## Mainstream Top 40 Hatches More Of Its Own Hits; Triple-A Supplying More, Too

You've heard a lot in the last nine months or so about mainstream top 40 PDs wanting records their stations could own. For the first time in recent memory, mainstream top 40 is starting more of the records it plays than any other format.

Top 40 Airplay Monitor took a look at every record on last week's mainstream top 40 chart and where each song charted first. Mainstream top 40 was responsible, counting ties, for 13 of the songs on that week's mainstream chart, trailed by rhythmic top 40 with 12. They were followed by triple-A, which was first (or tied for first) on eight songs, and adult top 40, which was first (or tied) on seven songs. Modern was fifth with five songs, including ties, followed by mainstream R&B's four.

If you look at which format was first to chart the most songs outright, top 40/rhythm-crossover and triple-A are tied for first with seven, followed by mainstream top 40 with five, modern

rock with four, and then adult top 40, mainstream R&B, and adult R&B tied with two.

All this represents a significant change from six months ago, when Airplay Monitor last looked at where mainstream top 40 hits came from. At that point, adult top 40, feeling a new infusion of energy from modern AC, was an easy No. 1, with or without ties, suggesting that a lot of the songs that might have started at either modern or triple-A were now being brought to modern AC first.

By contrast, rhythmic top 40—despite the publicity around the dance revival—was first on only six songs last November, about half of what it's responsible for now or what it had six months before. All rock formats, including triple-A, saw their influence wane between last spring and fall. Now, modern is roughly the same, triple-A is up sharply, and mainstream rock—which was barely on the map—has fallen off completely, contributing as few

## Capstar Absorbs Patterson's 36 Outlets

**C**apstar Broadcasting, 1 year old next month, starts celebrating early by absorbing Patterson Broadcasting and its 36 properties for a reported \$215 million, giving Capstar 156 stations. Patterson CEO **Jim Wesley** will be Capstar chairman.

After lunch, Capstar buys the eight stations of New England-based Knight Quality Radio for \$70 million. For dessert, Capstar does a combination swap/buy with SFX, buying SFX's Biloxi and Jackson, Miss., outlets, some of which were in the original Capstar empire, for \$60 million. SFX then trades **WGNE** Daytona Beach, Fla., and **KKRD/KRZZ/KNSS** Wichita, Kan., for Capstar country/album combo **WESC-AM-FM/WTPT** Greenville, S.C.

In other station trading, ARS and EXCL make an equally complicated deal that gives EXCL jazz **KSSJ** Sacramento, Calif., and the frequency of **AC KBAY** San Jose, Calif. ARS gets triple-A **KINK** Portland, Ore., and the frequency of Spanish **KBRG** San Francisco. **KBRG** will move to **KBAY**'s frequency. **KBAY** will then swap frequencies with classic rock sister **KUFX**.

Triple-A **WRNR** Annapolis, Md., is picked up by **WXRK** (K-Rock) New York PD **Steve Kingston**'s Empire Broadcasting. **GSM Steve Hopp** becomes GM. MD **Phil Harrell** is the new PD.

### FORMATS: THEN THERE'S NO MOUNTAIN

Triple-A **KTMN** (the Mountain) Albuquerque, N.M., is on a collision course with satellite oldies. PD **Rich Robinson** has already left the station; MD **Cole Croshaw** is overseeing the facility until it moves to satellite. Reach Croshaw, who's looking to make the leap to records, at 505-474-3045.

Album **WYST** (97 Rock) Detroit changes its nickname to 97.1 K-Rock, more in line with CBS **Howard Stern** flagship **WXRK** New York and modern **KROQ** Los Angeles. Look for new calls.

Following last week's Stern-led flip from country to rock at **WBOB** Minneapolis, simulcast triple-A **KTCJ** flips to classic country.

N/T **KLSX** Los Angeles switches its weekend music from modern to triple-A, tapping former rival **KSCA** talents **Anita Gevinson** and **Julio Flores** for weekend shifts.

