AC PDs Try To Warm Up Their Hits Without Adult Top 40's Help

Don't be surprised if you see an AC programmer doing a Henny Youngman impersonation by saying, "Take my hits... please!" Yet it's not funny to those programmers who have seen adult top 40 stations opting for more modern rock-based product. With those stations no longer warming up the hits for them, AC PDs are now sole owners of a growing legion of AC-only hits from the likes of Jim Brickman, John Tesh, and such pop veterans as Phil Collins, Bette Midler, Lionel Richie, and Rod Stewart.

The upshot is that AC reporters, long considered the pop universe's most conservative, are now more willing to start records outright and far less hung-up on call-out than most of their top 40 counterparts. The problem is that with AC's relatively slow rotations and a lack of support from other formats, even those PDs who are relatively aggressive on currents worry about those songs' long-term durability.

"The labels are now trying to start AC stories on some records to bring

to pop radio," WMGF (Magic 107.7) Orlando, Fla., PD Ken Payne notes. "The problem is that we get a lot of unproven music, and we have to decide if it's a hit before it can be researched."

WLTE Minneapolis PD Gary Nolan says, "Years ago, soft ACs wouldn't break new product or be the only station in town playing specific cuts. Now hardly anybody else is playing Chicago, Elton John, and gold by the Eagles and Whitney Houston. We seem to have a lot more exclusive music than ever before."

The problem, says WTVR-FM (Lite 98) Richmond, Va., PD Tony Florentino, is that AC-only product takes too long to break. He says, "Since we only play them, at most, 15 to 20 times a week, it can take our audience up to six months to become familiar with them. Until then, those records test unfamiliar without exposure elsewhere. For example, we had John Tesh and James Ingram's 'Give Me Forever' in current rotation for six months—and it still came back unfamiliar."

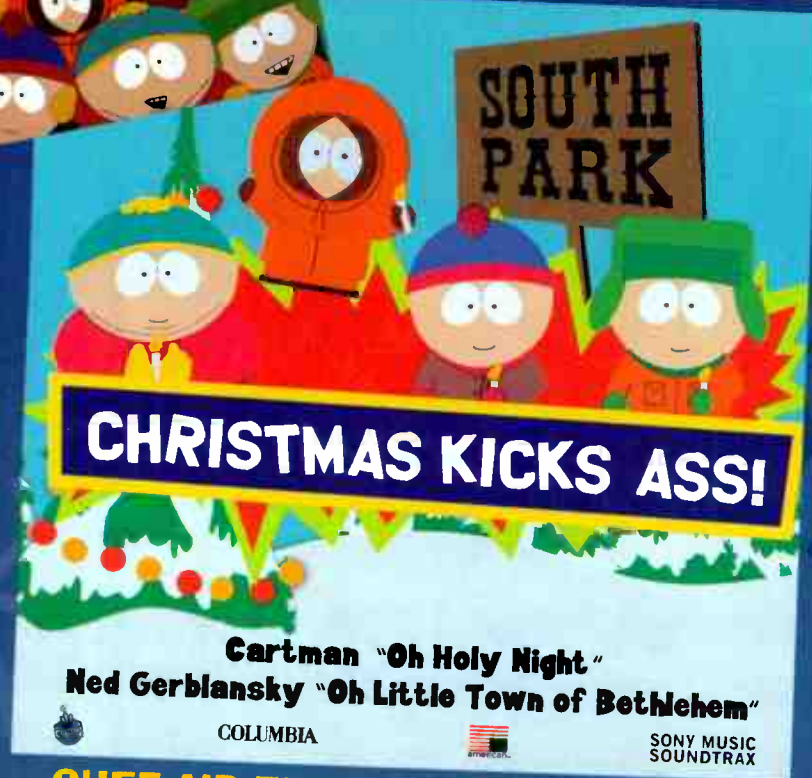

Talent Puddle Tops PDs' List Of Concerns

Programmers are worried about finding qualified air talent, radio's heavier-than-ever spot load, and the time-management problems created by consolidation. They're not particularly worried about threats to radio from new technologies, such as digital satellite

radio and Internet listening. Two-thirds of them expect a mega-corporation such as Microsoft or AT&T to make a run at radio ownership. And despite the optimism displayed by their bosses at the recent National Assn. of Broadcasters convention, the majority of them expect the economy to have a negative impact on radio over the next year.

