## RENO UPS SLOT LICENSE, EOAROS SAME

RENO, NEV. - City license on slots upped from $\$ 40$ to $\$ 50$. Salesboards remain at $\$ 20$ per year. (Solesboard license authorizes operation of unlimited number in one room). Fear closing of all gambling rooms here due to war manpower demands.

## FRESNO OFS FEAR UPFED LICENSE FEFS

FRESNO, CAL. - Ops here have been complaining for sometime that license fees as at present in effect are too high for machines. Now belief is that even higher license fees will be placed into effect this year.

## SET MIDNIGHT CURFEW ON IND. PHONOS

FRANKFORT, IND. - Phonos in this area are not allowed to be played after midnight or before 6 A.M. Some ops in this section believe that this curfew may spread.

## SAN EERNARDINO OPS SEE UFPED LICENSES

SAN BERNARDINO, CAL. - Ops here of the belief that license fees will be hiked away up this year. Claim that this may cut down on number of machines now operating.

## MICH. OP FIGHTS FINBALLBA.N IN SUP. COURT

 FLINT, MICH. - L. W. Deniel of Flint imusement Company, this city, putting up a fine lone man fight for re-hesring in the Supreme court of this state on free play pins. Court declared FP pins "gambling" on November 30, ' 44 by a split decision, 3 of the judges voted the games "not gambling". Tho re-hearings unusual in Supreme Court here belief that because of split decision new hearing can be obtained. Michigan ops are urged to help Daniel defray expense of this case.
## HUTEHINSOA K.O.'S LIG. MACHS WITH HIKED LIC.

HUTCHINSON, KANS. - This city licenses music at $\$ 10$ per year, pins at $\$ 35$ per year and cig machines at $\$ 15$ per year. Ops here report that this cig license $K .0 .1$ s these units with cig shortage now in effect and these machines have been placed in storage. Instead of city gaining, it has lost revenue and citizens have suffered loss, too.

## OHIO WANTS HIGHEK MUSIC LICENSE FEES

YOUNGS TOWN, O. - Suit now pending in Court of Appeals to up music license from $\$ 5$ to $\$ 10$ per year and add $\$ 1$ for each wall or bar box.

17 YR. MINIMUM ARCADE FLAY AGE FOR. OHIC
COLUMBUS, 0. - Legislation now pending would set minimum age for patrons of penny arcades at 17 years. At same time very high license fees being proposed for arcades.

## PHILLY OPS FORSEE HEAVIER LICENSE FEES

PHILhDELPHIA, PA. - Many ops here are preparing to see license fees zoom to new highs with new bill expected to bo introduced to city council here very soon.
PINS SMASHED IN ALBANY TERMED "SLOTS"
ALBANY, N.Y. - Pin games are being picked up here and smashed as "slot machines".

## VILLAGE HAS SI. MONTHLY PIN LICENSE FEE WELLSVILLE, N.Y. - This village has distinction of having unique pin license in effeot. Charge is $\$ 1$ per month - in advanco for each machine.

## MUSKEGON FRESS RAPS PINS EACH WEEK

MUSKEGON, MICH. - On an average of at least once each weok, the leading newspaper in this eity, Muskegon Chronicle, has been rapping pinball games, ops here report. This has created condition whereby ops believe that pins will not be allowed here for long time to come. Claim need for a "Public Relations Bureau" very great and hope that the trade will get such a bureau into action to help ops hese gain better understanding.

## SOUTH WASH. OFS EXFECT LICENSE HIKES

SEATTLE, WASH. - Music ops in this City report that increased license fees on phonos and also on wall and bar boxes are expected hourly by music men in the southern part of this state. Belief is that if such increases go thru that entire state will be effected and that licenses may prove too heavy for profitable operation.

## OKLAHOMA CPS FEAR STATE LEGIS MEET

OKLAHOMA CITY, UKLA. - Coinmen here are worried about present meeting of the state legislature. As one noted ops puts it, "We expect them to pour it on us this year". Majority of coinmen here fear that state legislators will arrange to very heavily tax coin equipment of all types and may hurt many operations. Urge that trade create a "National Tax Countil" immediately to help.

## FROVIDENCE MUSIC OPS EOIL AT DISK MFRS.

PROVIDENCE, R.I. - Music ops here are boiling at leading record manufacturers whom, they claim, are giving retail outlets preference on purchases and absolutely not cooperating with coinmen. Many ops here report they are forced to purchase late releases direct from retail stores. Claim no courtesy shown them by disk mfrs. Music ops here ask that leading music men meet with mfrs or ereate own record making firm.