Modern **WHYT** Detroit is using new positioner "Modern hits of the '80s and '90s." No musical changes have been made.

Modern **KXBS** Oxnard, Calif., flips to Spanish; PD **Stephanie Rose** and staff exit.

**WDJB** (the Storm) Fort Wayne, Ind., drops modern AC for WWI adult standards as **WSHI** under new owners. PD **Trip Simmons** exits.

### MANAGEMENT: AUSTIN GROWS BEARD

**James Beard**, last GM in Louisville, Ky., at Jacor's properties, including classic rock **WSFR**, becomes VP/GM of album **KLBJ-FM** Austin, Texas and its duopoly partners.

Former **WFXC** (Foxy 107) Raleigh, N.C., GM **Chris Jones** transfers to market VP for Pinnacle's Myrtle Beach, S.C., stations including classic rock **WYAV**.

With GM **Dennis Lamme** exiting modern **WMRQ** Hartford, Conn., and SFX sisters (including classic rock **WHCN**), SFX Northeast regional VP **Manuel Rodriguez** is overseeing the stations.

### PROGRAMMING: VIRGIN NO MORE

Billboard Bulletin reports that Australian radio consultant **Ian Grace** replaces **Mark Story** as PD of **Richard Branson's** U.K. national album rocker **Virgin Radio**. Grace previously consulted the station until Story's arrival in 1995.

Modern **KZON** Phoenix PD **Bill Pugh** exits to join Jacor as OM of sports **KIIS-AM** Los Angeles and **XETRA-AM** San Diego.

**Mike Edwards**, recently OM at top 40/AC **WBHT/WMGs** Wilkes-Barre, Pa., becomes PD of modern AC **WSJZ** (Alice 92.9) Buffalo, N.Y., replacing **Steve Weirsman**.

Modern **WDST** Poughkeepsie, N.Y., PD **Dave**

**Leonard** joins sister company Woodstock Communications as VP of operations to develop Internet programming. He retains his afternoon slot. Former PD **Jimmy Buff** returns as OM/evenings. MD/morning man **Nic Harcourt** adds PD duties.

Country **WHOK/WHQK** Columbus, Ohio, PD **Jim Hayes** exits to be OM at modern/country combo **WOSC/WWFG** Ocean City, Md.

### PEOPLE: SYNDIEMANIA!

Classic rock **KSEG** Sacramento, Calif., picks up **Mark and Brian's** syndicated show for mornings. **Roy Kinji** joins as promotion director from the same at crosstown AC **KYMX**. In other syndicated morning news, modern AC **WKSI** Greensboro, N.C., picks up the **Bob and Sheri** show. And with modern **WDGE** Providence, R.I., picking up **Mancow** (Rock Airplay Monitor; April 18), former morning man **Scratch** moves to middays. **WKSI** also hires **PJ** for middays from nights at crosstown album **WKRR**.

Album **WFYV** (Rock 105) Jacksonville, Fla., morning team **Lex Staley** and **Terry Jaymes** move to album **KTXQ** (Q102) Dallas for the same. Co-owned **WFYV** will be the first affiliate of a planned morning syndication network.

Arbitron has flagged classic rock **WCKG** Chicago afternoon host **Steve Dahl** for a January World Wide Web site mention of the survey. Dahl's posting said, "The fall ratings come out today, and I'll let you know tomorrow how I fared. I hope lots of [my] fans got diaries for Christmas, if you know what I mean." Now we need to see if he gets cited for his latest comment, carried in The Chicago Sun-Times: "Hey, the cool part is that this gets it mentioned again in the paper! Now everybody will know how important those [diaries] are."

## Mainstream Top 40 Hatches More Of Its Own Hits; Triple-A Supplying More, Too

songs to mainstream top 40 as country. R&B radio, which was barely able to start any records toward mainstream a year ago, had struggled into contention. It's down slightly now.

