Winter Arbs: AC Nabs Former Country Listeners Before T40 Can

Whatever Monica Lewinsky may have done for President Clinton, she didn't do much for news/talk stations this past winter, judging from Airplay Monitor's national Arbitron winter numbers. AC stations, however, had their best book in nearly four years, apparently benefiting from country radio's misfortunes. R&B stations were off slightly—with upper-demo losses that suggested the increasingly hip-hop-driven nature of the format might finally be exiling some adults—while rock and top 40 were flat.

N/T stations had a good fall book and no reason to expect anything but a better winter. But N/T, while still the leading format in Arbitron's 94 continuous-measurement markets, was off 16.5-16.2 12-plus this winter. It was down in all dayparts except midday, where it was up 17.1-17.3. While that could mean that Rush Limbaugh and all midday talkers were benefiting from Interngate,

that 17.3 share is only two-tenths higher than where the format was in winter '97 and winter '96.

The No. 2 format, AC, was up 14.4-15.1 for its best book since fall '94, although that's still short of the 17-18 shares the format was commanding before its slide began in the mid-'90s. AC was up in every daypart. It was off 8.8-8.5 in teens, news that won't disturb any AC sales manager, but up in every other demo, including 18-34 (15.7-16.7), 25-54 (16.7-17.7), 35-64 (16.1-17.0), 18-plus women (18.9-19.8), and men (10.7-11.4).

A couple of things seem to be happening on the AC front. One is that AC, not top 40, seems to be the beneficiary of country's ongoing decline. Country was off 10.3-9.8 12-plus this time. The country slide, which seemed to stabilize several books ago, was the sharpest since winter '96, when the format lost an entire share. Country had its lowest number since summer '90, which was also the last

Silberman Joins Top 40 Airplay Monitor

Airplay Monitor has named veteran music and radio journalist Jeff Silberman managing editor of Top 40 Airplay Monitor. Silberman, who will be based in Los Angeles, replaces founding Top 40 Airplay Monitor managing editor Kevin Carter.

Silberman has been regularly reporting on the music business since 1978. Most recently, he was editor in chief at Network 40; he previously held a similar post at Hitmakers magazine

for two years.

Over the years, Silberman's work has appeared in such trade and consumer publications as Billboard, the Chicago Tribune, The Hollywood Reporter, Daily Variety, BAM magazine, The L.A. Weekly, The L.A. Reader, Music Sound & Output, Music Connection, and Rock It magazine. He also wrote three episodes of "The Cutting Edge" series, which appeared on MTV in the early '80s.

Silberman, who begins his new position June 1, is one of several recent appointees at the Airplay Monitor publications, joining recently named national chart manager Linda Silver and marketing manager Rob Accatino.

Star 100.7 Gives Johnson GM Nod

Moves from PD to GM are fewer and farther between these days, but long-time KFMB-FM (Star 100.7) San Diego PD Tracy Johnson is named VP/GM for that station and N/T KFMB-AM. He'll continue to serve as PD of Star 100.7.

HEFTEL NABS S.D., FLIPS N.Y.C.

After weeks of speculation, Heftel has finally announced the purchase of Jacor's top 40/AC combo KKLQ (Q106)/KJQY San Diego for \$65.1 million. The two stations will flip to Spanish-language formats around July. Despite the sale, WXRM Fort Myers, Fla., APD Dave McKay is named PD at KJQY, assuming duties that had been handled by the particularly busy Todd Shannon (who remains PD of Jacor top 40s KHTS and KKLQ).

Meanwhile, at press time, Heftel was stunting in preparation for the launch of a tropical Spanish format on brokered ethnic outlet WNWK New York. The new Caliente 105.9—the name translates to "Hot"—was set to go head to head against WSKQ (Mega 97.9) under GM David Martinez and PD Tony Luna from WCOM San Juan, P.R.

