# "The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round" By Bill Gersh 



## THEY'RE COMINC BACK

It is indeed interesting to note, in almost every day ${ }^{3}$ s mail, the reports that more and still more former coinmen are once again returning to the industry. A great many of them are a bit "raw" about what has gone on since they left the trade. But, they all want to again get back into the action for which this industry is so noted.

These old-timers are the men who helped build the large routes and noted distributing businesses. Miany of them entered into other industries when the tide of war forced ever deeper rationing to affect this trade.

They now claim that leaving this business was just temporary and that they always had intended to return the moment the opportunity offered itself.

They're coming back. They all seom to be pepped up with the thought that this business is starting its long postowar pull forward. They feel that action will be faster than ever, and that profitable future growth is a surety.

Just the other day one former coinman called at the offices of The Cash Box. He had confined himself to the real estate business for the past few years. He had sold his route and also his jobbing business.

He reported. "I met some of the old guys in the business and from the way they talked I got all steamed up again. Well - here I am, asking questions. I sure want to get back in this business. It's a business I know and I like."

This seems to be about the average statement of these men who left the business for the past few years. They all "like the business". They all "want to get back" into it again. They all "are steamed up" over future possibilities.

As far as the men who have endured all the rationing and headaches of this ware time period aro concerned - here come the first new customers of the postowar era seeking to get locations, enter into jobbing and distributing, or into one or a myriad of tho angles which are part and parcel of this industry.

Theres no doubt that most of these men will find it just a bit tougher to get going now than they probably would were new machines in production and good used equip. ment available at low prices. But regardless of what the present situation is, the se back.

Surely this first sign of growth, with the return of the oldatimer, is going to be many, many times enhanced as the months go by. The returned servicemen who know this business are reported to be coming back in ones and twos here and there thruout the country. This is expected to increase into a steady stream of men who, for one reason or another, the armed forces will honorably discharge and roturn to civilian life.

In addition, and once the new machines get under way again there is expected to be a rush of much new blood to the field. Therefore the industry can look to greater and more hectic action than it has ever before enjoyed. All this is most clearly indicated by the old-timer who is coming back into this business again.

## MUSIC SECURITY

The average music coinman does not believe that he is in any danger of being pushed claims that locations any too easily, even after the new oquipment comes into being. He claims that most music operators, especially those who have many remote installations,
are pretty secure in the ir spots.

## "The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"

This moted music man, making this statement, writes, "Take some of my locations. I have a lunch wagon, one of the best in the country, with 26 wall boxes in it, in addition to three speakers, a hidden unit, and even a public address system. I would just like to see someone throw me out of that location.
"If any guy wants to walk in there and spend the kind of money necessary to make this kind of a remote installation, and then cut commissions, he's welcome to this spot. I know this location owner. And even if this competitor (whoever he may prove going to want the installations. him the very latest gadget in remote systems, he isn't
"The reason is simply that this location once went thru over a week's work and dirt that was required to make the installation we now have in there. It took us a long time until we had everything perfected so that this location liked the way the installation was made. Like a lot of others we were forced to change boxes, speakers, step-ups, and goodness knows what else, until we got the tone and sound spread that
"Since then he has painted over the moulding which we used to cover the wire and anyone that can walk in there and have him get us to rip all that out, well, the guy deserves the spot. I claim that the average music operator is pretty secure in his locations today, and that he will not get too excited about buying large quantities
"Furthermore, most of us have paid off just about everything that we owed and we like to feel that we don't owe some factory a lot of money. I like the feeling, and
"Sure I would like to place more machines - but that doesn't mean that I'm going to interfero with better than $75 \%$ of my present installations. Not unless the manufac turers can show me something that will not only earn me more money but that will prove better and more economical in every way.
"In fact, even if I wanted to pull some of my installations - I just wouldn't have the heart to do it for the work that went into these spots is something everyone

Whether or not this is security, is something that the future will decide. It is a fact, tho, that such expensive remote installations are the exception. Yet there is a lot of good meat in this letter and there should be a lot of thought given to it by the men actively ongaged in the music machines industry.

Frankly, it sounds like the old days when modern phonos were being introduced. At that time the old line phono men claimed they wouldn't buy. Today, these firms are long gone with past history of the phono business. More than likely all progresproduced. And rightfully so too if they get their share of the fine

## ACTION AHEAD

The trade is getting prepared for what it believes will prove to be the greatest action period in all of its active history. The average coinman feels that once announcements of new equipment come forth - he will have to be prepared to jump into an entirely different and new kind of action than he is now demonstrating, so that he will not be left behind in the rush.

Already a great many coinmen have made trips to Chicago. Most were a bit disappointed to learn that the manufacturers are still too busy with war work to take time

These coinmen should realize that most of the manufacturers are still very, very busy people - working hard to help Uncle Sam finish this war so much faster. And that is definitely to the advantage of every coinman as well as to all tho peoples in this

Whatever action will come about will naturally be of this industry's own making. The trade has been waiting a long, long time to again see machines rolling off production lines. Having waited this long-it surely can continue on just a little bit longer.

There is also no doubt that the average manufacturer is just as anxious as is the smallest operator to get back into good old time coin machines action. To meet with of time men at the annual shows. To greet them when they visit his factory with lots want. .

## "The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"

The fact remains that used machines dealings continue and will continue on for sometime to come. Even when production does get under way - at some time in the distant future - this will not mean that coinmen can just toss their used equipment overboard.

The action that is going on at this time will surely remain the sort of action that can be expected for sometime to come. The action ahead is as yot entirely ephemeral.


