First Look At 23 New Acts Radio Will Hear Plenty About In '96

The first quarter brought radio plenty of new artists, but that's nothing compared to what's coming from labels before the end of the year. To give you a head start, we've compiled a rundown of 23 artists to whom you will be introduced in the coming months, along with some pertinent information about them. We've also given the labels a license to gush, so be forewarned.

Artist: Trace Adkins

Label: Capitol Nashville

Debut single: "There's A Girl In Texas"; March 25

Debut album: June
Factoid: Artist is 6'6" tall.

Label gush: "A very distinctive voice, a baritone that cuts like a tenor. A country voice you'll come to rely on."

Debut single/album: To be determined.
Label gush: "A mixture of J.J. Cale, Merle Haggard, and the Eagles—Bakersfield, Calif., meets Memphis and Nashville. Big House's distinct writing style, mixed with lead vocalist Monty Byrom's talent, should make them jump out from the rest. As a live band, they are very powerful."



Shake-Up In Seattle; KCIN Kissed Off

Following last week's sale of KCIN Seattle to EZ Communications, the entire programming and air staff has left the building, including MD Lia Knight, PD Ray Randall, ND Ann DeAngelo, and morning man Ichabod Caine are still under contract, but their futures with the company have not been decided. Randall, whose contract expires May 1, has been invited to apply for the vacant PD job at duopoly sister KYCW (Young Country). Meanwhile, after five days of simulcasting sis-

ter KMPS and two more of KYCW, KCIN unveiled its new "rhythmic AC" format March 25, becoming "Kiss 106." KYCW GM Gary Taylor adds those duties at Kiss and its AM KRPM, replacing John Rogers. KMPS' Becky Brenner and Karen Oboi are helping program Kiss.

Also, at KYCW, Matt Bruno adds MD and acting PD duties to his creative director and production director chores. He replaces Lindsey Cipic, who is now MD/middays at cross-town top 40 KUBE. **PHYLLIS STARK**

RADIO ACTIVE BY PHYLLIS STARK

Sebastian Joins KZLA; Tim & Willy Confirmed

John Sebastian has been named PD at KZLA Los Angeles, effective April 8. Sebastian is currently PD at classic rock KSLX Phoenix. He has been in radio 28 years but has never done country. However, he has previously worked with KZLA GM **J.D. Freeman**. Sebastian is accepting resumes for an MD to replace **KUBL** Salt Lake City-bound APD **Cary Rolfe**. In other Chancellor news, KBGG San Francisco PD **Bob Hamilton** is now overseeing sister stations KNEW/KSAN.

Former KMLE Phoenix morning team **Tim Hattrick** and **Willy D. Loon** are now officially the morning team at the station now officially known as WKXK (Kicks Country) Chicago. They'll start in June, at which point **Nancy Turner** will move to early middays. Also, **Alan Stagg** from cross-town WCKG joins for morning news. And **Mark Campbell** joins as director of marketing and promotion. He most recently was director of field marketing at Entertainment Marketing Inc. in Chicago and previously was advertising and promotion director at WNYN New York.

Boston-based American Radio Systems and San Francisco-based Henry Broadcasting Co. have agreed to merge in a deal valued at approximately \$115 million. Henry owns nine stations, including country KSKS Fresno, Calif. Also at KSKS, evening host **Chris Costa** adds MD duties. She replaces **Scott Stevens**, now at crosstown KNAX.

WCDA Albany, N.Y., which we reported last week had dropped satellite country for a gold-based country mix, has become WPTR-FM. PD **Steve Warren** did mornings at WPTR-AM in the '80s.

In Fargo, N.D., KFGO-FM (Moose Country 102) has entered into separate LMA's-to-buy with country rival KVOX-AM-FM and oldies KKDL. **Ed Schultz** from crosstown WDAY-TV becomes VP/operations for the four stations, as well as KFGO-AM; KFGO GM **Dick Boyd** is now GM

for all five; and KVOX GM **Clark Wideman** becomes sales manager for all five. KVOX-FM ups morning host **Ann Phibian** to PD, replacing **Bob James**. Also, KKDL flips from oldies to rock.

