## INDIANA G.O.P. CONVENTICN NOMINATES CAPEHART U.S.SENATE

 Some of the Hoosier State's leading coirmen wired The Cash Box (Friday, June 2) that Homer E. Capehart, Fackard Manufacturing Corp., Indianapolis, Ind.had just been nominated for United States Senator (long term) by the Republican convention in that state. The news has since been carried over the air and in the press.Aside from President Franklin D. Roosevelt, who was formerly on the board of directors of Camco (Consolidated Automatic Merchandising Corp., New York) when he was Governor of New York, Homer E. Capehart will be the only other man connected with the coin machines industry who will be a member of the nation's executive body, if elected.

It is believed by these Indiana coinmen, who are close to the situation, that Capehart will be elected and that this will not only honor their state but will greatly honor the coin machines industry of the country.

## FRONT PAGE PUBLICITY IN COLUMBUS ON SLOTS

The Columbus Evening Dispatch (Wed., May 31) carried a front page, big headline story that the War Production Board office in Cleveland reported that "illicit slot machines" were being manufactured in Columbus of scarce war materials in violation of WPR's order M-126, which prohibits delivery,acceptance or use of materials in the manufacture of gambling devices.

Were a similar type violation to happen in any other industry - it might, possibly, obtain two or three lines of closely packed; small type, buried away somewhere in the business news section of this same paper. But the very fact that "slot machines" were mentioned by WPB's office in the press release of this item, it was blasted wide open on the front page of the Columbus Evening Dispatch which also calls itself, "Ohio's Greatest Home Daily".

Here again is noted the need for public relations effort on the part of this industry so that matters of such localized nature may be held down to their deserving point.

## I. C.C. URGED TO SUSPEND MOTOR FREIGHT RESTRICTIONS

Tho Transportation Board of Investigation and Research recommended to the President and the Congress (Fri., June 2) that the Interstate Commerce Commission be directed to suspend for the war's duration restrictions which this agency claims hampers the efficiency of motor freight carriers.

By removing such harsh restrictions as are now in effect, this will react to the benefit of all in this industry. As is well known, coinmen have been finding it ever more difficult to arrange for interstate motor freight.

The trade will watch the results of this recommendetion to the President and the Congress in the hope that it will meet with their approval.

## WP B TO INSTITUTE TIGHTER LUMBER CONTROL <br> WPB has just announced that a drastically revised lumber limitation order which will

 include specific directions to mills heretofore unaffected by controls will be issued very shortly. The revisions, which are being made as a result of the information secured under operation of the present Im335 order, were outlined in Washington (Fri., June 2) by WFB officials to the wholesale lumber distribution industry advisory committec.In addition to placing lumber consumption ceilings on various end uses, the order will also specify that no lumber may be shipped by any mill directly to users except on certified orders. While uncertified orders may bo taken by mills from distributors the latter will also be required to sell their stocks to certified users only.

The great need for lumber in this industry is well known. Crating for shipping as well as lumber for cabinets to replace damage as well as cabinets for revamping are among the lumber needs. It will therefore be to the interest of coinmen requiring lumber for the balance of the year to check with their present source of supply.

## "The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round" <br> By Bill Gersh



Reports are coming thru in ever growing numbers of more and still more direct sales being made which are pushing coinmen out of good locations. This is more or less due to the high prices being paid by retailers, who are today in a position to pay higher prices for income producing coin operated equipment. Rather than just obtain a percentage, many retailers are taking advantage of coinmen who introduced and educated them to this business, by now purchasing machines directly. In many cases they obtain these machines at no more than regular trade prices.

Many noted coinmen thruout the country report that this practise now seems to be increasing instead of diminishing, which would seem the logical result due to the fact that equipment is becoming more and more scarce each day. It certainly isn't logical for any coinman to expect his business to remain solid if he allows himself to be captured by the glamour of a few extra dollars by the direct sale of one machine. This may not hurt him inmediately, nor directly, but he just can't believe that some other coinman will remain quiet, especially if distressed by such a direct sale to location he has spent many years developing. This other man, too, must eventually find a way of getting rid of equipment which becomes useless to him if his location is gone because of a direct sale. And, it should be remembered, that he, too, in his anger, may sell direct. This is how the vicious circle starts.

Direct to locations sales burns the candle at both ends for the sellers, There is always that fringe of the unscrupulous in any industry who will take advantage of a situation for a quick profit grab. This does not help them in the least. Erentually they are discovered and scorned by the trade.

The men in this trade who are foolish enough to believe that by selling a location they are simply getting rid of a machine at a good price, will have a long row to hoe before they can convince the men in this business who have made this industry the means for earning their livelihood of this.

