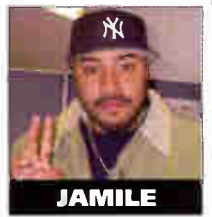

## Now's Your Chance To Cast Your Vote

A pair of R&B/hip-hop stations and three adult R&B outlets are our formats' most nominated stations for the 2003 Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Awards, to be handed out Feb. 8, 2003, at the Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Seminar in Miami Beach. Your chance to vote begins on page 17. The ballot will also appear in the Nov. 23 issue of *Billboard*.

Stations could be nominated in up to three categories this year. Getting nods for station of the year, program/operations director of the year, and assistant PD/music director of the year are R&B/hip-hop outlets WPGC-FM Washington, D.C. (in the major-market category, for stations in Arbitron's top 20 markets) and WHRK (K97) Memphis, as a secondary-market nominee. On the adult R&B side, the top nominees are major-market WDAS-FM Philadelphia and KMIQ (Majic 102) Houston and secondary-market nominee WBHK (Kiss 98.7) Birmingham, Ala.

For the first time in nearly a decade, this year's nominees were chosen by the editorial and chart staffs of the *Airplay Monitor* publications. The number of nominees were streamlined, with awards given in 10 formats and six categories. There were also changes in *Monitor's* industry recognition awards this year. Label of the year awards will be tied to the year-end charts that appear in *Monitor's* final issue of the year, dated Dec. 20. The independent promotion company of the year award remains but as an open-ended write-in category. And *Monitor* also plans to designate four stations—one each in the R&B, rock, country, and top 40/AC worlds—as "innovators of the year," to be announced between now and February 2003.

Winners in all other categories will be determined by readers of both *Monitor* and U.S. subscribers of *Billboard*. They will be announced Feb. 8 during the Billboard/Airplay Monitor Seminar & Radio Awards, set for Feb. 6-8, 2003, at Eden Roc Resort in Miami Beach. And in case you don't agree with our choices—it was, in every case, hard to pick only a few—we've given you the opportunity to write in with your own candidate.

### Rock Station Takes CC Battle Public

While some stations that compete with Clear Channel outlets have made oblique references to their use of voice-tracking or collective contesting, Jefferson-Pilot's '80s gold KBZT San Diego is making *not* being owned by Clear Channel a major part of its positioning. The station flips to modern rock as "FM 94.9" under PD Garrett Michaels, formerly of KYPT Seattle, and consultant Dave Beasing of Jacobs Media.

Positioners, which run about once an hour, include "Clear Channel programmers phone it in from out of town. We live in San Diego. So we care what's on the radio here. And we know you do, too"; "Not one of those cookie-cutter Clear Channel stations"; and "When the Flash [the former crosstown XHRM] got popular, Clear Channel bought them and shut them down. Here's the good news. We're not for sale."

#### RADIO ISSUES AN ALL POINTS BULLETIN

WGZB (B96) and sister WBLO (Hot 104) Louisville are using their airwaves to help police find a Halloween-night grocery store bandit who killed two people and critically wounded a 10-year-old girl. The girl, shot four times, played dead and was later able to give police a description of the man. Now the stations are running an hourly PSA encouraging listeners to call police with any information that could lead to the arrest of the suspect, as well as posting his description and an artist drawing of the suspect on their Web sites. A reward has been established, as well as a special tip line. PD Marc Gunn says, "I felt we needed to do this, because this man shot a little girl with every intention of killing her. My initial actions were out of anger, but now it's a mission . . . The next step is to create a fund to help the families victimized by this tragedy."

#### MURDER DEFENDANT CHARGES SLANDER

Tampa, Fla., dentist Randy Puryear, currently on trial on second-degree murder charges, has sued Clear Channel for slander stemming from comments made by former WSSR (Star 95.7) morning hosts Carmen Connors and Chris White. Puryear allegedly killed a man who he thought had pushed his girlfriend and her son Sept. 10, 2000. The *St. Petersburg Times* reports that the suit stems from comments the morning team made two months later, which Puryear says characterize the murder as a "hate crime" and him as a bigot and racist. The dentist claims he has "suffered harm both personally and profes-

sionally as a . . . result of the repeated false statements uttered by the on-air talent."

#### FORMATS: PRAISE FOR NEW ORLEANS

Wilks-owned talk/active rock hybrid WXXM New Orleans flips to FM gospel as "Praise 94.9." R&B oldies sister KMEZ PD Le Bron Joseph will oversee both stations.

Adult R&B WMPZ Chattanooga, Tenn., flipped to all-Christmas music Nov. 1.

AC KZAP Chico, Calif., flips to "Club 96-7," playing R&B, hip-hop, and dance titles. The station kicked off with 10,000 songs in a row, with PD Boomer at the helm. He'll be on-air, along with local club DJ John Feiste, by early December.

#### PROGRAMMING: INFINITY FLEXES

Modern rock KROQ Los Angeles PD Kevin Weatherly is upped to senior VP of programming. Also, country WUSN Chicago PD Eric Logan is named VP of programming and relocates to New York.