Those were just a few of the findings from Airplay Monitor's first survey of broadcasters in all the formats it covers. PDs were queried on a multitude of topics ranging from the quality of available current product and budget cuts in marketing and promotions to the health of their format overall. The results appear in the annual year-end combined issue of

Airplay Monitor, which mails with this, the year's last regular issue of Airplay Monitor.

In addition to the year-end survey, Monitor's "Best Of '98" issue also features the top songs, artists, and labels of '98; interviews with the hitmakers of the year, including Celine Dion, matchbox 20, Backstreet Boys, Brian McKnight, Dixie Chicks, Usher, Fastball, Creed, Next, and Semisonic; and conversations with the promo execs behind the year's most successful labels. For the third year, "Best Of '98" also features hundreds of year-end Power Playlists from individual Monitor reporters. It's our thank-you for making this Airplay Monitor's most successful year ever.

While Airplay Monitor's offices will remain open through the holidays, this is the last regular issue of Top 40 Airplay Monitor until the Jan. 8, 1999, issue. Because Broadcast Data Systems continues to monitor airplay throughout the publishing hiatus, the first charts of the year will reflect airplay between Dec. 28-Jan. 3, while "last week" chart numbers will refer to airplay from the week before.

Several Execs Out In 'Unigram' Merger

Billboard Bulletin confirms that a number of record execs will exit the labels being consolidated in the Universal/PolyGram merger. They include Mercury Records Group chairman/CEO Danny Goldberg, Island Records chairman Davitt Sigerson, Motown president/CEO George Jackson, A&M chairman/CEO Al Cafaro, and Geffen chairman/CEO Ed Rosenblatt.

As expected, the new Universal Music Group will be run by chairman/CEO Doug Morris, vice chairman Bruce Hack, president/COO Zach Horowitz, and Universal Music International chairman/CEO Jorgen Larsen.

In the U.S., the consolidated labels will become four entities. In New York, Island and Mercury merge, with PGD president/CEO Jim

Caparro becoming chairman of the Island/Mercury group. PolyGram Canada chairman John Reid becomes president of the Island/Mercury group. A second New York outfit will be derived from Universal Records, Motown, and Polydor. Two L.A. groups will consist of Interscope, Geffen, and A&M as one entity and MCA Records remaining as a stand-alone.

While speculation continues that 2,000-3,000 layoffs will occur, Morris said, "We're not prepared to discuss it yet... All it does is scare people. It's very unsettling. We felt it was better to get through the holidays before a lot of the announcements are made." On the artist side, "the roster will be trimmed," Morris said. "We can only work so many artists."

Evergreen Founder Ginsburg Gets Digital

Scott Ginsburg, founder of Evergreen Media Corp., has been named chairman/CEO of DC Systems Inc. and has made an \$11 million investment in the company. He most recently was president/CEO of Chancellor Media Corp. after that company merged with Evergreen. DC's current chairman, Richard Harris, becomes vice chairman of the board. Current president/CEO Henry Donaldson will continue as president/director and assumes COO duties.

PROGRAMMING: PHIL IN THE BLANKS

Phil Michaels, APD/MD of Cox's adult R&B WHQT (Hot 105) Miami, is now PD of co-owned WTLN-FM Orlando, Fla., currently a religious outlet but rumored to be headed for a rhythmic top 40 or young-end R&B format.

WROX (96X) Norfolk, Va., long hampered by signal problems in the southern half of Tidewater, adds a translator in downtown Norfolk on 106.1 FM.

After announcing plans to join Cumulus in a group programming position, KISF Las Vegas PD Brian White stays put at the adult R&B outlet.

Bill Stewart has lost the interim tag from his PD gig at KGOT Anchorage, Alaska.

