haini, 16; Rudy, 15; Kathy, 14; Elizabeth, 12; and Moana, 11 adopted a new name: Quasar.

They were performing under that name when Don Powell "discovered" them in early 1984. Having managed Stevie Wonder in the late '60s and later co-managed David Bowie, he felt that the family had the potential to become a major recording act.

At Powell's suggestion, they changed their name to The Jets, recorded a foursong demo and filmed two videos (showcasing Rudy's flashy choreography for the group). With these selling tools, The Jets had no trouble snaring a long-term contract with MCA Records.

The group's debut LP, The Jets, was recorded in Minneapolis and produced by Powell and David Rivkin (whose credits include Prince and Lipps, Inc.). Each member of The Jets ably carries his and her own weight, but it is 13-yearold Elizabeth whose lead vocals truly demonstrate technique far beyond her years.

The songs on the LP, most of which were commissioned for the group, are as upbeat and refreshing as the musical unit itself. Like New Edition, The Jets have the kind of polish and determination that make them seem destined to attract a legion of adult fans in addition to their enthusiastic teen followers.

The Controllers, a vocal quartet from Birmingham, Alabama, is another group with enormous potential - a fact that is born out by their current MCA LP, Stay.

Produced by Barry Eastman (Billy Ocean) and the production team of Ralph Benatar and Galen Senogles (DeBarge, Billy Preston), the album is an eight-track offering that capitalizes on the group's rich gospel background, while remaining on the cutting edge of black pop.

The Controllers - a family group of brothers and cousins comprised of Lenard Brown, Reginald McArthur, Ricky Lewis and Larry McArthur - began singing together in a gospel group as youngsters.

voungsters. In 1975, the quartet signed to Birmingham-based Juana Records, a small indie that was distributed by TK Records in Miami. Frederick Knight produced the group's first LP which yielded an international hit single, "Somebody's Got to Win, Somebody's Got to Lose." The Controllers' association with Juana continued until 1982 and they recorded three LPs with the label.

The group signed with San Francisco-based manager Jimmy Bee in 1983, and shortly thereafter hooked a recording contract with MCA. The group's first MCA LP was produced by Nick Johnson and contained the sweetly soaring ballad hit, "Crushed." Their current LP does an

Their current LP does an excellent job of highlighting the group's extraordinary vocal flair. Reggie McArthur's cover of Marvin Gaye's "Distant Lover" is particularly effective and "Stay," the group's currently charted single is a great introduction for those who may have been unfamiliar with The Controllers and their gospel-reared soul sound (but are now prepared to "stay" around as loyal fans).

Good-looking Colonel Abrams is another artist who is earning his share of fans and followers. His first MCA single, "Trapped," was a number one dance record in this country, a number two pop hit in the United Kingdom and a top ten smash all over Europe. Luckily, his debut LP, <u>Colonel Abrams</u>, delivers on the promise of "Trapped" with a lively and diverse collection of scintillating soul.

tillating soul. Actually named Colonel Abrams IV ("because my great-great-great grandmother heard the word 'colonel' and thought it'd be a fine name for her son") Abrams was born in Detroit, Michigan.

Moving to Harlem and then later to the Bronx, Abrams remembers singing in doowop groups as a youngster. He was a mere 10 years old when he wrote his first song called "It's A Miracle," which he has vowed to record one day.

By the mid-'70s, a series of different bands, showcases and performances at Amateur Night at the Apollo Theatre had brought him into a band called 94 East. Signed to Polydor, the group recorded one LP, but management and legal complications resulted in its never being released and the group disbanded. Abrams stayed in New York, but the group's lead guitarist went back home to Minneapolis. His name was Prince.


Two disc jockeys from WBLS produced two indie sides with Abrams called "Release the Tension," b/w "Running," which quickly became popular dance-floor jams on the East Coast. Signed to Streetwise Records, Abrams' first release, "Music Is the Answer," zipped up to the top ten of the dance charts. Unfortunately, Streetwise folded and Abrams was back to relying on his own resources again. With his longtime friend

With his longtime friend Marston Freeman, he wrote and recorded "Trapped," took it to clubs and got it played. A subsequent management contract (with the same hot firm that handles New Edition, Ready For the World and John Waite) brought him to the attention of MCA Records - and the rest is vinyl history.