In other business news, despite rumors that they would be sold to Hicks-Muse, the five Pulitzer Publishing radio stations, including AC KKLT Phoenix, go to Hearst-Argyle Television. Meanwhile, look for Capstar to close on the SFX stations May 29 with a takeover June 1. That's also when that Chancellor Media will LMA the Pittsburgh SFX outlets, including modern adult WDRV (the River) Pittsburgh, until it can finish acquiring them.

COAST GUARD FINDS RADIO STUNT UNMENTIONABLE

The idea was to attract cross-dress...uh, cross-dress from other formats: The New York Daily News reports that WKTU New York's plan to stretch "bras across the Hudson" was shot down by the Coast Guard, which said the stunt would interfere with local commerce. WKTU had collected 10,000 bras from celebrities, including Gloria Estefan, Naomi Campbell, and Celine Dion. The bras were ultimately headed to California sculptor Nicolino for a bra tapestry in Washington, D.C., to raise awareness of breast cancer. Hamilton ended up using the bras to parasail down the Hudson on May 21.

PROGRAMMING: KQKS ADAPTS CAT

Longtime WJMN (Jam'n 94.5) Boston APD/MD Cat Collins is the new PD at crossover KQKS (KS107.5) Denver, replacing Rick Stacy, who stepped down to concentrate on mornings.

Bill George is the new PD of modern adult KUCD Honolulu and classic rock sister KKLV (98 Rock). He was previously PD of jazz WSJZ Boston and AC WWL Providence, R.I.

KQKQ (Sweet 98) Omaha, Neb., PD Michael

Steele will now concentrate solely on PD duties for classic rock sister KZFX (the Fox). MD JJ. Morgan is overseeing things for now with some help from Bill Richards Consulting's Mark Todd. Meanwhile, longtime morning host Rockett will move to one of KQKQ's AMs as a talk host.

Suburban Washington, D.C.'s WINX isn't the only AM station looking to top 40 for answers. The M Street Daily reports that KOHO Honolulu, now silent, will return in June as a rhythmic top 40, something not in short supply on FM in that market. The station will be known as Party Radio, under GM/PD Ira Littman.

PD Bob Laurence exits AC KGBY (Y92) Sacramento, Calif. . . . AC KLSY Seattle PD Bobby by Irwin exits to relocate to Colorado.

KYLZ/KMMG Albuquerque, N.M., PD Mark Allen exits the rhythmic top 40/adult R&B combo. KPRR (Power 102) El Paso, Texas, PD John Candelaria, who was originally thought to be his replacement, becomes OM for Clear Channel's five El Paso stations.

MD Peter Oleshchuk (who goes by the air name Bob Jackson, at the probable behest of his station's voice guy) is upped to PD at AC WHMS Champaign, Ill., replacing Paul Kraimer. Steve Khachaturian, morning man at N/T sister WDWS, is now GM for both stations, replacing Rick Atterberry.

Joe Abby, most recently PD of WJXY Myrtle Beach, S.C., before its switch from country to top 40, becomes PD/morning man for Cumulus modern rocker WBZF Florence, S.C., as well as PD for three sister stations: AC WMXT (Mix 102), oldies WFNN, and classic rock WHSC (the Fox).

Jerry Clifton is now consulting KXHT (Hot 107) Memphis; the crossover outlet was signed on last year by Steve Smith. Dr. Michael Lynn, most recently with country WDSY Pittsburgh, is helping OM Chris Taylor at KXHT, following last week's departure of PD D-Rock.

PEOPLE: INDUSTRY MOURNS MORGAN

Sorry to report that Los Angeles radio legend Robert W. Morgan, 60, most recently the morning host at oldies KRTH L.A., lost his lengthy battle with lung cancer May 22. Morgan, who retired in January, was part of the legendary '60s air staff at L.A.'s KHJ. Long thought of as the template for morning men during top 40's AM heyday, Morgan's oft-acerbic on-air style, relatively gentle by the standards of the time, was also a clear forerunner of Don Imus in the early '70s and, by extension, an entire generation of more controversial jocks. Morgan was a former Billboard air personality of the year winner.