Sirius Satellite Radio names Joel Salkowitz VP of music content and programming. Salkowitz was already in-house at Sirius overseeing some of its talk programming. He is the former PD of WTJM and WQHT New York. Also at Sirius, Cindy Sivak exits as VP of industry and talent affairs to form Sivak Entertainment, devoted to talent booking and logistics for radio, TV, conferences, and special events. Tom Versen, the former head of production and creative services for Sirius, has returned to the helm of his Blue Sky Productions, an audio production company that produces *The Dave Koz Radio Show*.

XM Satellite Radio VP of programming and operations Dave Logan exits with the elimination of his job title. Several people within the company will take on his responsibilities, including VP of external programming Steve Harris.

MTV senior VP of music and talent programming Tom Calderone is upped to executive VP.

WVWZ Charleston, S.C., PD Corey Hill exits. GM Cliff Fletcher is taking T&Rs for an on-air PD.

Modern KUCD (Star 101.9) Honolulu PD Jamie Hyatt now has a hand in the programming of rhythmic top 40 sister KIKI. In addition, KUCD MD Ryan Sean is now doing the same for KIKI, which means that MD Tati Paligreen becomes music coordinator.

Clear Channel/Corpus Christi, Texas, VP/market manager Kent Cooper moves to those duties at the CC/Tucson, Ariz., cluster, including rhythmic top 40 KOHT.

### How Long Is A Career? About 4 Years

It might feel as though there are a lot of veteran artists on this week's R&B/hip-hop chart. R. Kelly, who debuts with "Ignition" (Jive), has been charting R&B hits since 1991. He has made 29 *Monitor* R&B/hip-hop chart appearances—not counting the first two years of his career—since *Monitor* launched in 1993. Aaliyah earns her 20th R&B hit this week, with "Miss You" (Blackground/Universal); she first hit with the No. 1 "Back and Forth" in 1994. And Snoop Dogg, who debuted last week with "From Tha Chuuch to Da Palace" (Priority/Capitol), had his first solo hit in 1993.

But compared with last fall, the current crop of hitmakers are newcomers. Looking at what was then known as the mainstream R&B chart a year ago, the average chart career span of the artists represented was seven years, with an average debut of mid-1994. This year, the average chart career is only four years, going back to mid-1998.

That said, there were some ringers on last year's chart whose careers long predate the *Monitor* era. They included Michael Jackson, whose solo career goes back to 1971 (which is what we counted); his Jackson 5 hits started in 1969; sister Janet Jackson, whose first chart records were in 1982; and the Isley Brothers, who first put a record on the R&B charts in 1962, although their career as pop hitmakers goes back several years before that.

This year, there's only one artist on the R&B/hip-hop chart whose career began before the '90s: LL Cool J, who first cracked the top 40 in 1985. After LL, Kelly goes back the furthest, followed by TLC (1992), Snoop Dogg, and Aaliyah. 1996 was the next big year for today's hitmakers, launching the careers of Jay-Z, Ginuwine, and Dru Hill.

One other note: 11 of the entries on this week's R&B/hip-hop chart are by acts that were also represented on the chart a year ago: Jay-Z, Nelly, Aaliyah, Ginuwine, Jennifer Lopez, Ludacris, Kelly, and Fat Joe, some of them more than once. Of those 11 titles, only two—Ludacris' "Move B\*\*\*h" and Aaliyah's "I Care 4 U"—are by artists who were represented by the same project in November 2001, which says a lot about how R&B and hip-hop artists stay busy (and we're not even talking collaborations here).

THE 5,000 CLUB: Missy "Misdemeanor" Elliott's "Work It" (Elektra) logs its third week at R&B/hip-hop's No. 1 spot, setting a detection record in the process, with 5,391 spins in a single week. The No. 2 song, LL Cool J's "Luv U Better" (Def Jam/IDJMG) has 5,141 spins, which would be a record itself if not for "Work It." Until three weeks ago, we had never seen the top two songs on the R&B/hip-hop chart both crack the 5,000 detection mark in the same week.

## MONITOR PROFILE

### KXJM's Ibrahim Jamile Trades Coasts For Hot 97's MD Slot

After more than a year's search, WQHT (Hot 97) New York has found its new MD: Ibrahim "E-Bro" Jamile, currently a morning-team member at KXJM (Jammin 95.5) Portland, Ore., who will start his new gig in January 2003.

Jamile, a native of Berkeley, Calif., began his radio career at 16 at KSEM Sacramento, Calif., while still in high school, first as the night intern and in the research department, then as night-show sidekick and eventually, as morning-show sidekick. He also would go on to host the station's hip-hop show under several PDs (including Dr. Dave Ferguson, Bob West, and Rick Thomas). But he earned national recognition as part of the team that signed on crosstown KBMB (the Bomb), which would eventually overtake KSPM for a while. We talked to Jamile about his past programming success, life as a morning-show personality, and his new endeavor.

