## Adult Top 40s Defy Format Boundaries

KHMX (Mix 96.5) Houston MD Rich Anhorn recently heard a record on modern rock and top 40/mainstream stations in his market that he thought his top 40/adult station could play.

He called the label and asked for the record. And the label rep asked, "Why?"

Several weeks later, that particular song is on Airplay Monitor's Top 40/Adult chart and doesn't seem like a stretch at all. But as the line between mainstream and adult top 40 blurs, a label rep or any industry observer might be forgiven for being caught off guard by the songs adult top 40s choose. There are adult top 40 stations playing Better Than Ezra's "Good" or

Montell Jordan's "This Is How We Do It" or Live's "Lightning Crashes," none of them likely AC candidates. There are enough adult top 40s playing Nicki French, TLC, Collective Soul, and Blues Traveler for those records to have charted. In fact, only five of the songs on last week's Top 40/Mainstream chart haven't already gotten adult top 40 airplay somewhere.

There have always been adult top 40s that push the format's boundaries, especially as new listeners, raised on increasingly harder music, grow into the 25-plus demo. Now, there are many different types of stations falling into that category. Some of the edgiest adult top 40s are such stations as WKTI Milwaukee or WKDD Akron, Ohio, which have no competition in the format.

### WPLJ Goes International For A Week

**S**o if you heard extra *Take That* music on top 40/adult WPLJ New York last week, it's because the entire station was simulcast on the frequency of London's forthcoming AC outlet Heart FM. What was scheduled to be a two-week simulcast ended abruptly after Heart reportedly got nervous about a morning show caller's attacks on local personality Caesar the Geezer. PD Tom Cuddy reports having been swamped by calls and faxes, especially from expatriate Americans, and was planning to give away a trip to New York for the station's listener-appreciation concert before the simulcast ended.

Arbitron and ABC both unveil new toys this week: Arbitron's is a new qualitative service called Radio Direct, which will be unveiled in 38 medium markets next year. Besides measuring 11 retail categories, the telephone survey will also measure media usage. ABC, meanwhile, has launched a 24-hour-a-day audio news web site, which will be available to all Internet users this fall.

After months of rumors, WTIC-AM-FM Hartford, Conn., has been sold to American Radio Systems for \$42 million. The sale is subject to FCC waiver or the passage of the current telecom bill, since ARS already owns two FMs, AC WRCH and '70s gold WZMX, in that market.

GM Bill Wells is out at top 40 WDJX Louisville, Ky. No replacement has been named.

KMXV (Mix 93) Kansas City MD Jon Anthony exits as his position is eliminated. PD Steve Wall is handling music duties . . . Top 40/adult WRQX (Mix 107.3) Washington, D.C., ups p.m. driver Carol Parker to MD, replacing Linda Silver, now at WMXV (Mix 105) New York.

Former Monterey, Calif., top 40 guy Jason Silva returns to radio as APD/MD at R&B adult KSOL San Francisco. Silva was previously national director of top 40/urban radio for Scarface Records.

WSSX Charleston, S.C., is now decidedly more uptempo as it moves in an adult top 40

direction . . . KIXI/KMKX San Diego GM Charlie Seraphin exits . . . Jim Schaffer exits as OM of AC combo WMYX/WEZW Milwaukee. Jim Morales is upped to PD of WEZW, which changes calls to WAMG.

After doing middays on an interim basis, replacing Leigh Ann, KHKS Dallas APD/MD Mr. Ed Lambert apparently impressed management so much that it gave him the shift permanently. The daypart police are investigating.

KTXY (Y107) Jefferson City, Mo., PD Jay Hastings exits. OM/p.m. driver Bobby Jackson has added the PD stripes . . . At WCIL-FM Carbondale, Ill., PD John Riley turns in his stripes to concentrate on the morning show. Andrew Zepeda has been named PD and moves from nights to afternoons. Production director Rich Bird picks up middays, as midday Shawna Matthews moves to nights.

KBFM (B104) McAllen, Texas, does the air shift shuffle, as PD Billy Santiago moves from afternoons to middays, Hitman moves from nights to afternoons, and Marisa moves from middays to nights.

Former KROQ Los Angeles "Lovelies" host Jim "Poorman" Trenton guest-hosted "Desperate & Dateless" on crosstown KIIS-FM this week for the vacationing Domino.