When P/T Steve Kelly celebrated his last shift on modern adult KKPN (the Planet) Houston by announcing that several Spice Girls had been killed in an Australian plane crash, he was on his way to nights at KAMX (Mix 94.7) Austin, Texas. KAMX rescinded its offer after word of the stunt

Twain's Country, Pop, And Now Rhythmic

RADIO BENETTON AD: Shania Twain's "You're Still The One" continues its assault on the pop side with a debut at No. 40 on the rhythmic top 40 chart. A majority of the 14 stations playing the track are spinning the dance version. Of course, stations in country strongholds, including Texas markets KTFM San Antonio, KPRR El Paso, and KZRR Corpus Christi, are playing the original version . . . Speaking of hurdling format boundaries, K-Ci & JoJo's "All My Life" bows on the adult top 40 chart at No. 40, which is telling, given the trouble rhythmic titles often have on a chart dominated by modern-leaning outlets. The last R&B title to cross to the adult top 40 chart was Janet's "Together Again." In the past year, there's been only one other R&B crossover—if you count Mariah Carey's "Butterfly." In 1995 and '96, there were nine R&B crossovers . . . Specialty programming on long holiday weekends usually upsets regular rotations, thereby making returns rebound and hampering the number of new debuts. But Memorial Day didn't have the usual adverse effect on the charts. There are four new debuts on mainstream top 40 this week.

AND NOW THE BIG FIVE: Seagram is to buy PolyGram for \$10.6 billion from Royal Philips Electronics. The merger of Seagram's Universal Music Group with PolyGram's music unit will create the world's largest record company, with a worldwide market share of 23% and revenue of \$6.1 billion. Seagram president/CEO Edgar Bronfman Jr. said cost savings of \$275 million to \$300 million could be achieved from the merger and that the process would take two years.

MUSICAL CHAIRS: After 10 years as Tommy Boy's VP of promotion, 40-year industry vet Mike Beccu will retire at the end of June. He began his radio career at legendary top 40 WMGM New York before shifting to the record side of the biz. When he was MGM Records' New York local, Beccu says, the first notable records he worked were Connie Francis' "Who's Sorry Now" and the Champs' "Tequila." Beccu worked for Polydor, Avco Embassy, Smash/Mercury, and ABC Records, where he rose through the local ranks to become national promotion director. Beccu also spent 14 years at RCA as national promotion director under five label presidents. RCA's West Coast crossover promo dude, Jack Cyphers, relocates to New York from San Francisco to replace Beccu at Tommy Boy.

Look for Crave VP of promotion Lisa Wolfe to exit that label in June; she will remain with Sony Music in an as-yet-undetermined capacity . . . Island VP of singles promotion Linda Murdock joins Craig Lambert's new Trauma team as VP of promotion on June 8. Her last day at Island is May 29 . . . Mercury's Maria Aronis is upped to senior director of national pop promotion . . . Atlantic ups David Burrier to the newly created post of director of artist development. Burrier will focus on tour activities and college and progressive marketing . . . Maverick's Detroit regional, Chad Brueske, will move to Philadelphia to fill A&M's vacant mid-Atlantic regional promotion gig.

Congratulations to Elektra's Greg Thompson, whose wife, Andrea, gave birth to Marissa Kelly Thomas May 18. And best wishes to Virgin's New York regional marketing director, Andi Turco, who weds King Crimson vocalist Tony Levin May 30 in Woodstock, N.Y.

FOR THE RECORD: KPTY Phoenix (602-423-9255; PD Rick Thomas, MD Eric Valdez) joins Monitor's rhythmic top 40 panel this week. New to the mainstream top 40 panel are WZAT (Z102) Savannah, Ga. (912-925-8007; PD/MID David Allen), and WKSL (107.5 Kiss FM) Memphis (901-375-9324; PD Chris Taylor, MD Robin Cole). WMBX (Mix 102.3) West Palm Beach, Fla. (561-616-4600; PD Kevin Callahan, MD Jeff Clarke), joins both the adult top 40 and modern adult panels.

got out, although he reportedly has other offers.

