BLACK vs URBAN—WHAT'S IN A NAME?

One of the raging controversies in black music circles today is the use of the terms "Urban" and "Black" to describe black-oriented radio formats. The debate persists not only on the programming side, but on the sales side, too. Those PDs, GMs, and SMs who are anxious to show that more than blacks listen to their radio stations fervently defend the "Urban" logo. Equal amounts of the same, plus black community groups and individuals decry the homogenization of one of the few remaining bastions of ethnic identity. Who is right?

The heart of the disagreement centers around the fact that to many people "Black" is a negative term. They perceive—or perceive people to perceive—that black people are second-class, powerless, unemployed, MONEYLESS! Or, that to label a music or format as "Black" is a vestige of racist thinking. Hence the term "Urban." Bland. Noncontroversial.

In their best-selling book, "Positioning: The Battle For Your Mind," Al Ries and Jack Trout advance an interesting observation. In discussing the power of a name, they state:

"...Take margarine, for example. Even though the product has been around for decades, it is still perceived as an imitation butter. (It's not nice to fool Mother Nature.) The same principle is involved in the shift from colored to Negro to black. 'Negro' is a margarine name, forever relegating Negroes to second-class citizenship. 'Colored' doesn't sufficiently polarize the situation. The implication is, the less colored the better.

"'Black' is a much better choice. It allows the development of 'pride of blackness,' an essential first step to longterm equality. (You might prefer to be white, but I prefer to be black.)"

As I see it, "Urban," like "Negro," is a margarine name. It implies that, somehow, all those blacks listening aren't black. All of the "Urban" advocates are overlooking one major factor-the importance of being first in the mind of the prospect—be it advertiser or listener. In the overall media market, radio ranks #3 behind TV and newspaper. However, in the black community, radio ranks #1! Arbitron studies show blacks listen to radio 20% more than the overall listeners do. Why? Because black radio provides its audience with generally the ONLY consistent, daily stream of entertainment, news and consumer information that reflects the black community's lifestyles, aspirations and identity. This is a community that spends \$240 BILLION annually!



NABOB OPPOSES FCC PLAN TO KILL MINORITY PREFERENCES

Washington: The National Association of Black Owned Broadcasters (NABOB) is opposing the Federal Communications Commission's plan to change a policy that considers minority ownership a factor in the issuance of broadcast licenses. The FCC is seeking to eliminate preferential treatment of women and minority, calling the rules that date back to 1978 "discriminatory classifications...that are inherently suspect."

The move was prompted by a case filed by James Steele, who list his bid for an FM station in St. Simons, GA to a woman, Dale Bell. Steele appealed the decision and the Commission, in a surprise move, agreed with him that preferential consideration toward minorities is wrong.

On September 15 the FCC filed a brief with the U.S. Court of Appeals, asking the court to reverse the 13-year policy of granting preference to minority applicants who meet all other criteria for ownership -- despite the fact that the policy has been affirmed in numerous court challenges since that date and has become an entrenched part of broadcast law.

NABOB has been in contact with Congressional leaders who oppose the FCC position and the organization will address the topic at its 10th Annual Fall Conference in Washington, October 1-3. Pluria Marshall, executive director of the National Black Coalition will also give his organization's perspective on the subject in an upcoming BRE editorial.

ARISTA ANNOUNCES APPOINT-MENTS IN R&B PROMO

New York: Vaughn Thomas, Arista Records' national R&B promotion director, has announced the appointments of three district managers in the label's R&B promotion department.

Connie Johnson has been named R&B district manager for the Northeast Region. She will work out of Philadelphia, and have responsibility for New York Boston, Philadelphia & Connecticut. Roland Lewis has been named Arista's district manager for the Southeast Region, working Washington D.C., Baltimore, Virginia & the Carolinas. He will be based in Washington D.C. Al J.



AL J. WALLACE

Wallace has been named district manager for the Southwest Region, with responsibility for the Texas, Louisiana & Arkansas markets. He will work out of Dallas. Wallace comes to Arista from WXOK radio in Baton Rouge, where he was operations manager and prior to that, program director.

"We see these appointments as part of a continuing effort to strengthen Arista's impact at radio and in the marketplace," said Thomas.