'Power 105.1 will never have the love, charisma, or character that Hot 97 does'

When you launched KBMB as a hip-hop station, what other stations around the country did you look to for inspiration and programming ideas?

The only thing I looked to other stations for was giving me imaging ideas to make a 6,000-watt station with no budget sound major market. I admit, not having callout research would force me to use markets with similar demographics as models, but mostly [I drew upon my experience] growing up with hip-hop and understanding what works on the air. That was also my staff's strong point in finding the hot joints on the Bomb. Musically, Sacramento didn't have anyone owning the hip-hop music position, so we imaged everything toward the hip-hop lover, and we played the hits throughout the day. Everyone at the station lived the hip-hop lifestyle... so we didn't look to trade magazines or conference calls [for] the next hit.

Whose idea was it to go more hip-hop at KBMB?

It was absolutely my idea and my ass if it didn't work. [Consultant] Michael Newman and the GM won't admit it, but they would harass me about playing too much rap or say it was too hardcore at certain parts of the day. But I would choose my battles and argue that if we were going to be hip-hop, we have to do it for real, because our audience will know if it's bullshit. Do it right or don't do it at all. Does that mean you don't play the hits? Absolutely not. We played the hits, but we would also image and sell hip-hop as the station's backbone. And we owned the streets and the 12-24 demo. If you do that, you will eventually win 18-34. That's knowledge passed down to me by Michael Newman.

Eventually, you left KBMB to do mornings at KXJM, but you continued to oversee the Bomb from Portland. How difficult was it to handle both jobs?

I would work mornings and plan for the next [day's show] up until about noon. After that, I'd go home and handle the music logs and any office drama [for KBMB]. I would also make day and weekend trips to Sacramento, to get face time with the on-air staff and office folks. I would also review imaging promos and production via e-mail. My usual day would end

about 6 or 7 p.m. . . . That went on for about a year-and-a-half. I couldn't have done it without the help of people like Sana G. [now at KMEL San Francisco], Big Kid Boots, Fillet. P.K., and Sonie [the latter two are now at KXJM].

Portland didn't really have the image of a hip-hop city.

Well, hip-hop is mainstream. That's why it is so successful here and in Sacramento. Suburban kids tend to like more of the hardcore rap than the 40-year-old advertising suits would ever admit.

Did it have anything to do with the success of KUBE Seattle, which helped bring hip-hop and R&B to the Pacific Northwest in the early '90s?

Seattle has its own movement, and so does Portland. But the Northwest is far removed geographically from the Bay Area movement and the hip-hop scene in Los Angeles.

There are tons of local acts here in Portland that have been releasing material for years, even prior to KXJM being on the air: Cool Nuts, Bosko—who does production for E-40 and Limp Bizkit—Starchile, Old Dominion, DJ Wicked, [and others]. Most of the popular local music lends itself to more of a grassroots, organic hip-hop feel. There are some gangster sounds, but being commercial is something that hip-hop in the underground here is not trying to conform to.

There is a perception that radio on the West Coast is very different from East Coast radio. Would you agree? If so, in what ways is it different?

Musically, yes, radio is very different. Particularly when you compare the West Coast to New York. However, being a role player, performing and completing tasks, understanding the listener's lifestyle and how they like hip-hop, plus understanding how to own a music position and supervising your core is something I can do in any market. Hot 97 is very successful, and I plan on fitting in perfectly with a staff that loves hip-hop and understands what good radio is.

The other differences are that New York has super mega-stars as local artists, and they often come by the station. They may even call you when their spins are down.

What things will you need to learn or get accustomed to with your move to Hot 97?

Basically, all I need to do is get to know the staff and how to get to and from work. [People like] Flex, Angie, Tracy, Emuff, and Scoop live and breathe Hot 97 and the city of New York. I plan on learning from them.

Hot 97 is still in a heated battle with WWPR (Power 105.1). Have you been able to listen to them? What are your observations?

They have their place, but Power 105.1 will never have the love, charisma, or character that Hot 97 does. Plus, Hot owns the 12-24 demo, and you keep those listeners until they are 35-40.

Musically, what are your strongest assets?

My strengths are my ear. I have great relationships with the labels and the artists I know, and yes, I have a ton of programming and promotion experience.

Where do you see hip-hop going, and what acts/records are moving things forward?

I'm a hip-hop purist... There's a lot of formula records out there that artists release 'cause they know it will do well in research and phone reaction, which is what most stations look for. But [acts like] the Neptunes are [sampling] live-music sounds... to make their beats have a raw hip-hop feel. Then you have Missy Elliott's new stuff, with that old-school foundation. I'm loving it. [Other acts like] Jay-Z and Lenny Kravitz are dope.

We are hip-hop, and hip-hop is [made up of] so many things that are music—rock, jazz, classical, blues country, blues, Middle Eastern sounds, Far East sounds. We do it all.

And what about the future of R&B?

Hip-hop is R&B.

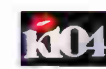
