Rebuilding A Heritage Rocker By Balancing Old And New

So you just got that new gig as a PD of a heritage rocker in a major market. How do you pilot it successfully into the new millennium, especially if you're dealing with a station that's been seriously dented in recent years by the fragmentation of rock radio?

That's the question facing John Duncan, who recently inherited the PD seat at KLOS Los Angeles, which sat at a 2.2 in the spring Arbitron. Ultimately, he says, the goal is to be true to the call letters. While KLOS made a much publicized stab at redefining itself as an active rocker, "it's a mistake to keep the calls and clear the slate. If you have a shot at taking a heritage station back to where it's been in the past, the calls are the most valuable commodity you have."

Duncan's first ally in reconciling the KLOS calls and their heritage was the Mark and Brian morning show. "They are, in my view, the kingpins upon which the rest of the radio station must be built. It was vi-

tal to get to know them and to hopefully earn their trust and respect."

Beyond the morning show, Duncan has been re-evaluating the station's talent needs. "The station had been changed dramatically and was an active rock station [with] very good active rock people but not right for a heritage station," he says. "Heritage people can be a great strength or a great weakness, depending upon their attitude, their energy level, their willingness to work hard and long to win, and how much they were able to maintain their name and reputation amongst a target audience."

Duncan adds, "I'm in the enviable position to have lots of great talent available in this market, with lots of great heritage associated with them. So there's a lot of people I can choose from if we're going in that direction."

Duncan says that heritage isn't merely in the audience's perception; it's something that can live in the halls of the station itself. When it

Evergreen/Chancellor Merger Finally Closes

Following shareholder approval, the long-awaited merger between Evergreen Media Corp. and Chancellor Broadcasting Co. was formalized Sept. 5.

Upon completion of all other pending deals, Chancellor Media will own 99 stations in 21 markets. **Jim de Castro** is COO. **WKQI** Detroit senior VP/GM **Larry Wert** becomes senior VP of operations. Viacom's **Bill Figenshu**, Chancellor's **George Toulas**, and **John Madison**, who effectively rejoins the company from PolyGram Group Distribution, have been named regional VPs. Veteran top 40 PD **Steve Rivers** has been named chief programming officer for the new company; he was essentially handling those duties for Evergreen.

Other new titles: **Steve Streit** is now VP of AC programming; **Bev Tilden** is VP of marketing; and modern adult **KXPX** Denver's **Skip Weller** becomes VP/regional manager. And as **KLOL** Houston VP/GM **Kathy Stinehour** heads to her new GM post at classic hits **WAXQ** (Q104.3) New York, **KLOL** GSM **Brian Purdy** is tapped as her replacement.

In other corporate news, **Jacor** picks up **Dr. Laura Schlessinger** syndicator Synergy Broadcasting for \$71.5 million. Also, Cumulus, owner of modern **WRXR** Augusta, Ga., picks up top 40/AC combo **WZNY/WBBQ**, for a total of five stations in the market.

Just when you thought **Hicks, Muse Tate & Furst** could go no further into broadcasting, the company has committed \$100 million to form a new company that will acquire, build, and manage broadcast towers.

Modern **WXSR** Tallahassee, Fla., GM **Dave Lowe** exits.

PROGRAMMING: PHILLY MAXES OUT ON MODERN ADULT

The long-expected flip of classical **WFLN** Philadelphia to modern adult **WXXM** (Max 95.7) occurred Sept. 5. DeMers Programming is consulting the station, which is also getting input from sister classic hits **WMGK** PD **Dan Michaels** and sister album **WMMR** PD **Joe Bonadonna**. Former crosstown modern **WPLY** (Y100) PD **Chuck**

Tisa is programming coordinator. Westwood One VP of marketing, promotions, and communications **Ted Kelly** will oversee marketing and

promotion for all four Greater Media Philly properties, including its three rockers.