RKO TO BEGIN SETTLEMENT TALKS

New York: RKO—and 69 applicants for its radio and TV stations—have been directed by the FCC to end a 21-year-old license battle. At an upcoming meeting, the parties will pick a mediator to oversee talks regarding settlements and buyouts. It is speculated that buyouts will be permitted.

RKO radio hearings are on hold with the stations in question being WRKO & WROR/Boston, WOR & WRKS/New York, WGMS-AM & FM/Washington, WHBQ/Memphis, WFYR/Chicago, WAXY/Ft. Lauderdale, KRTH-AM & FM/ Los Angeles, and KFRC/San Francisco.

TIN PAN APPLE LABEL FORMED; FAT BOYS, LATIN RASCALS FIRST ARTISTS

Los Angeles: Tin Pan Apple Records, an outgrowth of the management company of the same name, was recently formed and has entered a distribution pact with

PolyGram Records.

Tin Pan Apple Management principles Charles Stettler and Lynda West will head the record company and will be taking their famed, corpulent clients The Fat Boys and the duo Latin Rascals with them.

The Fat Boys are joining the new label, even though there was still a year and one LP left on their contract with Art Kass' Sutra Records.

Stettler, who with West owns Tin Pan Apple Management, will serve as president of the new record company, while West serves as secretary and treasurer of the label in addition to her duties as creative director.

Commenting on these artists joining the PolyGram fold, Dick Asher, president and chief executive officer for the company, said, "The Fat Boys and the Latin Rascals are among the freshest and most dynamic performers around today.

"We are excited about our association with Tin Pan Apple, and look forward to working with them and their artists," he continued.

West said that the label roster and staff will remain small and that PolyGram, namely the black music division under the guidance of Dick Wingate and Jerome Gaspar, will handle most of the promotion and marketing functions, while Tin Pan Apple, under her direction, will handle things like publicity, album graphics, creative direction, etc.

Kass told BRE that he granted The Fat Boys a release from the contract and that he entered an agreement with the Tin Pan Apple company for compensation on the LP due.

"It was an amiable agreement," Kass said, adding, "I will receive some compensation from the remaining (obligated) album's sales."

C.E.M.A. TO MANUFACTURE AND DISTRIBUTE ALLIED ARTISTS RECORDS

Los Angeles: Dennis White, executive vice president of C.E.M.A. Record Group Services and Ken Buttice, executive vice president of Allied Artists Records have signed an agreement by which Capitol will manufacture and distribute Allied Artists Records. According to Buttice, Allied is a "small, boutique-style" label with a limited number of artists, one of which is former Miss America Suzette Charles.

Said White: "The E.M.A. group will be able to nurture a new label such as this and further the exposure of many new acts for today's marketplace."

Allied Artists is slated to release five albums over the next year.

REV. DEL SHIELDS, WWRL/NEW YORK: TAKING HIS MINISTRY TO THE AIR

Religion and radio, particularly black radio, have enjoyed a lengthy relationship. Most black AM radio stations devote the majority of their Sunday airtime to religious programming, including gospel music and on-air sermons.

Ironically, New York's WWRL has reversed this time formula slightly by offering the "Morning Fellowship" from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. each Monday through Saturday under the spiritual guidance of veteran broadcaster, the Reverend Del Shields.

Rev. Shields is a unique media minister, in that he comes from an extensive background in both radio and television. He might be recalled for his work as a jazz jock at WLIV and host of the nationwide radio show "Night Call," or for his work as a producer, writer and host for various televison projects.

But more recently, Shields has been lending his voice, heart and soul to pastoral duties at the Zion Gospel Church in Queens, New York

He can lay claim to a wider ministry through his show at AMer WWRL, "Morning Fellowship," a combination of gospel and inspirational music programming in addition to discussions of a variety of spiritual issues and problems.

One such portion of his airwave soul-searching is "Conversations in the Sanctuary." That program airs 11:30 a.m. until 12 noon each Sunday. The show has featured Albertina Walker, Dorothy Norwood, Rev. Calvin Butts of the Abyssinian Baptist Church and Rev. Susan D. Johnson of Mariner's Temple Baptist Church.