Like his labelmates The Jets and The Controllers, Colonel Abrams is one of the dynamic new breed of hitmakers that MCA Records is proud to welcome to the family.



WINDHAM HILL LABEL PACKAGES VIDEOS FOR ITS ETHEREAL NEW MUSIC MIX



Perhaps you've seen CBS-TV's "Sunday Morning Show," featuring the often poetic commentary of veteran journalist Charles Kuralt.

Each week on that show, Kuralt rolls film footage of some exquisite slice of nature to close the Sunday morning broadcast.

Often this footage, which is accompanied by show credits, is rendered without benefit of dialogue or music.

Occasionally, some music - usually jazz or classical - is employed in conjunction with the clip.

Taking the concept of pastoral vision and sound a

step further is Windham Hill Records, long considered the Calvin Klein of boutique labels.

The Palo Alto-based label, which is distributed through A&M Records, has literally created separate sections in retail record stores with its ethereal fusion of jazz, classical, folk and soundtrack music, all dubbed "New Age Music."

The vibes of this often pastoral sound have been put to visuals in a series of videos produced by Windham Hill, Dann Moss Prods. and the Pioneer Corp.

Distributed by home video marketing innovator Paramount Home Video, the first two releases, featuring Windham Hill music and sights culled from nature conclaves throughout the U.S., are titled "Water's Paths" and "Western Lights"

Each tape runs about one hour, is priced at a suggested list of \$29.95, and is available in stereo hi-fi in both VHS and Beta.

The music of Windham Hill artists such as Will Ackerman, Michael Hedges, Shadowfax, and Mark Isham, to name a few, are visually interpreted in this series.

"Water's Path" takes a visual excursion through snowcapped mountains, journeying by streams created by the thaw, through a mountain lake and on to the rivers that empty their story into the ocean.

The Grand Canyon, Monument Valley, Lake Powell, and Canyon De Chelly are among the sites filmed to the music on "Western Light."

The videos have already become the rage in trendconscious Japan, where the titles are available on laserdiscs.

MTV's pop sister, VH-1, is currently investigating development of a periodic segment that will permit programming of such videos.

Four-color posters featuring the distinctive, crisp photography and graphics that Windham Hill has become noted for are also available for use at retail.

Thus far. the Windham Hill videos are primarily available through home video retail stores, but full-service home entertainment centers are sure to feature the collection in coming months. "Winter" and "Autumn Por-

"Winter" and "Autumn Portrait" are other titles soon coming from the Windham Hill Video collection.

SHORT BITS: Oscar-winning actor Lou Gossett, Jr. and his co-star in the film "Iron Eagle," Jason Gedricks, both star in the video to Capitol Records' King Cobra's "Iron Eagle (Never Say Die.)" Jack Cole directs and Tammara Wells produces the video, which is shot in and around the Chino Airport just outside L.A.

"When The Going gets Tough," the theme song to the film "Jewel Of The Nile," sung by Zomba/Arista recording artist Billy Ocean, was made into a video, featuring the stars of the film - Michael Douglas, Kathleen Turner and Danny DeVito - "accompanying" Ocean on the tune.

But it was banned in the U.K. due to a segment depicting Danny DeVito playing a saxophone.

It appears that the British Broadcasting Corp. banned the vidclip after ardent complaints from the local musicians' union. The segment was subsequently reshot.

New vid clips include: "Stay," MCA recording group The Controllers; "Saturday Love," Tabu/EPA artist Cherrelle with Alexander O' Neal; "Greatest Love Of All," Arista artist Whitney Houston; "Insatiable," T-Neck/EPA artists Isley-Jasper-Isley; "The One You Love," Motown recording artists Lushus Daim & The Pretty Vain; "Diana," Philly World/MCA artist Eugene Wilde; and "Baby Please Don't Take It (I Need Your Love)," Jive/Arista act Jonathan Butler.