WYSK (Y99.3) Fredericksburg, Va., which dropped satellite soft AC a year ago, has evolved to adult top 40 under PD Jon Reed, also PD of country duopartner WFLS. Fredericksburg, halfway between D.C. and Richmond, Va., hasn't had a local top 40 since WGLQ carried ABC's long-defunct satellite top 40 format in the early '90s.

Former WBIX (Big 105) New York PD Adam

Goodman joins the Randy Lane Co. to head up the consultancy's newly created talent division.

Hollywood Hamilton's "Rhythmic Countdown" weekend show has been picked up by Chancellor's KYLD (Wild 94.9) San Francisco.

Russ Parr, morning host at crossover reporter WKYS Washington, D.C., becomes the latest entrant in the syndicated morning host sweepstakes. He'll be heard on co-owned WDTJ Detroit and WPHI Philadelphia, among others, Jan. 4.

Steve Cochran returns to music radio from WMVP Chicago in mornings at WKQI (Q95.5) Detroit, sending Kevin O'Neill to middays.

With WAKS (Kiss 100.7) Tampa, Fla., middayer Marvelous Marv going to N/T sister WFLA, p.m. driver Bobby Rich takes middays; P/T Mike Reeves is in afternoons.

Rick Hummer, previously with KIBB (B100) L.A. in its pre-KCMG days, joins Root Communications top 40s WXXM Myrtle Beach, S.C., and WJMX Florence, S.C., for mornings, teaming with Yvonne Velasquez from WEZB (B97) New Orleans.

At KZZU Spokane, Wash., morning producer Jillian Fontaine exits; newcomer Molly Allen joins Breakfast Boys Dave and Ken for P/T until a full-timer can be hired. All-nighter Dave Daley exits, replaced by swing Derek Michaels.

Promo staffer Adriane Biondo is upped to promotion director at AC WPLL (Planet 103) Miami, reporting to marketing director Camie Dunbar.

Columbia Creates Spinoff Label C2

C2: Consolidation may be the order of the day, but Columbia is doing the exact opposite, creating a spinoff label called C2. The new label will utilize Columbia's existing A&R, marketing, publicity, and sales staffs but will have a separate promotion staff headed by recent Work Group expatriate Dennis Reese, who will report to Columbia executive VP/senior VP of promotion Jerry Blair and label president Donny Ienner. He'll oversee a staff of nine regional and four national promotion execs.

Joining from the Work Group in the Denver regional position is Jay Freidstein. Brett Glassman joins from Red Ant in New York. Maverick's Wendy Goodman joins in Dallas. Sharon Lepere joins from Geffen in Chicago. Joining from Columbia in Atlanta is Ray Mariner. Jonathan Meyer joins from Crave in L.A. KFRR Fresno, Calif., programmer Don O'Neil will handle San Francisco; Jamie Willis joins from Mercury in Boston. Columbia's Dave Watson, who was a regional in Cleveland, will handle some national promotion rep duties from that market. Gordie Gillespie, who was VP of alternative at the Work Group, is named VP of promotion, and Columbia's Cindy Levine is named to a national director position in L.A.

The artist roster, which is still being assembled, will consist of acts that are already on Columbia. The first priority will be Joey McIntyre's single "Stay The Same"; a record from Dovetail Joint will be worked to modern rock late in January. Also, a project from Meja will be delivered in January.

MUSICAL CHAIRS: According to Billboard Bulletin, Def Jam Recordings CEO Lyor Cohen is in talks to become Universal Records president. That post has been vacant since Daniel Glass exited in January '97... Rick Dobbis is named executive VP of Sony Music International based in New York. Dobbis had been London-based president of PolyGram Continental Europe.

LONG LAST: Brian Woods of WLQJ Roanoke Rapids, N.C., E-mails to point out that Edwin McCain's "I'll Be" (Lava/Atlantic) broke the record for the most weeks on the mainstream top 40 chart last issue, with 40 weeks. Real McCoy's "Another Night" held the old record, with 39 weeks on that chart. Long chart lives are more typical at AC, where Elton John's "Something About The Way You Look Tonight" (Rocket/A&M) moves to recurrent after 68 weeks on that chart.

