



Los Angeles: Record industry veteran Eddie Gilreath and former Arista Records staffer Richard Smith have been named to positions at Geffen Records.

Sources say that Gilreath, most recently holding a marketing and sales position at Elektra Records, will handle sales and marketing for all Geffen product.

Smith, who worked in promotion for Arista Records, will handle similar chores for Geffen's black artist roster.

Although it could not be confirmed at press time, there is speculation that Geffen Records is seeking to hire an executive to handle black music A&R responsibilities.

No stranger to the WEA record companies, Gilreath has also executive roles at Island Records and Warner Bros. Records.

Both Gilreath and Smith will report to Geffen president Ed Rosenblatt.

The new Geffen executives will be based in Los Angeles.

MILWAUKEE STATIONS REQUEST EMERGENCY AID

Milwaukee: After suffering massive damage to their tape/LP libraries following a flood that hit the city on August 6, radio stations WYMS and WNOV are requesting help from record companies and other stations across the country. Disc jockey samples of blues and jazz product are needed, according to Mannie Mauldin, Jr., an executive producer for the stations. WYMS and WNOV have gained notoriety in their market for being stations that are "manned" by

female jocks--both black and white. Both stations feature a blues and jazz musical format.



MOTOWN TO LAUNCH \$65 MIL-LION TV PRODUCTION SCHEDULE

Los Angeles: Motown Productions plans to launch a \$65 million television production schedule in addition to several theatrical, home video, cable and Broadway projects.

Motown's first dramatic series (on the ABC network) is set for this fall, along with a late-night talk/variety show in first-run syndication. The company is also developing properties such as "Be My Baby: The Ronnie Spector Story," a miniseries, and "Murder At the Met," a one-hour drama.

This year, Motown has production and/or development projects with all three networks, Cannon, Disney (TV and film), HBO, King World, MCA, Home Video, MGM Showtime and Tri-Star, according to Suzanne de



Passe, president of Motown Productions.

The company's involvement in TV production began in the late 60's with NBC specials starring Diana Ross and the Jackson 5. Its feature-film production began with the 1972 "Lady Sings the Blues."

Her answer knocked me off my chair when she related that she did indeed get enought love—and that she'll be marrying HAROLD HUBBARD of THE HARLEM GLOBETROTTERS in June '87. In fact, Shirley has just taken residence in Atlanta to be close to her future hubby.

Sigh! Well, I then went on to ask Shirley what her two sisters have been up to. **BRENDA JONES** is living in Atlanta, she said, and busy being a full-time mommy. **VALERIE JONES** is attending school in Detroit. 
The parade was originally started as a

KRE SUCCUMBS TO THE QUIET **STORM**

As of August 13th, KRE-AM/Berkeley is no more. It's now KBLX-AM. Inner City Broadcasting announced that KBLX-FM "The Quiet Storm" will simulcast over the 1400 AM frequency (formerly KRE).

The reasons cited for the change were threefold:

1. Across the board budget cuts;

2. KRE's low ratings; and

3. The inability of KBLX to reach key sectors of the Bay Area (San Jose, Marin County and East Contra Costa County) due to the troublesome topography of the region.

Those hit the hardest by the 'storm' were the entire KRE airstaff as well as the programming department and two salespeople. A total of 15 people were terminated.

Well, I guess "another one bites the dust." That's two airstaffs terminated in one week (WAIR/Winston-Salem being the other).

WAIR 'BEAMS' ABOARD THE SATEL-LITE MUSIC NETWORK

In a related development affecting the 'mortality' of black radio airstaffs, BRE has learned that most of the onair personnel of Holiday Broadcasting's WAIR/Winston-Salem, NC, were relieved of their duties on Friday, August 15th. WAIR officially ioined the "beam team" of the Satellite Music Network's "Heart and Soul" format when the switch was flipped at midnight on Saturday.

Airstaffers affected by the change are PD/MD Ron Lee, Tony Richards, Donzella Hendricks, Cornell Brow and Curtis Dankins. Part-timde operators remaining at the station are Liz Michaels, Leon Henry and Tim


Jackson.