WMGI (Mix 100.7) Terre Haute, Ind., inks new p.m. driver James Gregory . . . As satellite AC WKBC-FM North Wilkesboro, N.C., readies its new top 40 format, June Poteat from noncommercial WVTI Roanoke, Va., joins for middays. John Reilly of WTIC-FM Hartford, Conn., signs on for nights. PD/p.m. driver Joe Martin still needs a morning and overnight person.

Jobs: WRVQ (Q94) Richmond, Va., is still in the hunt for a morning show. Package to PD Lisa McKay, 3245 Basie Road, Richmond, Va. 23228. Also, WNDU-FM (U93) South Bend, Ind., midday jock David Jewell leaves the business, leaving U93 with a midday opening. T&Rs to PD/Food Services Director Bill Mitchell, 54516 U.S. 31 North, South Bend, Ind. 46638.

## TOP 40 TOPICS

### Is FM Radio The AM Of The '90s?

**W**e tend to forget that a lot of radio history is determined as much by signal strength as by programming. Look at who won the AM top 40 battles of the '60s, and—even with some great stations—the pattern you still see is often the signal pattern. Fifty thousand-watt CKLW Detroit vs. 5,000-watt directional WKNR; 50,000-watt WKBW Buffalo, N.Y., vs. 1,000-watt WYSI; 50,000-watt KCBQ San Diego vs. 5,000-watt KGB; 50,000-watt WABC New York vs. 5,000-watt directional WMCA. The only exception that springs to mind is 5,000-watt KHJ Los Angeles vs. 50,000-watt KRLA, and in that case, KRLA was directional and KHJ was the most influential top 40 of its time.

In the early '80s, R&B and country radio finally came into their own. It wasn't that the music got better. (You'd have a hard time explaining how the Supremes, Four Tops, Ohio Players, Commodores, and James Brown held R&B radio back.) Instead, R&B and country made the move to FM in most markets. At the same time, top 40 radio was pronounced dead. In reality, many of its defectors were AMs that subsequently had a hard time competing with FM in any format.

In recent years, top 40 has become a format of the signal disadvantaged. In markets from Knoxville, Tenn., to St. Louis, to Augusta, Ga., the "good" signal has gone to a country or AC duopoly partner, while the top 40 has been left to make do with less. As heritage FMs fled the format, the stations that replaced them were often suburban move-ins without full market coverage or many other resources. If top 40 was no longer a format the whole office could agree on, it was increasingly not a format that the whole office could hear—especially if it was in one of those glass-and-chrome buildings downtown.

I mention this because of an essay by Robert Unmacht in this week's M Street Journal in which he contends that what killed AM radio was not the lack of stereo, but merely inability to cover a rapidly expanding metro. Now, Unmacht suggests, FM is in for the same trouble. FM allocations were set in the '60s and '70s, when markets were smaller. Now, two-hour commutes are no longer unusual, and the likelihood of any single station being the one you can hear "at home, at work, or in the car" is decreasing, as suburban sprawl continues.

Unmacht notes that 100 stations "are already implementing a short-term fix, adding additional small stations on the fringe of the primary station's coverage area to patch together a more appropriate coverage area for

the market." Already, top 40 has been both the benefactor and victim of such simulcasts—occasionally even in the same market, as witnessed by KYLD San Francisco's addition of a simulcast partner and KHQT San Jose, Calif.'s absorption into triple-A KFOG. WRHT gave Greenville, N.C., its best top 40 book in years, but it needed WCBZ to extend its signal.

The problem, Unmacht says, is that since these stations were never meant by the FCC to fit together, there are still very few arrangements that cover an entire market. Classical KRTS Houston had a simulcast partner and yet still went dark, because neither covered downtown. Country KIKF Anaheim, Calif., and its simulcast partner in the San Fernando Valley were meant to protect each other; that's why they're aimed away from each other and why there are still pockets of L.A. where both have problems. Same for the now de-funked R&B simulcast between KACE Los Angeles and KCXX San Bernardino, Calif.

There are other problems. When stations have two sets of call letters but promote one, you can't expect both to be credited accurately at ratings time. And, as Unmacht notes, "As a listener . . . I would rather tune to one frequency that covers my market than try to remember which of the four frequencies I can hear my favorite station on when I am in a given part of town."