The passage of the Telecom Act means that Sconnix's Davenport, Iowa, company, Mississippi Valley Broadcasting, is now overseeing eight stations—six that it owns, two with which it has a sales agreement. **WLLR** GM **Larry Rosmilso** is overseeing all eight in addition to his WLLR duties.

By the time you read this, KHIT Reno, Nev., is expected to be an album rock outlet. PD **Rob Williams** stays on as OM.

KHSL Chico, Calif., has been LMA'd by Alta Broadcasting to McCoy Broadcasting, owner of crosstown N/T and AC combo **KPAY/KMXI**, which is in the process of purchasing KHSL. KMXI PD **Clark Michael** adds those duties at KHSL for now and says no format change is planned. He replaces **Ron Woodward**, who stays with Alta. McCoy GM **Dave Brower** adds those duties at KHSL, replacing **Gus Smith**, who moves to sales at the station.

Owner **Bill Payne** takes PD/morning duties and **Shelby T** becomes MD/overnights at classic country **KTFX** Tulsa, Okla.

KTOM Monterey, Calif., morning co-host **Karyann Hamilton** adds MD duties. She replaces former APD **Keith Medlin**, now at crosstown **KAXT**.

As tipped here two weeks ago, former **KPLX** Dallas MD **Chris Huff** joins **WIVK-FM** Knoxville, Tenn., for nights. **Colleen Adair** moves from nights to middays, replacing **Bob Thomas**.

WOGY (Froggy 94) Memphis taps former "Miss Memphis" **Cheryl Green** for overnights. Green is using her real name, as Froggy starts downplaying frog-derived names in favor of what **OM Joel Burke** calls "real people on the radio."

KKNU Eugene, Ore., moves overnighter **Ryan West** to middays, midday host **Beth Bryant** to nights, and P/T **Jeremy Wingnut** to overnights.

The Other Reason Vets Have Trouble At Radio

Wade Jessen is attending the NARM convention in Washington, D.C. This week's guest column is by Airplay Monitor editor Sean Ross.

Ive wanted to write a guest column for Wade ever since January, when he quoted Charlie Daniels, who asked in a commentary for Billboard if George Jones' "He Stopped Loving Her Today" would get played if it came out today. In that column, Wade recalls being an MD in 1980, when that song came out, and having to struggle to get it played at his station during the "Urban Cowboy" craze, when "the flavor of the day had replaced the original recipe."

That was true, to an extent. But there was more going on than just artist image in 1980, and there is more going on today. Traditional country was down in 1980 but not entirely out: The record that followed "He Stopped" at No. 1 was Charley Pride's remake of Hank Williams Sr.'s "You Win Again." To fully appreciate the situation then and now, you have to look at the issue of an artist's track record.

When an artist is hot enough to get anything he releases played on the radio, that artist is usually tearing through material as fast as it can be found. When an artist is trying to make a comeback, they become a lot more careful. By then, however, PDs may be down on an artist because of the songs released during the artist's hot streak. In a perfect world, Ronnie Milsap's "True Believer"—his 1993 comeback attempt—would have been a bigger hit than some of his early '80s MOR records that were really "(There's) No Gettin' Over Me" side-

ways. But those songs, even though they were hits, used up a lot of Milsap's bonus points with PDs; by the time he contemporized in the early '90s, the bias was already there, but it didn't come out of the blue.

Now look at Jones' output in the six years between "The Grand Tour" and "He Stopped Loving Her Today." There are some classics. ("Someday My Day Will Come," the single before "He Stopped," is pretty great also.) There are a lot of throwaway novelties, too—the songs that are dismissed as "ditties" now—and a lot of duet projects (*not* including Tammy Wynette) where the pairing was more notable than the songs. Consider also the 15 years after "He Stopped"—first a very fertile period, then a return to the duets and novelties, with occasional moments of greatness in between. In other words, even eminences like George Jones occasionally chased the flavor of the day, too. And when time didn't tarnish an artist's image with PDs, inconsistency sometimes did.

