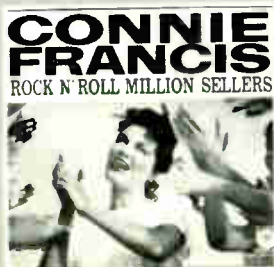

SHOWMANSHIP IN SOME POP SINGERS

An awareness of the values

On records the most striking instance of the renaissance of showmanship can be found in the work of Bobby Darin not only because he is a young singer with all the assurance, projection and casual craftiness of an old pro but—what is most remarkable—because he gained his first popularity in the rock 'n' roll scramble.

Effective

Mr. Darin made it evident that he had much more to offer than a rock 'n' roll appeal in his recording last year of "Mack the Knife" on which he followed the arrangement popularized by Louis Armstrong several years earlier and used a vocal style patterned closely on Frank Sinatra's. It was a highly effective performance but it left the listener wondering how much it owed to Mr. Armstrong and Mr. Sinatra and how much to Mr. Darin.

Any doubts that Mr. Darin can stand up on his own are dissipated by *This Is Darin* (Atco), an excellently programmed set on which Mr. Darin's musical personality comes across in casual, finger-snapping brush-Knife" much of its vitality is present once again in the out-and-out rhythm numbers, but this time without obvious borrowings. And Mr. Darin has the ability to adapt his personality to his material, subduing the flipness when it would be out of place without sacrificing a bit of the strong presence that keeps his faster numbers bubbling. He has obviously bubbled a lot from Mr. Sinatra but the thing that distinguishes him from others who have gone to the same school is the magnetic musical personality he has built on this solid foundation. This is the best work that belongs with the genre of such masters of the genre as Bing Crosby and B.

R.&B.-Pop Standards

Altho most of the following disks were originally released in the rhythm and blues market (circa 1948-1957), all of them are solid singles sales and programming items today in the pop field (mainly big cities) as well as r.&b. locations.

The list, compiled by a check of dealers, deejays and juke box operators across the country, spotlights more than 200 such platters, categorized under the year each disk was first released. Pop copies of the songs are not listed—only the r.&b. originals. All of these platters are currently available to disk jockeys and operators even tho some of the labels are inactive today as far as new releases are concerned. Particularly strong items are indicated by asterisks.

Jockeys should find this collection of r.&b.-oriented standards an interesting 1960 programming feature—a striking reminder of the transitional period during the '50's when r.&b. disks were first integrated into the pop singles field on a major basis.

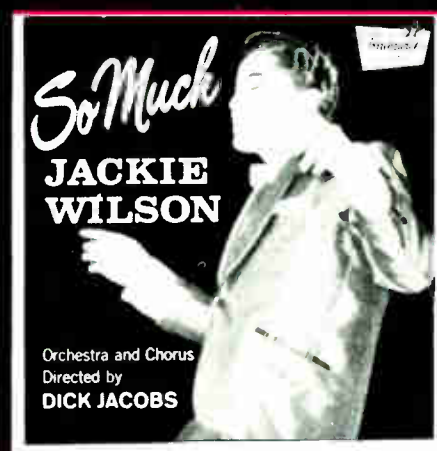

BUYERS AND BOOKERS OF TALENT will need no diagrams to tell them how valuable this compilation is, or how to use it. They have continuously requested biographical data as well as for the personal managers and booking offices or leading talent. This feature should answer these requests.
