Members of the club are indignant over the gppearance of these 2 pinballs and the noise they are reported to be making when played. They beefed so loud and long that the story made the $N . Y$. press and is bringing a laugh from all who read it.

# WHY WE NEED A PUBLIC RELATIONS BUREAU 

For a long time now The Cash Box has been urging the trade to get together to create a Public Relations Bureau for the future good and welfare of all concerned with this coin operated machines industry.

There is no doubt of the great need for such a bureau. The taxation problem in itself requires that such a bureau come into existence to help lay the necessary ground work prior to any further proceedings toward more equitable taxation on the part of coin machines men.

The industry will greatly expand and greatly increase its operations during the post-war period. New territory will be required. Many new types of locations will be opened. Much ground work here, too, will heve to be done. A Public Relations Bureau can do this sort of work well.

In addition, legislatures will be seeking for more revenue to prepare public works programs for returning veterans. These legislators, as always, will jump on this industry to grab as much as they can from this business for the deficits which will be created in their community budgets because of such programs. A Public Relam tions Bureau will be in a position to foster better understanding of this industry by these legislatures, as well as by the public at large, and thereby helt outrageous taxation.

At the present time the Federal Government is spending $\$ 2$ for every $\$ 1$ that it takes in in income and excise taxes. This is due to the fact that we are now spending $\$ 90$ Billions per year and only taking in $\$ 45$ Billions from income excise and all other taxes. Estimates have been made that after V-E (Victory in Europe) day there will be a cutback of 40 per cent to 50 per cent in war production. Naturally, this may seem to some that the Government will not then require as much income. This has, however, already been proved to be an erroneous assumption.

Chairman George of the Senate Finance Committee and Chairman Doughton of the House Ways and Means Committee have already stated that taxes will continue in effect at their present rate thru 1945 and possibly until after the Japs are totally defeated. Even tho, when the war in Europe ends, Government expenditures are expected to decline about one-third, to about $\$ 60$ Billions. But, during this same period, the tax yield is also expected to be much lower because of the lower earnings which will accompany the cutbacks of war orders.

By the above the members of this industry can estimate the fact that a Public Relations Bureau will become a great need to help any National Tax Council which may be created, and to also help prevent, by a complete educational plan, the imposition of greater taxation upon the men in this business.

If a Public Relations Bureau is successful in doing just this one job, it will be worth whatever cost may be required to place some noted, national figure at the head of such a burenu for this industry.

It should be remembered that the baseball world eventually was forced to adopt just such a plan and elected the late Judge K. M. Landis to this position. The moving picture people, too, when they found they were too far out on a limb, were forced to get someone to coagulate their group and obtained the services of Will Hays. There are men who have sprung into national prominence during this war who would fit perfectly into such a position for this industry, and who could head a Public Relations Bureau that would prove invaluable to all the trade.

Another very important reason for the creation of such a bureau is the educational work which someone must undertake with the press of this nation. The newspapers are among the very first to jump down the necks of this industry. When a delegation of men come together to call on a newspaper publisher to discover his reasons for hitting so harshly and unfairly at the members of this trade, they are tremendously surprised to learn how really ignorant he is of the true facts. A Putilic Relations Bureau could cure this s:tuation.

## "The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"

A prominent, national figure, heading such a bureau, would be in position to take up any newspaper crusade with any publisher in the country and thru diplomatic and educational effort perhaps halt any further crusading actions. Many newspapers are reported to have used this business as a means to further their circulation. Others have used it as a"sensationalist" space filler. Because this business is unorganized it is easy prey for such people for it has no means whereby it can successfully ficht such cruel actions. A Public Relations Bureau could do much to halt this sort of thing and, at the same time, bring about better understanding with the pross of the nation.

There are crusaders, blue-noses and politicos all over the country who use this industry as a verbal football. The trade is not unaware of this and it doesn't fear these men, but these sort of people are attempting to gain themselves free publicity by blasting away at this business. They do convince some of the general public and this again starts the ball rolling against this industry. This has, many, many times in the past, been responsible for closing good territory to the equipment of this industry.

The men now in this business should also visualize what the effect will be on this industry when the trade enters into what can become its greatest oxpansion era during the post-war period. At such time equipment will becone more prominent. Machines will appear everywhere. This is naturally going to be ammunition for the loud cannons of crusaders, politiciuns, tax seekers, etc., etc.

