Which Format Starts The Most Hits? Surprise! It's Adult Top 40

What format sends the most records to mainstream top 40? With that format in yet another state of transition, a lot of label folks find themselves asking that question again. So Airplay Monitor did the math, looking at each record on last week's mainstream top 40 list and where it charted first. And the results are startling.

Modern rock, to nobody's surprise, is the starter format for a lot fewer songs than it was six months ago. But, surprisingly, the same goes for rhythmic top 40, too. The format that charts the most mainstream top 40 hits first is adult top 40, followed by mainstream itself. R&B radio, which had a hard time crossing anything over six months ago, has a little easier time of it now.

Adult top 40 stations were the first to chart nine of last week's mainstream top 40 titles outright. If you count ties with other formats, it was first on 13 altogether—or nearly a third of the chart. That's an almost complete reversal from six months ago, when adult top 40 could be said to have started only two

records outright, "Because You Loved Me" and "Insensitive."

The role of adult top 40 in breaking records is something its label reps can feel good about. For years, they had to fight the industry perception that their format wasn't musically aggressive at all. Even when hot AC became more active, it was still thought not to start records of its own but merely to cherry-pick mainstream top 40 after songs had been warmed up there.

Adult top 40 was first by at least a week to chart Merrill Bainbridge's "Mouth," Donna Lewis' "I Love You Always Forever," Celine Dion's "It's All Coming Back To Me Now," Journey's "When You Love A Woman," Seal's "Fly Like An Eagle," de Taal's "Just Between You And Me," the Wonders' "That Thing You Do!," Hootie & the Blowfish's "I Go Blind," and Bryan Adams' "Let's Make A Night To Remember." Ties are Eric Clapton's "Change The World," Hootie's "Sad Caper," Madonna's "You Must Love Me," and the "Grease" Mega-Mix.

Mainstream top 40 was first on Alanis

FCC Looks At Mancow; Chancellor Changes

The Chicago Sun-Times reports that **WRCX** (Rock 103.5) Chicago morning host **Mancow Muller** is under investigation by the FCC in regard to two indecency complaints and one hoax complaint. The latter came from the Chicago police, who responded to a broadcast last May in which a caller claimed a bomb was planted in Lincoln Park.

George Toulas is upped from executive VP/regional manager to senior executive VP at Chancellor Broadcasting, adding duties at the group's Long Island, N.Y. stations and New York's **WHTZ** (Z100). Also, VP/regional manager **Skip Weller** adds the Long Island and Pittsburgh properties to his duties.

SFX Broadcasting and Multi-Market Radio have completed their previously announced merger: MMR president **Mike Ferrel** becomes president/CEO at SFX, the surviving entity. Former MMR chairman "**Cousin Brucie**" **Morrow** is expected to enter into a two-year consulting agreement with SFX. However, at press time, there were indications that SFX's deal for EZ Communications' Charlotte, N.C., stations was about to unravel.

WWMX (Mix 106.5) Baltimore PD **Todd Fisher** replaces **Bob Davis** in the long-vacant PD position at top 40/adult **KSTP-FM** Minneapolis.

KSFM/KMJI Sacramento, Calif., VP/GM **Jerry McKenna** adds responsibility for ARS sister stations **KXOA/KQPT**.

Russ Morley (ex-KDMX Dallas) is now OM/PD of **WMC-FM** (FM100) Memphis, replacing **Chuck Morgan**. Morley will be OM of N/T **WMC-AM**.

Former **KSOL** San Francisco PD **Russ Allen** is named PD of R&B **WJHM** (102 Jamz) Orlando, Fla., replacing **Duff Lindsey**. His first job will be finding a co-host for new morning host **Ms. B** from N/T rival **WTKS**.

After four down trends, **KQMQ** Honolulu PD **Jamie Hyatt** moves the station from dance to an R&B lean, head-to-head with **KIKI** (194). Elsewhere, mix-show guy **Kutmaster Spaz** takes nights, replacing **Jimmy the Geek**.

