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ALBUM REVIEWS

Among the many long-playing albums released last month, the 100 reviewed

here are considered to be the best. They have been so chosen by the reviewing

staff of The Billboard, business newsweekly of the music industry. Reviewed

prior to their release, these albums are now in stores thruout the country.



GEMS FOREVER - Mantovani and his Ork (1-12") - London LL 3032-Containing similar film material to that in the highly successful "Film Encores" set, this new entry by the famed British maestro is the lead item in London's special "May Is mantovani Month" production. A good cover and release immediately following the conductor's successful American concert tour should attract his many friends.

STICKS AND BONES - Marty Gold Ork (1-12") - Vik LX 1126-In honor of "Marty Gold Month" which the label has designated for the conductor-arranger, Vik is releasing two new LP's by Gold, of which this is one. Set features marvelous Gold arrangements and bright sounds on an unusual group of standards. Percussion and trombones are the featured sections on this set and they make it a strong one for hi-fi fans. Tunes include Grieg's "King of the Mountains," and "Limehouse Blues."

THE FABULOUS DORSEYS IN HI-FI-Tommy Dorsey Ork Featuring Jimmy Dorsey (1-12") - Columbia C2L 8-Before the tragic deaths of Tommy and Jimmy Dorsey last year they had recorded scores of sides with the Dorsey Brothers band. Columbia bought these tapes and has now released 24 of the sides, beautifully packaged in a twin-set LP album. It contains 12 sweet standards, seven swinging spirituals, and five original swing items, all featuring Tommy's melodious trombone and Jimmy's great sax work. Dorsey-styled arrangements, performances, and sound are all fine. For nostalgia set should easily become one of the important items of the year.

THE LONG, HOT SUMMER — Sound Track (1-12")—Roulette R 25026—One of the rare Hollywood scores that makes for good listening out of cinematic context. The big selling point is Jimmie Rodgers' smooth vocal treatment of the title tune, already released as a single. But composer Alex North proves again—as he did before in "Streetear"—that he has a fine musical ear for the lazy warmth and shimmering violence of the Deep South, while neatly avoiding the standard cleffing cliches. His musical "characterization" of Eula Varner (Lee Remick) is a gem of pure sex-on-wax.

THE GREAT SONG HITS OF MILLER & DORSEY ORKS - The Alumni Ork Conducted by Bobby Byrne (1-12") - Grand Award G. A. 33-366—Set packs a lot of nostalgia as alumni of Glenn Miller and Tommy Dorsey bands duplicate arrangements of yesteryear in numbers closely associated with orks, such as "In the Mood," "Little Brown Jug," "Marie" and "I'm Getting Sentimental Over You." Among top sidemen are Jimmy Abato, Tex Beneke, Charlie Shavers and Pee Wee Irwin. Good combination

LOVE NEST - The Hi-Lo's With Frank Comstock Ork (1-12") - Columbia CL 1121 - The group's fourth effort for the label, and it's just as fresh and interesting as its predecessors. Tho the boys have not been as widely publicized as they were but a few months ago, this smart collection of readings in their familiar style of "Dancing on the Ceiling," "Wait Till You See Her," etc., will bring 'em back to the public eye.

Conducted By LeRoy Holmes (1-12")

-M-G-M E 3539—The Italian grouping is nicely done up by string orchestra with mandolin accents. Holmes gives slick readings of "Arrivederci Roma," "O Sole Mio," "Santa Lucia," "Torna a Surriento" and other expected selections. Fits mood music category.

LISTEN AND RELAX - Ella Fitzgerald & Gordon Jenkins Ork (1-12") - Decca DL 8697-A group of earlier sides recoupled makes for nice listening. The thrush is in fine voice and the arrangements by Gordon Jenkins, tho dominated by strings as compared to the more jazz inspired backings for Miss Fitzgerald's more recent efforts, are neverthelss smooth and well-recorded. Attractive cover sets the tone for the mood offerings like "Black Coffee," "Lover's Gold," etc.