Mainstream top 40 was first outright to chart En Vogue, Real McCoy, OMC, Erasure, and the second Spice Girls single. It was tied on Jewel, Gina G, Wild Orchid, Crystal Waters, Hanson, "Wannabe," Celine Dion, and, assuming you count only its current, post-"Jerry Maguire" incarnation, Bruce Springsteen's "Secret Garden." Mainstream and adult top 40 were tied on "Secret Garden" this time, although adult top 40 charted it separately two years ago.

Rhythmic top 40 was first on Blackout Allstars, Babyface, Mark Morrison, BLACKstreet's "Don't Leave Me," Az Yet, Joose, and Crystal Waters. It was tied on "Wannabe," Monica, R. Kelly, Wild Orchid, and Gina G.

Triple-A was first on seven songs, more than twice the three songs it claimed possession of six months ago. It was first to chart the current hits by the Wallflowers, Paula Cole, Sheryl Crow, Duncan Sheik, Counting Crows, and U2. It tied with modern and adult top 40 on the current INXS.

Adult top 40 was first on two acts, Savage Garden and the Cardigans. Its ties included Springsteen, INXS, Hanson, Celine Dion, and Jewel. Mainstream AC was first on Jon Secada and tied on the current Celine Dion. (Six months ago, it also had one outright first—Streisand and Adams—and a tie on "Change The World.")

Modern was first on four songs and first including ties on five; that's down a hair from four and six last fall, and still off sharply from 10 outright and 12 with ties a year ago. It was first on "Don't Speak," White Town, Luscious Jackson, and Leah Andreone, with a tie on INXS. In a graphic illustration of the much-vaunted "changing face of modern," all but one of those songs are rhythmic in nature. By comparison, the songs started by modern for top 40 a year ago included hits by Everclear, Oasis, the Foo Fighters, the Gin Blossoms, and the Red Hot Chili Peppers.

Mainstream R&B was off from three starts, five with ties, six months ago to two starts, four with ties, this time. Its starts were "No Diggity" and Keith Sweat's "Nobody." Its ties were Monica and R. Kelly. Adult R&B, which was also tied on R. Kelly, was first on both Toni Braxton singles—"Un-Break My Heart" and "I Don't Want To."

### TO THE SHORES OF TRIPLE-A

So what's changed over the past six months?

• Mainstream top 40 was already starting to realize the power of records it could own, and labels began to respond in kind. And while some of the songs owned by mainstream top 40 (or by mainstream and adult together) may not have sold in the same quantity as R&B or multiformat titles, it helped the format's cause that there were at least enough successes last year that "mainstream top 40 record" was no longer synonymous with "turntable hit."

• PDs in adult top 40's modern AC camp have become more aggressive during the past six months. That may be because as the format and the buzz around it grew, they felt more comfortable reaching deeper into the triple-A world for music. It may be because so many albums by established artists ran their course so quickly last fall that they had no choice. In any event, the news was good for Duncan Sheik, the Wallflowers, Paula Cole, et al.

• Despite the R&B-to-top 40 stats, mainstream top 40 seems more willing to take a chance on R&B music; it just seems to prefer that it not come from R&B radio. Of the seven songs that rhythmic top 40 charted first, one, BLACKstreet's "Don't Leave Me," is a mainstream R&B record that rhythmic top 40 just happened to get to first. Most of the others—Babyface, Mark Morrison, Joose, Crystal Waters, Az Yet—are poppier R&B records that got some, but not as much, support on the mainstream R&B side. Rhythm-crossover radio had a handful of those a year ago (Coolio's "1-2-3-4," Tony Rich Project's "Nobody Knows," Color Me Badd, 3T), but only the Quad City DJ's fit that category last fall.