The first hour of the new format featured **Sheryl Crow**, "A Change Would Do You Good"; **Cyndi Lauper**, "Girls Just Wanna Have Fun"; **Third Eye Blind**, "Semi-Charmed Life"; **Savage Garden**, "I Want You"; **the Cure**, "Friday I'm In Love"; **Dave Matthews Band**, "Crash Into Me"; **No Doubt**, "Don't Speak"; **the Mighty Mighty Bosstones**, "The Impression That I Get"; **Prince**, "Little Red Corvette"; **the Wallflowers**, "The Difference"; **Meredith Brooks**, "Bitch"; **Live**, "Turn My Head"; and **Gin Blossoms**, "Hey Jealousy."

Veteran programmer and consultant **Bob Chrysler** joins LBJ-S Broadcasting as director of programming, overseeing the company's five Austin, Texas, properties, including album **KLBJ**, modern **KROX**, and triple-A **KGSR**.

Modern **KQRX** Odessa, Texas, PD **Frank Hall** is upped to station manager, as recently arrived **J.J. Toons** takes PD/mornings from his most recent gig as album **KLFX** Killeen, Texas,

APD/MD/night jock. Meanwhile MD/middayer **Shaun Slaughter** and afternoon host **Jammin' Joe** swap shifts.

Triple-A **WNCS** Burlington, Vt., PD/afternoon driver **Glenn Roberts** exits. **Greg Hooker** joins as PD/middays from the same post at oldies sister **WSKI**. That moves

Modern **WGRG** Binghamton, N.Y., goes soft AC, not top 40 as rumored elsewhere, according to **M Street Journal**.



Home Is Where The Heart Is For Headswim's Glendining

The house where guitarist/singer/songwriter **Dan Glendining** of **Headswim** grew up retains a lot of meaning for him. In fact, the Glendining family is inextricably tied to the development of the Essex, England, band. One of four brothers, Glendining says he was forever changed when, as a 12-year-old, he rummaged through his eldest brother's room. "I think it was just listening to my older brother's records like **the Who** and things like that," he says. This adolescent awakening stoked a period of rebellion, with Glendining casting aside his cross-country running shoes in favor of cigarettes and guitars. He also grew his hair long, which ultimately became a bone of contention at school and which, he says, was his excuse to quit at sixteen. "I was just really naughty basically: a bad child," he laughs. "I don't like authority and people telling me what to do."

Glendining didn't have to search far and wide to put together his own band. He found an accomplice in his brother **Tom**, who had taken to the drums, and the two middle brothers rearranged their shared upstairs bedroom to accommodate a rehearsal space. The Glendining brothers recruited neighborhood mate **Nick Watts** to play keyboards in 1991. A couple of years later, bass player **Clovis Taylor**, a childhood friend of Glendining's, completed the lineup after returning from art college. The quartet played around for a while and caught the attention of Sony U.K. In 1995, **Headswim** debuted with a U.K.-only LP,

"Flood." Glendining views this period as a developmental phase for the band. "When we got together, gigging was our main reason for writing those songs," he says. "We just really wanted to slap people around the face, so the album was pretty heavy. It was disappointing afterwards because we realized it was too one-dimensional."

But that disappointment was nothing compared with the devastation Glendining felt when his youngest brother, 19-year-old **Matthew**, lost a long battle with leukemia right before the album was released. The tragic event halted **Headswim**. "I couldn't write a thing, really. Every time I tried to write a song I just felt . . . there was nothing. It just didn't seem right," he says. A kindred spirit of Dan's, **Matthew** was also a prodigious artist who contributed all the artwork for **Headswim**'s first album.

Slowly, Glendining awoke from his personal and professional funk with a couple of compositions, "Devil In My Palm" and "Brother," and in so doing inadvertently fitted himself with a new-found confidence he'd previously been lacking. "It was just like sitting around playing the acoustic that I found my own voice and thought, 'I can sing,'" says Glendining. Naturally, writing songs that dealt with such personal loss and the various emotional responses he was going through initially posed an uncomfortable dilemma for him. "I didn't want it to seem like I was writing a song and benefiting from him dying. That's what stopped me in the first place," he says.

