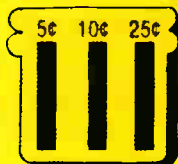

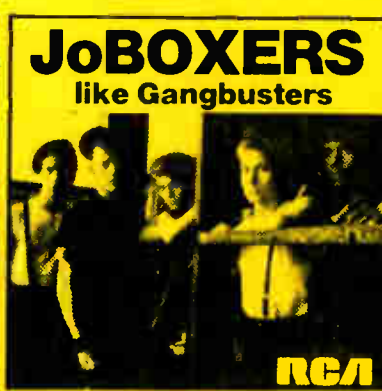

THE FIRST WORD

The winner of the **MTV Basement Tapes Finals**, held September 14, is **Rail**, from Seattle, WA. Their video of "Hello" received 36% of the votes, with almost 107,000 people calling in over 75 minutes. Runners up were **Joe Salvo** (30%), **Friday** (13%), **Slyder** (9%), **Messendger** (7%) and **Young Invaders** (5%). **Rail** wins an EMI recording contract.

The fifth annual **New Music America** festival will be held in Washington, D.C. October 7-17. More than 200 musicians/performers from throughout the country as well as Spain, Japan, Mexico and Canada will be presented, including the **Phillip Glass Ensemble**, **Ornette Coleman**, **Jamaaladeen Tacuma**, **Trisha Brown/Robert Rauschenberg/Laurie Anderson**, **Anthony Davis** and **Oliver Lake & Jump Up**. The performances will be at various Washington locations. For further information call 202-347-4717.

To celebrate the release of the **Einstein's Riceboys** LP **Civil Rice** on Compact Disc, **QL Records** will be giving away a CD Player to a college radio station. Watch the **Dialogue** section for details!

RECORD NEWS: **Geffen** has signed **Moving Pictures**, **Don Henley**, **Ray Parker** and **Irene Cara** . . . **The Renegades** has changed its name to **Wire Train**. Their debut LP **In A Chamber** will be released by **415/Columbia** . . . **Relativity** is releasing **Clock DVA's** LP **Break Down** . . . **I.R.S.** has signed **Torch Song**, a London-based trio. Expect an album in February or March . . . **Elektra** is releasing an album of music from the **Playboy Jazz Festival** which will feature **Grover Washington, Jr.** and **Weather Report** . . . **Alligator Records** has completed production of the label's first video clip, featuring **Big Twist And The Mellow Fellows** doing "300 Pounds Of Heavenly Joy" . . . **Bearsville Records** has the **Deal** recording a 5-song EP with **Richard Gottehrer** producing and the **dB's** recording an LP . . . **JEM** is releasing a complete **Brian Eno** box set called **Working Backwards 1983-1973**. All of his solo works will be included, plus a special edition **Music For Films 2** and a rarities EP including some unfinished pieces . . . Look for the **Cramps** LP **Off The Bone** on **I.R.S.**

JACKPOT! SINGLES, TRACKS, ETC.

★ **C.S. ANGELS "Will You Stay Tonight" (12") (Jive, c/o Arista, 6 W. 57th St., New York, NY 10019)**—Producer **Mike Howlett** has given the **C.S. Angels** (nee **Comsat Angels**) a state-of-the-art radio polish and it comes out beautifully smooth. It sounds a bit like **Modern English's** "I Melt With You," and should meet with just as much acceptance.

★ **BLACK UHURU "Party Next Door" (12") (Mango c/o Island Records, 444 Madison Ave., New York, NY 10022)**—The next door neighbors are throwing a party and you can hear it from your place—it sounds so good because its being hosted by **Black Uhuru**, Jamaica's sizzling hot trio. You'll recognize the repetitious groove of the guests of honor—the unbeatable team of **Sly Dunbar** and **Robbie Shakespeare**—as you start dancing to this sound that is more than just conventional reggae. It's not quite reggae-funk, and it's not exactly reggae-rock. It's **Michael Rose's** smooth, sensuous vocals combined with a hypnotic rhythm that'll drive you wild.

TOMMY TUTONE "Dumb But Pretty," "Someday Will Come," "National Emotion" (LP cuts) (Columbia, 51 West 52nd St., New York, NY 10019)—Certainly not music for the mind ("You're dumb but pretty/But baby you're all mine") but **Tommy Tutone** makes some of the best true-blue stadium rock around. It makes you want to burn down the freeway in your little red corvette—party rock lives! "National Emotion" sounds like a revved up '80s cop of **Sam Cooke's** "Having A Party."