At WPXY Rochester, N.Y., night jock/assistant MD Mike Danger gets the MD nod, replacing J.J. Rice, who was named PD of nearby WWHT (Hot 107.9) Syracuse, N.Y., last week. Late-nighter/research director/music coordinator Norm on the Barstool adds assistant MD and assistant production director stripes. And the station adds morning sidekick Krista Bettino, who held similar duties at oldies WHTT Buffalo, N.Y.

Meanwhile, at co-owned modern adult WZNE (the Zone), PD Rick MacKenzie moves himself from middays to mornings, teaming with local newswoman Wanda Miller. Kate McLean joins the station for middays from AC rival WRMM. KBOS (B95) Fresno, Calif., PD Steve Wall puts

himself on the air at 2-4 p.m. With late-nighter Dennis Martinez exiting for KCMG Los Angeles, afternoon host G-Man is now working 4-8 p.m., while night jock Mr. Clean is now on 8 p.m.-midnight. Mixer B. Down takes over midnight-3 a.m., while creative director Travis is now doing 3-6 a.m. P/T Lisa Huzar exits for rival KSEQ.

At adult top 40 WXLO Worcester, Mass., morning newsman Frank Foley becomes the morning anchor, joined by Joanie Ciani, most recently with WSJZ Boston.

KMZQ (Lite 100) Las Vegas promotion and marketing director Jo Sorrell is relocating to Washington, D.C. New PD Burke Allen needs her replacement, as well as a morning producer and jocks for nights and overnights.

Mr. James Builds His Dream Format As Cleveland Rocks To Adult Top 40 WMVX

Every few years, a new station redefines the parameters of adult top 40, usually by playing oldies that today's 25-44 audience loved as currents but that weren't considered remotely AC at the time. With modern AC's recent growth spurt, adults have gotten used to hearing rock'n'roll on an AC station lately, but it's still unusual hearing "You Shook Me All Night Long" by AC/DC or "Rock And Roll All Night" by Kiss played at adult top 40.

But just before the last phase of the fall '97 Arbitron survey, former WRQX (Mix 107.3) Washington, D.C., PD Randy James flipped Jacor's mainstream AC WLTF Cleveland to WMVX (Mix 106.5), a music-intensive, gold-based, and unusually hard-rockin' adult top 40. By the winter, WMVX—which uses the positioner "greatest hits of the '80s, '90s, and '70s"—was up 3.3-5.7 12-plus, No. 6 in the market.

Cleveland has a long history of hot ACs that rock, from WGAR-AM in the '70s to WMJI in the early '80s. It also has an undeniable musical heritage, much of it centered around legendary album rocker WMMS. But James researched the format for the first time two years ago at

mention the '70s last, unlike most stations that play the '70s, '80s, and '90s? "[Because] the '80s was the most important decade, the '70s were second, and then the '90s. The '70s are mentioned last and a little inverted to get attention and because of the advertising axiom that the first and last thing said are the most important," James explains.

Here's a sample hour on WMVX: Prince, "Raspberry Beret"; Crowded House, "Don't Dream It's Over"; Elton John, "Saturday Night's Alright For Fighting"; Journey, "Lovin', Touchin', Squeezin'"; Tonic, "If You Could Only See"; T'Pau, "Heart And Soul"; Police, "Roxanne"; Rod Stewart, "Tonight I'm Yours (Don't Hurt Me)"; Daryl Hall/John Oates, "Family Man"; matchbox 20, "Push"; Scandal, "Goodbye To You"; and Styx, "Come Sail Away."