THEY'RE PLAYING OUR SONG — The Art Van Damme Quintet (2-12") — Columbia C2L 7—Here's a bargain package, spotlighting more than 40 standards—covering a period of 50 years. The tunes—"Sunday Kind of Love," "I'll Never Smile Again," "I'll Remember April," etc.—are handed relaxed, tastefully simple instrumental treatments by the Quintet with standout work on vibes by Chuck Calzaretta and accordionist Van Damme. Solid nostalgic wax.

NIGHT AND DAY - Joel Herron Piano and Ork (1-12") - Westminster WP 6079-These arrangements of great Cole Porter tunes are full of taste and wit. Rather than having an overbearing lush quality, the accent is on subtlety of rhythm and color. "Begin the Beguine," "Night and Day," "I Get a Kick Out of You" are typical material. Class pop wax, with a nice cover.

MARJORIE MORNINGSTAR - Sound Track (1-12") - RCA Victor LOC 1044-An unusually programmatic background score by top-flight Hollywood composer Max Steiner. Strains from "A Very Precious Love" are utilized thruout. Gene Kelly warbles the theme on one track. Strong appeal to the movie-goer.

MUSIC FOR HAND JIVING (1-12")— Various Artists—London LL 3034—This platter may shoot out front as a sudden novelty craze. Actually, it's a collection of fast-paced rockabilly, Dixieland and jump numbers by British artists like Tommy Steele, Terry Dene, Graham Stewart and others. The gimmick is that they're tailored for "hand jiving," a British craze in which teen-agers dance — with their hands. Should interest alert collectors on the prowl for new material.

DANCE AND STAY YOUNG (1-12")—
Dave Carroll Ork — Mercury MG 30251—
Great stuff for the over-40 record buyers.
This platter serves up a nice suave helping of maestro Carroll's gently bouncy beat on 15 pleasant standards like "Elmer's Tune,"
"My Man," "Don't Get Around Much Any more," and others. It's the kind of thing you'll hear in any high-priced hotel nitery between stageshows.

SAY, DARLING (1-12")-Original Cast-RCA Victor LOC 1045-This original cast album has something added: full ork backing to give the numbers a show-tune feeling lacking in the stage version, which uses only pianos. Sid Ramin's bright orchestrations and drive for Jule Styne's somewhat spotty score. Betty Comden-Adolph Green lyrics are apt to please if not enthuse. Johnny Desmond, at his most effective here, easily takes vocal honors. Vivian Blaine and David Wayne also produce some warm and potent efforts. Colorful cover and jockey play of singles releases of several tunes by Perry Como, Tony Martin and Dinah Shore may also help boost album appeal.

STEVE ALLEN PLAYS HI-FI MUSIC FOR INFLUENTIALS (1-12")—Coral CRL 57218—Allen plays piano with ork arrangements by Neal Hefti on a number of tunes, for one reason or another associated with the "influential" people in our world. It's a new peg for introducing a program of easy listening material, played with a gentle beat by Allen and company. Tunes include "Dancing on the Ceiling," "Blue Moon," and three Allen originals, "You're So Influential," "I'll Tell the World," "Telling the Others." Nice packaging that should attract more on Allen's name value than on the "influential tag.

DANCING WITH GIGI - Ray Ellis Ork (1-12") - Columbia CL 1122-Several instrumental versions and an original cast LP of the Lerner-Loewe score from the coming flick, "Gigi," are on the market already. However, Ray Ellis' sparkling and inventive arrangements provide a danceable item that can make many fans happy. It's an attractive score and pic opening will certanly spark interest.

THIS IS SINATRA, VOL. II (1-12") — Capitol W 982—New recordings of some of his earliest hits will make this another Sinatra triumph like Volume I. Nelson Riddle's ork gives solid support on "You Forgot All the Words," "Put Your Dreams Away," and others. Crooner is in top form, giving a mature but still seductive sound. Attractive cover shot of Sinatra for fans.

SELECTIONS FROM "OH CAPTAIN!" (1-12")-Rosemary Clooney & Jose Ferrer With Phil Moore Ork-M-G-M E 3687-The score of Broadway's "Oh Captain!" provides a delightful vocal romp for the noted husband-and-wife duo, and a fine debut for Miss Clooney on the M-G-M label. Ferrer sings with charm and persuasiveness on numbers like "We're Not Children" and "Three Paradises," and smooth-voiced Rosie is a treat to the ears in "Morning Music of Montmartre." The fine bounce and gay spirits of the teaming make for the strongest kind of album material, and a nice color cover has visual values.