Cost effectiveness was the reason given for the change. Commercial production duties will be handled by the stgaff of WAIR's sister station, WSEZ (a "classic rock" station).

As more stations format satellite programming, the future for 'live' jocks seems more questionable. This trend also triggers the question in my mind: "Will anyone ever challenge the license of a "beam team" member onn the grounds of little or no local-oriented programming? Stay tuned...

IS THE SUMMER BOOK IMPORTANT? BRE continues its look at the importance of the summer book. This week, we spoke with Ray Boyd, PD/ WVEE in Atlanta

RAY BOYD:



"Every book is immportant. We try to win them all without a let-up in effort. We're not spending a lot of money, but we are bringing in a lot of sponsors to help subsidize our expenses through trade-outs.

"Our summer promotion theme is called 'The Greatest Summer of Your Life.' We're also tied into major concerts such as Run-D.M.C.'s 'Raising Hell' Tour, The Fresh Fest, the Budweiser Superfest and the Kool Fest. And we're giving away trips to the Caribbean.

VEE-Summer Sprees include Super Summer Cook-outs held at a lucky winner's home with a V-103 jock serving as chef-preparing, of course, great barbecue and all the fixin's. The food is provided by V-103 and a local grocer.

"And if that isn't enough, each month of the summer there's a free party in the park with guest recording artists and great local talent providing the entertainment. They don't call it 'Hot-Lanta' for nothing!'

RON LEE:

"The summer book is very important for two reasons: 1) It helps us to keep national accounts; and 2) A good summer book helps us to maintain momentum from a local sales standpoint.

To compete in our 'hot' market (Piedmont Golden Triangle), we find it necessary to promote regularly. We're involved with trip give-aways; most recently, a trip to anywhere the winner decided upon.

TO BUILD A DREAM ON


The following interview with Tony Gray, PD at WRKS-FM/New York, was conducted recently by BRE publisher Sidney Miller.

BRE: I would not attempt to imagine how you must feel at this very moment as you have just learned of the fruits of your labor. That is, fulfilling your dream of winning in the #1 market with the highest numbers ever on your very first book!

I spoke to Barry Mayo and congratulated him on the new book. He first thanked me, then told me that he wanted no credit for this book because you deserve it as programmer. So I want to join Barry and black radio across the country in saluting you and your staff on your success.

TG: Well, what can I say? I have been blessed in finding myself in a position with a man who says, "What are the tools that you need? Here they are, now go do your job." So because of that, I chose to work in a radio station where the operation is what it should be. The General Manager gives the Program Director what he needs to win and lets the guy do the job. That's the only situation I can work in comfortably. Any other situation, and I don't perform up to my potential.

When I was considering programming job offers prior to taking this position, I wanted to know what my role at



the radio station would be and how much support we would have from the GM and the corporate offices to help the station maximize its potential. Here at KISS, we are all in sync with delivering the very best product possible to the marketplace. Whether I am in New Orleans, Miami, Philadelphia or New York, my objective is to give that listening audience-our target audience-the best radio station that they can get. You cannot accomplish that goal without the support of management and ownership. (It affects) the ability of a programmer to be able to make the necessary moves and adjustments to make a radio station great.

BRE: About your competition, Z-100, I would assume that they have a much larger promotion budget. How do you program around that?

TG: In just about any market, CHR-formatted stations have a much larger budget than its urban competitor. I have faced this in every market I've worked. My objective has been to take the programming budget that I have and use 'mirrors' to make it look—or appear to be—as large as their budget and then program in an aggressive manner.

The situation here at KISS is really the best I've ever had. When I walked in here they gave me a million-dollar programming budget to work with and

that does not include my promotional dollars on an annual basis. So having that kind of budget to work with makes my job a lot easier.

BRE: What basic advice could you offer to a guy in a smaller market with strong CHR competition? How could he mirror his promotional dollars to make them seem larger than they are?

TG: It's tough to be specific because each case has its own characteristics which make it a little bit different. What I normally do is study my opponent, see exactly what his weapons are so that I know what I have to defend myself against. Then I try to take my weapons and be as aggressive and effective as I possibly can.

BRE: But if they're giving away a car every week, what do you do?