BLUES IS LIVE AND WELL IN CHICAGO--AND ON VINYL VIA ALLIGATOR

Blues harmonica giant James Cotton has been blasting attentive, frenzied audiences for many years. He's from the old school

of blues - the funkier, the raunchier; the raunchier, the better.

But this man is a smooth mouth harpist; only his soul is funky.

It all comes together on his second release on Alligator Records, "Live From Chicago - Mr. Superharp Himself," which was just released March 20.

Recorded at sold-out shows at the newly renovated Biddy Milligan's in the Windy City, Cotton and his sevenpiece band worked the audience into a frenzy for three straight nights, leading to the music on the LP.

It was billed as a celebration of Cotton's more than 20 years as band leader, after 12 as the harp player for Muddy Waters' aggregation. Using a Metro Mobile

Using a Metro Mobile truck, engineer Justin Niebank captured the sounds, which were co-produced by Cotton with Alligator chief Bruce Iglauer. Final mixing was done at Streeterville Studios.

Flying Fish Records is releasing some serious U.S.A. roots music, including re-releases of material by Martin, Bogan & Armstrong and new music by Johnny Littlejohn.

That Old Gang Of Mine, a Steve Goodman-produced LP, from this seminal blues outfit, is the vinyl proof that this band has added to the blues lexicon.

The critically acclaimed film "Louie Bluie" recently brought Martin, Bogan & Armstrong's music to a wider audience.

And although Carl Martin has passed on, Howard Armstrong and Ted Bogan have been keeping the fire live, most recently during a performance at the University of Chicago Folk Festival.

The last US released LP by Johnny "Littlejohn" Funchess was <u>Funky From</u> <u>Chicago</u>, on ABC/Bluesway Records in 1973.

With release of <u>So-Called</u> <u>Friends</u> for Rooster <u>Blues</u>/ Flying Fish Records, Littlejohn has shown remarkable sonic growth. The Chicago/Mississippi

The Chicago/Mississippi Delta bluesman has augmented his stark guitar riffing and urgent vocals with the uptempo horn blasts of an eight piece unit.

Aboard new arrangements by trombonist Bill McFarland, Littlejohn synthesizes the gritty experience of his southern sharecropper life as a youth with his role as performer/ambassador of blues sound in today's urban blues.

It's a treat for all.



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BOBBY JONES VISITS SOUTH AFRICA

Bobby Jones, Nashville's nationally-acclaimed Gospel TV host and recording artist, has said that a recent trip to South Africa left him shaken, horrified and sobered by the realities of life there. Furthermore, it has given him a renewed sense of commitment toward his work in Gospel music.

At the recent James Cleveland Board Meeting in Las Vegas, Jones (whose Gospel variety show has been broadcasting for the past two years on a black TV station in South Africa) told BRE: "I'm just happy to be back home." When asked why he went there, Jones said, "I went because the black churches in South Africa asked me to.

"The Gospel is under attack there, with some calling Christianity 'a white man's religion.' Soweto is really terrible. They've burned down three or four churches."

Jones went to Soweto and Botswanna during the Christmas holidays. He has since been regarded by South Africa's black church community as a hero for visiting at a time when violence was at an

all-time high.

While there, he lent moral support to Youth Alive, a service organization that aids the black community in South Africa. One of its jobs, according to the singer, is "to go around in vans and pick up the corpses of the people who had been gunned down because families of the victims were not permitted to do so."

Jones noted that when asked to visit South Africa he "felt terrified. I was putting everything I had on the line. My career and my life...but not my faith. Jesus took risks. If I was serious about Christianity and what I talked about every week on TV, I had to go."

When asked if he feared a backlash from the black community in the U.S. for going there (particularly in the wake of the recent "Sun City" record), he said, "I felt that song was appropriate, but I didn't go to South Africa to perform. That would have been totally inappropriate. People were in mourning and concerts in the black areas were forbidden. anyway.

den, anyway. "I went to attend a conference there and I could have been arrested at any point. It aged me tremendously. I have never been under such stress in my life. I was scared of everything, but God brought me through."