Shields is also currently active working with churches, community leaders and drug rehabilitation centers in a tri-state area to fight the evils of the new drug of choice, crack.

Shields led the development of the "Save The Children" program to protect youth from the drug's addictive devastation. He has been lecturing at churches, holding forums on the "Morning Fellowship" and directly assisting young addicts through the "Save The Children" program, which has acquired funds from the J-CAP and Samaritan Village.

"We must get our values back again," Shields said recently, adding, "We must get back to trusting."

WINDHAM HILL VIDEO GIFT PACK DUE FROM PARAMOUNT

For a limited time starting Oct. 29, a four cassette video series featuring top artists from the New Age label Windham Hill Records will be offered to the home market for \$99.95 by Paramount Home Video as a holiday gift item.

The lushly photographed sight and sound poems feature the music of Windham Hill artists such as Will Ackerman, George Winston, Michael Hedges, Shadowfax and others.

The first of these videos, titled, "Western Light," "Winter," "Winter's Path" and "Autumn's Portrait," were released last holiday season.

Available in both VHS and Beta hifi formats, the videos sell for \$29.95 individually, making this special gift package a bargain. Sales will be supported by trade advertising and major video publications.

Currently Windham Hill act Shadowfax is enjoying popular radio airplay with the relatively new LP Too Far To Whisper, so there might be some radio promotion highlighting the "Windham Hill Gift Set."

Motown Records and Showtime The Movie Channel, Inc. will be joining forces in the promotion of this venerable label's most legendary sounds.

Coinciding with the August 24th airing of "Motown on Showtime," Motown released an anthology series of Motown music on CD.

The initial groups featured on the Showtime program were the Temptations and the Four Tops, who had best of packages featuring their music released on CD.

Subsequent "Motown on Showtime" and CD releases will include Michael Jackson (and a first-time ever compilation of his Motown music) on a show set to air earlier next year; and other acts such as Marvin Gaye, Smokey Robinson and the Miracles and the Marvelettes.

Motown and Showtime have even more closely joined in this copromotion. The CD anthologies are being repackaged with a modern updated look, including a design incorporating graphics used in connection with the Showtime series. The cable channel's logo will be stickered on all the CD sets.

Additionally, running through December, oldies and nostalgia radio stations will be conducting Motown trivia contests, with winners receiving Motown CDs and Showtime parapehenalia. Showtime held a series of Motown parties in six major cities during August.

Since its inception October 1, 1985, RIAA/VIDEO non-theatrical music videos have reached a record high in monthly gold and platinum certifications, registering seven gold and three platinum certifications.

Whitney Houston was awarded gold and platinum kudos for her self-titled RCA/Columbia Pictures Home Video release. That company has registered six gold awards this year, including July's 'Hall and Oates" and "Police."

Other gold awards include two by Elvis Presley, one for "68 Comeback" and another for "Aloha For Hawaii," which was also certified platinum. Both are from Media Home Entertainment.

Rounding out the gold was "Sade: Diamond Life Video" (CBS/Fox Video) and Barbra Streisand's "Putting It Together...The Making of the Broadway Album" (CBS/Fox Video).

Joining Houston and Presley in platinum was "Alabama Greatest-Hits," on RCA/Columbia Pictures Home Video.

If there's nothing like "Autumn in New York," then try "Fall at Manhattan" (Records, that is.)



MUSIC PUBLISHING: THE BATTLEGROUNDS OF THE BOTTOM LINE

Part Two

In the opening episode of this epic, songwriters and publishers had watched their years of flourishing pass away. Americans had been buying sheet music to use at their home pianos. But sheet-music skyrocketed in price. Consequently, people started buying records. As record sales rose, publishing slumped. Songwriters and publishers didn't make much money when their music was put on record. They always had depended on sheet-music sales.

To get some of the new money in the record business, songwriters and publishers decided to organize as the American Society of Composers, Authors & Publishers (ASCAP). They planned to use the Copyright Act of 1909 to collect royalties on records. Record companies didn't want to pay. In fact, all music users—performers, broadcasters, restaurants, cabarets, tearooms—were against paying royalties. But for song creators, there was no other way to survive. So, with the battle lines drawn....

n 1914, Music War I broke out.
The central issue was royalties.
Copyright law said that a creator of music owned the exclusive right to profit from public performances of his music.

