REPORT OF THE MEETING WITH OPA

NOTICE

Regardless of what you may have read or heard, this is the only complete, true and first hand report of the committee's meeting with officials of the Office of Price Administration in Washington, D. C., Thursday, August 19, 1943, as reported by a member of the committee chosen to meet with OPA. (The Cash Box was the only coin machines publication to come to the fore and courageously arrange for a Wartime Conference, at its own expense and with no thought of personal profit, but instead for the good and welfare of the entire industry, to call together the operators, jobbers and distributors of this industry from among whom a committee could be chosen to meet with OPA. In keeping with its established policies The Cash Box brought you a first hand report of the first Wartime Conference and the minutes of this meeting are at the offices of The Cash Box for the perusal of any coin machines man. Here again The Cash Box brings you the only complete and first hand report of what actually took place when the chosen committee met with OPA.)

It is historical to note at this time that the marvelous fighting spirit of the coin machines men has come to the fore, aroused by The Cash Box, which offset the first frightening published reports about MPR-429 by a complete analysis of this regulation. This fighting spirit is better than ever exemplified in the fact that the industry is today wholeheartedly back of The Cash Box to continue its brave fight until complete clarification is won at OPA and an organization of mutual benefit to all organizations and individuals in this industry is set up for its future protection and welfare. It was this fighting spirit which caused the members of the industry to ask The Cash Box to call for a Second Wartime Conference within 60 days as reported in our last issue. A form is attached to this issue for your promised attendance at this conference. It is the hope of those who attended the first Wartime Conference that this mutually beneficial organization will be realized at this Second Wartime Conference.



The committee of six men appointed at the first Wartime Conference held at the Waldorf-Astoria Hotel in New York City, August 16 and 17, to represent this industry went on to Washington, D.C. on Wednesday, August 18, 1943 and met at the Mayflower Hotel that evening and the next morning to discuss the presentation of their problem to the Office of Price Administration on Thursday, August 19. It is pertinent to explain here that the members of this committee continued in conference thruout Wednesday morning and evening and into Thursday morning, without regard to their own rest or time (and entirely at their own expense) and went on to the Office of Price Administration where the OPA group of officials awaited them.

The conference started at 2:30 P.M. Thursday. Present for the coin machines industry were: Wm. Marmer of Sicking, Inc., Cincinnati, O., representing operators, jebbers and distributors; Alfred W. Blendow, president of the Arcade Owners Ass'n., New York, representing arcade operators; Henry J. Windt of Hoosier-Simplex Music Company, Indianapolis, Ind., chosen at a meeting of operators in Indiana to represent them at this first Wartime Conference; Alvin J. Goldberg of Chicago-Simplex Distributing Co., Chicago, Ill., who also has offices in Indiana, California, Pennsylvania and New York representing distributors; Lee J. Rubinow, president of the Automatic Operators Ass'n. of New York, representing operators; and Bill Gersh of The Cash Box who was chosen as spokesman for this committee.

The committee was greeted with extreme cordiality. The officials of OPA were tremendously interested in what could be done for this industry regarding price regulation. Questions were shot at the members of this committee by all these officials and the general idea was to learn just how and why and where and when a ceiling could be arranged and regulation put into effect. It is understood, as explained by OPA, that this industry, like any other, is subject to regulation. It is also understood that this industry has been and continues to be under GMPR (General Maximum Price Regulation). In fact, all industries are generally covered by GMPR. The very fact that

more specific regulations are now being written for each and every industry is to supersede this general coverage by GMPR. MPR-429 supersedes GMPR and becomes law as of September 1, 1943.

The committee was brief and to the point in explaining why MPR-429 would prove injurious to all in this industry. The committee not only explained that this regulation hurt the capital investment of each and every operator in this industry but that it would also absolutely curtail sailes and therefore others would suffer to a great extent. At the same time the spokesman for the committee explained that the problem of MPR-429 permeated itself down to the distributors, jobbers and operators. The following chart was drawn to explain this point. The chart was arranged to show the various steps in the complete working set-up of the coin machines industry.

The manufacturer was immediately eliminated from the chart due to the fact that he is not manufacturing coin operated machines at present and therefore has no bearing in MPR-429. Next the consumer was removed from the chart for it was explained that he is already protected by the mechanical limitations of the machines themselves and is therefore not being overcharged for the services which coin operated machines render. (In short, 20 years ago the consumer paid 5¢ per phono play and is still paying the same. This is also true of all other types of equipment on the market at this time.) The location owner was next eliminated from this chart due to the fact that he is not interested in MPR-429. He is only interested in receiving his commissions from the machines. He does not buy or sell machines. Therefore this left the distributor and jobber and the operator, and these were the men represented at this meeting.

OPA's officials then asked questions regarding prices of equipment generally. This was explained by the operators on this committee. As one official, questioning one of the committee asked, "You would rather have a low price, wouldn't you, than pay a high price?" This operator intelligently answered that he would much prefer to pay the higher price and know that the machine he was getting and placing on location would have more attractiveness and eye appeal and play appeal and thereby bring him so much better returns than to place a machine on location that was shoddy and worn looking and which he knew, from past experience, would not bring him profit at all, but more than anything else, would actually lose the play. OPA also wanted to know whether the present "service" being rendered to the consumer today was as good as the service being rendered in the past. This was marvelously answered by one music operator who explained that today the public were not only getting better, amplified tone, but also better and more costly rocords made by better, higher paid orchestras as well as finer service in a much more beautiful machine and a greater solection of music, and that they were still only paying the same nickel for all this tremendously improved service.