And when competition becomes keener among the men in this industry they, too, will bring themselves more to the attention of these very people who are ready to smash at them for selfish gain. Therefore some sort of organization must come into being to help save this situation. And only a Public Relations Bureau, headed by a nationally prominent figure, can do the job.

It should also be remembered that a great many metropolitan centers thruout the nation are cilosed to various types of equipment. There is no reason why these cannot be re-opened when the right time comes. But no one is in position to step in by himself, or even with the help of only a few others, and attempt a drive for negative legislation, which is the most difficult and most expensive legislation.

Once a bill is pushed thru a city or state legislative body, the man who attempts to void that bill, or create another bill which will, at the same time supersede the first, has a most difficult and expensive task on his hends. Only a proninent, nationally recognized man, wi th the aid of a good organization, can even attempt such a job, and hope for success.

To enumerate the many other reasons for the need of a Public Relations Bureau for this industry would be useless if what has been already stated here doesn't drive the necessity for such a bureau home to the reader.

The Cash Box can point to a great, great many other reasons. But it feels that the members of this industry, those who subscribe to The Cash Box, are the true leaders of this business. These are the men most interested in the future welfare of this trade. These men will agree with The Cash Box that a Public Relations Bureau, headed by a nationally prominent person, is a great necessity for this trade.

DU YUU AGREE?


People change, problems change, moods change - the world, in fact, is in a constant state of flux. Industrics that fail to change with the changing times do not survive.

It has always been to the credit of the coin operated machines industry that it has been able to keep pace with the changing mood of the playing public. It has not kept pace with the change of progressiveness required in its own inner-industry councils.

Change is the most necessary and important factor for the continued success of this industry. This is the one facet in the jewel which makes this industry so attractive to heavier investment. It has not only met the requirements of the public but it has been able, by continued perseverance, to continue to meet public demand for the new, the novel, the different and the unique, all this even during wartime.

Perhaps all this can be attributed to the fact that this industry does not and will not, make any committments unless it feels that these will be the culmination of all its desires. "The men who are right on the firing line of this industry, the men who cover the locations, can instantly note any change which may occur in the mood of the player and quickly arrange to change the play to meet this new mod.

But even of greater importance than the fact that the trade has recognized it must constantly change its equipment or fade out of the picture as an industry, is the fact that it must change its own tactics to continue as an industry, especially if it desires to be recognized, to win prestige, to gain respect in the eyes of the public and all other industries in the nation.

There are men in this industry, possibly just a few hanging on to the outer fringe of this businoss, without whom this industry can do very well. These are the men who have created the harm which has, at various times, befallen this industry. These are the sort of people who, when everyone else plays ball, play their own game. The result is, because of them, all the rest of the team loses.

It is a well known fact that only one small operator, buried away somewhere in the outskirts, is usually the man who causes an entire territory to close. But it is necessary today that that very man be weeded out of this industry for the preservation and profitable continuance of all the others.

A great many inner-industry tactics must change. Certain distributors and jobbers, who are believers in selling only to what they term "suckers", must be cured of this belief. These men should be more honest and call their "suckers" - the "storekeepers". They will then have applied the correct meaning to the word. These are the men who like to burn the candle at both ends by selling the storekeeper and the operator as well.

Moving picture distributors and jobbers do not sell film to grocery stores or drug stores - they have consideration and respect for the theatre owner and his investment in their industry. Nor does the grocery store, drug or cigar store know what the theatre owner pays for film.

But by such men in this industry openly advertising prices to storekeepers everyone knows what machines cost, und the operators of the se machines are therefore left high and dry with very little defense for themselves when they find their own locations want to buy machines.

This must be remedied. This is one problem facing this industry, not only today, when machines are scarce and the law of supply and demand has placed products at a high peak - but for the post-war period, when such sellers can definitely ruin this business. Change or die. Get those prices away from the eyes of storeke epers.

Certainly it won't hurt if a storekeeper sees an ad on machines which entices him to ask for coin operated equipment for his place of business. But surely it isn't necessary to have him also know the lowdown price of that equipment. He doesn't toll the operator the lowdown price of his merchandise. He keeps that to himself as his own trade secret.

Therefore this industry, too, must arrange to keep its trade secrets and its problems to itself and not have every police precinct, every mayor's office and every government agency receiving weekly information.

Change or die. This is for the men in the industry to decide. And to decide now - while they can - before the post-war period, when they will be so busy trying to keep their heads above water that they won't know from which sides the water is being rushed in to drown them.