WIMJ Harrisburg, Pa., has dropped AC and is stunting with Christmas music. Also, **Boyd Arnold** replaces **Ron Roy** as GM of **WIMJ** and oldies sister **WWKL**, following an LMA-to-buy that takes the station from Barnstable to Dame Media.

KZFM Corpus Christi, Texas, promotes veteran midday jock **Ed Ocanas** to PD, effective Dec. 2, as **Charlie Maxx** and her husband relocate to Greenville, S.C.

Middayer **Rich Bird** is named permanent PD at **WCIL** Carbondale, Ill., replacing **Andrew Zepeda**, now programming **KLYV** Dubuque, Ill. **WCIL** p.m. driver **Brian R. Powell** adds production director stripes, and news anchor **Clark Lance** is upped to ND, as **Joey Helley** returns to OM duties.

As tipped here several weeks ago, Spanish broadcaster El Dorado Communications is unloading its LMA'd stations in Dallas, **KRVA-**

AM-FM and **KTLR-FM**, to Z Spanish Radio. El Dorado's other three LMAs in Houston—**KOND**, **KEYH**, and **KLVL** should be unloaded by the first of the year.

KNRV Killeen, Texas, PD **Joey Armstrong** exits. **Dan Watson** is acting PD, while consultant **Larry Kent** looks for a replacement.

Longtime **WJET** (Jet 102) Erie, Pa., PD **Neal Sharpe** is named APD/MD/promotions director at Nationwide's **WNCI** Columbus, Ohio, replacing **Dan Bowen**.

Darrin Stone, PD/MD of classic rock **KRQC** (Q92) Monterey, Calif., and interim MD of sister **KDON**, is named APD/MD/afternoons at **WABB-FM** Mobile, Ala.

Former **KIIS** Los Angeles p.m. driver **Chuck Nasty** is official in mornings at **KHOM** New Orleans. The Nastyman replaces **Bill Dutrey**, who will end up on another Clear Channel station. **KHOM** taps **Reggie Louque** from **WLSS** (Loose 102) Baton Rouge, La., for station imaging and to fill nights for now.

Artist **Jim Brickman** teams with **WLTW** New York's **Valerie Smaldone** for a new ABC Radio Networks weekend show, "Weekend Morning," due to debut Jan. 4.

WHYI (Y100) Miami returns to its personal **WPLJ** New York talent bank this week, picking up **Chris Marino** for late nights. Y100's last full-time hire, afternoon jock **Kenny Walker**, was also procured from **WPLJ**.

After a brief stint at AC **KQMB** Salt Lake City, **Geronimo** resurfaces at cross-town country outlet **KUBL** (K-Bull 93) as MD/middays.

Classic rock **WOZZ** Green Bay, Wis., morning host **Ken O'Brien** follows PD **Terri Dugan** to adult top 40 rival **WQLH** (Mix FM) as MD/afternoons. Former MD **Kenny D.**, stays on as morning producer.

WZYP Huntsville, Ala., PD **Marc Summers** moves from middays to afternoons, replacing **Steve Wayne**. Night jock **Mindy Madison** moves to middays, leaving **Summers** in search of a night jock with MD skills.

KHHT (K-Hits 107.5) Denver APD/afternoon jock **Steve Douglas** has apparently turned down his transfer to overnights, as the station makes room for the incoming **George McFly**.

WXEG (the Edge) Dayton, Ohio, promotions director **Raye Kimberlain** goes to co-owned **WBTT** (the Beat) as MD.

KISX Tyler, Texas, welcomes **Joey Combs** from **KHKS** Dallas for overnights.

WKXJ Chattanooga, Tenn., hires **Storm Bennet** (ex-WOCQ [OC104] Ocean City, Md.) for afternoons, replacing **Chad Elliott**.

