

DISTRIBUTING-OPERATING POOLS

Some coinmen have been somewhat disturbed by the creation of distributing-operating combines. These, they claim, have been set up in an effort to control complete territories. Many such pools, they report, have been formed in various sections of the country. Yet such combinations, in general, are today considered a natural resultant of present business conditions.

This wartime period has taught many in this industry that the best and most profitable division at present is operating. Coinmen have learned how to operate during this war. They have earned their greatest profits operating.

Today these men want to maintain their operating units as a nucleus, and as the basic profit factor of their businesses. They also want to go ahead, while maintaining their operations, to lead their territories in distributing the products of the factories at the same time.

To accomplish this they have pooled their interests with others in the same or even outside, territory. In some cases they have thereby created combines of outstanding strength. These naturally attract the attention of the trade.

It is only good business to believe that the man who has operated successfully, and who knows how to sell, is the man upon whom this industry can depend to continue its growth. Therefore such men, desiring to enter into the distributing picture, must be given all due consideration.

It is also well to remember that the combine which does control the greater majority of locations in a certain territory, is the outfit to tie to, as far as the average producer is concerned. This means almost instant and complete distribution. It can also mean success from the standpoint that such firms will know how to intelligently guide whatever operators they will create.

The distributing-operating pools which have been created throut the nation are but a natural advancement, the outcome of business progress. Such pools are today being discussed in many industries throut the nation. The electrical appliance field has been studying the distributing-retailer pools which have been created in its field, and finds them of good value and of general benefit. Other industries, too, are favorably inclined toward such combinations.

Whether or not such combines will be able to continue successfully in the postwar period will only be noted at that time. There is no doubt that at the beginning of the post-war era, such combines will probably attract much attention to themselves. But whether they can outlast former business procedure is something which only time will tell.

It is doubtful whether these pools can control both the locations and the sales of a product. The new blood that will enter into this industry will only do so in the belief that it can obtain locations for the equipment it will purchase. The combines will have to allow these men certain locations in which to operate successfully, so that this new blood can continue on prosperously and there by remain good future customers.

This is one problem which will have to be solved by the combine itself as it continues on its way in this industry. Many other problems will come up. Some are already making themselves manifest. These combines will yet have to go thru their growing pains period. It is much too early as yet to gauge their full effectiveness or importance in the coin machines merchandising picture.

NATIONAL FORUM FOR JOBBERS - DISTRIBS

In the past few months there has developed within the industry, and among many of the most noted jobbers and distributors, a demand for a national forum. The basic idea for such a meet being that these men become better acquainted by discussing their problems openly with each other in national forum, and at the same time arranging a method for recognition which will help to gain greater respect from the operators.

Basically, the plan is logical. The buyers in this, or any other industry, should not have to worry whether its distributors and jobbers are financially reliable and will live up to any promise they might make. In the drug and grocery fields, the distributor and jobber is looked up to with great respect. He has won prestige. He is considered the leader in his business. His brand name is just as outstanding, and just as impressive and salable, as are the national brands that he also features.

The average coin machines distributor believes that he, too, should be given this sort of respect. There is no reason why he shouldn't. Many of this nation's distributors have gone far out of their way to help build financially independent operators in their territories. Many of them can recall when they almost forced machines on certain of their customers, for which these customers can thank them most sincerely today. In short, the coin machines distributor has been an important figure.

But nationally he hasn't gained that rank and prestige and respect which can assure him better business understanding. This is his reason for calling all the nation's distributors and jobbers into national forum. By so doing he hopes to become better acquainted with the other members of this division of this industry. He also hopes to arrange for certain qualifications, for anyone entering into his division, which will gain greater respect and prestige.

An annual, national forum of the nation's coin machines distributors and jobbers should bring about a great many benefits to the trade. By a closer and better understanding of each other's businesses, these men can help all concerned with the industry. They can eliminate much that is proved evil. They can also add much that would prove of good value. They can, by agreement among themselves, be the moving force to raise the spirit and charge the confidence of all engaged in this industry.

URGE USE OF HANDICAPPED VETERANS URGE COINMEN EMPLOY RETURNED LEADERS HANDICAPPED VETERANS IN OFFICE AND REPAIR DEPARTMENTS. BELIEVE THESE MEN WELL FITTED PROGRAM TO START IMMEDIATELY. FOR THIS WORK.

NEW YORK—Leaders of the industry from everywhere in the nation have come together as one voice to urge the trade to employ returned handicapped veterans of this war.