That James is able to play both "Pour Some Sugar On Me" by Def Leppard and "Possession" by Sarah McLachlan on the same station says a lot about the legacy of WMMS and its multiple identities over the past 25 years: WMMS was the top 40, the classic rocker, the rock station, and the alternative station. It was everything [to everybody], and it could be at the time ... But then fragmentation came along, and they made some moves that were questionable.

"We've been told a lot of times that we are what WMMS should be sounding like today. I don't know that I agree with that, but it's interesting that it's being said. It tells me that a lot of what we're doing is on target, because there's a huge dissatisfied cell out there of 25-44 adults that were listening to other stations by default," James says.

Unlike many PDs, James says he looks for currents that fit with his library, rather than vice versa. At the moment, there are only about 10 to 14 of them, something that hasn't made Mix very popular with some label reps. But, James says, that could change, depending on how the market evolves. WMVX did play Celine Dion's "My Heart Will Go On" at its peak but was off it quickly. When Jacor's Midwest hot ACs made the decision to run a joint "\$5,000 song of the day" giveaway this spring, those sort of choices led to a two-hour conversation among the nine stations involved, most of which also lean toward rock but don't play "Cleveland Rocks" by Ian Hunter. "Celine was a record that everyone wanted to play, and I said, 'I just can't, guys,'" James recalls.

Besides the cash giveaway, Mix's promotion has thus far consisted of a month of strategically placed TV spots. In addition, James says, "we're very high visibility on the streets, but we don't clutter up the airways with it. We just go out and own events that we feel are necessary to own." The station's recent "Seinfeld" party drew 3,000 listeners and was covered on not only the NBC affiliate but also the ABC outlet.

The no-clutter approach extends to the "Mix Most Music Morning," during which Julie Fox plays at least nine songs an hour and leans heavily on service elements. While that type of morning show is rarely thought of as a market leader, James says that the morning is third in demo behind classic rock WNCX's Howard Stern and R&B WZAK's Tom Joyner. And while James says that Mix will eventually need to go more foreground in mornings, that's more likely to mean playing seven songs an hour rather than none.

For now, James says, "I feel like I'm 10 years old. This is the format I always wanted to do. I think it would work in any town that has a rock background ... as long as there's a heritage rock station that was larger than life and is now gone." And while the trend these days may be toward specialization, "I've never been to a focus group or research project where the listeners said they didn't want variety." SEAN ROSS

WRQX, about the time that mainstream top 40 WWZZ (Z104) came to town and took some of the 12-plus tonnage that Mix 107.3 had controlled by default.

James saw an opportunity to combine the three "core sounds" in an adult's frame of reference: '70s classic rock, the MTV '80s, and today's modern crossovers. While some modern AC PDs contend that adult tastes are now current-driven, James says, "If you want to be strong with 25-54 adults, you can't be playing a lot of new music all the time. I was more looking for the foundation"—the '70s and '80s gold that helped shape listeners' current tastes.

James arrived in Cleveland in September, launching WMVX in October even though the station's auditorium test wasn't on the air until the following month. Unlike most top 40 and AC stations, the station's target is 25-44 adults, not just 25-44 women. "I've always believed this is an androgynous society. It's not like it used to be, when men and women were so opposed in their musical likes and dislikes ... The audience is 55%/45% women to men, but I don't focus it on women. It's very male friendly."

So in an era of specialization, are other stations targeted too narrowly? "If you keep researching research that's been researched, eventually you're going to get down to some narrow cell that you're going to serve, but it's extremely small. Does this leave us wide open for attack? No, because we're approaching this very differently from what's been done before."

That means a lot of detail work, including spending three hours a day on the music log, as well as making sure the '70s and '80s oldies are carefully staged. (The station uses several voice talents.) And why does WMVX's positioner



time it was below double digits. And it's not that far from the 9.2 where the format started its rise in 1989. Its teen number—again in a demo that few stations target—was down 5.8-5.2, its lowest number in that demo since summer '91.

