Recent Tornado, Storms Show Radio Veterans, Outlets Prepared For Worst

Tornadoes that touched down in Nashville on April 16 were only the latest in a stretch of natural disasters that have hit Birmingham, Ala., and Orlando, Fla., in the last few months alone. How does a music-intensive radio station prepare both itself and its audience in times of disaster? Programmers we spoke with pointed to the need for redundant systems and getting the information out responsibly.

Classic rock WGFX Nashville PD J.J. Duling saw the April 16 tornadoes firsthand. "We knew from the Doppler radar that it was headed this way," says Duling. Station staffers looked out over the town from the back of their building. "You could see this wall of clouds. It was unbelievable. We could see stuff blowing sideways," he says. "The whole thing just enveloped the downtown. [Growing up in the Midwest], I've been in tornadoes before, but I've never seen anything like this."

While damage was extensive only six blocks from the station, WGFX stayed on the air, suffering just a few

downed trees. Its antenna is on the tower used by a local TV station on the north side of town, and the tornadoes cut a path between the station and the transmitter, leaving both untouched.

Duling also relates that only two weeks ago he had drilled his air staff on what to do in case of a storm. "The dissemination of information is critical, as is having an air staff ready for it," he says.

THE GATHERING STORM

Radio is a necessity when it comes to the public managing its way through a storm. Long after cable lines snap and power outages render TV sets useless, a battery-operated radio can be the last link to the outside world. While stations everywhere are likely to have redundant systems, it's even more important when it's a station in a frequent tornado or hurricane area. What's more, the new technologies make redundancy systems even deeper.

Modern WKRO/classic rock WHOG/top 40 WVYB Daytona Beach, Fla., caught some of the recent

Chancellor Re-Signs de Castro, Devine

On the heels of CEO Scott Ginsburg's surprise departure from Chancellor Media last week, COO Jimmy de Castro and CFO Matthew E. Devine have signed new, five-year contracts with the company. According to a statement issued by Tom Hicks, chairman and interim CEO of Chancellor Media Corp., de Castro will also "increase his oversight responsibilities to include any and all radio stations Chancellor may acquire." Chancellor also announced that it has reached a separation and consultancy agreement with Ginsburg—the company's largest individual shareholder—under which he will resign from Chancellor's board of directors.

Meanwhile, equity researcher Bear Stearns, following a conference call with Tom Hicks, has issued a report saying Chancellor has written \$25 million in pay-for-play contracts. The report states, "We think that record companies will find this concept intriguing to (a) break an artist, (b) push important artists' releases, and (c) help an artist gain a foothold in an increasingly fragmented and competitive music industry. The company could use the strength of distribution of the 400-plus radio stations owned by Chancellor (108 stations) and Capstar (300 stations) and combined cumulative 12-plus... reach of nearly 61 million listeners and take full advantage of the economics of these 'audio infomercials.'"

The report also praises Chancellor for "in-

venting new forms of promotion on radio. Typically, movies, concerts, and trips were given out by individual stations during individual station promotions. However, the company is now developing cross-station promotions."

TRANSACTIONS: BIG CITY GETS FOUR

Big City Radio, owner of modern trimulcast KLYY Los Angeles, is at it again, picking up four suburban Chicago outlets, including triple-A WCBR Arlington Heights, Ill.

PROGRAMMING: WDRQ ON A TEAR

Modern WPLT Detroit APD/MD Alex Tear officially gets the PD slot at sister rhythmic top 40 WDRQ.

Modern KFMA Tucson, Ariz., interim PD/MD/afternoons Chuck Roast officially gets the PD nod.

Modern AC WSSR (Star 95.7) Tampa, Fla., PD Chuck Morgan is upped to director of programming for Clear Channel/Tampa, including triple-A WHPT (the Point).

Classic rock KIOO Visalia Calif., OM/PD Charlie Wolff exits. Sister top 40 KSEQ morning man Rik McNeil is acting OM for both properties.