Realizing that no songwriter nor publisher could monitor the use of his music all over the nation, the concept of ASCAP was to combine the catalogs of all music makers and license it to music users for a fee. Then, once the fees were collected, ASCAP would distribute the money to the publishers and songwriters. These fees would have to be fought for. It would mean war.

Music War I would be a protracted war—a long series of small assaults by ASCAP into new territories in licensing. The battle was in the courts.

First, ASCAP had to affirm its legitimacy, to prove its legal right to exist, establish a beachhead, as it were. The first court test was Church v. Hilliard, pitting a publisher against a hotel.

The judge ruled: The hotel had entertained with music to gain customers and profits. And since a creator owns the right to profit by his music, anyone else who profits by the music owes the creator royalties. Score a victory for ASCAP.

Round Two: The scene: The U.S. Court of Appeals. The ruling: If you don't charge an admission price, performing music at a hotel does not constitute a

performance for profit. The appellate court reversed the earlier decision. Score one for music users.

Rubber match: The Supreme Court ruled that performing music for customers was performance for profit. Royalties were due. With the blessing of the Supreme Court, ASCAP could escalate the battle. In 1917, the year of the key ruling, ASCAP went after the movie business—one of the biggest resisters of licensing.

The movie makers organized an effort to boycott ASCAP and otherwise resisted licensing fees. For five years, the two forces tangled, racking up legal expenses galore. It got so bad that ASCAP's legal expenses were far more than the settlements won. ASCAP was losing a war of attrition.

the major battles it needed.

By 1933, Music War I was over and ASCAP had won. For the next few years, ASCAP concentrated on solidifying and expanding its domain, and on recruiting members. ASCAP knew it was powerful and used the power to convince creators to join its ranks. Soon ASCAP had a monopoly. The organization's control over the music business was questioned, but quietly.

(During this era, many black performers fought to join ASCAP without success. The treatment of blacks during this era will be the focus of later installments in this series on publishing.)

As the years rolled on, the licensing fees rolled in, and ASCAP roared on. The NAB, though, had its eye on 1940. That's when the licensing agreement be-



But by the close of 1922, most of the bad blood had bled. The movie makers gave in. They would pay the license fees. The next opponent would be radio. Word went out to the radio operators in 1922 that ASCAP intended to collect licensing fees from them. The two sides tried negotiating, but failed.

The radio forces organized into the National Association of Broadcasters. They tried to get ASCAP disbanded for violating anti-trust legislation. The Justice Department ruled in favor of ASCAP.

The licensing organization won several key cases in the next few years of court battle, until it became obvious to the broadcasters that they would not win in the courts.

NAB shifted its attention to the Legislature, attempting to exempt the radio business of the fees on the premise that radio was a fledgling public service that would be crushed by the weighty fees. The problem was that radio stations were making good money.

The next ideas were to try to limit the amounts of the fees; to limit the music that they would apply to; to base the fees on a formula, instead of letting ASCAP charge whatever it wanted. Radio lost all these battles. Having run out of creative defenses, radio gave in. ASCAP won again.

ASCAP continued to expand its domain, territory by territory. The court tussles continued, but ASCAP had won

tween radio and ASCAP would expire. The broadcasters got the idea of developing their own catalog of music—to crack the monopoly.

Meanwhile, ASCAP was dividing within. Writers, publishers and composers were bickering about how the licensing fees were distributed among them. Also, years earlier, after being licked by ASCAP, movie makers had infiltrated the licensing organization. Now they were causing dissention. Too, the early publishers resented the contemporary publishers, and vice versa. The paint was chipping all over the walls of solidarity.

As the expiration of the licensing contract drew closer, the attacks on ASCAP mounted. Legislation in 34 states was aimed at ASCAP—attacks from all sides. Music War II was brewing. ASCAP fought case after case, and earned victory after victory. But dollars were constantly flowing to ASCAP's attorneys. And time ticked on, closer and closer to the expiration of the original agreement with radio.