### Top 40 Vet Philips Strives To 'Own The Artists From Day One' At Modern 99X

**B**rian Philips was a veteran of the top 40 trenches when top 40 WEGX (Eagle 106) Philadelphia was blown up under his watch. He landed at WNNX (99X) Atlanta, which had just made the then-daring switch from top 40 to modern. Now OM of WNNX and a Pollack Media Group consultant, Philips recalls being in Atlanta during Eagle 106's last and 99X's first days. "I'd been to a [99X] in-store and was impressed with the look of the audience. We were trying to sort out top 40's problems, and I re-

their stations get out of balance with too much of a certain kind of product."

Modern, too, is at a crossroads. "What more can happen to this scene?" asks Philips. "The lead singer to the founding band of the whole ideal shoots himself. Stone Temple Pilots are trying to balance a touring schedule with rehab, and Soundgarden decides it's time to go separate ways... We're looking at a new generation of bands that are certainly experimenting with a lot of things, but there's no cohesive galvanizing scene... There doesn't seem to be a central mass-gathering point in pop music or new rock music right now."

99X is proactive on the musical front, with Philips embracing the likes of Dave Matthews. "Things that you previously would've written off as being too soft or adult in appeal have proved to have huge constituencies 18-24," says Philips. "Our objective is to build our future around bands like Live, Counting Crows, Wallflowers, Dave Matthews. Those are artists who write well and produce deep albums... Our greatest emphasis is on sorting out these bands based on their potential to [stay] with us for the long run."

The fact that most of those acts have become core album acts doesn't bother Philips, who says WNNX owns those acts "by playing them first, by going deeper, and by establishing intimate relationships with the artists that stations in other formats simply can't hope to do. The station's credo is 'Own the artists from day one.' We always knew that if we were successful, somebody would come in and start cherry-picking our best bands."

On the other end, Philips doesn't see another owner trying to aim a modern AC his way. "I don't know if a competitor looking to shift to modern AC wouldn't assume, quite correctly, that we are so well-entrenched with so many of the images that make up modern AC that there has to be a more practical thing to do in Atlanta."

Here's a sample hour on WNNX: Blind Melon, "No Rain"; Third Eye Blind, "Semi-Charmed Life"; Sneaker Pimps, "6 Underground"; Smashing Pumpkins, "Muzzle"; Psychedelic Furs, "Love My Way"; Foo Fighters, "Monkey Wrench"; U2, "Mysterious Ways"; Bush, "Comedown"; Abra Moore, "Four Leaf Clover"; Red Hot Chili Peppers, "Higher Ground"; and the Wallflowers, "One Headlight."

A perennial thorn in modern's side, talent development, was tackled by Philips from day one by creating a successful local morning show. "We didn't go into this with the idea that we just need to be somehow competitive in the morning or that we needed to just put something on that was compatible with the music in the morning," he says. "We went in with the idea that we needed to kill in the morning. And that's our objective, more than just passing the time of day until it's time for retro-lunch... The idea was to have a big enough morning show to steal people away from other Atlanta morning shows and not mind if we lost them at 10 a.m. or if they didn't have a natural affinity for the music. Then at least we had a good entertaining morning show, and we were competitive."

"We just did a focus group a while back," he says. "We in the business say this about radio stations all the time: 'It has to be more than a radio station.' But when you watch a listener through the glass say, 'All the other stations are just radio stations, and 99X is so much more than that.' That's what you live for. That's the kind of thing that makes you stop and consider how much fun and how rewarding this whole project has been. When people are able to verbalize something like that and understand that that is what we're trying to do, it's a great moment."

member thinking this looked like a bright idea for attracting a desirable young audience.

"We're so used to it now, but the idea of this music being used to build a contemporary commercial format was an unproven, if not completely new, idea. I remember conference calls from Philadelphia with other CHR programmers when this station flipped to modern and everybody thought they'd lost their mind. 'How bad could things have been at Power 99 that they thought that was a good idea?' Which, in retrospect, is pretty funny."

