## WHAT TO EXPECT THIS FALL

 AND WINTERNow that the half-way mark has been passed, and the general concensus boing to the offect that Gemany will be dofeated before this year is over, business men can look forward to the following ovents, according to the Research Instituto of Anerica.

## FALL, 1944

War Production, which is reported to have reached its peak during the first half of this year, will decline.

A manpower shortage will continue to pinch lesseessential civilian industries.
The Nationel income will be at its highest level.
Some wages and price lovels will go up. The rate of savings will continue to go up in spite of taxes.

A large proportion of war production is expected to shift to the West Coast.
Post-war problems will occupy more and more of national thought. The situation will be somewhat confused by a halfawar, half-pcace atmosphere.

Dies and tools used in war production will bocome increasingly available on the market.

Consumers will start to resist "victory" models of products and will instead look forward expectantly to the new post-war products.

Reconversion of some plants for peacetimo operation will start getting under way slowly.

The public is warnod to start preparing for the return of soldiers to the family and also for possible loss of war plant jobs due to cancellations of war contracts. The goverment, tho, will work hard to help such workers find new jobs.

Manufacturers are urged to do the following. Estimate market for prewor and war models in first yoar after Hitler's defoat. Docide on nood for new products. Search for new products ideas. Products plans for customers shouldbo shecked. Continue to check the availability of materials for now products. Determine capacity for production. Estimate materials noed. Watch inventory. Plan for reconversion of business.

As far as salos are concerned, the following is offered. Analyze market outlook. Examino distribution sot-up. Plen on rebuilding of salos force. Start recruiting now salesmen. Prepare advertising program.

## WINTER, 1944

Real decline in war production begins, especially in such lines as shipyards, tools, construction and light ammunition. Curtailment may reach rate of $25 \%$ of 1944 peak by the year's ond.

Slow expansion in production of civilian goods, liko washing machines and rofrigerators.

Unemployment in war production areas may reach $4,000,000$ by end of the year.
Servicemen returning to civilian jobs. Rate of return will probably exceed 100,000 monthly by year's ond.

Economic uncertainties accontuated by the election.

## "The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Roypd",

Loosening up of materials for some civilian goods, but smaller than expected volume of output.

## Gradual disappearance of "sellers" market.

Jurisdictional disputes among trade unions beginning in some industries reconverting to civilian production.

Severance pay proposals beginning to be discussed.
Begin to "earmark" sone of your savings for a new car, television radio, a now house, refrigerator or other luxury items that you will want as they become available on the market.

Manufacturers are suggested to make their decision on post-war materials. Prewar models should be offered so that they hit the market early. New products should be tested. Prepare to meet competition from new ríal products. Check capacity against sales plans. Discontinue substitutes. Watch government disposal of plants and equipment. Obtain bids and place sample orders for materials. Reduce inventory to a minimum. Docide on size of now inventory. Decide on plant location. Check postawar use of government owned facilities. Get estimates on roconversion costs and start reconversion program. Plan engineering. Decide on disposal of equipment. Start survey on available tools and machinery. Make replacements and repairs. Dispose of obsolete equipnent.

And for sales forces the following is being suggested. Examine need for changes in market coverage. Be ready to shift into new markets. Discuss plans with your outlets for your products. Get ready to assist your outlets with service and credit. Start intensive advertising.

Also suggested. Expect and prepare for return of some soldiers to old jobs. Overhaul your working force. Start your labor training program. Expect drain on cash for replacements and repairs. Check adequacy of your cash reserves. Watch for frozen accounts and rise of business failures. Prepare plans for long-term funds.

## COMMENTS

The entire program as presented here has helped many business men to enter into greater and more intensive planning for the postowar period. As is well known to the trade The Cash Box has been urging the membors of this industry to get more deeply into post-war planning for there is no doubt anymore that the ending of the war may come as a complete and sudden surprise and many will be caught short, as they were after the last war.

Every division of this industry must be fully prepared so that each and every coirman will be ready to make the most profitable move in his territory. There is no doubt that with soldiers expected to return at the rate of 100,000 per month beginning late Fall and increasing this number during the Winter that this industry will probably be able to somewhat re-establish its labor situation and will also gain a greater

At the same time war plant reconversion has a great many business men worried. There may suddenly come about long lay-off periods while manufacturers prepare for domestic production. This industry will not suffer by these. In fact, it is expected to profit from the lay-offs which will come about. This temporary reconversion period will cause much unemployment but the slack is expected to be taken up by goverment agencies now making plans in this regard with manufacturers.

Regardless of how this program strikes the public generally, there is no doubt that this industry will survive it with flying colors. There is also no doubt that used machines will continue extremely $\nabla$ aluable, even when reconversion seems imminent for this industry. The production lines of the present factories will not be able to take care of the huge backlog demand which has already accumulated in this industry and estimated at far over $1,000,000$ machines of all known types.