OK, nobody comes up with "The Grand Tour" or "He Stopped" every time out. That's why they call them "career songs," and Jones is luckier than most to have had enough such songs for about 20 different careers. But the issue isn't just whether radio would play "He Stopped" if it came out now, but also whether there is a steady supply of songs of that caliber. That's not just an issue for Jones, who would need such a song to blast his way back into contention, but also an issue for some of today's hottest artists, who will see their hit streaks dwindle in a few years and not know why.

Steve Miller exits his position as VP/GM at A&M Nashville. No replacement has been named.

Waylon Jennings has signed a three-album recording contract with Houston-based Justice Records. His first release, "Right For The Time," is due May 21.

Anita Mandrell has been named director of publicity and artist development at Decca. She previously handled publicity for **Alan Jackson**.

Several country artists recently teamed up to record a single, "Hope," as a benefit for the TJ Martell Foundation. The single will be released by Giant in mid-April and will be promoted when many of the artists involved in the project perform it together during the Academy of Country Music Awards telecast April 24. "Hope" was produced by **James Stroud** and written by **Gerry Beckley**, a founding member of the group **America**. Other performers on the record include **Vince Gill** and **Lorrie Morgan** plus an all-star chorus comprised of **David Ball**, **Mandy Barnett**, **Kim Carnes**, **Andy Childs**, **Mark Collie**, **Helen Darling**, **Holly Dunn**, **Skip Ewing**, **Highway 101**, **Ronna Reeves**, **Victoria Shaw**, **Daryle Singletary**, **Lisa Stewart**, **Steve Wariner**, and many others.

Columbia has teamed up with **WPOC** Baltimore, Best Buys, and Nashville's NightClub at the Holiday Inn in Timonium, Md., to promote artist **Marcus Hummon**, who will be "in residence" at the Holiday Inn, performing every Wednesday night in April. He is set to host a songwriter night there April 24, at which he will take questions from a reservation-only audience of 75 people.

The Country Dance Music Seminar will be held April 8-10 at the Stouffer Renaissance Hotel in Nashville. The seminar will include workshops and panel discussions on such subjects as "Programming Music For The Dance Floor" in the day and showcases from 12 artists in the evenings. The event will culminate in the Country Dance Music Awards April 10 at the Wildhorse Saloon.

The Country Music Assn. Awards show has been set for Oct. 2 at the Grand Ole Opry House. CMA's entertainment expo, SRO '96, will be held Oct. 3-5 at the Nashville Convention Center.

Steve Azar

"SOMEDAY" (RIVER NORTH)

Hailing from the Mississippi Delta, Steve Azar grew up in the heart of blues country. Musical influences included B.B. King, Bruce Springsteen, Hank Williams, and John Mellencamp. At age 12, he began guitar lessons and discovered songwriting. After seven years on the road with his own band, Azar moved to Nashville to pursue a record contract. This is the first single off his debut album, "Heartbreak Town." Azar co-wrote 11 of the album's 12 cuts.

Paul Brandt

"MY HEART HAS A HISTORY" (REPRISE)

A native of Calgary, Alberta, Brandt sang in church as a boy, grew up on gospel music, and began playing guitar in ninth grade. In high school, he listened to such artists as George Strait, Dwight Yoakam, and Clint Black and entered talent contests. Although he won a \$1,000 prize at the 1992 Calgary Stampede, he chose to pursue a career in nursing and spent two years as a pediatric nurse before switching to music full-time.

This is the first single from his debut album, "Calm Before The Storm." Brandt, 23, wrote or co-wrote six songs on the album.



Keith Gattis


"LITTLE DROPS OF MY HEART" (RCA)

This Austin, Texas, native won a Texas State Finals talent competition at 16 and was asked to headline at the Future Farmers of America Nationals in Kansas City for a crowd of 26,000. That experience spurred Keith Gattis toward a musical career. Gattis played with Ernest Tubb's Texas Troubadours and on tour with Johnny Paycheck before signing up with RCA. He wrote or co-wrote eight of the 10 tracks on his self-titled debut.