RADIO CALLS THE SHOT

Although it hasn't been released as a single, Alanis Morissette's "Unsent" is picking up significant airplay at such stations as WBMX (Mix 98.5) Boston; KMXB (Mix 94.1) Las Vegas; KZZO (the Zone) Sacramento, Calif.; KBBT (the Beat) Portland, Ore.; and WTIC-FM Hartford, Conn. The common thread? They're all owned by CBS, which has played records as a bloc before on the modern side (God Lives Underwater). WBMX PD Greg Strassell, who networks with CBS' modern AC stations, says that unlike some recent chainwide initiatives at other groups, this decision was made organically: "During our weekly conference call, we were talking about what would be the next track for Alanis; most of us chose 'Unsent.' So we all decided to go for it."

MONITOR PROFILE

Cat Collins Rides High At KQKS Denver, Where The Kids Are Really All Right

Cat Collins considered his job at WJMN (Jam'n 94.5) Boston to be the best APD/MD gig in the country. "Everything about the station, from A to Z, exuded class," he says. "I loved the people—everyone, including GM Matt Mills and PD Cadillac Jack, were great."

That was why he turned down several medium-market PD offers in the past. Yet when Jefferson-Pilot VP of programming Don Benson approached him about the PD job at KQKS (KS107.5) Denver, "it met all my criteria," he says. "I clicked with Don and [Denver VP/GM] Bob Call right away. I definitely wanted to program a station that owned the rhythmic position, had room to grow, and was owned by a company that would do whatever it took to keep that position. Don and Bob understand [that] a rhythmic station's bread and butter is 18-24, and they wouldn't ask me to get the 25-54s. We were all on the same page, which made my decision easy."

Once aboard, Collins quickly ascertained the music differences between Jam'n and

KS107.5. When it comes to hip-hop, "without a doubt, we lean West Coast," he notes. "Granted, the hits are the hits everywhere. The top 10 or 15 songs are the same across the country. Beyond that, however, favorite styles of music and regionalization come into play. For instance, Lauryn Hill is Jam'n's biggest artist, but while popular here, she's not one of our core artists. On the other hand, TQ does really well here, but Jam'n has never played it."

Here's a sample hour on KQKS: Brandy, "Have You Ever?"; OutKast, "Rosa Parks"; Janet Jackson, "Got 'Til It's Gone"; TQ, "Westside" (special Denver version); Fugees, "Killing Me Softly"; Dru Hill Featuring Redman, "How Deep Is Your Love"; Big Punisher Featuring Joe, "Still Not A Player"; Monica, "Angel Of Mine"; Timbaland & Magoo, "Luv 2 Luv U"; Jay-Z, "Can I Get A . . ."; TLC, "Diggin' On You"; Rome, "I Belong To You"; Monifah, "Touch It"; and 2Pac, "California Love."

The other main musical difference between KS107.5 and WJMN is that the Denver station is more current-based. "Jam'n can play four to five mass-appeal monster oldies, such as Gloria Gayner's "I Will Survive," which test well with 18-24s there. The Rob Base and Evelyn 'Champagne' King hits don't test well with our 18-24s. Our typical gold is something by 2Pac. If our gold could test well with our core as well as the 25-34s, that would not only increase TSL with our core but make the station more accessible to the entire market."

In fact, Collins is trying to develop a taste in his core audience for the mass-appeal oldies. "We started a flashback lunch with Mary 'Cha-Cha' Chavez, where I can mix the olds—those that test well now and some that don't—to make the latter records more acceptable to our core. This has worked at other stations before. It will only be a half-

hour program, so it won't taint the station's position. If it works, it'll build a perception of more variety and can make those mass-appeal records more acceptable to the core."

Before Collins took the job, morning man (and veteran programmer) Rick Stacy held the fort quite ably. Yet Cat insists that he's not programming while looking over his shoulder. "It was made clear from day one that Rick would be concentrating solely on the morning show. Yet I look at his experience as a plus. He's programmed in five other markets. I'd be foolish if I didn't pick his brain and ask him about things. In fact, the same can be said for [MD-turned-morning co-host] Jennifer Wilde, [who] also has programming experience."