"Despite Yourself," **Headswim**'s first U.S. release, was cut in January '96 with dance producer **Steve Osborne**, who was hired for his work with **Happy Mondays** and has also done remixes for **U2**. Uplifting despite its melancholy, "Despite Yourself" weaves dreamy passages that nod to the majesty of **Radiohead** and the spirituality of **Jeff Buckley**, of whom Glendining considers himself a "very big fan." "I've always been into writing serious songs, and that's what Buckley and Radiohead are like," he says. "To be honest with you, not many bands in Britain are like that; it's all chirpy, throw-away really."

So far, **Headswim** has only done a few weeks' worth of dates this year in the U.S. with **Kula Shaker**, which leaves Glendining chomping at the bit. "I'll tell you what, man, I find it really annoying sitting around doing nothing, especially if you spend a long time writing an album," he says. "You do a tour, and you just want to carry on." Instead, Glendining's been able to pen some B-sides on his 4-track recorder in between having pints and playing pool with his old friends down at the pub.

Behind the band's first single, "Hype," is another one of the Glendining's rooms. Among the many paintings the late **Matthew Glendining** left behind was one that was inscribed with the proclamation, "The hype is as high as an elephant's eye"—a reference made by the youngest sibling about his two older brothers' touted future. "He had the same outlook as me, slightly cynical about the whole music industry thing," recalls Glendining.

comes to music, Duncan feels it's invaluable. He's been testing the library to see what's still viable, but "the harder part is to mix into that fabric the spice of the radio station that creates relief and that creates excitement and 'Oh wow,'" he says. "You have to rely heavily on the collective experience of your staff... We're fortunate to have a lot of that heritage at our disposal. MD Rita Wilde knows the market inside out and knows the music."

With KLOS having "lost the trust of the audience" through its previous changes, he says, that trust is key to bringing the core back. "You have to go back to them and admit that we screwed up but we're OK now. Then give it time. Wounds take time to heal, and this is a wound between the station and the audience."

Once the product is fixed, "marketing is essential to the successful restoration," he adds. "Just fixing the product and making it what they like again doesn't tell them that you did that. A lot of them are so disenfranchised that they don't even come you anymore, so how would they know?"

THE CHALLENGE IS OBVIOUS

Last January, album WBAB Long Island, N.Y., programming coordinator Eric Wellman was named OM. WBAB was at a 2.6 12-plus in the spring. "The challenge is obvious," he says. "How do you keep the young end interested while keeping the old end from being pissed off?"

Wellman says that before his arrival, "the station was going down the road of being [increasingly] tight on currents. We were probably headed up to the direction WNEW is in right now—if it's not an established artist with new product, we won't play it." And that, says Wellman, is a problem. "You're going to wind up becoming an oldies station, and you're going to have a niche segment that will listen because they grew up listening to you."

Now, Wellman says, the goal is "to keep the same formula that was at AOR for 25 years: The best old stuff and the best new stuff that makes sense. We haven't done extreme things on the air. A good example is Sugar Ray, 'Fly.' It's hot and happening, but we felt that that was the kind of thing that was going to drive the 45-year-old guy away. On the other hand, Sublime was definitely new and quirky, and in 'What I Got' you hear 'Lady Madonna,' and that lends familiarity to even an older listener."

Wellman sees a paradox when combing through new music for appropriate material. It's hard to tell from sales, because his core listeners, in their mid-30s, aren't an active record-buying audience. "There are some situations where we look at a John Fogerty record and know it's not going to be five-times platinum," but they'll play it nonetheless.

As for the younger end of his audience, he believes some will become fans because "this has probably been the first time... youth grew up listening to their parents' music. A 20-year-old can listen to Zeppelin and Floyd and also be open to the newer stuff... You go to the H.O.R.D.E. festival with Neil Young and see just as many 20-year-olds as 40-year-olds."

With New York rock radio going through changes, Wellman sees an opportunity to funnel in new cume. "Once we get them... we want to provide everything they want to hear. We don't want to be just one thing to them."

A GREAT TIME TO BE MAINSTREAM

When album WRDU Raleigh, N.C., PD Bob Edwards took over a year ago, he knew his station's heritage was his best ally. "WRDU certainly meant something to that 30-plus audience that grew up with the station. The image was very much burned in to the [listener] in the market. We had the idea that if we did a better job with the music, we could increase the TSL."