Retail record stores owned by music coinmen have been known to be in existence for sometime. Their growth is more apparent now than ever before. From Main Street to Broadway, the music operator seems to have decided that his knowledge of records, needles and all other appurtenances connected with music, makes him exceptionally well fitted for the retail store business.

Whether this will continue on just as progressively after the war or will prove another wartime fancy, is unpredictable at this time. Suffice it to say that the majority of music coinmen who have so far started music stores seem to be very much pleased with the results.

Interesting is the fact that in most cases this is a development from the used record sales which many music men featured in their present operating headquarters. Thruout the country signs can be seen on the windows and even in bold letters on the outside of the stores of these men, advising the public that used records can be purchased for $10 \not \subset$ and up.

These clicked with the public. It is now generally believed that this idea was the forerunner of the present retail music stores which are appearing thruout the nation, owned by music machine operators.

The music operator features everything from albums of classical music to record racks in his retail store. He also makes a great feature of the fact that he carries a most complete stock of used records.

The record manufecturer can look to these retail stores to bring him a large volume of business after the war. Thcy may prove the link between what the operator needs in addition to his automatic music business. At the same time he will be able to obtain the lowdown wholesale price for much of the supplies he uses.

Certainly this is one development that should be followed with great interest by all the music division of the industry for it may lead to something entircly new in the post-war period.

## SALESMEN MOVE AGAIN

It is interesting at this time to report that salesmen for some of the large factories, who have for sometime now occupied themselves with routine office matters, are again beginning to get out on the highways and byways of the nation and meeting with the trade.

That they are asking many questions (and also answering just as many) which was more or less to be expected. It is also a surety that they are reporting some rather interesting facts to their factories.

The manufacturers are probably finding these reports extremely valuable, as they continue to experiment to find the products thoy believe the trade will want, when domestic production is again allowed them.

The fact, tho, that the salesmen are again beginning to move about the nation means that the manufacturer is recognizing the fact that the cut-backs on war materials may force him to an earlier request for a return to his former products production.

The manufacturers will have to be ready, as WPB stated, to instantly enter into domestic production so as to take up the employment slack when the European war finishes and the big cut-backs come into being.

Whatever these salesmen learn will not only benefit their factories, but is sure to also benefit all engaged in this industry. It pays therefore to be quite frank and aboveboard with these men for they are reporting exactly what they learn to their factories.

## "TALKING OUT LOUD"

## USED EQUIPMENT SALES ONLY UNTIL SPRING OF 1945

Leading Coinmen Do Not Expect to See New Machines Until Late Spring of 1945. Claim Used Machines Sales Action Will Continue to Lead Field.

NEW YORK-Probably the most important statement as yet made is that of this industry's leaders who have come to the conclusion that there will not be any new machines until late Spring of ' 45 .

They base their judgment on the facts which have become apparent since WPB has gone into reconversion action. They believe that WPB is first interested in getting the consumers the merchandise which they have so badly needed for sometime. After that is covered, these men report, WPB will probably allow the manufacture of luxury items - among which they classify the products of this business.

These men also believe that merchandising equipment and music machines will come to the market before amusement devices. They state that many manufacturers, because of this, are swinging over to the music field. They expect to see manufacturers who have never before built music equipment in the music field. Some of , these, they claim, will also manufacture venders.

One of these men states, "The whole industry now realizes that it will be many, many months yet before new machines will come on the market. It will be months after that before this industry will see production somewhat in comparison to what we knew before the war.
"There is no doubt that rationing of raw materials will become fact as all industries go into reconversion. This will prove to be an absolute necessity so that there will not be inflationary bidding for steel, zinc, copper etc.
"WPB will probably so arrange rationing of such materials that all the most important industries, such as manufacturers of hospital necessities, electric appliances, etc., which the public are sorely in need of at this time, will come first.
"It is a sure thing that repair parts will be allowed to this industry. This will only be because WPB realizes that the manufacturers in this trade have gone all out to make the materials of war which have won so much praise for the men in this business.
"But, the very fact that repair parts will be allowed, means that WPB will not consent to allow this business to go into actual manufacture of new equipment for sometime to come."

The above ties in with events taking place at WPB's offices in Washington, D. C., every day. There is no doubt that this very important agency realizes that this industry, like all other luxury industries, regardless of the number of employees, will have to wait its turn in the line up which is being created.

Also impressive to this trade, regarding rationing of raw materials, is the fact that the automobile industry is expected to only build 2 million cars the first full production year. This is less than half of what the largest manufacturer in this field built in 1940.

Therefore, these men claim, if so important an industry as the auto business will only be allowed to build a small percentage of what they can and would like to construct - this field will also be rationed on a comparable basis.

The trade is therefore urged to continue along with its present used machines sales and make this the most important part of its business from now until sometime in the Spring of 1945 when leaders expect to see the first new machines.

This past week collections maintained their downard trend but the first faint glimerings of rising collections mere plainly discernible thruout the nation. The average dow for collections this past week was about $9 \%$ thruout the country, which includes all types of equipment ranging thru the amusement, merchandising and service fields.

This lon average for a drop in collections created great optimism thruout the country. Many reported that they expected to see the upswing in take this coming week. From reports received there is no doubt that this will be the case when the next week rolls around.

There is also no doubt that a great many of the merchandising machine men are only suffering on collections due to the fact that they cannot obtain the merchandise they need. Some of these men report that their machines are selling out faster than ever before in their history, but that they simply cannot obtain sufficient merchandise to keep their machines full at all times, or even half full.

Amusement machines showed the first upswing in collections. Phonos continue to be the steadiest of all the coin operated equipment and some of these showed increase in take amounting to anywhere from $5 \%$. to as high as $25 \%$. This is unusually good recovery and is attributed to the cooler weather.