Whatever short term advantage acorues to such men is lost over a period of time. They not only find that the customers they enjoyed become lost to them, for they have helped to throw these same customers out of locations and therefore the se men do not need to purchase any equipment from them, but at the same time, they have most definitely hurt all the industry, for they have lessened its location possibilities and its eventual earning power and growth.

There is no doubt that those merchants, or at least the greater majority of them, who purchase equipment directly, lose out especially when repairs and services are required for the equipment they purchased. But in the meantime the coinmen who lose these locations find themselves in a real predicament. And once the retailer learns costs and methods and means of purchase - he is hard to control on any sort of a decent percentage basis. It takes years to get such locations back to the trade.

The Cash Box has many times been tempted to bring the names of such sellers to the fore. Yet the very fact that these men are only a small minority, actually on the outer fringe of this industry, causes even this recognition of their damaging efforts to be too good for them.

The trade must make up its mind that it cannot, and certainly should not, tolerate such men. It must educate them so as to eliminate this practise or continue to suffer hurt after hurt.

Whatever profits the man who hurts his fellow men? There certainly is no repeat business in selling directly to locations. There is certainly no real, long term, profitable customer here. There is nothing but a fast, one time sale, which benefits no one in the long run, and just brings enmity as well as a reputation to such sellers that stinks to high heaven - in very short order.

## "The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"

The trade has gone too high up the ladder to allow such action. If coinmen will demand, as they did in the jobber and distributor survey conducted by The Cash Box a few short months ago, that no seller of merchandise be allowed to operate and therefore to compete with the men he is selling except under certain conditions, surely then, these men don't want an outer, irresponsible fringe of sellers, selling directly to their locations.

Many times a seller, because sameone far away from his territory wants his equipment and sends a check in full along with the order, and even tho he realizes from the name on the check, or the letterhead, or even the order itself, that this is a location and not a bonafide coin machines man, yet he goes ahead with the sale in the altruistic belief that he is not harming anyone in "his" territory by such sale.

This trade has before it the greatest opportunity it has ever faced, especially in the coming post-war period. It can, with close cooperation, build itself to its greatest prominence as the leading division in the entertainment industry. It plays a close second today to the leader in this field - the moving pictures industry.

But if that small, irresponsible, outer fringe of hangers on to this industry cannot be subdued and pushed aside so that this business can go on ahead to greater recognition, greater respect and prestige, than this business has failed of itself to clean its own house.

This must be done. The rising number of complaints most definitely indicate that a certain unscrupulous few in this industry have found this a most opportuno moment to take advantage of this business by direct selling to locations. This sort of selling, whether to retailers, P.X.'s, or to any other direct location, hurts all in this industry.

Such sales simply burn the candle at both ends for the sellers themseltes, who many times, try to sell the very same men whom they are knifing in the back, by selling direct to the locations of these men. The very fact that this practise continues on at this late date shows a lamentable lack of proper organization within this industry itself. This should be immediately cured.

## SCHOOL FOR MECHANICS

As proposed in the May 30, 1944 issue of The Cash Box, a school for coin machines mechanics becomes a most important, and now due to the hundreds of answers received from the trade, a very popular necessity.

Everyone in the trade agrees that such a school would prove invaluable, not only for today, but especially for the postwar era when large numbers of mechanics will prove more than ever necessary.

This industry, as far as its mechanical workings are concerned, has become highly complex. Indays gone by the average mechanic could handle a slot machine, phono, pingame, cigarette machine, digger scale, merchandiser, console and whatever was presented to him for his skilled touch. There are very, very few such men left these days for machines are becoming ever more intricate. The intricacies of the new mechanisms require specialists.

At the same time it takes many months to train a good mechanic in each division of the field. The average operator, jobber, distributor or even manufacturer has little time for such a task.

With the ending of the war, and a return to domestic production, the hectic hysteria that will result will most certainly push aside every thought but obtaining, selling and placing equipment of all types. Few, if any, will think of developing mechanics to help keep these new machines functioning perfectly. Few, if any, have any ideas as to just what intricate mechanisms may suddenly appear in the new machines as new materials and new ideas are presented.

Therefore now, while the entire industry is in a position to give more proper thought to this problem, can a school for coin machines mechanics be organized and such a school should be made an immediate possibility.

In such a school men can be taught every detailconcoraing certain types of new equipment by experienced instructors. Here returned soldiers, high-school youths just out of technical schools, war workers, many, many others, can be given complete surety that they will, on graduating from such a school, find lucrative positions awaiting them in this business.

Remember, the pingame of old is a thing of the past. Electronics have come to this field as they have come to other fields. The intricate electrical mechanisms of guns, phonos, etc., will look like a child's toy compared to some of the machines being contemplated for manufacture - tomorrow.