Mahlon Moore, PD of Pacific Star Broadcasting's modern adult KUCD (Star 101.9) Honolulu, exits to program crosstown Caribou R&B oldies outlet KHUL (Kool 102.7). Packages to director of programming Jeff Silvers.

Dave Matthews Band Returns To The Top

CHART MONITOR: The Dave Matthews Band's "Don't Drink The Water" (RCA) vaults 3-1 on the triple-A chart, marking the group's second stint atop that chart. "Too Much" spent one week at No. 1 in June 1996.

Is Goo Goo Dolls' "Iris" (Warner Sunset/Reprise) poised to become the next multi-format soundtrack hit? This issue, the title bowed on the mainstream rock chart at No. 39 with 2.3 million audience impressions and on the mainstream top 40 chart at No. 34 with 7.2 million audience impressions.

Despite having topped the modern rock list for 15 weeks and falling out of the pole position four weeks ago, Marcy Playground's "Sex And Candy" (Capitol) still reigns on the rock Big Picture audience chart with 25 million listener impressions.

UNDERTOW: Back in the Oct. 24, 1997, issue, Ozzy Osbourne's "Back On Earth" (Epic) bowed simultaneously on the mainstream, active, and heritage rock charts. This issue, after 26 weeks on those charts, "Back On Earth" goes to recurrent and comes off all three charts.

Several other titles reach recurrent status this week: matchbox 20's "3 AM" (Lava/Atlantic)

MONITOR PROFILE

Modern Rocker Posts Big 12-Plus Numbers But Remains Musically Aggressive

Since it moved to a better frequency in November '97, modern rocker WRAX Birmingham, Ala., has more than doubled its numbers, up 3.5-6.0 from summer to fall and up to an 8.3 share 12-plus in the second winter Arbitrend. In a market that has been without a true mainstream top 40 for years, WRAX's determinedly broad music mix has allowed it to fill several niches. Yet at a time when many modern outlets are going more conservative to compete with modern AC and a reinvigorated top 40, WRAX PD Dave Rossi remains one of the format's most outspoken advocates of new music.

After five years of programming modern WAVF Charleston, S.C., Rossi signed on as PD of WRAX when that station was an overly wide active rocker in what Rossi calls "a very boring radio town." Rossi and Jacobs Media flipped the station modern but were hampered by a 6,000-watt signal that only half of the station's own employees could pick up in their offices. His engi-

Rossi draws from the widest possible universe. "You've got pop alternative, rock alternative, [and] adult alternative to pull from. You've got these tremendous pools of music out there, [so] that you don't have to sit there and say, 'Everything's got to sound like Alice In Chains,' and then you have Creed, Days Of The New, and five other bands that sound like that. You don't have to do that. That's a flavor. You can be diverse. And I think that's the opportunity that a lot of people [miss when they] stay under one little area," says Rossi. "There's a lot of palatable music out there. The alternative format can be the most mass-appeal format on the radio."

Here's a music monitor on WRAX: Days Of The New, "Shelf In The Room"; Candlebox, "Far Behind"; Alanis Morissette, "Uninvited"; Third Eye Blind, "Losing A Whole Year"; Dave Matthews Band, "Crash Into Me"; Morcheeba, "Let Me See"; Primitive Radio Gods, "Standing Outside A Broken Phone Booth With Money In My Hand"; Our Lady Peace, "Chimpy"; Radiohead, "Creep"; Semisonic, "Closing Time"; Tonic, "If You Could Only See"; and Jolene, "Pensacola."

When Rossi's not worrying about radio's lack of support for new acts, he worries about localism being lost to automation and satellite broadcasting. "You're basically going to have the same format with the same jock. All the jocks are going to be doing is saying 'Birmingham' instead of 'Charlotte' or 'Nashville.' It gives you that tremendous opportunity there to own the [local] position," says Rossi. "You hear about the advantage that radio's local, but radio seems like it's getting away from the local aspect, and I don't want to be part of the demise of radio. I don't want to be part of what kills radio. I don't want to give this new technology, this new type of radio, the opportunity to do what I do. I don't want to strip my radio station so bare that [a listener will think], 'Why not listen to a satellite-delivered radio station?'"