Stacy and Wilde have to concentrate on their morning show, as they're up against stiff competition, including modern adult rival KALC (Alice 106)'s rebroadcast of KYSR (Star 98.7) Los Angeles' Jamie, Frank, and Frosty and, most recently, Howard Stern. "I tell them—and being veterans, I don't have to preach it—not to worry about Stern or Jamie, Frank, and Frosty. Just worry about super-serving our audience. They don't have to attract listeners from Alice; they just have to keep our listeners happy. Rick and Jennifer do a great job. They ooze creativity and out-of-the-box programming. I realize that saying we're not the least bit concerned about our competition sounds like B.S. programmer hype, but it's true. Our guys just have to keep doing a great job of super-serving our core."

The competition doesn't end at 10 a.m., either. In fact, with the bombs being traded between Jacor and Chancellor stations, Collins almost feels like an innocent bystander. "It'd be safe to say that Chancellor and Jacor don't like each other here," he says. "I grew up with San Francisco radio, and I worked at stations in San Jose, Calif., and Boston, and I've never seen as intense a competitive environment as we have here. First of all, this market is over-radioed. With so many signals, people are constantly getting in each other's way. In Boston, almost every station carved out its own niche. Here, one station shows up at another's promotion with supersoakers full of Gatorade, and they squirt the listeners. I don't know what that accomplishes, but it seems to make them feel better."

Jefferson-Pilot may not be a mega-giant group, but it's well-represented in the Mile High City, with KQKS teamed up with the No. 1-billing FM, country KYGO, as well as classic country KCKK and sports KKFN. "We don't back down to anybody," Collins asserts. "Jefferson-Pilot will do whatever it takes to defend our positions. Remember, CBS, Chancellor, and Jacor all have huge debt services, while we don't. They have to increase spot loads and cut spending in order to meet their Wall Street margins. If they want to spend millions more to take us on, it's only going to add to their debt."

Collins is more concerned with maintaining KS107.5's stranglehold on its target demos. "We own 12-24s and are third 18-34," he says. "I don't care who the GM is; any major-market station that's No. 1 in 12-24, No. 3 in 18-34, and No. 12 in 25-54 should make money. Jefferson-Pilot knows we own our position, and they set realistic expectations on revenue. If we budget right, own our positions of strength, set realistic goals, and don't try to go after older demos we won't be able to own, we can do quite well. KQKS made awesome money in 1998, and we expect to make it hand over fist next year."

WSNY (Sunny 95) Columbus, Ohio, PD Chuck Knight affirms, "They do take forever. We need the cume of the marketplace to grow these songs to make them legitimate. It takes a massive investment in time until you reach a point where it pays off in research with passion scores. Sure, you can front- and back-sell them, but ACs that have no-repeat days compound the problem. It's hard for an AC to create a hit all by itself."

"A true hit AC song is something that will be played in supermarkets over the next 20 years," Payne says. "Unfortunately, songs that don't break outside the AC realm never get to that level."

Some PDs, especially at soft ACs, still deal with this issue by not playing a significant number of currents. But the PDs we spoke to believe ACs can't live on golds and recurrences alone. "You have to add currents now to generate the product you'll be playing two years from now, when your audience tires of the older stuff," Nolan explains.

Obviously, it's becoming more incumbent upon AC programmers to find ways to, if not pick the hits straight out, at least hedge their bets in playing the most likely hits. Surprisingly, there's not a consensus on how to do that.

RELY ON STAR POWER

When it comes to taking a chance on new AC product, the first inclination is to rely on the superstars of the format. "AC-only records take so long, you need power hitters to hit home runs," WLIT (Lite FM) New York PD Jim Ryan says. "That's why we took a chance on 'True Colors' by Phil Collins, an artist who has historically done well. We feel a lot more comfortable taking a chance on his records than [AC-only] songs by new or less popular artists."

Yet even superstars don't get free rides. "Being a more artist-driven format than top 40, we'll absolutely play a ballad by Mariah Carey in power out of the box, but the song may come down [in rotation] after its initial impact," WSNY's Knight says. "It'll still take at least four weeks until research will tell us if the record's driving the passion buttons of our listeners. When the song finally sinks in, we may move it back up again."