Part of country's decline is explained by the smaller number of stations: As faltering country outlets exit the format, not all their listening is being reclaimed by rivals. Last fall, 257 country stations were rated in the continuous-measurement markets. This time it was 250. And that's down from 319 in summer '95.

Then there's the recent musical changes in the format. Country PDs have refocused their efforts on upper demos, adding more gold and more midtempo music, and yet 25-54 and 35-64 were down more sharply than 18-34. That reinforces the claims of some PDs that younger demos are, in some cases, more enthusiastic about hearing some oldies again than older listeners. But those drops, coupled with AC's gains and recent programming changes in both formats, suggest that an increasingly perky and current-driven AC may be claiming the "new, uptempo, but adult-friendly music" franchise that made country such a potent force in the early '90s. It also suggests that some of the adults who might normally be making their way back to top 40 are stopping at AC (or adult top 40) on the way.

AC STUNTING TOP 40'S GROWTH

Top 40, which fell sharply during the fall after six months of growth in early '97, was again flat in the winter, holding at an 8.2 share 12-plus. Top 40 was up slightly at nights (11.6-11.8), in teens (30.2-30.7), 18-34 (12.2-12.4), 35-64 (4.1-4.2), and adult women (7.6-7.7), but was off in 25-54 (6.6-6.5) and adult males (5.4-5.3). While the format may not be getting cannibalized by adult top 40 and modern AC stations that differ from top 40 by only a few titles, those formats have managed to stem top 40's growth.

HIP-HOP HITS R&B'S UPPER DEMOS?

R&B had been on a major growth spurt, with one record-setting book after another since early/mid '96. This time, it's off one-tenth, 11.9-11.8, a figure that includes both mainstream and adult R&B outlets.

R&B had its highest teen number ever but was flat 18-34 and off 25-54 (11.4-11.1) and 35-64 (9.3-9.0). It was up in nights (18.4-18.7), an-

other best-ever number), but flat in mornings and off in middays (9.3-9.0). When you break out numbers for adult R&B stations, they remain solid in 25-54 (holding at 5.1). Now consider that many mainstream R&B stations are more hip-hop-driven than ever and that some of the stations that would normally move most rap out of middays when the kids go back to school didn't do so last fall. If mainstream R&B is losing in 25-54 and middays, perhaps mainstream PDs need to reconsider their dayparting.

(It's worth noting that if you look at 35-64, it's mainstream R&B that holds firm and adult R&B that was off sharply, 5.4-4.9. Then again, mainstream R&B's number in that demo, 4.1, was already small to begin with. And, unlike somebody in the 25-34 cell who can listen to either mainstream or adult R&B with equal comfort, 35-64s have more likely chosen one camp or the other. Jazz stations, in any event, were up 3.0-3.2 12-plus, their first good book since summer '96, suggesting that they might also be picking up a disenfranchised R&B listener or two.)


BAD DAY FOR FLAT ROCK

Rock formats were flat or down slightly this time out, with album rock holding at a 6.8 share 12-plus (still tied for its second-lowest book since we started the national Arbitron survey 10 years ago). Classic rock slipped one-tenth of a share (4.7-4.6). Modern rock, which has also been solid at a 4.1 for the last year, was finally off slightly 4.1-4.0.

As with top 40, we've believed for the past few books that the new modern adult stations were stunting modern AC's growth but not cannibalizing its existing numbers. This winter, modern was up slightly in 25-54 and 35-64 but off in teens, which suggests that the recent musical softening by some modern rock outlets has made the format's demographic profile a little older but hasn't had much effect overall.

In other format news, Spanish tied its best-ever book, up 6.2-6.3 12-plus. Oldies stations were off 6.1-5.8; while those losses were across the board, many oldies PDs are worried that there's not much audience left for the format below age 40. Adult standards outlets were up 3.4-3.5. Classical was up 1.7-1.8, despite the recent loss of several major-market outlets. Religious stations were flat at a 2.2.