Less than two months before the expiration of the ASCAP/radio agreement, the broadcasters dropped the bomb: They formed BMI. Broadcast Music Inc. was the long-discussed competing licensing agency, the trust-buster. War was ready to explode. The final sands of time dripped through the



hour glass. The ASCAP/radio agreement expired. ASCAP unveiled its new agreement. The contract called for a doubling of licensing fees. The plan was clever: independent stations would get off easier, at the expense of the networks. ASCAP would try to woo independent stations away from the networks. This was war.

Negotiations began. Time dragged on. The networks made moves to decrease their reliance on ASCAP music. First, they ordered their stations to play a few songs not licensed by ASCAP. Then they demanded that they play more songs from other sources. These demands gradually escalated throughout 1940.

On the last day of 1940, the war went all out. Commercial radio boycotted ASCAP, almost eliminating its songs from airplay. ASCAP was badly hurt, but all sides suffered—as radio slumped during the boycott.

Meanwhile, five days before the boycott, the Justice Department filed criminal charges against ASCAP.

And BMI.

And the networks.

The Justice Department charged that all the parties were working against the interests of free trade.

Now faced with slumping profits, broken-down negotiations, an ASCAP boycott and the consternation of the Justice Department, the time seemed to be nearing for the war to end, for the power plays to cease, for a solution to be found.

To allow everyone to save face and to avoid the pricy prosecution, the Justice Department offered consent decrees. The decrees would require that the signing parties consent to the Justice Department's terms, without admitting to being guilty of the criminal charges. The decrees, in effect, would arbritrate the dispute.

BMI signed a consent decree January 28, 1941. ASCAP signed one February 26, 1941. The war was over. For the moment.

But in business, naturally, there is no lasting peace. The struggle has been constant. Take last week, for instance.

ASCAP staged a press conference on the lawn of City Hall in Los Angeles to protest two licensing bills, pending in Congress: S.1980 and H.R. 3521.

In an interview with BRE, Morton Gould, President of ASCAP, explained his organization's opposition to the bills. He said songwriters would have to sell their works for a one-time fee, rather than receive continuing payment as use

of the songs continue.

"This would stifle the incentives to write music and to publish it," Gould said. Furthermore, he added, the buyout fee would be paid before anyone knew if the song was a hit—thus letting the broadcaster off much cheaper than under the present system.

Gould said he intends to appeal to the people. He wants music lovers to write their congressmen. Gould seeks to inspire grass-roots sympathy by having celebrity songwriters describe the proposed bills as debilitating to creators.

Already videotaped appeals by Stevie Wonder, Smokey Robinson, Lionel Richie and Quincy Jones, among others, have been screened before congressmen.

Gould says he realizes ASCAP is up against potential power plays by broadcasters. Broadcasters control airwaves and politicians need media exposure, said Gould, admitting that songwriters will have trouble competing with such clout.

"(But) we can compete with the sounds and faces of our Lionel Richies and Stevie Wonders, and with the images of our Duke Ellingtons and Irving Berlins," he said.

STAND BY ME

The coming-of-age film genre has recently come of age with the successful release of the Rob Reiner film *Stand By Me* a chronicle in the lives of four young people who discover that growing up doesn't mean growing apart.

The period piece film, set in the outback of Oregon during the late '50's has combined powerful performances from the youthful cast and the aptly chosen music of the period, namely the film title, "Stand By Me," to build a vivid portrait of another time, with an emotional impact of timeless resonation.

The Columbia Pictures release of the Act III Production shot down the popular film "Top Gun" from the top spot at the box office after only three weeks of release and has maintained a steady tally at the cash register.

The film recently recorded a healthy \$3 million weekend— bringing this sleeper hit's box office total to \$20.4 million in its first 38 days of release.

Stand By Me the soundtrack on Atlantic Records, has also shown strong response from consumers. The album, powered by airplay of Ben E. King's 1961 version of "Stand By Me," has debuted

on the national charts, and is the subject of a comprehensive joint promotion and marketing scheme by the film and record companies.

It has also garnered critical acclaim from film critics, while the soundtrack has earned plaudits from reviewers.