THE KRIEGER-DENSMORE BONANZA "Get Up, Stand Up" b/w "Kinky Reggae" (12") (Rhino Records, 1201 Olympic Blvd., Santa Monica, CA 90404)—Former **Doors** guitarist **Robby Krieger** and drummer **John Densmore** pay tribute to **Bob Marley** as they cover two of his songs. "Get Up, Stand Up" is presented in a very entertaining rock 'n' roll interpretation, whereas "Kinky Reggae" is not so amusing. The real beauty of this record lies in the thought and the liner notes which include a very touching story by **Densmore** in which he tells of the **Doors'** involvement with Jamaica and reggae music, as well as what a crucial influence **Marley** has been. Dedicated to **Rita Marley** and **Bob's** mother, **Cedella Booker**.

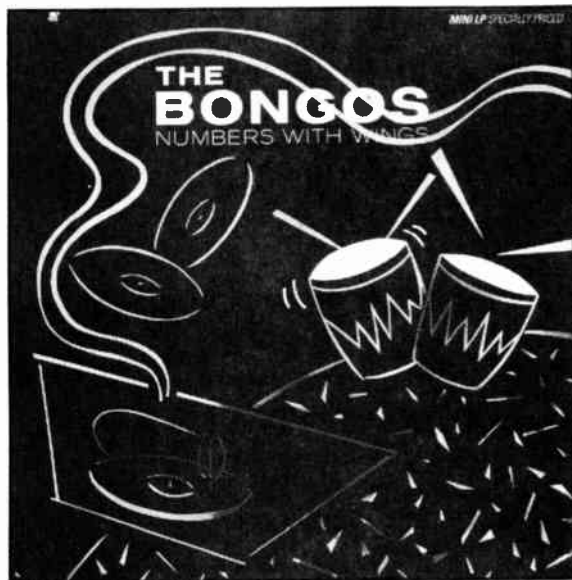

The title track is priceless—we learn that Eek-A-Mouse went to Disneyland to meet Mickey Mouse, and he's very clear as to who is the mouse and who is the man. What I really want to know is who are these ladies from California that he refers to in so many of his songs? Perhaps his next album will tell.

According to the "Rootsman," the new Rolling Stones album, *Under The Night*, is to include a reggae track . . . But you can't expect us to grant your station an interview without first hearing a tape of some interviews you've done recently. Send us an air check and more information as to your logistical set up for such calls. After proving that your staff can successfully interview some of our newer acts, we can work on talking to some name acts down the line... In a related matter, we will sometimes have a couple dozen premium merchandise items for promotional giveaway purposes. We keep a running list of the two dozen or so stations who have most recently done successful promotions. Size of the school or station isn't a factor here; we look for professionalism and response. Keep us informed by mail with the particulars of recent promotions you've done - maybe your station will become one of our favorites... Attack Of The Killer B's, another favorite, is a compilation of great and obscure B-sides of past WB singles. Bob Merlis, our affable VP of Publicity, did the R'n'D on this project and would be glad to talk to other record junkies out there about this compilation and/or vintage Studebakers. Give Bob a call at 213/953-3223.

Dear Industry Colleagues, Clients, Friends and Fans of KWST:

Sad news of the kind we hate most to hear about. After 12 years of "Progressive" AOR (album-oriented rock) as KLRB and KWST, our owners, Walton Broadcasting Inc., have decided to go satellite-automated Country/Western on or around September 9, 1983. This puts to an end the Monterey Bay area's only rock and roll radio station, and adds a 3rd country station to the market. The last day on the air for the current staff was Friday, September 2, although management may continue in an AOR vein with interim jocks until the satellite equipment can be installed to re-broadcast the country format, which originates in the Midwest... Several staff members, including current Program Director Mark Kaufman and Music Director Rosalie Smith, are considering offers to stay on at AM downstairs, KIDD. There is also the possibility of another station filling the niche by picking up the lucrative rock format, the clients, and some of the staff. The station has made money for virtually all of its 12 years, but automation alone will probably save \$20,000 a month in overhead... The Program Director of the new format will be long-time Monterey Bay area broadcaster Johnny Morgan. We wish him luck; he certainly has his work cut out for him. In a free enterprise system, the owner of any business has the right to sell whatever product s/he pleases, regardless of economic feasibility or the needs of the community it serves... We wish to sincerely thank from the bottoms of our hearts the hundreds of industry contacts, business clients, and colleagues that have come to mean so much more than just "Business acquaintances" to us; and the hundreds of thousands of loyal and loving listeners to whom we owe the fact that we survived and prospered for so long in a business known for its insecurity. The records companies lose a forum for exposure of exciting new music; the retail record industry loses sales from customers who have nowhere to hear the music--but it is to the listeners themselves, whom we leave bereft and helpless citizens, whom the airwaves were meant to serve, we make this promise: Rock and Roll will re-surface in your neighborhood soon; nothing has been able to stop it yet, and nothing ever will. When it does, carry the torch and support it with all your heart. That empty space on the dial will remind you how easy it is to lose what you take for granted because it's always been there, and you guess it always will. ...So count your blessings, keep on rockin', and see ya on the dance floor!

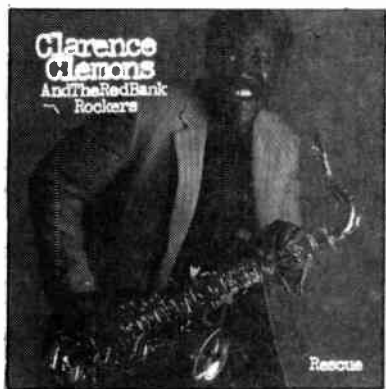

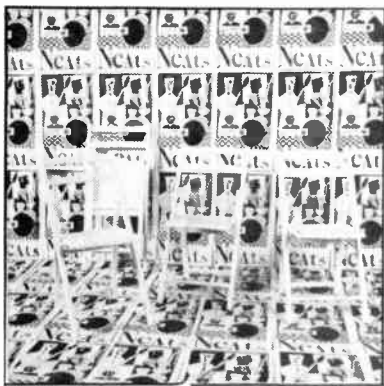

X More Fun In The New World (Elektra, 655 Fifth Ave., New York, NY 10022)—Critical darlings X have finally created a body of music that will satisfy critics, radio and fans—whether avant-garde or mainstream—at the same time. John Doe and Exene's voices work magically together—their harmonic interplay is at times even reminiscent of the wonderous Slick/Kantner/Balin harmonies of the early Jefferson Airplane. While the music still sizzles, it's been lightened ever-so-slightly, which should assure album radio that X, while still doggedly determined to get its message across, will play in Peoria. Intelligent, incessant music. An American rock 'n' roll masterpiece. Top cuts: ALL especially "New World," "Poor Girl," "Breathless," "I Must Not Think Bad Thoughts" (listen carefully and see if you don't find yourself nodding in agreement), "How House" and "True Love (Part II)."

★ JACKPOT! ★

T-BONE BURNETT Proof Through The Night (Warner Bros., 3300 Warner Blvd., Burbank, CA 91510)—*Proof Through The Night* is nothing short of one of the strongest efforts of the year. Burnett's songwriting is often startlingly brilliant, his lyrics wise and moving. He gets superb musical help from friends Pete Townshend, Ry Cooder, Richard Thompson and Mick Ronson to name a few. The music is guitar based rock tinged with folk and country and is uniformly superb. All that's missing is an obvious radio track/hit single—we urge you to dig deep and find your favorites. Ours are "The Murder Weapon," "After All These Years," "The Sixties," "Pressure" and "Stunned."

JoBOXERS Like Gangbusters (RCA, 1133 Ave. Of The Americas, New York, NY 10036)—Along with Wham!, the JoBoxers represent the vanguard of current British pop, and *Like Gangbusters* is one of the best pop LPs of the year. Like Wham!, the JoBoxers flaunt their youthfulness but without the flash—and probably without the bum. Wham! is overtly and knowingly sexual, while the JoBoxers are still relishing their new-found sensuality. It's joyous, exuberant and not too knowing. Top cuts: "Just Got Lucky," "Boxerbeat," "She's Got Sex," "Johnny Friendly."