In-band digital radio may offer better audio, Unmacht says, but it "will only perpetuate the out-of-date allocations we live with today." He suggests that broadcasters come to grips with "a new out-of-band digital system that can be better allocated to target the economic and social areas of the country." A lot of owners won't like that solution because even if it's done within the context of local formats, not national superstitions, it still doesn't preserve the status quo that current owners seek to protect by trumpeting the sanctity of "local" broadcasters.

The problem is, of course, that when 25% of the country is on a satellite format of some sort, and the rest is being divided into ad-hoc networks and simulcasts, the sanctity of local radio is under fire from *local broadcasters*. As regional nets and national morning shows proliferate, we get closer to national superstitions of the sort that already define radio in mainland Europe. France's NRJ and Skyrock are great top 40 stations. But they constitute almost the entire format in that country. And anybody scared of that scenario here isn't going to have a very easy time defending radio's local service record when we've spent the past five years explaining why eastern Long Island is served perfectly well by simulcasts of New York and western Long Island stations.

### Hard To Be Easy



Last week, soft AC KXEZ (Easy 100.3) Los Angeles unveiled its new TV spot with former prostitute Divine Brown, who had been listening to KXEZ during her infamous liaison with Hugh Grant. Two days later, the station announced it was pulling the spot due to listener complaints. Despite being blown out at KXEZ, Brown intends to pursue other potential careers in radio, such as hook testing, affiliate relations, or creative services director.



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## Adult Top 40s Defy Format Boundaries

Some evolved from top 40/mainstream and still consider themselves part of that mind-set. Some are in the process of evolving back toward that format. Some lean modern, like KALC (Alice 106) Denver. Some are rock-flavored, like KHMX and WKDD New York. Some lean rhythmic, like KTHT (Mix 102.7) Fresno, Calif., and WYXR (Star 104.5) Philadelphia.

### WALKING A THIN LINE

So where's the line between the formats? "The only major difference between adult and mainstream top 40 is deciding whether the 18-24 demo or the 35-44 will be your secondary," says WHYI (Y100) Miami PD Casey Keating. "If 25-34 females are your target, you have to decide what side of that target would you rather emphasize. If it's the younger side, you'll more closely resemble a mainstream top 40; if it's the upper side, it's more like an AC."

"There are some records I'll shy away from," Keating adds. "For example, we'll play TLC's 'Waterfalls,' but wouldn't play 'Red Light Special,' which was a younger-feeling record. The most important consideration is, does it sound like Miami? Would it be a potential turnoff to a 25-34 female?" Keating notes adult dance records seem to do very well there, such as those by Real McCoy and Ace Of Base. "Ballads also do extremely well here: Bryan Adams, Bon Jovi, Selena, etc. . . . Rock and modern rock records are the tough ones to sell in this market . . . with the exception of stuff like Hootie & the Blowfish. Just about anything else goes, as long as it's not too young-sounding."

"It's what we don't play," says WKII Milwaukee PD Danny Clayton. "Most urban stuff won't fly here because of the heritage of WKII, which was a full-blown top 40 through the '80s that was always rock-based. We played Scorpions, Whitesnake, Bon Jovi, Journey, etc., and we still have to build on that chassis. It's easier for us to cheat on the rock side than the rhythmic side."

For KTHT PD Jon Zellner, the difference is "mostly the era . . . the average year of our station is around 1987-88, whereas a mainstream station would average in the early '90s. We spin our currents as often as a mainstream top 40, about 50 times a week. We only play about 300 titles, and many of them are older songs that work well in this market."

KALC MD Jim Lawson also says that being 50% gold and recurrents is what sets him apart from a mainstream top 40. Lawson describes Alice 106 as "the hits for females 18-34, specifically 25-34 in Denver, whatever they are, wherever they come from, period." In an open letter to the industry, Lawson, citing the station's emphasis on research, says, "Alice is whatever the listener thinks it is. You know Alice as an adult top 40. We, however, have yet to define it, even in our own minds."

He finds alternative and rock music seems to get to the mainstream faster in Denver. "We have the freedom to reflect the audience as their tastes constantly change . . . and they do," Lawson says. "Last summer, we were more urban-leaning, this summer, we're more rock-based." As far as rhythmic product goes, "We usually wait until it's top 10, with the exception of a TLC or Babyface, which our core listeners have embraced as core artists."

Wherever the line is, it changes constantly, as WKDD PD Chuck Collins notes. "Our audience has told us they want certain titles, certain textures, a certain tempo," he says. "For example, TLC's 'Waterfalls' is through the roof for us now, but perhaps as an adult top 40 or hot AC I may not have touched that record six months ago."