## "The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"

This now equipment will really and truly present a unique and puzzling problem to many of the men in this industry. Electronics will most definitely be taken advantage of by the manufacturers in this business. Other advanced developments in mechanical and electrical construction are also certain to appear as a result of the lessons learned in war work manufacture. The music machines field is expected to become an entirely separate and highly skilled mechanical problem because of the many lessons the se manufacturers have learned about tone quality and foproduction generally during this war period.

The men now engaged in this industry, that tight, small, highly concentrated nucleus, upon which the entire hopes and the future growth of all this industry rests, are capable of taking the nocessary time to help teach mechanics. They, themselves, cannot do it at present. With the lack of sufficient help. Harried by so many extraneous details. Snowed under by so much extra work. The men now in this business are in no position to give careful, precise instructions to educate mechanical minds for this business. And even if the men in this industry did have the time at present to dovelop mechanics, would they know just what the mechanical intricacies of the new equipment which will be presented in the post-war era will be like?

Only a school for coin machines mechanics makes possible a correct and logical answer. Men already engaged in mechanical repair work will find post-greduate courses introduced so that they, too, will better understand the new equipment as it is presented. There is no earthily doubt that to assure himself better results as well as the trade a better knowledge of the mechanical and electrical intricacies of his new products, the manufacturer will arrange with the inventor and his own engineers to give a cour se of instruction in such a school.

In fact, when it comes right down to brass tacks, such a school would prove of tremendous value to the manufacturers, as woll as to all others in this industry. It assures the manufacturers that the trade can be made to better know and better understand their equipment, especially the new equipment they intend to produce. It will save them thousands of dollars in unnecessary returns for repairs. It will help them gain greater favor in the eyes of the buyers by assuring the buyers that the equipment will oontinue to work on location because of the mechanical under standing of the equipment by the graduates of such a school who have been given a course in their types of machines.

Now, then, is the time for a school for coin machines mechanics to be started. The trade, by its many answers to The Cash Box request in its May 30, 1944 issue has proven it is tremendously in favor of such a school and is more than willing to support it wholeheartedly. Who will be the first to start the ball rolling?

## ON OPENING TERRITORY

of great importance, and much in discussion these days, is whether or not the larger metropolitan centers will again be opened to many types of amusement machines, after the war. As is well known, with such cities as New York, Chicago, Cleveland and Detroit legally closed to free play pinball games and other types of amusement machines there is a tremendous market lost to the industry.

Many in the se cities are already begining to plan on how these can be opened. Discussions are rife at this time among coinmen suggesting one method after another. The extremely favorablo decision obtainod in the state of Pennsylvania for free play pinball gemes, is being studied by many of these men. This is a model decision. Pennsylvania's coinmen are procoeding cautiously and carofully so that nothing will upset this decision.

In New York City many gather about on "Coinrow" (Tenth Avenue) and the leading topic of discussion always reverts to how this huge metropolitan center, which can use over 20,000 free play pinball machines could again be opened to the se games. This city alone, as can easily be understood, is a tremendous market in itself for this industry. Its opening would mean greater prestige for all the trade. It would also mean that over 300 coinmen would again bocome buyers.

And this is true of Chicago, Detroit, Cleveland and other smaller centers, too. In the se markets another great number of machines could be placed into operation. They would tremendously add to the prospective business which this industry looks forward to when domestic production again gets under way.

As coinmen in these metropolitan centers seek for a means, there may be among the readers of The Cash Box some men with daring ideas which could prove of great benefit to opening the se centers. (If you have any ideas in this direction send them in to The Cash Box now.)

"Over here one is always thinking of home and what the folks back home are doing at the same time of day. I read an article sometime same time of day. I
"An old man stopped a young man who was in the service and asked, "What time is it?" The service man replied, 'It's 5 o'clock.' The old man answered, 'You must be slow, as it was 5 o'clock when I started out.' And the service man said, 'Well you see when I entered the serv ice my Pop gave this watch to remind me of home. I live out West, and when it's 5 o'clock by my watch I know that Pop is just getting home. When it's ten, the family is going to bed You see, I can find out the time wherever I am, what I like to know is what time it is-at home.

Yes, Bill, it's the same with me and all the others over here. Thinking of home and all the folks is what makes the boys in the fox holes, folks is what makes the boys in the fox holes,
and the boys that are over the enemy in planes, and the boys that are over the enemy in planes,

"I have been over here about 3 months now and am with a swell outfit. We have a day room with a bar where only wine is sold. One day I was able to go to town. I wanted to buy some thing to send home. I walked and walked and what do you think I bought? Not a damn thing. Most of the stores were closed because of the war. And the ones that were open had 5 c and 10c store merchandise that they were asking $\$ 2.00$ and $\$ 3.00$ for. One thing I saw was a pair of shoes that sell for about $\$ 1.98$ in the states ond they were $\$ 18.00$ here.