SWINGIN' DOWN BROADWAY (1-12")—
Jo Stafford With Paul Weston Ork—Columbia CL 1124—The thrush has never sounded better. With superb backing by a swinging Paul Weston big band, not unlike early T. Dorsey ensembles, Miss Stafford shows her wonderful tone, ease and flexibility to best advantage on such smart material as "The Gentlemen Is a Dope," "Tomorrow Mountain," "It Never Entered My Mind." Mr. and Mrs. Weston are a gas here.



COUNT BASIE PRESENTS (1-12")—The Eddie Davis Trio & Joe Newman — Roulette R 52007—This is the first in the label's new jazz series titled "Count Basie Presents." The man Basie is presenting here is Eddie Davis, a fine tenor man in the Coleman Hawkins tradition, but modernly styled. In addition, the Count himself is here on piano, along with a fine fem organist, Shirley Scott. Trumpet man Joe Newman helps out strongly on many of the sides. The Davis Trio, plus Basie, plus Newman, really swings and the album is an auspicious one for all concerned. Tunes include standards and originals.

DINAH WASHINGTON SINGS FATS WALLER (1-12")—Mercury MG 36119—This is one of Dinah's best. She handles Waller's tunes artfully with backing from a group of top jazz musicians, conducted by Ernie Wilkins. She shouts and croons, and is highly effective in either groove. The set can have appeal to pop, jazz or r.&b. fans. Orchestrations are effective. Just about all of the great Waller's best tunes are included.

DON SHIRLEY WITH 2 BASSES (1-12")—Cadence CLP 3008—DON SHIRLEY SOLOS (1-12")—Cadence CLP 3007—Shirley's style allows him to take advantage of his classical training. He has a big, grandiose sound. Using two basses gives him plenty of room for experimentation and improvisation. He's fleet, dexterious and interesting. Standout set of the album with two basses is the "Porgy and Bess Suite," In the set of piano solos, he presents an attractive program of ballads. He's a talented artist, and bassists Jim Bond and Kenneth Fricker complement nicely. Attractive covers.

THE GERRY MULLIGAN SONG BOOK VOL. 1-Gerry Mulligan and the Sax Section (1-12")—World Pacific PJ 1237—The tunes are Mulligan originals. Mulligan-style arrangements are by Bill Holman with augmentation by the great baritone star. Included are his renowned "Venus De Milo," "Revelation" and "Crazy Day." The sax section features Z. Sims, A. Cohn, Lee Konitz and A. Eager. Rhythm section is F. Green, guitar; H. Grimes, bass, and D. Bailey, drums. The set is a swinger.



BRAHMS: SYMPHONY NO. 2 (1-12")—
Minneapolis Symphony Orch. (Dorati) —
Mercury MG 50171—This is one of the
most recorded of all the Brahms repertoire,
yet this brilliant exposition of the work will
undoubtedly account for its share of sales,
due to the reputation established by Dorati
with the Minneapolis Ork for its top-selling
reading of Tchaikovsky's "1812 Overture."
Olympian recording process again captures
the big, rich sound. A beautiful cover shot
of huge redwood trees.

TEEN SCENES; KAY: CLAFLIN: ROUND DANCE & POLKA FOR STRINGS (1-12")-Orch. of the Accademia Nazionale di Santa of London (Camarata) -Composers Recordings CRI 119-Claflin made an impressive showing with his "Lament for April 15th" which was recorded on this label last year. His "Teen Scenes" is an interesting suite that musically describes certain teen-age moods and situations. Thy are charming and programmatic. McBride's "Pumkin Eater's Little Fugue" is a short orchestral work that incorporates a theme and variations idea within a slightly fufual framework. "Workout for a Small Orchestra" utilizes jazz idioms. The Kay works are based on folkish themes. Devotees of works by contemporary American composers will enjoy.