Six of the 10 songs on the soundtrack are by black artists or mixed groups. The artists represented on the record include King, Shirley and Lee, Buddy Holly, The Del Vikings, The Coasters, The Chordettes, Jerry Lee Lewis, The Silhouettes and The Bobbettes.

In addition to the title track, tunes like

"Yakety Yak," "Let The Good Times Roll," "Mr. Lee" "Get A Job" are making new fans through the movie.

The film, culled from a novella, "The Body," written by the monarch of horror, Stephen King, is a sudsy story on the surface, but actually explores the less visible depths of budding human sensitivity.

Because the title of King's autobiographical fiction may have cast the wrong impression about the story, director Reiner sought another title for the film in a stack of old 45 records he'd worn ragged as a teenager. He discovered Ben E. King's immortal song "Stand By Me," whose title and lyrics fit the character of the story.

In fact, many of those involved in the film believe that the 10 selections on the soundtrack serve as another character in the film—much in the same way music formed much of the environmental texture for the nostalgia film *The Big Chill*.

But while the music in "...Chill" was viewed from a retrospective sense by the story's characters, the music in "Stand By Me" provides, in a historical sense, the backdrop from which much of the action takes place.

Put together by Atlantic Records senior vice president/west coast general manager Paul Cooper and Columbia Pictures Music Group senior vice president/general manager Bob Holmes, the soundtrack's use in this film shows the popularity of black music during this era, and in an ethnic strata not known for its fondness for soul music. The current popularity of the soundtrack denotes the longevity of the music—its transcendence of time.

"In this film," said Holmes, "the music is contemporary; it's not nostalgia, but the music of the time.

"It's significant because the setting for this movie is not some urban environment, where it would appear more likely that the music be heard," he continued, adding, "this was the Northwest and these were 12- or 13-year-old white kids—which really illustrates how important this music was to everybody."

Holmes further explained that the music represented on the soundtrack, from King's "Stand By Me" to The Coasters' "Yakety Yak" were the favorites of Reiner as he was growing up.

"The music Reiner wanted to use in this film," Holmes said, "accurately reflects what was happening at the time, and also shows the integrity of black music.

"The people who are working in TV and movies today," he added, were listening to that music when they grew up. Movies about the '50's and '60's are being produced and directed by people of that era."

Holmes believes that films like *The Big Chill* and *Stand By Me* also point out the importance of Motown and Atlantic Records to the development and popularity of black music.

"The reason we made the deal with Atlantic (for this film)," he explained, "was because it was the company with the largest number of tracks that Rob wanted to use in the film."

According to Atlantic's Paul Cooper, the project was put together quickly due to time constraints. "It all came together so fast. We saw the movie in the late stages...when they were showing the film for theatre bids."

Cooper said that after the viewing, Atlantic president Doug Morris gave him the green light to work with Columbia Pictures Music in the development of a soundtrack.

"We usually give ourselves six months before the release of a film to develop and put together the promotion of a soundtrack, but this happened in two months," Cooper said.

The use of the song "Stand By Me" as the title of the film and as an important part of the soundtrack came as a surprise to Ben E. King, who performed and cowrote the song with Jerry Leiber and Mike Stoller.

"I was walking through the business district (in New York City) when a friend, I don't remember who, stopped me to say hello and then mentioned that a movie was getting ready to be done and the title of the film was one of my songs," King recalled.

I couldn't find out which one it was," King continued, adding that about six weeks ago he got a call from Norman Lear's office that they would be releasing the Reiner film with the name "Stand By Me."

"I was really floored when they told me that."

King pointed out that all the tracks used in the film and on the record were

the original versions, merely electronically cleaned up to more closely conform to current audio standards.

He also noted that while he was by no means idle when he learned about his de facto involvement in the film, his time has earned a new premium now. King was already planning tours of Europe, Canada and the West Indies, and was discussing an album for the upcoming year.

"I've gotten a lot of calls (since release of the movie) that have helped the things I had brewing before the movie came out," he said, adding that he's had to reschedule some things to accommodate his involvement in promotion of the film and the soundtrack.

He had already made an appearance on the "Late Night With David Letterman" show prior to the film's release and is now scheduled to appear on "American Bandstand" and on October 3 will appear on "The Tonight Show Starring Johnny Carson."