OPA then questioned as to where a possible line of demarcation could be drawn. That is, where the distributors and operators would be satisfied, as far as price of used machines was concerned. This was also well handled by the committee who stated that they were more than willing to work out a schedule of prices with OPA. It was, after much questioning along this line that OPA's officials asked just what could be done for this industry under the present MPR-429. It was here that the committee explained that the operators, jobbers and distributors were in the wholesaler category according to OPA's own definition of what a sale at wholesale was as contained in MPR-429. One member of the committee dramatically explained the fact that no operator nor jobber nor distributor actually "used" the machines he purchased. The committee asked after this explanation, that the words "or leasing" be added to the present definition of a "sale at wholesale" and thereby clarify the operators in this industry as "wholesalers". At this juncture in the discussions it was noted that more than three hours had already been consumed.

It was pointed out that this industry would have to go back under GMPR if it was removed from MPR-429, where it has always been along with all other industries. Whether or not the coin machines industry would be entirely removed from MPR-429 wasn't definite. But, if the operators are classified as wholesalers in this interpretation then as far as this industry is concerned they are excepted from this regulation (for wholesalers are excepted from MPR-429.) At the same time it was explained that where two or three old machines were used to make one machine that these men who are rebuild-

ing such machines come under Regulation 188 (of course with the understanding that they are paying the 10% excise tax to the federal government). But even under this Regulation 188 the rebuilder 's status is very hard to define for his product actually becomes a new product and not something that was formerly manufactured.

The answer to this entire problem we believe should be a new regulation referring specifically to this industry with probably a "dollar and cents" ceiling, as was the expression used by one of the OPA officials at this meeting. But whether OPA wants to take the time now to write such a regulation is something that can be cause for speculation.

It is well to remember that as far as the 130,000,000 consumers of this nation are concerned none of these is being affected by this regulation. They are still paying the same price for the services rendered by this industry as they always did. They are completely protected by the mechanical limitations of the machines themselves. Therefore the consumers are not being hurt. Of course, were some consumer to purchase a machine for his own use, or wore some of the department and sporting goods store sales of coin operated machines to be made to some consumer, then naturally these would be covered by MPR-429.

But due to the fact that this little industry is not affecting the 130,000,000 consumers in these United States in any serious fashion and even if MPR-429 continues on as a law it is more or less undorstood that deals will be excepted from this regulation just as sales at wholesale are excepted from this regulation. In short, we return to the original point as analyzed and explained sometime ago in The Cash Box and that is, that sales between jobbers and operators, between distributors, jobbers and operators, between distributors and operators, are all "wholesale sales" for eventually the operator, too, resells the machine he has purchased.

We have faith in the committee that represented this industry. We believe that their work was extremely commendatory. We know that they carefully and intelligently and efficiently explained their industry. The very fact that they were complimented at the end of this meeting is sufficient proof to all that this industry was well represented at this meeting with the Office of Price Administration.


Personally, we are of the belief that whether MPR-429 remains in effect or not that it will not affect the sales of this industry from the standpoint of wholesale sales. It is our belief that to get true regulation an entirely new bill will have to be written and that this will require the services of the outstanding operators, jobbers and distributors in this industry, and take months to complete.

This report is not to be taken as a "word for word" report of all that transpired at this meeting. Such a report would require many times more pages than are here already. With all modesty, having been a member of this committee, let it be said that this committee handled itself in such fine fashion that it can only be complimented to the skies. To sit here and read this report is simple. But, to enter into a room with OPA, not knowing what questions will be shot at them, not knowing the attitude of the men with whom they will meet, not having ever met with any government agency previously, is a severe mental strain.

For the marvelous job they accomplished in this meeting with OPA-The Cash Box takes great pleasure in giving our Honorable Mention Award to the members of this committee; namely: Wm. Marmer of Cincinnati, Ohio; Alvin J. Goldberg of Chicago, Ill.; Henry J. Windt of Indianapolis, Ind.; Alfred W. Blendow of New York and Lee J. Rubinow of New York. And, in addition, wants to personally thank them on behalf of all this industry for the marvelous explanatory and good will job they did.

SECOND WARTIME CONFERENCE

Now that the first milestone has been passed on the road to the creation of an organization to act as a common meeting ground for all the organizations and all the rugged individuals in this industry it is the hope of The Cash Box that the plea of those who attended the first Wartime Conference will be realized and that a Second Wartime Conference, to take place in 60 days, to arrange for the National Coin Machine. Board of Trade or the National Coin Machines Chamber of Commerce or whatever name will finally be decided upon to designate this organization as a mutually beneficial organization for all concerned will be made a tremendous and outstanding success. By filling out the form enclosed with this issue you will make this Second Wartime Conference possible. By getting all your friends and acquaintances in this industry to do the same you will make it completely representative of this industry. By such action you will have caused this industry to again advance one more progressive step forward.



(P) "'Sale at wholesale' means a sale by a person who buys a commodity and resells it without substantially changing its form to any person other than the ultimate consumer except that for the purposes of Paragraph 1499.3 of this General Maximum Price Regulation a sale at wholesale shall include any sale by such person to an industrial or commercial user."

DEFINITION OF A WHOLESALER ACCORDING TO MPR-429

(Sec. 4, P. 4) "Sales at wholesale. A sale at wholesale is a sale to a person who buys for the purpose of reselling the goods rather than for use. Sales at wholesale remain covered by the General Maximum Price Regulation."