Hot AC **WIAL** Eau Claire Wis., loses midday/promotion director **Becky Nichols** to cross-town country **WQRB**. Former **KFMS** Las Vegas promotions staffer **Tiffany Hanson** replaces **Nichols**.

As former **WFLZ** Tampa, Fla., night jock **Bubba the Love Sponge** readies his debut on co-owned **WXTB** (98 Rock), Mr. Sponge is now showing up in the middle of records and spots on 98 Rock to comment on them.

The Aircheck Moment: For You And Posterity

A few nights ago, I was listening to an aircheck of **WMMS** Cleveland from fall '94, shortly after it switched to modern rock. **WMMS** sounded great then. There was enough energy for any two top 40s, not a lot of slacker affectation, and, most important, songs I still remembered two years later—something that has traditionally been in short supply on 2-year-old modern rock airchecks.

Even then, I had a suspicion that somebody else would have enjoyed those tapes more than I did. The next morning, I called former **WMMS** PD **John Gorman**, who has now been job hunting for several months, to ask if he needed tapes of his own station. Not surprisingly, Gorman told me that he hadn't taped **WMMS** at the time—he was always more worried about what would be on the station next and, like a lot of PDs who suddenly find themselves in the same situation, just hadn't devoted any energy to it.

There are, I guess, a lot of PDs who would be in the same situation tomorrow if their jobs went away, either because of the new regulatory environment or the old "philosophical differences." Besides the time crunch, which is only worse now—Gorman was programming two stations for much of the last few years—there's a tendency to never be satisfied with your own station. Some of the most ardent aircheckers I know still have to be badgered relentlessly to provide me with tapes or listen lines for their stations. In roughly the same way that nobody ever really likes hearing the sound of their own voice over the telephone, the tendency to hear mistakes on your station that the public doesn't notice means that there are very few times PDs recognize their stations as clicking on all cylinders.

During my year-and-a-half programming adventure at **WGCI-AM** (Dustyradio 1390) Chicago, I was guilty of this, too. I've got three scoped C-60s on the station, but I don't have a lot of the things I was proudest of—i.e., bringing in **Tyrone Davis** for the end of Daylight Savings Time, so that he really could turn back the hands of time, or most of the special weekends, for that matter. Who, after all, had time to tape every weekend? And there was a lot that I wouldn't have wanted to save for posterity; despite this, however, one of my friends still

has a tape of one of the **WGCI** jocks mulling a taped bit with a caller and proceeding to air it anyway. That this took place well after I left the station was cold comfort, especially when my friend began circulating this around the industry like the "nine" tape or some other aircheck collectors' fave.

Between the perfectionist thing and the time thing, it's amazing that any documentation of this industry takes place at all. A few top 40 stations of the '50s, '60s, and '70s were heavily airchecked, even when that required recording off-the-board at the station itself instead of any nearby boom box. Many other stations weren't, and the situation with country or R&B radio is much worse. Finding a New York airchecker with tapes of **WWRL** or **WHN** from the '70s instead of **WABC**, **WXLO** (99X), and **WWDJ** is next to impossible.

Ask folks who were in the industry in the '70s or before about their airchecks and they're rarely closer than the attic or garage. As likely, they're at a parent's house or long discarded. There are also the PDs who felt that keeping their airchecks meant living in the past. Or that airchecking is meant only for radio geeks, a stereotype that I realize I've done nothing to combat here by admitting that I listen to airchecks at home. (I was weeding them down, OK? I'm still clinging tenuously to last year's promise about spending more time in the real world—even though the same friend who is circulating the **WGCI** gaffe tape tells me that the first issue in any 12-step program is to stop lying to yourself.)

But even if you don't have any interest in airchecks for posterity, or even if you recognize that documenting your career through airchecks is not the same as, say, taking pictures of your kids growing up, chances are you don't have enough of either, and it's probably the same procrastination at work. Besides, it's a lot easier to reach over to the aircheck machine on your desk than to get the kids to sit still for pictures. And if 18 years in a family can fly by like nothing, think about how many radio jobs you're likely to have in that time—especially amid this new hysteria. If only as a tool for yourself, now is the time when the changes in radio most need to be documented and when we are least likely to do so.