"I remember sitting in Philadelphia looking at [SoundScan numbers for] Nirvana and Pearl Jam and talking to [Steve] Kingston in New York and going, 'My God! Look at these bands out of nowhere, with no airplay. Who are these people?' and then trying to find a way to make those records fit on Eagle and [WHTZ New York]. That was a real challenge, because they were bumping up against CeCe Peniston records. It was an ugly time."

Now Philips uses crosstown top 40 WSTR (Star 94) as an example of how the rest of the country has changed. "I remember a record guy throwing up his hands over 'Good' by Better Than Ezra and saying, 'You know, we can't get this record played at Star. They just think it's too alternative.'" Since then, top 40 has gone through three phases, he says. "The first phase is 'Better Than Ezra's 'Good' is too alternative for us.' The second phase was 'We'll play 99X's songs after they're established hits, but we'll still allot six weeks of lead time for 99X to establish them as their own.' And the third phase is, 'We'll put Meredith Brooks on the day the envelope arrives with the record in it.'"

While modern is now safe for the masses, Philips sees today's top 40 as conservative. "These stations are different beasts from what they were even in the early '90s," he says. "A record like U2's 'Discothèque' at the top 40 I remember would have immediately been embraced even if it didn't ultimately prove to be a big top 40 hit. Just the sound of it, the excitement of it, the fact that there's a new U2 record that has strong pop overtones... I'm surprised at how safe and conservative this current run of top 40 is. I think part of that means they'll be less likely in the future to try to grab things from us until they're proven. They have been burned a few times by letting

### Living And Dying In L.A. Redux

Rarely has anyone come away from Los Angeles feeling indifferent about it. On *Naked's* self-titled debut album, the unique nature of the sprawling metropolis is broached once again. Notes singer/guitarist Jonathan Sheldon. "There's so much money in such a concentrated area. People can surround themselves in a certain way that is disconnected to what goes on in the rest of the world. Because of the entertainment business, the fantasy's heightened, the decadence is multiplied."

Sheldon's family moved from Pittsburgh to L.A. when he was 6, affording him an outsider's viewpoint, past the city's surface glamour. "I think if you're from L.A., you often tend to think that this is the way the rest of the world thinks. It is fully an anomaly. It's not the normal situation for people."

What is the norm in L.A., however, is the constant influx of musicians from all over the world. *Naked's* bass player, Damon Martin, comes from Washington; drummer Petur Smith is a native of Iceland; and guitarist Jeremy Ireland ventured down from Northern California. The three guitarists, who had crossed paths on other projects, joined up in 1994; Smith came aboard after they signed. Pooling \$5,000 from service jobs, they recorded a three-song demo in three months. The tape landed with former Gasoline Alley owner Randy Phillips, who brought the group to Red Ant

when he signed on as president/COO. Although Sheldon cites Echo & the Bunnymen, U2, and the Cure as influences, *Naked* recalls American heartland rock more than early-'80s new wave, although there is an element of U2's soul searching in its lyrics.

Sheldon feels an obligation to establish more dialogue in contemporary music. "I think what's lacking in a lot of the music today is a sense of critique, criticism, a talk or a conversation about the world we live in. A lot of [today's] music is quirky and interesting, but it's self-reflective or apathetic. I think we're a reaction to that."

Sheldon says the single "Mann's Chinese," which is about the quest for deeper meaning amid the modern world's superficialities, is based on the time he spent living around the corner from the famed Hollywood theater. Sharing a low-rent apartment with his guitar teacher's brother and without a car, the songwriter spent lots of time walking the area. He remembers the lingering, unsettled feeling of watching

the dilapidated boulevard magically transformed into an ostentatious, red-carpet gathering place of the stars whenever Hollywood would shut down the street and premiere its latest blockbuster-to-be. That dichotomy drives the song, echoing Sheldon's own feelings of displacement. "A lot of people come here and don't really put their finger on what it is they're missing or why they feel detached."