CHOPIN: NOCTURNE, POLONAISE, SCHERZO, BARCAROLLE, WALTZ, NOCTURNE, GRAND VALSE BRILL-IANTE (1-12")—Rudolph Firkusny, Piano—Capitol PAO 8428—A brilliant performance. Firkusny does these popular pieces with tremendous technical virtousity and taste. Sound is excellent, and the general attractiveness of the product is enhanced by booktype packaging with interesting notes and cuts.

SARASATE: ZICEUNERWEISEN: ST .-SAENS: INTRODUCTION & RONDO CAPRICCIOSO, HAVANAISE; CHAUS-SON: POEME (1-12")-Zino Francescatti, Violin With Columbia Symphony Orch. (Smith) & Philadelphia Orch. (Ormandy)-Columbia ML 5253-There are numerous versions of each selection of repertoire presented here. Coupling popular works with a true virtuoso, however, can't help but result in worthy product. Such is the case here. Francescatti performs with a tonal quality of rare beauty and technique that is flawless. Name value of the soloist, which gets highly displayable billing, plus the Philadelphia Orchestra make this a potent new entry.

MOZART: PIANO CONCERTO IN C MI-NOR; CHOPIN: BARCAROLLE (1-12")-Walter Gieseking, Piano & Philharmonic Orch. (Von Karajan)-Angel35501-A distinguished addition to the catalog of packages by Gieseking. The pianist, who has recorded much Mozart for the label, is superb on this album. The selections of course are high points in the works of the two composers. Von Karajan's batoning emphasizes the exalted character of the concerto and the romantic coloring of the barcarolle. Packaging is typically Angel-exceedingly

BEETHOVEN: QUARTET NO. 13 (1-12") Hollywood String Quartet-Capitol PAO 8429-A handsome and distinguished album. The Hollywood String Quartet has been linked internationally with the towering Beethoven work penned at the height of his power; the group performed the work to bravos at the 1957 Edinburgh Festival. Their reading is impeccable, their tone rich and round. Capitol has provided superb sound. Beautifully packaged in a double cover.

BERNSTEIN: TROUBLE IN TAHITI (1-12")-Beverly Wolff, David Atkinson, Various Artists & The M-G-M Ork. (Winograd)-M-G-M E 364-Latest disk contribution by multi-faceted composer welds musical comedy idiom to opera for interesting results. Some marital tensions in suburbia are illuminated with wry insight. Comments by "Greek Chorus" in guise of radio vocal trio are especially amusing. Live productions of the work plus composer's constant exposure as conductor, TV personality, performer and stage writer make this of topical interest.

PROKOFIEV: SYMPHONY NO. 5 (1-12") -The Philadelphia Orch. (Ormandy)-Columbia ML 5260-One of Prokofiev's strongest and most appealing works in a vigorous. brilliantly played performance that should take its position as the favored version. The orchestra's fine sound has been captured unusually well.

MOZART: SYMPHONY NO. 40, EINE KLEINE NACHTMUSIK (1-12")-Pittsburgh Symphony Orch. (Steinburg)-Capitol PAO 8432-Spirited, disciplined performances of the Mozart works. Both are heavily recorded. The excellent reproduction and packaging, however, give this set added appeal. Steinberg evolves the haunting quality of the symphony to best effect, and the serenade is also well-presented.

RAVEL: QUARTET IN F MAJOR: DE-BUSSY: QUARTET IN G MINOR (1-12") -Budapest String Quartet-Columbia ML 5245-The lovely chamber music compositions, Ravel's "Quartet in F Major," and Debussy's "Quartet in G Minor," are performed with care and technical skill on this new release by the Budapest String Quartet. The quality of the recording, the excellent sound, and the name of the Budapest, should help make this a strong contender among string quartet collectors.

VERDI: LA FORZA DEL DESTINO HIGHLIGHTS (1-12")-Maria Callas, Soprano; Elena Nicolai, Mezzo-Soprano; Richard Tucker, Tenor; Various Artists; Orch & Chorus of La Scala, Milan (Serafin)-Angel 35432-This abridgement has the best music and most popular arias of a long and costly complete version. Callas darkens her tones excitingly and brings fervor and true pitch to a dramatic role which is her forte. Tucker and baritone Tagliabue match her fire; their final duet is the disk's high spot. Class package includes text.