Morissette's "Head Over Feet," No Mercy's "Where Do You Go," En Vogue's "Don't Let Go (Love)," La Bouche's "Fallin' In Love," Jewel's "You Were Made For Me," and Wild Orchid's "At Night I Pray." Add the "Grease" record, Clapton, Madonna, and "Sad Caper," and you get 10 records altogether, or six that charted first exclusively at mainstream top 40. Six months ago, mainstream's score was two exclusives—the BoDeans and Voice Of The Beehive—or eight counting ties. And the BoDeans title was, of course, an oldie at the other formats that might have started it.

The top 40/rhythm-crossover format was first to chart four records, six with ties. No Mercy, despite being a dance record, did not start there, but Amber's "This Is Your Night" did. Then again, five R&B records either charted first at rhythm-crossover or charted at top 40/rhythm and R&B simultaneously. The Quad City DJ's "C'mon N' Ride It (The Train)," Ghost Town DJ's "My Boo," and New Edition's "Still In Love With You" all charted first at rhythm-crossover. Toni Braxton's "You're Makin' Me High" and R. Kelly's "I Believe I Can Fly" charted simultaneously at mainstream R&B and rhythmic top 40.

By contrast, rhythm-crossover was first on 11 records six months ago, making it either first, if you don't count two ties at modern, or second. At least five of those titles were considered pop/dance, including Everything But The Girl, two La Bouche hits, Billie Ray Martin, and "Macarena."

As for modern rock, it was also first on four songs—six with ties. The four are No Doubt's "Spiderwebs" and "Don't Speak," Primitive Radio Gods' "Standing Outside A Broken Phonebooth With Money In My Hand," and Republica's "Ready To Go." The ties are Sheryl Crow's "If It Makes You Happy" and R.E.M.'s "Bittersweet Me." In late May, modern started 10 records exclusively, 12 including ties, giving it twice the influence it displays now.

Even triple-A and mainstream rock had more influence six months ago. At that time, mainstream was first on three hits, five including ties, among them "Everything Falls Apart," "The World I Know," and "Hook." This time, mainstream was first only on Dishwalla's "Counting Blue Cars." It was tied for first on the R.E.M. hit.

Triple-A's count was three exclusives and five with ties. The exclusives were Blues Traveler's "But Anyway," Wallflowers' "6th Avenue Heartache," and John Mellencamp's "Key West Intermezzo." The ties are Crow and Clapton. Six months ago, its count was four and six—and that doesn't take into account that Monitor didn't have a triple-A chart until earlier this year. If it had, some titles might have gone to triple-A instead of modern.

R&B—if you count mainstream and adult together—was also first on four, or six with ties. It was first on Keith Sweat's "Twisted," R. Kelly's "I Can't Sleep Baby (If I)," Blackstreet's "No Diggity," and (courtesy of the R&B adult format) Toni Braxton's "Un-Break My Heart." The ties are on Braxton's "High" and Kelly's "Fly." That's not so encouraging, but it is an improvement over May, when the only records to chart first at the format were "Killing Me Softly" by the Fugees and "Count On Me" by Whitney Houston.

Mainstream AC had one exclusive and one tie. The song that charted first was Barbra Streisand and Bryan Adams' "I Finally Found Someone." The tie was Clapton. We didn't tabulate AC for six months ago, as mainstream ACs hadn't been broken out of the adult top 40 chart till a few weeks prior.

Country, in case you're curious, isn't represented at top 40, but there is, for a change, a country hit being worked to top 40. Shania Twain's "If You're Not In It For Love (I'm Outta Here)" was serviced to top 40 due to its success at KALC Denver.