This is the time. This industry is a highly concentrated unit and the men can get together more quickly, more easily, to help effect the cure by the creation of a council to coordinate the desires of all the members of the industry regardless of their status.

# "Talking Out Loud" 

DISTRIBS GAIN IIIPORTANCL
Wartime Proves Their Value And Power. Manufacturers Concede Fact Distribs Have Continued Contacts With Operators And Jobbers While They Have Been Busy With War Work

## EYES ON DISTRIBS FOR POST-WAR

## Foresee Distribs As Major Force To Rebuild And Expand Trade For

 Post-War Period. Large Increase In Number Of Distribs And Jobbers Expected. Many Distribs Seek National Forum.NEW YORK-Most outstanding fact which has come to light is that the nation's leading manufacturers of coin operated equipment today recognize the greater importance of the distributors. The general belief is that the distributors, especially those who have withstood this wartime period, have proved themselves most capable tact with operators and jobbers. Becanse of this they have been able to naintain a merchandising factor of great importance and value to the future of this trade.
It i, alno believed thruout the industry that certain manufacturers may decide to have distributors who will handle their lines explusively. This has been coming to the fore since the days just before the war when certain manufacturers arranged to have distribs who could artually lie called "direct factory agent." represent then in important territories. This may prove an even more prominemt practise when the post-war era comes into being, is the belief of many distribs at this time.
Hany new manufacturers are also expected to enter into this field when reconversion sets in and these will most definitely be dependent on distributors to help them gain quick acceptance for their products. Therefore all eyes are on the distribs. Their postion grows in importance daily. There is no donbt that a great many coinmen, who formerly did not distribute equipment, are today interested in getting
into the wholesaling division of this industry and are pointing all their efforts in this direction.
In addition to all these facts the distribs themselves have come to the belief that they must yet together mino some sort of national forum to arrange for more ethiral prattise and better understanding of each other's business problems and territories. There has long been a sore bere of contention in the distributing division regarding shipments of machines into each other's territories. This has always hurt the trade for it brought on price wars and other injurious factors which created anything but good will for the distributor
By a national forum, many distribs are of the belief that they will be able to arrange a cure for a great many of their problems, and that the men who form this very important division of the field will be able to better continue onward in the post-war period if they rearls an underetanding between each other reaperting the other man's wishes, All the trade look- to the distribs to help increase and expand this ficld. Many ops are a bit suspicions of the honorable intentions of certain distributors, but generally the belief is that with the cost of equipment murh higher than ever before in the listory of the industry that the new blood which will be bronght into this field, after the war, will prove of a better and more financially solid nature.
This, say leading distribs, is sure to be the case for they point to the fact that even ten machines today, and especially after the war, will involve a much larger financial investment than ever before in the history of this busincss, and that becanse of this fact alone they will be able to bring in the sort of new blood which will meet with the complete approval of all factors in the trade.
The National Electrical Wholesalers Association at their annual form this past week in New York City brought home some very important factors for the average distributor's benefit. They pointed out that even tho the average manufacturer in their field has been tending toward factho the average manufacturer ha heirne this inconsistent with good and economical distribmtion and has turned back to the recognized distrib in each case. I census of distribution fartors proved that it was cheaper for the average factory to use already established distributors than to create new agencies

One important point that was brought out at this formm was that the average elertrical appliance manufacturer has been mable to keep a sales force in the field to contart retailers during this war period, whereas the distributor in the territory has continued his contacts and has therefore more solidly established himself for post-war.
Also of great importance, and what proved to be a main topic for discussion at this forum, was the fact that there was a greater tendency toward "streamlined distribution". This was claimed to mean that dis tributors would carry less competitive lines, or would confine thenselves to one line, and wonld also go direct to the retailer instrad of working thru the jobber. This did not meet with general approval of these distribs in the electrical appliance field

There is no doubt that a national formm of distributors in this in dustry wonld also prove as valuable to this trade as did the formm of electrical appliance wholesalers to their business.
It is also believed by the average eoin marhines distributor that some sort of method for recognition must come into being which wilt bring about a more bonafide and acrepted firm to help benefit the trade and which will, at the same time, gain the approval of the operators and jobbers and give them greater confidence in the distributor with whom they will deal in the post-war period.
This is more or less in keeping with the survey made about two years ago by The Cash Box to rearh a point of arreptance for the distribution division of this industry, and which was published for the benefit of the trade at that time