APPRECIATING THE 'F WORD'

That word, of course, is "frequency." The reach and frequency of airplay are all the more important in a format where heavys are rarely played more than 25 times a week. How much frequency is enough to familiarize the AC audience with a song? It varies, ranging from 100

spins on WTVR and 120 spins on WLIT (Lite FM) Chicago to 150 spins on WSNY and WLITW.

"I spend a lot of time examining reach and frequency to see how many times our people actually hear the music," WLIT PD Mark Edwards says. "We're very fortunate to have an extremely long TSL, so we don't have to play something a million times in order for our listeners to become familiar with it."

Edwards believes that you really don't need a long time to ascertain the hit-worthiness of every record. "We can see pretty early on if they hate it," Edwards notes. "If a record is a stiff, we know pretty quickly."

"If I get high negatives on a song, I first check to see if I'm playing the correct hook or not," KOST Los Angeles PD Jhani Kaye says. "I'd try a different part of the song, and if that comes back negative after two or three weeks, I don't need to go any further with it."

"In general, it's really song-specific," Kaye adds. "Some brand-new songs sound familiar to respondents in call-out immediately, even if they never actually heard the records. Other songs need airplay in their own market to make the respondents at least somewhat familiar with them."

HITTING THE RIGHT SPOTS

Another way to get an early research buzz would be to spotlight the most aggressive sub-cell in your target demo, which KOST's Kaye thinks could work "in theory." However, "the most successful stations program to a 10- to 12-year age span, and anything less than that is tough" to ascertain, WSNY's Knight notes. "A five-year age span is the most difficult research to analyze."

There are other ways to increase a song's frequency at a station. "Record companies are offering more and more time buys these days," says WMGF's Payne. Knight concurs, "Hopefully, they'll include song clips to make the record more familiar to the audience."

Kaye notes, "Records advertised on TV have a lot of weight behind them, if those commercials are aired during highly rated shows. That alone can work wonders."

Exposure from movie soundtracks can also help the AC-only record, but the song's success largely depends on how it's used in the movie. "If the song is played during the movie and not thrown in at the end credits, it can have quite an impact," Kaye says. But WLIT's Edwards adds, "It's got to be in a big movie. If it's not much of a movie, then it doesn't matter. It also helps when people from that movie are showing up on other TV shows and in People magazine. Those things let people know what's going on."

And Payne believes that "movie exposure is overrated. Look at the audience who attends those movies, especially those who generate the repeat business. That's the teen audience. Most adults wait until the movie comes out on video. They'll see it once and return it. How much impact could that exposure have?"

That depends, too. Although it's not an AC-exclusive record, Ryan cites Sarah McLachlan's "Angel," which wasn't worked at AC or top 40 radio until months after the release of the movie "City Of Angels," a successful rental item. Ryan notes, "It has been a very big song from us, thanks in part to the movie and its rental business."

In a sense, AC programmers are somewhat like the PDs of top 40's "golden era," when programming by gut was the norm and research consisted of phone requests and sales. "That's really true," Payne says. "The interesting thing is that the mechanics of call-out don't work that well for AC anyway, since our demos don't have a level of music awareness that enables them to get really familiar with the music."

WTVR's Florentino asserts, "You can't be gun shy about [not playing records until they're familiar and test well]. If we like a record, we'll play it in current for up to six months without testing. It still serves a great purpose in keeping the station fresh and on top of the current music scene."

In 1998, Europe's Hits Rivalled Ours

I've been tabulating my top 100 songs of the year since the mid-'80s, a radio-geek hobby that has survived despite repeated evidence that I might finally be growing up, whether I want to or not. Throughout that time, I've noticed a correlation between what's on the list and how healthy top 40's available product was that year.

In good top 40 years, the top 10 looks more like the charts; in not-so-great radio years, it's filled with obscurities, imports, LP cuts, and the like. In 1985, the year in which top 40's mid-'80s revival clearly slowed down, for instance, my favorite record of the year was "Little Sheila" by Slade. (You don't remember it, but it sounds sort of like their version of "Jump" by Van Halen.) And even though I should be too embarrassed to admit this, consider that this was the year of "Broken Wings" by Mr. Mister, "Can't Fight This Feeling" by REO Speedwagon, and "St. Elmo's Fire" by John Parr, and then tell me what choice I had.