That gets back to his arrival in Birmingham. "It was almost like everybody had a truce in this market, like 'I'm not going to try my best. You don't try your best. You just do your thing, I'll do my thing, and we're not going to after one another. We're not going to be aggressive,'" says Rossi. "Our station in Charleston was amazingly promotionally active. And I brought that here. 'Let's get out in bars. We can't be out enough. There is no such thing in my opinion as being overexposed in a market. It does not exist for an alternative radio station . . . Let's get our call letters up wherever we can.'"

Month by month a promotional calendar, which seemingly no other station in the market had thought of, according to Rossi, was built. "Two years ago, I was here for St. Patty's Day, and it might as well have been any other day of the week," says Rossi. "We implemented a pub crawl, and it's immensely successful. So we go from two years of nothing to this year being covered by the TV stations down here."

Rossi also put Romano's concept of raising listener expectations to use in the annual City Stages event for which streets are blocked off and 15 stages are set up for all types of musical performances. "That's when we whipped out our Porta-Potty giveaway," says Rossi. "We were able to position it as, 'We're the little guys, with no budget. We're going to give you what you really want. We're going to give you VIP passes, so you can VIP hassle-free at City Stages. We're going to give you your own personal Porta-Potty, so you could go whenever you want. Fuck the cars. Fuck the houses that you're never going to win. But how about a Porta-Potty for this big event that you're dying to go to?'"

Recent Tornado, Storms Show Radio Veterans, Outlets Prepared For Worst

tornadoes that passed through the Orlando area in February. They're all "digital paperless radio stations," says OM Taft Moore. "That means mirrored hard drives, and we also need CD players . . . From an engineering standpoint, it's important to have redundant systems throughout the group."

For those areas like Daytona Beach, where high winds are a given, "you need to have the extra guywires on your tower," says Moore.

And there's also the extra tower. WGFX's is in its backyard. Ironically, Duling says, "a year and a half ago, we lost our [backup] tower to a twister . . . The new stick made it through fine."

When Louisville, Ky., was beset by a tornado two years ago and endured last year's devastating floods, country WHKW was a first-person participant in every aspect. PD Dennis Hill cites an unexpected benefit of consolidation. Being part of Louisville's Clear Channel family, the station's building currently houses "four [radio] stations, plus the Kentucky News Network and an ABC-TV affiliate. For individual stations, it's kind of difficult to do what we can do here. We can pool resources. One of our sister stations is a major news and information station," says Hill. "Things that need to be passed along to the public, they'll do the computer printout and make four or five copies for everyone."

Moore tells one scary story of his station's early days in a field in a disaster-magnet trailer. There was a hurricane bearing down on the facility. Moore phoned his announcer and told him to voice-track his last hour and get out of there. "It took me five calls to the place" to motivate the guy, recalls Moore, because the announcer wasn't happy with the tracks. "I actually ended up screaming at him, 'I can no longer be responsible for your safety. You're in the path of a hurricane. You are in a mobile trailer. If it hits, you will die.'"

WE INTERRUPT THIS BROADCAST

Aside from the EAS responsibility that all stations have, most PDs will go the extra mile when natural disasters strike. "We're a very music-intensive station," says WHKW's Hill. But when the going gets rough, "you throw the format out the window."

"News and national disasters don't happen during stop sets and liner breaks and talkovers," says Moore. "This is the great advantage of radio over other media. Radio is about immediacy. I want it to be my station that they're listening to."

Especially when it comes to tornadoes, time is precious. "Usually, if there's a tornado warning, it's been spotted . . . When you have a warning, you dump out of a song. Otherwise, by the time your song fades out, somebody's dead," Duling says. "This one took about three minutes. A lot of songs are longer than three minutes . . . We will fade a song down and get it on."