TG: Let's say I'm in New Orleans and can't give away a car every week, probably a good countermove would be a dollar promotion where you could attach a reasonably large figure to a grand prize. Maybe my manager and I can put together a package where I can give away \$50,000 in total, let's say, or maybe \$10,000 cash, an automobile, and several trips. A combination of things just to make it look large. As long as it doesn't put my company in the

hole to compete against a guy who has what sometimes appears to be an unlimited budget.

BRE: KISS has often been characterized as a teen-oriented radio station. In this book, however, I notice that you increased in teens *and* adults.

TG: This station is still relatively young. I say 'young' in terms of years that it's been involved in this format—five years. That's young in comparison to our competitor. WUSL in Philadelphia will be four years into their format as opposed to WDAS having been into their format for a number of years longer.

In a situation like that you have to look at the relationship that a station like WBLS or WDAS has built among black partisans. They've established a 'comfort zone' between themselves and the black community because they've been there so long and it's comfortable to listen to. After all, it's been the black radio station for that community for so long. In fighting a radio station like that, my feeling has been, sure, they've got a head start, but I can run a little bit faster.

I just try to present the very best product to the consumer. And under those circumstances, the consumer will select the best product.

BRE: Let's talk about your music. I've been listening to the station over the past few days and I detect a definite shift in your sound during certain time periods. Is this a programming ploy to increase adult listening?

TG: A smart radio station has a target audience. You know who you can attract and then you direct the station at that target audience. An even smarter radio station may have some demographic shifts during the course of the day. Then you make adjustments with the music presentation and in some cases, the entire package. The object is, of course, to maximize your attractiveness to the available audience. We do some day-parting here and we make some minor adjustments, quite honestly, in almost every hour. The radio station is positioned to attract its maximum potential audience at all times.

BRE: What about crossover? How do you teel about artists who give you music that is obviously targeted more to CHR than your black base?

TG: That's a funny question. I am not in the record producing business. My business is to attract as large a listening audience as humanly possible with the ability that God has given me. I think

it's a mistake for artists (particularly black artists) to make a concentrated effort to attract someone that they might not be able to attract. I think you're pretty safe in knowing what the black lifestyle is like. In my mind, I feel you have a better chance of doing well with black listeners than you do with general market listeners.

I like to see artists do well outside of the black format. Artists like Michael Jackson, Tina Turner and Lionel Richie all do well on other formats. But my line of thinking is they have to do well with us (that is, the black listeners) first, and if somebody else wants to listen to their records, fine.

If I were a recording artist and had the ability to sing like Michael Jackson, I would not make a concentrated effort to appeal to anyone else. I would try to make records for the people who have supported me for a number of years and will always be there as long as I give them good music. I would always strive to keep them happy.

BRE: I totally agree. Are there any major artists who have big records that you did not play out-of-the box or not at all?

TG: There are not a lot of records that I play out-of-the-box because they are made by a particular recording artist. I play records out-of-the-box because they are hit records. Anybody can have a stiff.

As to how great you are, any programmer can have a bad box, no matter how good he may be or how strong his track record may be. So I try not to judge any artists on the name factor alone because they may not always have a great record. I always hope they do because it makes my job easier when they do.

A new artist like a Gwen Guthrie, who doesn't have a track record, is doing very well in New York.

BRE: I see black radio evaluating every record and if they feel that the artist has moved too far out in left field, they are abandoning out-of-the-box airplay.

TG: Black radio, as you well know, Sidney, is a business. This radio station we are sitting in today is a \$45–50 million dollar property—and it's not a game to be played with. The people who own this property expect results. If my boss doesn't deliver the bottom line that they expect, he can have problems. And if I don't deliver the results that he expects, I can expect problems. It's just as simple as that.

BRE: Tell me about some of your stops along the way.

TG: St. Louis is my home. I started

hanging around KXLQ/KATZ. I used to listen to KXOK when I was a little kid, that's where I started.

I moved from St. Louis to Normal, Ill., home of Illinois State University. From there to New Orleans and across the country. I've liked most of the cities I've worked in and I learned from every city.

BRE: Tell me about your staff.

