## "The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"

UNCLE SAM LEARNS ABOUT TAXES
For years this industry has fought inequitable taxation. Many times it has been successful. Just as many times it has failed. Revenue seekers, for some unknown reason, have always felt that "luxury" industries should be taxed to the limit. But Uncle Sam has just learned a very severe and expensive lesson - that a tax can be pushed just so high, and then it reaches a point where it defeats its own purpose.

Congress pulled a boner when it doubled the tax on fur coats and jewelry last April 1. Since this 20 per cent tax went into effect the buying of coats and jewelry crashed. The result is that the treasury is getting a lot less cash than it figured on. And since all the cash that the Treasury can possibly raise at this time for the successful conduct of the war is of great and even extreme importance, Uncle Sam has learned a very harsh lesson about the time honored economic law of diminishing returns.

On a nationwide basis, sales of fur coats are down 40 per cent from the levels at this time a year ago. In some stores sales have plunged as much as 60 and 70 per cent. And during this post summer, declines from 1943's levels ranged up to 90 percent. The Treasury's tax receipts also turned out all wrong. In September, which is usually a good collection month, the Internal Revenue Bureau received only $\$ 3,667,000$ in taxes compared with $3,047,147$ in Septomber a year ago. And remember that this present tax was upped from 10 to 20 per cent. The gain was unusually small. And the future looks even darker.

In the meantime fur coat manufacturers are much worried because their retail customers are dwindling away. The retailers themselves are in an uproar because they're caught with large supplies on hand and fear that they'll have to take some very big losses. All this because Congress figured that by boosting this luxury tax from 10 to 20 per cent it would not affect such sales and the Treasury would get more money from the fur industry.

The very same thing is happening in the jewelry field. The Internal Revenue Bureau figures show that jewelry sales for the three months ending September 1 were down 24 per cent from last year. Again the Treasury's collections were much lower than anticipated. The evidence is clear. High excise taxes haven't disturbed cheaplypricod items or sales of necessary goods, but they've made a big dent in the luxury fields.

For example, the City of Omaha's proposel to raise the license on pinball games from $\$ 15$ to $\$ 150$ per year and on phonographs from $\$ 5$. to $\$ 50$. per year, will act exact ly the same to the treasury of that city as has the upped fur and jewelry taxes to Uncle Sam's Treasury in Washington. City officials in Omahe should first make a complete survey of the situation in both the pinball and music fields in their city. They will learn that a $\$ 150$. yearly license fee on each pinball game will probably wipe out more then $75 \%$ of the gemes now located in this city. Instead of receiving greater revenue, they will receive a lot less than they ever did before. This same holds true for the automatic phonographs in Omaha.

This is the time for the trade to bring these facts home to all tax makers in the nation. The above statistics released by the Internal Revenue Bureau of the Treasury Department and analyzed by persons who know the fur and jewelry fields has brought home a very strong point to Uncle Sam. Just the same as persons well acquainted with the pinball and music and other coin machines fields could prove to the City of Omaha, or any other city's administration, prior to any city council allowing excessive and extremely inequitable taxation to be imposed.

[^0]It should be remembered that the A.O.A. (Arcade Owners Ass'n.) is still fighting to get more equitable taxation for their businesses in Washington. Samuel "Curley" Robinson and his AOLAC (Associated Operators of Los Angeles County, Inc.) paid an unsuccessful visit to Washington and explained these very facts, which are here presented, to the House Ways and Means Committee at that time.

## "The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"

The case of the counter game is a clear and outstanding example of what excessive taxation has done to one division of this industry. Here inequitable taxation has pushed an entire field out of existence. No consideration was given to the difference in the earning power of counter games as compared to slots. But because both featured reels with similar symbols, they were taxed in the same category.

Everyone in this industry knows that no counter game every built could be classed in the same category with a slot, as far as earning capacity was concerned. The counter game is still just a game. But the Government, by inequitably overtaxing this machine, pushed thousands upon thousands of these into basements, warehouses, garages, barns and goodness knows where, but took them off locations and thereby not only did the revenue fall but the general business that was conducted because of the se machines has also hurt the general economy of this industry to some extent.

Here an entire field lies dormant be cause of the fact that inequitable and excessive taxation has knocked it out, and further because no thought or study was given to the requirements nor tax paying capacity of this field. The same can heppen to any other field in this, or any other so-called "luxury industry", unless Congress now takes a lesson from what has just been proved to be the facts in the fur and jewelry fields.