The good news about 1998 is that I was, indeed, able to come up with 100 songs I really liked, not always so easy in recent years. And a lot of them were top 40 hits. But the list is also heavily informed by all the international radio listening I did this year, full of great radio records that you probably don't know: "Every Day Should Be A Holiday" by the Dandy Warhols (on the "There's Something About Mary" soundtrack here), "Deeper Underground" by Jamiroquai (from the "Godzilla" soundtrack but not a U.S. single), "The Ballad Of Tom Jones" by Space (in which a couple trades insults for four minutes, including "I just want to cut off your nuts," which didn't seem to faze U.K. programmers much), and "Alane" by Wes, a pan-European smash with at least three hooks, all of which, unfortunately for U.S. programmers, are in Bantu.

Having publicly declared my shameful love for all things bubble-gummy so many times before, I'd really like to tell you that my favorite song of 1998 was something other than an Aqua album cut. But "Dr. Jones" (which strongly resembles the Aqua-related "Superhero" by Daize, also a favorite) was everything that an adjunct professor of Toni Basil studies could want: relentlessly catchy, uptempo when little else was, and blessedly unhindered by serious intent. It was the kind of record that was badly needed in a year when the teen groups (and everybody else) decided to show their chops by releasing ballads. Even 18 months ago, PDs would've swallowed their objections to "disposable music" and found a place for it. This year, even being a British (and European) No. 1 wasn't enough to get it released here, and, as is usually the case, no top 40 PDs found it on their own.

My full top 100 list (available, upon re-

quest, by E-mail, if you're really curious) is full of songs that either weren't released here, are due out in early '99 (like B*Witched's "C'est La Vie" and Bell Book & Candle's "Rescue Me"), or were released domestically but not worked to top 40, like Dag's Carolinas-only hit, "Our Love Would Be Much Better (If I Gave A Damn About You)." But my faves weren't entirely eclectic; here's the rest of the top 10.

2. Sparkle, "Be Careful": With Kelly Price's "Friend Of Mine" and a handful of others, the record that reclaimed the '70s R&B legacy. It's not all that surprising that R. Kelly should've been the one to make a neo-blues record. He is, after all, from Chicago.

3. Brooks & Dunn, "How Long Gone": I've always heard that they were heavily influenced by late-'80s country-rockers Foster & Lloyd. This was the most tangible evidence to date.

4. Pras Michel, "Ghetto Supastar (That Is What You Are)": Just when you're about to lobby Congress for tough anti-sampling legislation, somebody completely recontextualizes a song, rather than just pilfering it.

5. Dixie Chicks, "There's Your Trouble": In a year when little at country radio stuck, they went platinum without top 40 airplay. (The label didn't solicit it, and again, top 40 PDs didn't go looking for anything that wasn't worked, no matter what it sold.) Proof that neither country PDs nor listeners really want the hot country boom of the early '90s to end.

6. Sheryl Crow, "My Favorite Mistake": She's inherited her former boss Don Henley's mantle for top 40 hits of substance, despite those previous claims about just wanting to have some fun.

7. Next, "Too Close": Not just because of the nicely subversive nature of the lyrics, but because it helped R&B crossovers, er, poke through at mainstream top 40.

8. Lenny Kravitz, "Fly Away": In a year when modern rock reasserted itself at top 40 and when adult top 40 rocked harder than ever, there were, amazingly, top 40 PDs who found this song harsh. But for fans of 1991's "Always On The Run," which this recalls, "Fly Away" is actually comfort food. And so was...

9. Beastie Boys, "Intergalactic": I've come to think of them as today's Lieber & Stoller, the '50s/'60s songwriters/label owners (Coasters, Ben E. King, Elvis, etc.) who melded jazz, R&B, and pop-culture references. They've grown immensely since 1986, but it was still just fine to hear them pick up where "License To Ill" left off.