TG: My people are the front line. I think we have one of the strongest air staffs in the country. Our morning guy, Chuck Leonard, has been in this market for years and has tremendously high name recognition. Chuck does an excellent job on the morning show.

My mid-day guy is Chris Welch who is just as excellent and is probably one of the best studio mixers I've seen in my entire life.

Our afternoon talent, Carol Ford comes to us from Cleveland. To my ear, she's the best female jock in America—black, white, Hispanic, or whatever.

From 6–10 p.m., our easy evening jock is Roshon Vance, who has worked for me in several other markets and is the best format executionist in the country. He has a unique personality that has gained him recognition in every market he has ever worked in.

He is rapidly gaining a strong following in New York City and probably is the most talked about personality on the station. His air name is J. R. Vance, "New York's Ugliest D.J." People want to know what the guy looks like, and he generates a lot of street talk.

From 10–2 a.m., we have Yvonne Mobley. She's been with the radio station a couple of years now and is an excellent talent. She has mastered the art of transferring honest warmth through the radio. When you listen to her show, you can tell that she sincerely enjoys what she's doing. She has a real feel for wanting to please her listenership. For me, this has always been a key to success in our business.

On the overnight shift from 2–6 a.m., we have Jheri Young. While he is relatively new in the business, he's coming along very well.

Robin Washington is our music coordinator and she, too, is doing a real good job.

That's our front line. The other folks around the station are not as visible but are just as key to me as a program director. The GM gives the PD the tools he needs to do the job, and then allows the guy to do his job. If I have to sing anyone's praises in the four months that I've been here, that's what Barry has done for me. He has given me what I needed to win. He says, "All right kid, go ahead and do your job," and that's all I have ever wanted.




EPIC'S RAY ANDERSON WEDS IN JAMAICA

Demonstrating a touch of Minneapolis sensibilities, Dazz never lets up throughout the entire LP. "Wild And Free" and "Body And Mind" get side one off to an electrifying start. By now everyone has heard the current single "LOVE M.I.A."

MCA RELEASES 12 TITLES ON **IMPULSE**

It's a dream come true for Ricky Schultz! As executive director of MCA Jazz/Zebra Records, Schultz has realized a goal in the release of 12 titles on the much-lauded, newly resurrected Impulse!

As Shultz told BRE some weeks ago, the label will be releasing a mixture of music from Impulse's catalog which teems with some of the most coveted names in the idiom, and music by young pioneers and keepers of the jazz light.

In this first batch, jazz luminaries Charles Mingus, Art Blakey, Benny Carter, Oliver Nelson, Quincy Jones, Ahmad Jamal, Sonny Rollins, Gil Evans, John Coltrane, **Duke Ellington with Coleman** Hawkins and Count Basie represent some of the depth and width of the Impulse! catalog.

These releases, all attractively packaged, include liner notes on the artist and the work being presented, providing the record buyer with some historical perspective on the artists and the music.

Even if you've got a lowend stereo system, the clarity of these audiophile oriented, digitally remastered discs, etched into virgin vinyl, will make you want to go to your local electronics store and upgrade to see what you're missing. These titles were also released on top quality cassettes and simultaneously.

In addition to past works by acknowledged jazz masters, two new artists' work came with this initial release.

Veteran pianist Henry Butler gets his recording break with Impulse! The album titled "Fivin' Around," features New Orleans native Butler with stellar performers such as Charlie Haden, Billy Higgins (he's performed live with both), Freddie Hubbard, Azar Lawrence, Jeff Clayton and Steve Kujala.

Butler, a versatile stylist, is often percussive and shows his strong bayou roots on much of the music. Standout tracks on this album include the title track, solo dirge "Improvisation of an Afghanistan Theme," "Giant Steps" and "Butler's Blues."

Joining Butler as the first new artist to be released on Impulse since MCA acquired the label from ABC Paramount is trumpeter Mike Metheny on "Day In-Day Out."

With his famed guitarist brother Pat joining him, Mike's music exudes some of the same ethereal qualities as the more famous sibling's music. The self-produced allbum also features players like Rufus Reid, Dick Ogren, Tommy Ruskin, Mitch Coodley, John Lockwood and Bob Tamagni.