This is one bit of evidence that would be well preserved by a National Tax Council and sufficiently played up to make every revenue seeker in the nation aware that excessive and inequitable taxation can, instead of bringing greater revenue, push an industry out of profitable future existence and cause great economic loss generally.

There is a point of diminishing returns. Uncle Sam has just learned all about it. This is the time for this industry to take advantage of this fact. Creating a National Tax Council now will prove of tremendously good and opportune value for all concerned with this business for today, and especially for the post war period.


In life, as well as in industry, there is a continual battle goine on between fear and faith. Yet in every cese, faith always emerges the winner. Fear is a man-made bogey. The fear bogeys are making the rounds of the trade today.

These bogey men claim that the manufacturers are going to take advantage of the present inflated prices. Another bogey going the rounds is the fear of certain distributors that they should not commit themselves for any product because another, similar product, might possibly come along better than the first.

Still another bogey concerns itself with the fact that there will be such a rush of new machines to the market that this, in itself, will upset all deals. And among some distributors arises the bogey man who says that wide open competition among all selling factors will become so great that this will kill off any possibility for profit. Furthermore, this bogey claims the distribs just won't get together for the general betterment of all concerned, and this, too, will slay many who want to go ahead.

Bogey man after bogey man arises and each one with a new and different story to tell. Each one ready to show how the industry is doomed. Each with a fear that is fighting the faith he has in this business. Each with something to counteract all the good that has already been done.

Faith is the greatest essential to success. It's the one and only thing that kept men going ahead in this industry when all claimed that this trade was doomed, right after Pearl Harbor. Faith built the backbone of this business. Faith in this industry and in its future is what is making many build better and more expensive quarters, what causes them to expand their operations and sales efforts and what makes them continue on ahead progressively

Those who lack faith in this business had best get out of it now, before the hectic, post-war period gets under way. They will then need every ounce of faith they can possibly corral to go ahead. Sure, many will be puzzled as to just how to best proceed at first. But if they have faith, they won't hesitate very long. They'll swing right into the spirit of this business and push with all their might and main and intelligence and power to get this industry - over the top. To make this a grand. er, greater, better and more respected business for all concerned.

WASHINGTON-With the announcement this past week from James A. Krug, chairman of the War Production Board, that resumption of construction, as well as production of consumers durable goods (under which category the coin operated machines industry is classified) and particularly automobiles, will be delayed "for some time" after Germany's collapse, leading coinmen instantly plunged into action in an effort to accumulate sufficient stocks of used machines to be able to continue their operations until the time when reconversion would be allowed.

Krug also reported that the trend of workers to enter into peace-time jobs, which had halted production in some of the nation's key war centers in the East and Midwest, had been halted and that many hundreds of
workers were returning to former war jobs. This meant, coinmen report, workers were returning to former war jobs. This meal
that labor would be difficult to obtain for a long time.

For sometime The Cash Box had been reporting that the used machines market would continue in importance, regardless of any other machines market would continue in importance, regardless of any other
reports. WPB's recent elimination of further domestic reconversion under reports. WPB's recent elimination of further domestic reconversion under
the Spot Authorization Plan, also announced earlier this past week, proved this belief regarding the importance of used machines to be true. Now this latest statement emanating from the office of WPB's chairman makes this an even greater certainty.

This industry will therefore have to accustom itself to the fact that it will not see a return to production of its goods for many months to
come. This means that the present used machines market will continue.
come. This means that the present used machines market will continue.
Many leading distribs have already reported that they are not seeking further sales in an effort to conserve whatever merchandise they have on hand.

Coinmen, who fear their operations may suffer should they not be able replace with merchandise at regular intervals, are asking for an increase in renovation of machines. These, they report, have proven themselves very capable of maintaining averages

The hope seems to be that firms who may be planning renovation work, will plunge into such effort immediately, so that the trade will be assured the machines it will require during ' 45 .

Tho encouraging to those who feared possible collapse of the used machines market, this latest WPB report has further confused many manufacturers who were eagerly looking forward to authorization for reconversion coming early during the New Year. These believed that reconversion coming early during the New Germany seem to be definitely defeated by the end of ' 44 that WPB might allow them to enter into former products production on some sort of percentage basis under the Spot Authorization Plan.

This latest announcement from Krug's, office upsets all plans and returns manufacturers to their war work with greater concentration than ever before. The industry is the manufacturers had no thoughts other than their war work.

It may be months before any further announcements are forthcoming from WPB which may, in any fashion, lend encouragement to the possibility that former products production reconversion can be undertaken.