BARELY A DIFFERENT FORMAT

The influence of adult top 40 on the mainstream chart might surprise those who didn't realize just how much the format has changed. But the fuzziness of the line between mainstream and adult top 40 has been evident for a while. After all, most mainstream top 40s have considered 18-34, not 12-24, their target for years. And even though adult top 40 doesn't use this liner much anymore, it was once the format that played "no rap and no hard

rock." Unless you count Dr. Dre's appearance on "No Diggity," there were no rap records on mainstream top 40 last week and nothing that can conceivably be called hard rock.

In truth, adult top 40 has been the industry's comfort zone for the better part of the past six years. And with the modern rock revolution having cooled, mainstream top 40 seems to have retreated to its comfort zone again, especially as adult top 40 becomes hipper.

Some of adult top 40's new aggressiveness can be attributed to the rise of modern AC, although many of the records that broke at the handful of key modern ACs are hardly modern records. "I Love You Always Forever," "Mouth," and "Just Between You And Me" are all thought of as songs that got an early initial boost at modern AC, but none are by artists with a modern image or base.

In fairness, it must be pointed out that most songs charted at adult top 40 only a week or two before the mainstream top 40 chart. The one significant exception is the year-old "I Go Blind," which was on the adult top 40 chart for 14 weeks before it charted at mainstream top 40.

Despite this, a clear pattern emerges of adult top 40, led by a few modern ACs, replacing modern and triple-A as the place labels build a base for mediumweight pop/rock records. Some of that is because modern is trying to set itself apart with harder (or rappier) records. Some of it is because, with some label reps now hearing from radio that a modern base is a liability, the type of records that were already sort of poppy for modern 12-18 months ago—i.e., Jewel or Morissette, aren't even being worried to modern now.

WHAT DOES TOP 40 OWN?

There's been a lot of talk in recent months—at least since modern's influence at top 40 began to taper off—about "pure pop" again becoming the core sound at top 40. Proponents of that theory cite everything from Bainbridge and Lewis to "Where Do You Go," meaning that "pure pop" is simply anything that doesn't come from the modern or R&B camps.

Mainstream top 40 was, during its doldrums, thought to have few indigenous records and certainly few real hits of its own. So it's significant that a quarter of last week's top 40 chart either charted first (or tied for first) at mainstream top 40. However, none of those songs were records that exist *only* at mainstream top 40. Two of those titles, the La Bouche and Jewel songs, had previous runs at other formats—without charting—a year ago. And of the three titles that charted mainstream top 40 without charting anywhere else, at least two have already midcharted.

As for pop/dance songs, it's hard to say which format they belong to. The fact that No Mercy charted first at mainstream while Amber started on the rhythmic side says there's still no real pattern. So what did rhythmic top 40 chart first? Mostly R&B records either at the same time or a week before mainstream R&B charted them. (That was also true six months ago, though there had been a bigger handful of R&B songs R&B radio had rejected—i.e., 3T, Tony Rich, Coolio's "1, 2, 3, 4"—at the time. Only the Quad City DJ's now falls into that category.)

If rhythmic top 40 didn't get to have its exclusives for long, R&B radio certainly did. Blackstreet's "No Diggity" and Keith Sweat's "Twisted" were on the mainstream R&B chart 13 weeks before charting at mainstream top 40. While R&B crossovers have a slightly easier time than they did a year ago, the bigger difference may be that the few R&B records that do cross over can count on going a little further. "Twisted" and "C'mon N' Ride It" are top 10s that might have peaked in the teens a year ago, judging from the fate of similar crossovers such as "This Is How We Do It" and "Freak Like Me."

As for modern crossovers, their journey from modern to mainstream—when it can be negotiated—is often lengthy these days. While "Don't Speak" crossed almost immediately, it's the exception. It was also the third hit by an act whose first two crossovers were exceptionally hard fought. "Ready To Go," which needed 13 weeks at modern to even chart mainstream, is considered a more typical pattern these days.