Marcus Hummon

"GOD'S COUNTRY, USA" (COLUMBIA)

The son of a U.S. diplomat, Marcus Hummon lived in such diverse places as Africa, Italy, and the Philippines. He first performed with his three sisters in the Washington, D.C., area, where he picked up the musical influences of James Taylor, Cat Stevens, Willie Nelson, and the Judys. His songwriting credits include Wynonna's "Only Love" and Alabama's "Cheap Seats." This song is from his Columbia debut, "All In Good Time."



Mindy McCready

"TEN THOUSAND ANGELS" (BNA)

When Mindy McCready was 10 years old, she began seven years of vocal lessons. After graduating from high school at age 16 so she

could pursue singing, she came to Nashville with a self-imposed one-year deadline. If nothing happened in that time, McCready planned to go home to Florida and attend college. Fifty-one weeks after she arrived in Nashville, McCready was signed to a record deal.

JoDee Messina

"HEADS CAROLINA, TAILS CALIFORNIA" (CURB)

After performing at a local radio show in Nashville, JoDee Messina was introduced to a producer who took an interest in the singer and began working with her in the studio. In a chance meeting in the producer's office, she met Tim McGraw. The two became friends and, when it was time for the album, McGraw helped produce it.

Gretchen Peters

"WHEN YOU ARE OLD" (IMPRINT)

Within months of arriving in Nashville (via Boulder, Colo.), determined to have her songs heard, Gretchen Peters quickly got a publishing deal. Her songs have been topping the charts ever since. "Independence Day," recorded by Martina McBride, earned Peters the 1995 Country Music Assn. Song of the Year Award, and "You Don't Even Know Who I Am," recorded by Patty Loveless, was nominated this year for a Grammy. "Chill Of An Early Fall," "Let That Pony Run," and "My Baby Loves Me (Just The Way That I Am)" were penned by Peters as well. "The Secret Of Life" is her debut album.




Ricochet

"WHAT DO I KNOW" (COLUMBIA)

Three years on the road helped to refine Ricochet's sound, which is distinguished by four-part harmonies. In motel rooms, the band spent hours practicing those harmonies and picking apart arrangements to achieve just the right blend. At a showcase appearance in Nashville, the group was offered a four-song developmental deal; a full-fledged record deal soon followed. "What Do I Know" is the first single from Ricochet's self-titled debut set.





Y108 Owns The Market, But Just In Case, Its PD Keeps Up Pressure

Two years ago, there were four country stations battling it out in Pittsburgh, three of which were co-owned. Today, there is just one country outlet left, WDSY (Y108), and that station is well on its way to realizing its goal of becoming No. 1 12-plus in the market.

In the last year, Y108 has climbed 6.5-8.3 12-plus and was No. 3 in the market, according to the fall 1995 Arbitrions, behind N/T KDKA and album rock WDVE. In the latest Arbitrands, the station was tied for No. 2 with WDVE.

The battle that once raged in the Steel City was between Entercom's mainstream country Y108, hot country WXRB (the Rebel), Real Country-affiliated AM WEEP, and EZ Communications' WQKB (the Bear). When EZ pulled the plug on the Bear about a year and a half ago, Entercom began simulcasting Y108 on WEEP, then continued to do extensive market research that led it to change the Rebel to modern rock as the Revolution last fall.

"After several studies, we found there was only room for one country station in Pittsburgh," says Y108 PD Justin Case. "We found that Y108 was in a very strong position because of its heritage and lack of strategic weaknesses and in terms of imaging in general ... What got us to change the Rebel to the Revolution was [the question], 'How can Y108 be No. 1?' The way to do that was to change the Rebel ... to help Y108 attain that No. 1 12-plus status."

At the same time, the company embarked on a heavy marketing campaign for Y108 that included TV commercials, bus-card advertising, and on-air contesting. Case says the purpose of the campaign was "to reinforce that we've been here and we're still here. We wanted to say to our listeners, 'Hey, come back to us.'"