The general belief is that most of these veterans being returned from the front lines have lost fingers, limbs and have other similar injuries, are well fitted for the inside work of this industry, especially in office and repair departments.

Many are also of the belief that these handicapped veterans will work out very well as location solicitors and good will ambassadors covering the various locations of operators. There is also a belief that as collectors these men will prove extremely well fitted.

Some operators, who have extremely large routes and use supervisors to cover these, will find these returned handicapped veterans perfect for this position.

"Not only is this a patriotic duty", one noted leader writes, "but this is an opportunity for members of this industry to once again prove to the country that they are always 'first' in helping as well as working for a future, better peace.

"The work which you have already done in The Cash Box in this direction, in many of your past editorials, in my estimation, makes you best fitted to drive home this message to the trade.

"There is surely room for these men in dozens of different positions in this industry. Not only will this help cure the manpower situation for us, but it will start this industry off first among all leading industries to recognize that these returned handicapped veterans must be given preference for positions in American industry.'

This is similar to a great many other messages which The Cash Box has received these past weeks. All urge the men in this industry to employ returned handicapped veterans.

The steel industry has already evolved a program for employing these men and is finding them of exceptional value. Many other industries are also taking in handicapped returned veterans and are finding them very good material.

These men have been found to work with real zeal at any job they get. They have also been found to be very well trained in many of the technical arts and therefore the members of this business will find them very well fitted for the mechanical intricacies of their repair departments.

A national movement in this direction is being called for at this time to make possible immediate installment of returned handicapped veterans everywhere in the trade.

It is the hope of many leaders in this business that the trade will make every effort to employ these men. Operators, jobbers, distributors, manufacturers and all others allied to this industry are urged to make application for these men with USES and other government agencies as well as thru the American Legion and other veterans' organizations advising that they will employ handicapped veterans. Specific outline of the positions for which these men will be wanted should also be given to these agencies so that the proper men can be had.



PARAMOUNT PIC LETTER TO AOA

NEW YORK-Last week AOA (Arcade Owners Assn.) thru its attorney, Herman Brothers, re-ported that Paramount Pictures, Inc., had assured this organization that their new picture, "Cheezit The Cops", built about a Penny Arcade locale, would in no fashion harm the arcade.

Brothers encloses the letter which Paramount has just writ-ten to him regarding this statement:

"We checked with our studio regarding the use of a penny arcade as one of the locations for the above production. We have received assurance that this picture does not show the amusement arcade as contributing to juvenile delinquency. Nobody connected with the arcade in the picture is associated with the murderer nor is the place a hangout for crooks".

The good and immediate work of AOA's attorney on this matter is receiving great commendation from the arcade trade.



OFFSET TAX LOSS BOSTON, MASS. — Former Lieut. Gov. Francis E. Kelly has just proposed a state lottery as

a means to replace the \$6,000,000 in horse and dog race revenue which will be lost as a result of the closing of tracks in this state.

In a letter to Tax Commis-sioner Henry F. Long, Kelly wrote, "A state supervised lottery could be conducted with practically no expense. Tickets could be sold by existing town, city and state agencies or depart-ments with no drain on man-power and with a minimum of wasted time and effort.

"Plenty of spare money," Kelly says, "is now available in Massachusetts and New England. Here is an opportunity for a progressive state with cou-rageous leadership to obtain new revenue of many millions of dollars by a voluntary con-tribution system rather than a tax".

In 1940 public voted 805,000 to 325,000 in favor of state supervised lottery. Possibly with large revenue loss from dog and horse racing this may now be-come fact. Coinmen here be-lieve this will not harm coin operated machines.

BITING TAX BUG WORRIES COINMEN

NEW YORK-More letters continue to arrive at the offices of The Cash Box from coinmen thruout the country who are worried that the tax bug may bite with intense deepness in their territories.

Some of these men state, "In view of the fact that horse racing closes in our state this month we expect that, with the legislature in session, some sort of action will have to be taken immediately to restore this tre-mendous loss to the state's revenue."

Many other reasons are also given by these men who believe that the tax bug's bite will be more severely felt this year than ever before by the trade. They are all of the opinion that a National Tax Council should be immediately created for the benefit of the industry.

One coinman writes, "Since we do not have anyone to whom we can turn in times of stress why not appoint The Cash Box and yourself as the working force this time and help us by shooting special messages to the trade so that we can get infor-mation from others?"