10. Dwight Yoakum, "Things Change": Always a dependable source of great singles. And in a year when country sounded more like soft AC, badly needed.

Adult Contemporary Stocking Stuffers

Since it's the season, we asked AC programmers what kind of Christmas music they'll be playing this year—primarily the classics of Bing Crosby, Nat "King" Cole, and such or the relatively newer holiday product from Celine Dion, Kenny G, and Mannheim Steamroller?

Kaye and Nolan note that they'll play a somewhat even mix of classic old and new. "Our average listeners are in their early 40s, so they still want to hear the classic songs," Nolan says. "Yet the new Celine Dion and the Kenny G Christmas albums are certainly acceptable. We'll mix it up really well."

However, the four other PDs lean heavily on the past. Florentino pegs the ratio to being 95% oldies to 5% new, but the others' ratios are not that dramatic. "When I was in Philadelphia a few years ago, we actually did a Christmas music test," Ryan recalls. "And they wanted to hear classics such as Nat 'King' Cole's version of 'The Christmas Song.' They didn't want to hear remakes. They may have thought Michael Bolton's 'White Christmas' was OK, but they really wanted to hear the Bing Crosby original."

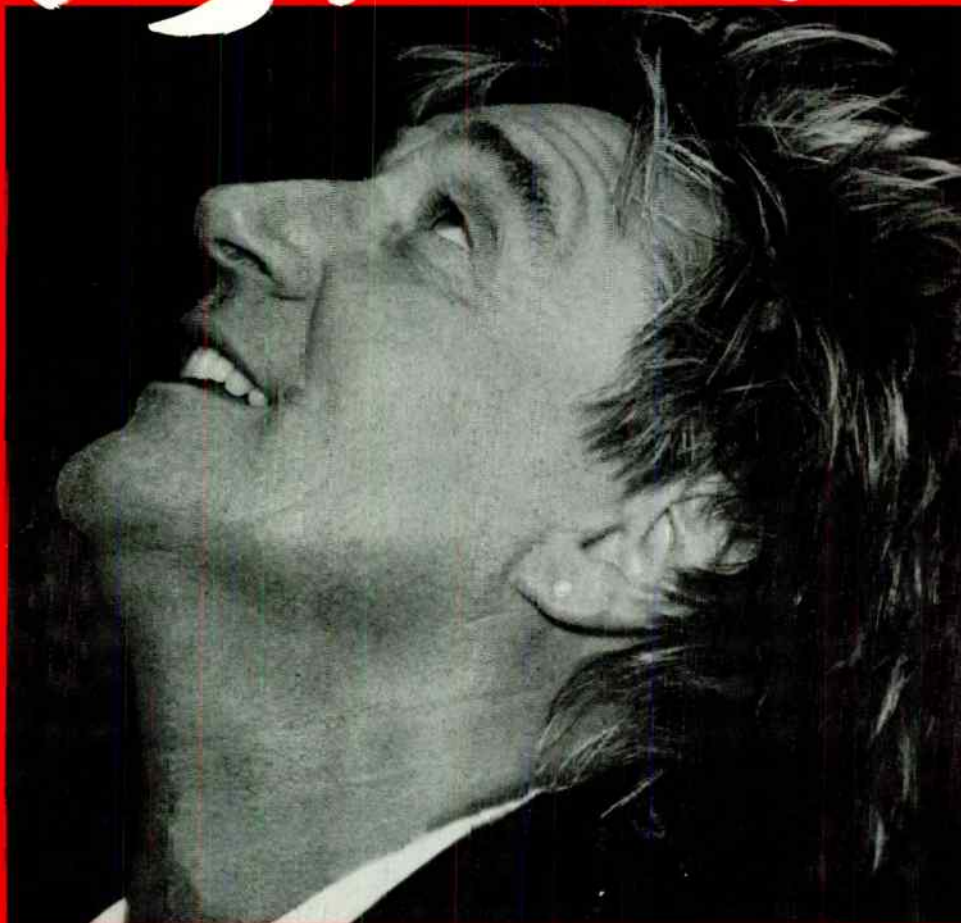
