However, the editors of The Billboard recognize that juke box operators and disk jockeys have been in need of new and better programming aids to help them make the most effective use of records. While this type of material could not appear in our weekly issues, it has been packaged in this form for compact and convenient presentation each Quarter.

Each feature included in this first issue was conceived, researched and developed to have lasting value. The Quarterly, therefore, is a reference tool, designed for virtually daily use during its lifetime. Its material was specifically planned to retain its programming value for a specific period of time—to be exact, until next September 14. In that issue, The Billboard will publish the Fall Quarterly, the contents of which will supersede the material in this issue.

We will welcome your comments and suggestions about this new Quarterly service in the interests of improving it for you.