### KNOWING WHEN TO SAY WHEN

The other thing that sets adult top 40s apart from their mainstream counterparts is timing. WKII's Clayton says, "If we feel a record has been exposed enough on stations we share with in the market, then I feel safe playing it. I'll watch it for a couple of weeks . . . it's just a general programmer's gut sense of when a particular record has crossed over to the mainstream."

Clayton adds, "When I first heard the Dave Matthews Band, I swore it didn't belong on WKII . . . It's now my favorite record on the station. That's where stations like mine have an advantage

. . . We can wait on those fringe records and truly see if we can borrow them. We're always very quick on Bryan Adams, Bruce Hornsby, Elton John, those big artists that sound like the radio station. Sometimes when they're close to the line I need to see more evidence and live with the record in the market for a while before seriously considering playing it."

WWSN PD John McFadden, after deciding if a record appeals to a 34-year-old female, looks at sales and requests. KTHT's Zellner says, "We check SoundScan album sales, because I don't think my audience is buying singles. When TLC's album has been No. 1 in Fresno for three months and getting tons of airplay, I think it's safe to say it's sufficiently warmed up to the point where our audience will find it compatible with the rest of the stuff we're playing."

Some adult top 40 PDs will put a record in call-out before adding them. KALC's Lawson used both callout and several weeks of on-air testing before deciding that he could not only play "December," but add it as a power. WKDD's Collins, however, feels testing songs in advance is of limited use. "Call-out is going to dictate primarily familiarity and burn," he says. "For a song like 'Lightning Crashes' by Live, you're asking for trouble unless you control your call-out cells to the point of directing your music to a given audience, and I think you've already established that when set down your strategic plan."

KHMX PD Pat Paxton says, "Our salespeople sometimes hear songs on [top 40] KRBE or [modern KTBZ] the Buzz, and bring them to my attention. Most of these salespeople tend to be 30-year-old females. If they hear something they like, we tend to pay attention." WKII's Clayton says to pay attention when the 25-year-old receptionist says she likes the new Live record. "Hey, you're in the demo: What are you doing telling me what kind of music we should play?" he jokes.

### ADULT EDUCATION

As Anhorn's experience would indicate, many of adult top 40's edgiest stations say they have had a hard time educating labels on the type of record they need, instead finding themselves worked on the same records as straight-ahead ACs.

Under founding PD Guy Zapoleon, KHMX was one of the first adult top 40s to aggressively use rock crossovers. After several years of relative conservatism, Paxton is moving KHMX back in that direction because of recent research that showed "our audience [is] interested in hearing newer music." But, he says, "Many labels still aren't used to stations who try to break out of the formatic box that they become placed in by the industry. We consciously try to not place ourselves in a box. If we did, we would miss a lot of hit records." Paxton sums up the philosophy of many adult programmers when he says, "We play records on our timetable, not necessarily the timetable of the record companies."

WYXR's Knight says, "We've gone to great lengths to try to educate the record industry as to what records are appropriate on our radio station and what records aren't. We've had meetings, sent out sample hours—to help local and national reps understand what we're all about." WYXR is earlier than most ACs on rhythmic product, but is not always serviced with it. "We sometimes have to specifically ask for a record because we're not listed as a top 40 radio station. We're listed as an AC or an adult top 40 station, therefore we were only serviced with that product flow. We sometimes have promo reps not mention a record that could be very legitimate for this radio station." Thanks to the ongoing educational process, Knight says WYXR is now on most AC and top 40 mailing lists.

Even the name of the format contributes to the confusion. Too frequently, adult top 40 PDs complain that labels see the terms "adult top 40" and "AC" as interchangeable. Y100's Keating isn't sure what to even call the format anymore: "Everybody is now customizing their own radio station for their own markets for those prime demos, so who knows what to call it?" he says. "I don't even know if it's important to give it a name anymore."

## PROGRAMMER PROFILE

### Hartford Listeners Latch On To New Music And Hold On To WKSS

Precision Media's WKSS (Kiss 95.7) Hartford, Conn., rose 6.3-7.2 12-plus in the spring Arbitrums. And VP/programming Jay Beau Jones, who joined the station in October '91, attributes it to "heavy praying and a mix of targeted marketing, cautious music selection, and luck."