Just from the standpoint of obtaining and maintaining locations, used machines value will continue high. Many who will reoenter into the field will seek used machines to recapture locations they left behind. Therefore the used machines market will have many high pricod months left in it until the manufactories begin to turn out equipment on somewhat the scalo they did prior to the war.

Also of great interest to the trade, along with this future outlook, are prices of machines after reconversion is well under way. The general belief is that prices will remain high. Materials and labor costs have risen well over the $30 \%$ mark to date and with compotition stepping up to a keener market than ever for raw materials, with all manufacturers seoking to reach the market first with their products, there is no doubt that cost of equipment will of necessity remain high for some months to come, at least until complete domestic production can be seen without any restrictions whatsom ever.

## WHAT ABOUT INCREASED TAXES?

One of the roally great problems facing this industry, especially for the postwar era, will be to reduce taxation from a burden to a workable outlay percentage of income. All industries are faced with this same problem. Experts realize that trade growth will be greatly curtailed, and that there will be much less interest to enter into new businesses, if taxes continue to remain prohibitive for such risk.

Congress has recognized this fact. It is now studying how to cut postmar taxation. Joint Congress committee experts have been ordered to start these studies at once. The hope is that these Congressional committees will be able to present a workable and logical method for a downward revision from present taxation so that industry will be able to continue on ahead and will not be hampered by inequitable and excessive taxation, as is at present the fact.

There have been a great many demands from among leading members of this industry that something should be done to bring about a better understanding (in the trade itself) as well as to taxing bodies, why and how this industry is being inequitably taxed. This was one of the reasons given by The Cash Box when it urged the industry to create a National Coin Machines Board of Trado and a National Coin Machines Tax Council. Such bodies would be in proper position to work with these Congressional committees on cutting down inequitable and excessive taxation for this trade.

In this past wook's issue of The Cash Box thore appeared notice of the fact that certain cities were again beginning to visualize the prominence of coin operated equipment and that further taxation, in addition to prosent taxes, was therefore sure to come into effect. (Terre Haute, Ind. and Cambridge, Mass. are in the throes of having license fees tremendously increased.) This industry must arrange to clear the atmosphere of this sort of misunderstanding or it will not bo able to proceed forward in the fashion it would like to in the post-war period.

There is very little difference between a town that is closed by legal procedure or police action and a town that is open whero taxation is so high that it simply does not pay to operate. (There is one town we have in mind where a license fee of $\$ 300$. per yaar was placed on pinball machines. The city authorities boldly and publicly stated that this license feo was purposely set at this excessive figure so as to discourage the operation of pinball.) This is just as bad as if that town were legally closed to pinballs.

The Congressional study inspired by business leaders assures this industry that business men overywhere are aware of the fact that taxes are excessive and therefore injurious to the further progress of all trade.

In the meantime this industry, nor any other industry for that matter, can make any approach to governing bodios to have taxation reducod while this war is in progress. But with the belief more or less general that much reconversion will be get.ting under way late this Fall for a great many industries, and that the war in Europe may end sometime this year rather prevalent, the nation's business men feel that the Government should be prepared to help them onter into the post-war era without tax obstacles in their path.

It should be the work of the leaders in this industry to arrange to see that there is present in Weshington someone to represent this business when the problem of lowered taxes comes up for discussion. This is a job that could best be done by a National Coin Machines Board of Trade or a National Tax Council. Since neither are in oxistence then this industry must depend upon a certain fow of its leadors to spend their own time, effort, energy and money to go on to Washington, when the time arrives, and help to protect all this industry as best as they possibly can.

Jersey Shore Arcades Win Restraint Injunction

Following the item which appeared here a few weeks back that a crusader had started to work on arcades located at the Jersey shore, specifically naming roll down games and skee balls, the following item has just appeared in The Newark Evening News which proves that the arcade men at the New Jersey shore are on their toes.
"Prosecutor Quinn can keep arresting operators of mechanical games on the boardwalk but he can't prevent them from doing business until Chancery Court has decided whether the law is being riolated in their stores.
"Vice-Chancellor Berry at Long Branch gave this view on the return of a show cause order obtained by two operators to restrain permanently the prosecutor from interfering with the games. He said petitioners had instituted the action in good faith and had the right to remain in business until the issue was decided." Asbury Park officials pleaded for the ViceChancellor to intervene on the side of the petitioners to protect their $\$ 76,000.00$ in rentals received from the operators of amusement games. This was denied by the court on the ground that revenue was no basis for deciding legality of games.

The Vice-Chancello stated that the quickest method of determining the legality of the games was thru criminal proceedings. Counsel for the operators invited such proceedings. A member of one of the operating concerns is now under arrest on his own invitation to determine the legality of the games. His hearing before a local magistrate has so far been postponed.

The operators claim that their games are games of skill. The prosecutor states that they involve more chance than skill and also that the award of prizes on the games is contrary to the law.

Vice-Chancellor Berry smilingly stated to the operators, "I may have to challenge you gentlemen to play these games to find out how much chance and skill are involved."