BEETHOVEN: SONATAS NOS. 8 & 9 (1-12")-Nathan Milstein, Violin with Artur Balsam, Piano-Capitol PAO 8430-Brilliant interpretations of the two Beethoven sonatas for violin and piano. Both Milstein and Balsam present commendable performances. The sound is excellent. Attractive packaging and good notes add to over-all

EASDALE: THE RED SHOES BALLET WEBER: INVITATION TO THE DANCE; DELIBES: SYLVIA, COPPELL (1-12") - St. Louis Symphony Ord (Golschmann)-Columbia ML 5254-Absorb ing orchestral colors are evoked by maest-Golschmann on Easdale's charming ballscore, composed for the film, "The Rec Shoes," a hit of several years ago. Con-petition on the other ballet scores is heavy and chief lure of the set is the Easday

BEETHOVEN: VIOLIN CONCERTO (1-12") Igor Oistrakh, Violin & Pro Arte Orch., London (Schuechter)-Angel 35516-Famous son of a famous father, Igor Oistrakh turns in a brilliant performance here of the great Beethoven "Violin Concerto is D Major" on this new release. The orchestra is the Pro Arte and the conductor is Wil helm Schuechter. This recording, which was made in England in the spring of 1957 could easily become a most wanted iten for classical collectors.

KREISLER: VARIOUS SHORT PIECES (1-12")-Zino Francescatti, Violin & Artu Balsam, PIANO - Columbia ML 5255 -Short, mostly fluffy pastries like "Capries Viennois" and "Liebesfreud," with "London derry Air" added, executed with charm and aplomb by a great talent.



ALI BABA AND THE 40 THIEVES Bing Crosby (1-12")-Golden A 298:20-The super, relaxed approach of Crosby seems to work out very well as he takes on the guise of story teller. The story is a natural for the children and the music bits by Mary Rodgers with lyrics by Sammy Cahn become an appealing part of the story. Back cover tells the story with attractive drawings for kiddies.

FUN FOR EVERYDAY-With Little Johnny Everything & His Sister Judy (1-12")-RCA Victor LBY 1005-Fresh delightful songs are spun with clarity and ease by the duo and fine combo backing. Best of all: "Horse in Striped Pajamas," "Bicycle Tricycle," "It's Fun to Swim." Educational aspect of lyrics, attractive cover and \$1.98 price are added inducements, but the writing and singing could score without them.

SLEEP TIME - Songs & Stories by Pete Seeger (1-12")-Folkways FC 7525-Accompanying himself with a rollicking oldfashioned banjo, folk artist Pete Seeger turns in a first-rate, entertaining job of spinning some tall story-songs designed to make Junior settle down at bedtime. On the other side, Seeger sings some new songs, including a solo voice, gentle lullaby that's a real delight. The cover is a fine example of good graphic art. Seeger's approach is not sirupy; even adults will like him.

COLDEN TREASURY OF POPULAR SONGS-The Sandpipers & Mitch Miller Ork (1-12")-Golden A198:24-A nice group of 18 rollicking pop songs, some fairly recent, are presented here in bright, simplified vocal and ork arrangements by Mitch Miller for moppet record collectors. Tunes range from old novelties like "Good Ship Lollipop" and "Mairzy Doats" to pop successes of a few seasons back, like "Doggie in the Win-dow," or "Hey, Mr. Banjo." Attractively packaged.



GREAT RUSSIAN FOLK DANCES Moisevev Russian Folk Ballet Company & Ork (Galperine) & Hungarian State Folk Ensemble (Gabor) (1-12")-Epic LC 3459-With the Moiseyev Folk Ballet receiving ecstatic reviews and sell-out public reception at the start of its American tour, this vigorous sampling of its musical forces should do very well. Orchestra gives vital but polished versions of folk dances and manages to communicate feeling of energy that animates dancers. Lively sound. Flip side is interesting, but milder, collection of Hungarian folk music performed by choir, orchestra, dancers and soloists.

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


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
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








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