He'd also like to thank the listeners: "The real secret behind our success is that the audience is really in tune with this radio station. They get what Kiss is all about. This radio station and the audience have a bigger, better connection than ever before." So Kiss has become part of the fabric of the community? "Yes, and I sure hope that doesn't change."

And he'd like to thank GM/COO Tim Montgomery, who signed the station on in 1984. Montgomery is one of three principals in Precision Media, along with Boston-based concert promoter Don Law and Premiere

er and burns faster."

Here's a sample of WKSS on weekends: Rembrandts, "I'll Be There For You"; the Bucketheads, "The Bomb!"; UB40, "Red Red Wine"; Janet Jackson, "You Want This"; Dave Matthews Band, "What Would You Say"; Real McCoy, "Another Night"; Hootie & the Blowfish, "Let Her Cry"; Human League, "Don't You Want Me"; and Corona, "Baby Baby."

Promotionally, Jones says, "the rules certainly have changed in 1995. You can give away \$1,000 a day, and you'll never have enough money to be able to compete with the state lottery." By taking to the streets, WKSS has had a more lasting impact. The Gary Craig & Robin King morning show enjoys those on-the-street, in-your-face, localized promotional opportunities. "Robin King found this incredible Judge Ito look-alike," says Jones. "Gary Craig and I brainstormed how to best use the guy, then Tim Montgomery decided to use him in one of our TV spots." The result was increased street talk.

Kiss also hooked up with Rebecca Lobo, the No. 1 female basketball player of the national champion University of Connecticut team. Jones found out she was a huge Bruce Springsteen fan and arranged through some connections at Sony Music to take her to a private Springsteen concert in New York. "It was our thank-you gift to her," says Jones, and, needless to say, Lobo is now a loyal friend of the station. "She calls us all the time," adds Jones, "and actually mentioned our call letters during an appearance on 'The Jon Stewart Show.'" Jones has no idea whether that call-letter incident had any connection with Stewart's subsequent cancellation . . . Police are investigating.

The Kiss staff is an interesting balance of industry veterans and relative newcomers. Craig has been in the market for about 12 years and was hired away from WTIC-FM in February '93. King started at Kiss as evening personality, later moving up to afternoons and middays, then pairing with Craig shortly after he was hired. In December '94, Jones hired Christine (aka Tina Simonet from KZFM Corpus Christi, Texas) for M1/middays. Jones, who does 1-3 p.m. himself, notes that the Spring midday numbers show her No. 1 18-34. "Basically, I'm riding Christine's coattails. I figure by the time the listeners realize she's gone, it's time for Jeremy Savage."

Savage is another station veteran who worked with Jones at WAAF Worcester, Mass., years ago and has been with Kiss since the beginning. Savage was named VP of operations last year and oversees all day-to-day operations, as well as assists in the marketing of the station, which, because of its strong signal, does promotions virtually statewide. Michael Mays has been with KISS since December 1991, and does nights. Jones recently inked "Artie The One-Man Party" from WMME Augusta, Maine, for late nights. KEVIN CARTER

Talent's Frank Barsalona. Montgomery, Jones says, is "one of the best top 40 GMs in the business. He knows this market and knows instinctively what needs to be done to reach our listeners from a marketing standpoint."

Kiss' spring success comes at a time when new modern rock rival WMRQ "has taken audience away from everybody, both of the AORs primarily, and probably us and [top 40 rival] WTIC-FM," according to Jones. It also comes at a time when WTIC-FM—which has just been sold to American Radio Systems, owners of crosstown AC WRCH and '70s outlet WZMX—has gone increasingly adult. "TIC-FM is clearly now a hot AC, targeting 25-54s. They've made that clear to the market, clear to the advertisers, and clear to the promoters," Jones says.

That leaves WKSS free to work the rhythmic side of top 40 and, according to Jones, to own the nightclub position in Hartford. "We're the only station in the market playing Diana King, Nicki French, and powering 'Waterfalls' by TLC. We consider ourselves the top 40 of the market. Listeners in Hartford, Jones says, "latch onto music faster than I've seen anywhere else I've worked. For some reason, music becomes familiar much quicker."

### WTIC Gets Santa To Help Beat The Heat

**T**he Red-Hot Summer of '95 has, so far, turned out to be just slightly hotter than the hinges of hell, creating discomfort and tragedy, especially in the Midwest. In many markets where the temperature hit record highs, promotions directors got busy brainstorming and helped turn the heat into a positive promotional opportunity.