The contesting included a \$20,000 Payroll Payoff and a \$10,000 rolling-jackpot contest, dubbed Cody's Cash Call, designed around the station's coyote mascot. (The mascot, incidentally, is recuperating from a St. Patrick's Day parade incident in which a band of excitable youngsters pulled off his tail.) More recently, Y108 gave away tickets for a cruise from Miami to Cozumel, Mexico, with the Mavericks.

Last summer, Y108 became aggressively visible in the market, going after noncountry events at which its listeners had not typically seen it in the past. That included a deal with Ticketmaster to have the Y108 logo on the back of all tickets, including those for sporting events, sponsorship of the out-of-town scoreboard at the Civic Arena, where the Penguins play, and "a lot of beer and chili festivals," says Case. Station staffers began showing up at such events as the Jimmy Buffett concert and Steelers games.

"We made an effort to get in front of as many people as possible," says Case. "That added exposure is really benefiting us now."

The station is big on image promotions and tries to sponsor a "benchmark" event about

once a month at which listeners can come out and meet the air staff. Those events include the Halloween midnight bowling party, Boo Bowl; a live Christmas Holiday Jam concert; a "prom for big kids"; and the Mother's Day Iron Mom competition. Case says those types of events help add personality to the station.

Another major focus for Y108 is its community-service obligation. It is involved in annual fund-raisers for at least a half-dozen organizations. "Just about anything we can do to get out and help the community we're involved in," Case says.

Entercom gives all of its employees a special day off each year dubbed Make a Difference Day, for which they are encouraged to work together for a charitable organization. Last fall, Y108 staffers worked with the Greater Pittsburgh Community Food Bank to refurbish a greenhouse; they picked, washed, and boxed nearly a ton of turnips.

Case says one of Entercom's "main philosophies is to be a good corporate citizen, so it's important for us to give back when we can."

Despite being the only game in town, Case says the station hasn't changed its programming philosophy. It is still 70% current/recurrent and 30% gold. Case goes back as far as '88 for gold but primarily plays music from '90 and thereafter.

The music is chosen by a committee that includes Case, MD Chris DeCarlo, and GM Joe Armao, a former programmer. "The three of us together bring a lot to the table," Case says.

"We have a conservative approach, because the Pittsburgh audience is older, so you kind of have to spoon-feed them new music and can't have too much [of it] out there at any one time."


The nature of the market sometimes results in the committee being late on records, or even missing a national hit altogether, but Case says if the song "hits all three of us right between the eyes," they'll go early on a record, as they have done recently with Lonestar's "No News," Jeff Carson's "Holdin' On To Something," and Keith Gattis' "Little Drops Of My Heart."

Here's a recent 4 p.m. hour on Y108: Joe Diffie, "Bigger Than The Beatles"; Garth Brooks, "If Tomorrow Never Comes"; Brooks & Dunn, "Rock My World (Little Country Girl)"; Faith Hill, "Someone Else's Dream"; Ricochet, "What Do I Know"; Trisha Yearwood, "That's What I Like About You"; John Michael Montgomery, "Long As I Live"; Martina McBride, "Wild Angels"; Vince Gill, "I Can't Tell You Why"; Tracy Byrd, "Heaven In My Woman's Eyes"; Travis Tritt, "Foolish Pride"; Alabama, "I'm In A Hurry (And Don't Know Why)"; and Clay Walker, "Hypnotize The Moon."

Case launched his career at WADM and WQTZ Decatur, Ind., in the late '70s. After a stint at WMEE Fort Wayne, Ind., he landed his first PD job at WZOQ Lima, Ohio. That led to programming gigs at WMME Augusta, Maine, and WPKX Springfield, Mass. He joined WDSY as PD a year and a half ago.

Having been in country for a while, Case says the best change he's seen lately is that labels are taking pains with artist development. "I like the groundwork a lot of labels are doing with advance music and artist tours—letting us get familiar with the artist, so when their music comes across our desks, we've already developed a passion for [it]," he says. "The most frustrating thing for me was to get a song [from a new artist] on my desk, [and] I've never seen or heard this person, and suddenly I'm being worked on it." Now, he says, "they are establishing stars for tomorrow."