He has also appeared in a video of "Stand By Me" with two of the film's stars—Wil Wheaton and River Phoenix.

Produced by Columbia Pictures, the video features old footage of King performing "Stand By Me" during a 1961 segment of Dick Clark's "Where The Action Is." The footage is shown on an old black and white TV. As the camera pulls in, it goes into the TV and King in the same location, but he is now singing the song during 1986. Wheaton and Phoenix are in the background playing musical instruments.

King's interviews and the video are part of an extensive marketing and merchandising campaign jointly waged by Columbia Pictures and Atlantic Records.

According to Joe Gallo, director of merchandising for the record company, major account advertisement, and radio time buys in 50 major markets, are among the marketing tools used to promote the film.

The label also used 50-second snipits of the soundtrack songs in an album giveaway contest at radio stations where the soundtrack title track is being aired.

Gallo added that in addition to label and film company in-store merchandising, the label also has waged a campaign with the theatres where the film is screening. Flyers offering film customers a dollar off the purchase of the sound-track are being distributed at theatres adjacent to record stores, in many cases at mall locations.

King said that while there are "no blacks in it (the film) at all, and you'll probably say 'wow' where are the blacks? But it's not about blacks—it's about kids growing up. And we are in the film, because of the music."

WEATHER REPORT UPDATED; NEW PERSONNEL ADDED

The Weather Report has been updated and the Columbia recording act, known as Weather Update, still features the seminal work of the remaining co-founder Joe Zawinul, whose electronic wizardry is still quite evident.

Release of the LP This Is This marks the 15th anniversary of the pioneering jazz fusion act, which has been widely imitated, but has always managed to add new dimension to its own style in an effort to remain distinct.

Since the departure of cofounder Wayne Shorter, who moved on to release a solo LP, Atlantis, and to pursue other solo projects, the fate of Weather Report invited widespread industry speculation. After Shorter's solo LP and Zawinul's solo LP, Dialects, word circulated that a new Weather Report, sans Shorter, was in the works. The new group features Zawinul on keyboards, bassist Victor Bailey, drummer Peter Erskine, percussionist Robert Thomas Jr. and, filling in as soloist, guitarist Steve Kahn.

Columbia labelmate Carlos Santana also lends some licks to the title track and the tune "The Man With The Copper Fingers."

Like always, the Weather

All-digital recording label Soundwings soars under the

direction of veteran composer Patrick Williams, who has produced and written music for a series of audiophile pressings in his initial release. Among them are LPs by jazzists Bill Watrous (trombone) and saxophonist Tom Scott.

Although considered jazz exponents, Watrous' Some-place Else and Scott's One Night/One Day cover a gamut of musical expressions including the classical genre, and could be widely programmed.

Williams, who has more than 50 motion picture and television scores to his credit, said that "Soundwings is geared for the audiophile, compact disc market."

LINER NOTES: There's a killer ensemble on the loose from BlackHawk Records, which just released the group's LP, Mudfoot. The ensemble is called The Leaders and consists of sax players Chico Freeman and Arthur Blythe, Art Ensemble of Chicago members Lester Bowie (trumpet) and Don Moye (drums), Cecil McBee on bass and Kirk Lightsey on piano. The LP by the group, which was formed two years ago for European tours, was produced by Freeman with BlackHawk president Herb Wong....John Scofield's Gramavision LP, Still Warm, remains hot following the guitarist's recent tour and the debut of the title track as a video on VH-1's "New Visions" program.





It was a crowd bulging at the seams of the 18,000 plus seat arena last Saturday night. From teens to young and older adults, they came to party with Lionel Richie "All Night Long" on the second leg of his 1986 "Outrageous" Tour.

The show opened with Sheila E. One need not mention what this dynamic singer-percussionist sang or performed instrumentally. Suffice it to say that she got at least five standing ovations and was called back for three encores.

As for Mr. Lionel Richie, attending his spectacular show will remove all doubt as to why it has been aptly called "outrageous!"

For starters, Mr. Richie can sing his back-to-back hits for two hours or more without missing a beat. Then add to that dazzling special effects like a "magic" piano that rises incredibly from beneath