He says heritage means WRDU can still "feature a lot of the artists that were first exposed on the station 10-15 years ago." And being able to play everything from Queensryche to Kenny Wayne Shepherd means that "right now is a

great time to be doing mainstream rock."

WRDU was up 6.9-7.1 in the spring, vs. a 4.3 share a year ago. It got some help from the departure of classic rock competitor WZZU (the calls have since resurfaced on another frequency) and WZZU's former morning show, the syndicated John Boy and Billy. "Putting on a syndicated morning show has advantages and disadvantages, and it's a decision you have to make pretty carefully," Edwards says. "It was a black-and-white ratings decision that they could bring in more cume to the station as a whole."

Edwards feels his first allies are those that have stuck with the station throughout most of its history. "The entire focus stays on that group. It's an easier sell on those people that grew up with the station. Everything we do is with 25-44 men in mind," he says. Despite this, Edwards shies away from new music from Genesis, Paul McCartney, and Fleetwood Mac. "We play AC/DC and don't daypart," he says. "We keep the station pretty tempo-driven, whereas for the next guy down the road, the Fleetwood Mac makes a ton of sense."

Promotions are equally aggressive. In the recent Sinners and Winners sweepstakes, the winner was offered a choice between taking his wife to the Bahamas for a week or bringing his buddy with him to a brothel for a week, all expenses paid. "The music is pretty mainstream, so we use the promotions to drive a lot of the image and attitude at the station," says Edwards.

STERN RETURNS WCCC TO ITS ROOTS

At album WCCC Hartford, Conn., PD Ron Dresner's massive overhaul of the station, led by the addition of Howard Stern, has been accompanied by a 2.6-3.1 rise. (The station was at a 2.3 in spring '96.) Stern's presence has "created an awareness of the station," says Dresner. "We cannot be in the position to get out and feel good about the ratings without Howard Stern, period. He's in the paper. What other PD can say, 'My morning guy has a movie.' I can sit back only because I have Howard on the air."

Musically, they decided to follow Stern's lead. "Howard attracts 18-34 adults, and I made sure the music was in line with that, and that means being an active rocker," says Dresner. Even though WCCC has taken a very different musical route than WRDU, it's no less motivated by heritage. "In this market we're inundated by '70s and classic rock signals. There is no active. The station was known for loud rock, and we decided to go where the roots are."

Dresner contends that his previous morning show spent 6½ years bad-mouthing WCCC on the air. "It didn't help our interest overall. We had to shake that and still do," says Dresner. "I've tried to overcome it with promo liners and other positive reinforcement messages." They're pursuing events and trying to get out in front of the people as much as possible. "It takes time," Dresner says.

HART'S HOMECOMING

When Garrett Hart signed on for the long-vacant PD gig at album WDVE Pittsburgh, it was a homecoming for the Steeltown native, who grew up with the station, then followed it closely on frequent trips home. "The big challenge for me is don't screw it up," he says. "And that is my great good fortune. I don't have to fix this."

Although still No. 2 in the market, WDVE has also been fragmented in recent years by the market's four-way rock battle. Hart says he isn't too concerned. "The only change that may be necessary is to review all the systems and see how we're working with the fundamentals."


Hart favors the musical flexibility that former OM Gene Romano set for WDVE. "The success of the station is that they didn't pick a specific sound and stay with it forever," he says. "Gene never said, 'This is good enough.' The market and audience changes, and you have to respond to how that works. That's going to be the challenge to me."

MONITOR PROFILE

Consultant Constantine Takes On PD Duties At Triple-A KINK Portland

Dennis Constantine is one of those names synonymous with triple-A. The 17-year veteran of KBCO Denver left the station as VP of programming to open his own consulting firm. This past week, though, his career took a new turn with the announcement that he was named PD at KINK Portland, Ore. While he'll still be keeping the consulting shingle out, Constantine is focused on his new station and its ARS parent as he executes a move he feels is necessitated by the current ownership climate.