Duling says new technology has widened the window. "Now, thanks to Doppler radar, you can see these things coming. You can give them 10 minutes," which, he notes, might make the difference when it comes to a worker in a high-rise office building getting to the basement.

Birmingham also recently lived through tornadoes of historic proportion. Modern WRAX Birmingham PD Dave Rossi says the weather was gathering all day, giving his station the opportunity to keep his listeners informed and prepared. As in Louisville, "there are six stations here," he says. "We have our [newswoman] that jumps on and monitors everything . . . She provides information for all six stations."

In Daytona Beach, Moore has structured his three music stations in a network situation around his AM N/T WNDB. "Because all four are networked through a newsgathering computer, my news anchors can break in programming in any stations at any point in time.

"I don't want my jocks to be responsible for telling the general public what to do. I want them handing off to my news department . . . That way, you're getting your facts from a factual source."

Other programmers note the need to stay

calm on-air. "We're careful not to overreact or oversensationalize," says Rossi. "If there is a warning, we will say a tornado has been sighted . . . We won't freak out on the air. We won't put people on chasing the storm. What radio does is it keeps people calm."

During the Birmingham storms, Rossi says, he instructed his staff to repeat the warning, run down the list of what to do in a tornado, and then play a short record and use that time to recheck radar, check the TV stations, and have the latest info by the time the record ends.

Rossi's next project is trying to set up a deal he had during his Charleston, S.C., days. He wants to find a local TV station and "hook up ISDN phone lines and put somebody over there in their newsroom as they're gathering that information and put it on the air," says Rossi. "It takes that out of our hands. We can then relay the information, but we're not giving wrong information."

AFTER THE DELUGE

Aside from guiding people as heavy weather bears down on a community, radio provides important resources in the aftermath. In response to the disasters that struck Louisville in the past two years, "we just tried to be very available to emergency crews and delivered emergency messages," says Hill. The community has "a very good emergency activation force, and they were constantly in touch with us and feeding us information as far as which creeks were going up and which roads were closed."

There's still a balance between regular and emergency programming. "You certainly don't turn into a news talk station. We're awfully music-intensive to begin with," says Duling, who spent the morning after the tornadoes hit putting local officials on-air to make important announcements about the downtown being closed.

The litmus test for Duling was, "What are the situations people might be in? Let's address those immediate concerns, making sure the majority of our time on the air goes to Red Cross and Salvation Army," agencies that were most active in helping people get their lives back together.

And lightning can strike twice, so Rossi emphasizes the need to not push people's panic buttons and manipulate the situation after the fact. He points to TV stations in his market that were tracking tornado warnings 60 or more miles away even a week after Birmingham had been hit. "They were tracking it to the Georgia border a hundred miles from here. It didn't really warrant the three hours of coverage it got," says Rossi. "Let's put the warnings out, but let's not get people going crazy."

Moore says that once the dust has settled, "we use the news department to assess the damage in terms of dollars and the human element. While we're doing that, we're thinking about [public-service] promotions." Given that his station jumps in on such campaigns "with both feet," Moore takes care to make sure enough people's lives have been touched to warrant a grand-scale effort.

When the tornadoes hit the Orlando area last February, the Federal Emergency Management Agency didn't see the Daytona Beach damage warranting any funding. But Moore's stations did. The morning teams at top 40 WYB and classic rock WHOG challenged each other to a fund-raising contest to see who could gather the most dollars to aid tornado victims. "We averaged collecting \$305 an hour," Moore says.

Less than 24 hours after Nashville was swept away in the tornadoes, Duling was already planning relief. The station's weekday \$1,000 give-away was put on hold for the two days surrounding the storm, and it's giving the \$2,000 that wasn't won to the Salvation Army. And the annual Nashville River Stages event his station is working on with PACE Concerts has also been turned into a fund-raiser. PACE "called me, and we're going to donate \$5 from every three-day pass sold."