This reporter has talked with Bobby Jones on many occasions and kept abreast of his many activities - but on this most recent interview with Jones, I saw a changed man. He was more sagacious, more intense and more serious than ever about being a part of the solution.

Appropriately enough, at the James Cleveland Board Meeting (which I will report on in greater detail in my next column), Jones offered his TV show as the vehicle to air black Gospel's most coveted awards ceremony the prestigious Excellence Awards. The upcoming awards will take place in August in Miami, Florida.

NEWS FROM THE MOTOR CITY





TONY DUPUIS & INFINITY: WALKIN' THAT LINE AND 'HEADING WEST



Music is communication, and that's what Tony DuPuis & Infinity are about on their latest ARD LP,

Heading West. The LP, just released March 17, represents a progression for this Lake Charles, La.-based band.

"We felt we had to show people that we are more than an instrumental group," Du-Puis told BRE recently. "We definitely thought that our approach on this LP showed that we've expanded our horizons."

On DuPuis and Infinity's first LP, <u>Night Visions</u>, released last year, the ethereal spectrum of sound

was thoroughly explored. On <u>Heading West</u>, percussionist/keyboardist Du Puis and group attempt to "give those who supported us on the last LP a thanks and to give some new listeners some new things."

Some of those new things come out on vinyl through the single "Takin' It To The Streets (Gonna Have a Party)," which was written by Con Funk Shun member Felton Pilate and Sheila E.'s uncle Coke Escovedo.

It is a decidedly more pop oriented piece than previous Dupuis/Infinity work, but there is the aura of jazz which attracted urban stations to Night Visions

last year. "The 'A' side of this new LP is designed to introduce people to our versatility, said DuPuis, who added lead vocals to his repertoire on this new wax." He added, "We didn't want

to limit ourselves to jazz or to just being a band that communicated, you know, on a purely pop level. We've got some character."

There is a plethora of character on this LP.

DuPuis said that his influences reach from the smooth pop of acts such as by Michael Martinez

Spyro Gyra, Bob James, Kenny Loggins, Chicago and Lionel Richie.

Tunes such as the danceable "Don't Run Away" the and the A side single, "Takin' It To The Streets..." reflect DuPuis and Inifinity's affinity for penetrating pop like that of

"Don't Run Away" was co-written by DuPuis and Ed Fruge, who contributed music to the "Rocky IV" movie soundtrack.

pop" with "Cosmic jazz/rock grooves are represented on side one with "Moon Bop," which DuPuis said reflects the band's desire to travel in the more high-tech, synthesised sounds that have become the staple at many urban stations catering tojazz.

The second side of the <u>Heading West</u> LP, according to DuPuis, is a "studio live" LP which is dedicated

to San Francisco. "I came up with the tune 'Frisco Strut' (the B-side on the single),' he explained, "while I was sitting at a Chinese restaurant in San Francisco's Chinatown.

"I noticeed that there was a certain style in the way people did things in that city and it was consistent everywhere (from) the Embarcadero (to) the old Haight-Asbury district."

DuPuis and Infinity revealed their true jazz roots ("something we wanted to treat our past supporters to") on the tune "Passing The Time." It's solid jazz, speckled with the rhythmic diversity present on the first LP and on side one of Heading West. Together for three years

as a touring and recording outfit, DuPuis and Infinity have opened live shows such as Spyro Gyra, Stanley Jordan, Muddy Waters and Roy Ayers among others.

The core band consists of James Marshall (trumpet, flugelhorn), Chester Daigle (keyboards), Chris Coleman (bass guitar), Mike Kittling (saxophone), Vewieser Taylor (percussion, congas) and Jay

Ecker (bass). "We are a family," said DuPuis," and our common goal as a family unit is to broaden our horizons.

"But we're a bunch of humble guys who just hope we can communicate through our music.

"If side one of the album lets us do that," Du Puis said, "then side two will surely let people see some of the other things we are capable of."


rapevine