Looking at the gathering phalanxes of stations in each market under one owner, Constantine says, "When you have four or five FMs, you don't need to have an outside vendor [consulting]; you can have somebody in-house. You can have maybe somebody from the corporate office who is a consultant and research person. You can

actually hire somebody on your staff to be a programmer or an overseer for the entire group. So, it's made being an independent vendor a lot more difficult in the new world of consolidation. For me, it made a lot of sense to go inside one of the companies and basically work my way up."

And Constantine is assured of ARS' commitment to the station and the format. "KINK at one time was the No. 1 billing radio station in Portland. Because of the quality audience, the type of people that listen to KINK, it has the opportunity to charge a lot more for its commercials and therefore be very dominant in the marketplace. ARS recognizes this and will give the station the opportunity to capitalize on the quality audience it has."

With nearly 30 years of history, KINK is not only one of the first triple-A's but also one that stayed true to the broadest tenets of the format. Constantine says it reminds him of KBCO's heyday, and he is mindful of the heritage. "I definitely am going to be respectful of what KINK is and what they're about. My job is not to go in and change what the station is about, because there are those expectations and I strongly believe that when listeners tune in to a radio station, they need to get what they expect to get. If people tuned in to KINK and didn't get what they expect KINK to be, it would harm the radio station. I can't go in there with an agenda and say, 'I'm going to make this into a rock station or a soft rock station or a classic-leaning [station] or whatever.' KINK has its own image and its own heritage, and I'm going to be very respectful of that and basically make the station fresh and exciting in what people expect it to be."

Here's a sample hour on KINK: The Wallflowers, "6th Avenue Heartache"; Joni

Mitchell, "Snakes And Ladders"; Genesis, "I Can't Dance"; Paula Cole, "I Don't Want To Wait"; Fleetwood Mac, "Little Lies"; Pat Metheny, "It's For You"; Ziggy Marley, "People Get Ready"; Chris Isaak, "Can't Do A Thing To Stop Me"; Joan Armatrading, "Down To Zero"; U2, "All I Want Is You"; Paul McCartney, "Great Day"; Steely Dan, "I Got The News"; and Robert Cray Band, "Smoking Gun."

At least one change that Constantine is eyeing is promotions that will allow KINK to bond with listeners. "I definitely think that the station could be more promotionally involved with the community. That's one of the things that we can do... The most powerful form of advertising for a radio station is word-of-mouth, because it's a personal recommendation. The more you can personally involve people with your radio station, the stronger an advocate they become for the station. They become your evangelists, and that's really what's going to [allow] KINK... to dominate the market."

After two dozen years in Colorado, Constantine admits there will be a learning curve to understand his new market at anything close to the level of intimacy he has with the Denver area, but he considers himself a quick study. While he'll be out in the streets meeting people and listening to them, he's going to start with his own air staff. "The air staff at KINK have all been there for a long time," he says. "I'm going to talk with each person individually and really get to know their perceptions to put together a picture of what this market is like. I know that it's a very active music community there. There's an arts community. There's a lot of interesting aspects of Portland that are appealing to me, and I'm really looking forward to learning as much as I can about the city so it can be reflected in the radio station."

Constantine doesn't feel any competition breathing down his neck at KINK, primarily because most of the related formats will all be under the ARS umbrella in Portland. "[Modern AC KBBT] the Beat is an ARS station, as is [jazz] KKJZ, and we also have KUFO, which is the low-end AOR, and then we have the country station," he says. "It's a very powerful group of stations that's going to be combining forces in Portland, and I'm sure that all of the PDs are going to be working together to create a very strong story for ARS and create a situation much like Jacor has in Denver, where you can take a huge percentage of the revenue out of the marketplace with just one group of stations."

And what about joining ARS at the time of its sale rumors? Constantine is the first to say that "there's no security in radio... There's going to be a lot of mega-mergers still to come. The SFX deal shows you how big these things can get. And they'll get even bigger. And eventually, you're going to have a company like Disney or CBS that's going to have four, five to eight stations in every major market. When they consolidate, they're going to bring the best people with them. I want to be in one of those companies as part of a programming team that's going to have an effect on where radio's headed. They're going to need good programmers, no matter what company it is. And I know it could be ARS next week and CBS the following week."