CLARENCE CLEMONS AND THE RED BANK ROCKERS Rescue (Columbia, 51 W. 52nd St., New York, NY 10019)—The Big Man steps out on his own—and delivers a sizzling, party album. This is traditional American R&B flavored rock 'n' roll (a la Sam and Dave, Junior Walker, Creedence Clearwater Revival) that shines with a contemporary sheen. Vocals are handled ably by John "J.T." Bowen, music courtesy of the Red Bank Rockers, with Clarence's sax out front, and his spirit shining through all of the tracks. Top cuts: "Jump Start My Heart," "Money To The Rescue," "Savin' Up," "Resurrection Shuffle."

LORDS OF THE NEW CHURCH Is Nothing Sacred (I.R.S., c/o A&M, 595 Madison Ave., New York, NY 10022)—No longer simply estranged former punks, the Lords have carried their sound into the mainstream, while retaining much of what made them initially appealing. They infuse their rock with a striking passion and a bit of frenzy. *Is Nothing Sacred?* is a striking sounding album that could (and should) cross into AOR. Top Cuts: "Bad Timing," "Dance With Me," "Goin' Downtown," "Live For Today," "Don't Worry Children."

NEATS Neats (Ace Of Hearts, P.O. Box 579, Kenmore Station, Boston, MA 02215)—Boston's answer to R.E.M., the Neats are a garage band with style. Their sound is loose (maybe a little too loose) yet (like R.E.M.) invigorating—the guitars, rhythm and often incomprehensible vocals merge into a distinct sound which is at the same time inspired by the sixties and totally original. In a word: neat. top cuts: "A.B.D.," "Do The Things," "Sad," and "Water."

JOHNNY CASH Johnny 99 (Columbia, address above)—Johnny Cash is an American cultural institution. What makes this LP so important is that it includes Cash's interpretation of two tracks from Bruce Springsteen's classic *Noblesse*, "Highway Patrolman" and "Johnny 99." Perhaps even more so than for the Boss himself, these tracks sound like they were tailor-made for Cash's traditional folk/country treatment and scratchy-sweet vocals. The rest is down-home fine as well, in the vintage Cash style. Also try "New Cut Road" and "I'm Ragged But I'm Right."

PARACHUTE CLUB Parachute Club (RCA, address above)—Parachute Club can most easily be described using a term XTC coined: funk-pop-a-roll. It's appealing, unpretentious pop which bridges black and white musics so well that it fits nicely into a variety of formats from urban to new music to rock to pop to . . . who knows? Top cuts: "Rise Up," "Slip Away," "Tobago Style" and "Alienation."

JONATHAN RICHMAN & THE MODERN LOVERS Jonathan Sings! (Sire, c/o Warner Bros., address above)—Jonathan Richman is back—as honest as ever. His lyrics are open and straightforward, praising simple emotions. And the music is bare and not at all subtle, in direct counterpoint to the lyrics and Richman's voice. Nobody else does what Jonathan Richman does. He is an original, and an American treasure. Top cuts: "That Summer Feeling," "Somebody To Hold Me," "Not Yet Three," "Those Conga Drums," and "When I'm Walking."

BAUMANN Strangers In The Night (Portrait, c/o Epic, 51 W. 52nd St., New York, NY 10019)—More state-of-the-art synthesized dancetronics from this master of machine music. Yet Baumann, former keyboard whiz with Tangerine Dream along with vocalist Eli Holland makes it all sound wonderfully human. He's already a club and college radio fave and some of the subtler cuts here (especially "King Of The Jungle") show definite AOR potential. Top cuts: "Strangers In The Night" (yes, a quirky upbeat cover of the 'Ole Blue Eyes standard), "Cash" and "Ground Zero."

MOTELS Little Robbers (Capitol, 1750 N. Vine St., Hollywood, CA 90028)—Martha Davis and her Motels follow-up their hit *All Four One* LP with another superbly satisfying effort. Lead by the mystical sure-fire hit "Suddenly Last Summer," Davis' inimitable pipes smoulder here, especially catching fire on the slower numbers. Little Robbers they are, borrowing riffs from such luminaries as Holland-Dozier-Holland's "Money" ("Where Do We Go From Here") and the Police's "So Lonely" ("Isle Of You"). But no matter—an impressive step in the evolution of a fine band. Top cuts: Above mentioned plus "Little Robbers," "Into The Heartland" and "Tables Turning."