WTIC-FM Hartford, Conn., tied in with Shady Glen, a chain of ice cream shops, to give away ice cream to overheated listeners. The Kelly and Kline morning show celebrated Christmas in July by playing Christmas music and the usual prerecorded artist holiday greetings and having some poor bastard dressed as Santa appearing at Dunkin' Donuts locations. The mornings news stories were embellished with a winter flair, and the weather reports included the outside wind-chill factor and information about the Department of Transportation being out sanding the roads. Kelly and Kline also kept listeners' pets cool by sponsoring their annual dog wash, with all proceeds to benefit animal-based charities such as We Adopt Greyhounds, and Protectors of Animals. The event was held at a local pet store, with vendors supplying all the pet shampoo, towels, gift certificates, and dog food. Other station clients were on hand to give away beverages. Promotions director Jennifer Berg also notes that N/T WTIC-AM

sponsored a two-hour Christmas-themed ice-skating party featuring Christmas music, holiday-wrapped gifts for attendees, another poor bastard dressed as Santa, and free TV coverage. ("And finally tonight, some wacky DJs at a local radio station," etc.)

KQKS (KS104) Denver promotion director Ross Prout slid into action with Waterworld—a local water park, not to be confused with the movie or with Wally World). KS104 is giving away a cool summer wedding at the park. Major client J.C. Keepsake jewelers provided the rings and served as a registration point. The station also traded for flowers, a wedding dress, and tux. Following the "I do's," the couple will reportedly go down the water slide together to properly inaugurate their new life. Value-added section: On the July 4 weekend, KS104 gave away passes to "Waterworld," the movie, and Waterworld, the park.

WZEE (Z104) Madison, Wis., promotions director Leigh Smith says the station's morning team gave away 25 pairs of lift tickets to the Skyline ski area, which is scheduled to reopen in November. The station also helped turn down the heat by simply giving away cold, hard cash. As soon as the outside temperature reached 104 degrees, the 104th caller won \$104. The weather forecast was recorded off Z104's N/T AM station and played back over the FM. Listeners started calling in and counting off the temperature as

it got closer to the money mark.

WHTZ (Z100) New York is coping with the intense heat on the city streets by giving away beverages out of the Z100 Hunvee, the station's urban assault vehicle. This street-based promotion gave promotion director Theresa Beyer a chance to promote sampling opportunities for a wide variety of beverage clients, including Orangina and Naya bottled water, as well as tie in with the rollout of Royal Crown's new Draft Cola. The giveaway consisted of about 10 cases at a time at various locations around the city,

and paper cups and hitting the city pools and parks. KGGI passed out 99.1 Cool Cones, summer T-shirts, and free passes to the local water parks. The cost of the entire weekend was about \$100, but the station was able to hit about 15 different locations and estimates that the jocks were able to press the flesh with about 4,500 listeners.

WXLK (K92) Roanoke, Va., PD Chris Taylor tied in with the heat wave by jumping into a Get Wet Weekend. K92 gave away tickets to Emerald Point water park in nearby Greensboro, N.C., the TLC "CrazySexy-Cool" CD featuring "Waterfalls," and tickets to "Waterworld" (a whole water theme, get it?). The water park passes and movie tickets were traded for mentions, as were the "Waterworld" movie tickets through one of the local movie theaters.

Chicago was particularly hard hit during the heat wave. On the first day that the temperature hit 100 degrees, WPNT (100.3) gave out 100 hand fans to listeners. It also bought three air conditioners: One was given to a nursing home, which was then pressed into service as a cooling center for elderly neighborhood residents. Another air conditioner was donated to a domestic shelter for abused women and children, and the third was given to a listener in a random on-air drawing. Community relations liaison Jeanine Baddoo and morning-show producer Cameron Sullivan note that the Steve Cochran morning show also set up a lemonade stand in front of the Wrigley Building, and instead of charging a quarter for a cup, they gave away the lemonade and a quarter to every parched listener who stopped by the busy Michigan Avenue location. In a touching effort to focus community attention on the special needs of the elderly during the heat wave, Cochran reminded listeners daily, "Don't forget to water your old people."

Under the 99 Days of Summer umbrella, KGGI also sponsored a Cool Weekend, for which it helped landlocked listeners beat the intense desert heat by renting a couple of sno-cone machines, flavored syrup,

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