## SAVANNAH OPS REFUSE LAMFS GET NO DECCAS

SAVANNAH, CA. - Music ops here are boiling at Decca Records branch office. Claim manager shipped them lamps without order and when they refused to accept these have not been able to get late Decca releases since.

## LOCATION NOTICE STOFS PHONO HIJACKING

NEW YORK - Since notifying locations directly not to allow phonos to be removed by anyone but owners, music op members of assn here report hijacking has practically stopped. Hijacking reached alarming proportions for a while. Insurance helped many music ops.

## THIS IS BIGGEST CALENDAR BUYING YEAR

NEW YORK - Trade went all out on buyine calendars this year. Almost every leading jobber and distrib. has been flooding customers with ' 45 calendars. Ups also went on spree and have been sending these out to locations.

## WISCONSIN OPS PREPARE FOR "USUAL BILLS

MADISON, WIS. - Ops here report they expect the "usual" bills to be introduced during the 1945 state legislature meeting seeking higher license fees on phonos and other coin operated equipment. (Free play pins lost decision in Supreme Court in this State this past year and none operating in Milwakee, not even novelty pinballs.)

## CHAMBER OF COMMERCE HELPS OHIO OPS

CULUMBUS, O - Bernard G. (Nick) Nebel, G.N. Vending Co., this city, is conducting a one man campaign to get coinmen here to join local Chamber of Commerce. Claims he has succeeded in getting C. of C. to recognize coin machines as "legitimate and respectable business". Also reports Chamber has asked city officials to ease up on unfavorable publicity now appearing in local press.

# THE COIN OPERATED MACHINES INDUSTRY CONTAINS A SLEEPING INDUSTRIAL GIANT 

This Business Can Open A Vast, New, Important Market To Help Assure The Future Of American Industry

By merchandising its operating, every jobber, distributor and manufacturer can be instrumental in opening an important market to all American industry. This trade controls a tremendous merchandising force to aid in its own as well as America's future business growth.

FOR a great many years the coin operated machines industry has rolled along under the force of its own power of acquaintance with many, many thousands of locations thruout this nation. It has continued its machines business without much regard for the fact that by this acquaintanceship it has within its control the largest possible potential for its own future growth, as well as for the future growth of much other American industry.

It is a well known fact in this industry, and accepted without much question, that the average operator is extremely well acquainted with all the profitable retail businesses in his territory. This has become so much a part of his job that neither he, nor anyone else in the industry, has thought too much about it.

This is one of the greatest powers this industry controls. As everyone engaged in this business knows, without a location a machine is worthless, regardless of the fact that the machine itself may be the finest ever yet produced by this industry. Therefore, being thoroly and intimately acquainted with the locations in his territory, is a necessity for even the smallest operator.

It is also an accepted fact that those locations which prove to be the most profitable to the operator are usually the locations which have the greatest amount of traffic, whether transient or local, in the area. In all
cases, regarding locations of every type in any territory, there is no doubt that operators in that territory have already many times tested them and know their value to the machines of this industry, as well as their general financial status and their comparative importance to all other businesses in the section.

To build a sound and successful business it is necessary for the operator to intimately know all the loca-
tions in his territory. He must, and usually does, test each and everyone, and thereby becomes more closely acquainted with them. Because of this there now exists in this business nationally the most outstanding, intimate knowledge of the varied retail trades locations in this nation known to any single industry source.

Coinmen are not lookers-on when a new business arises in their territory. They go right in and get acquainted with the owners. And in a very short period of time come to know the general value of the business. Because of this they have an exceptionally fine understanding of the varied retail businesses of the nation. The trades covering and selling only certain classes of retailers do not have such insight into fields other than their own.

For example, it is a well known fact that a drug salesman entering the average town may have some idea of the extent and importance of the drug stores

located in that community. But, he will intimately know little else concerning other retail businesses in that same town. Yet this salesman knows that by speaking with the operators in that same town he can, within a few minutes, ascertain whether it pays him to try to do business with even his own line of drug stores located in that town.

The reason is simply that the average good operator has tested these spots. He is probably in there with one type of machine or another. He knows just what these places are doing from a general business standpoint. His figures may not be accurate to a minute degree, but from the general standpoint can be accepted, for they have proved to be extremely accurate in the majority of cases.

What is the trade doing with this marvelous knowledge of the retail locations in the country? These hundreds of thousands of retail locations that are an integral part of this business? These locations are being efficiently covered by the operators on an average of once a week and in some cases are being visited even more frequently. These retail locations range from the most prominent businesses in the large, metropolitan centers of the nation, to the lonely country cross-roads general store where electricity hasn't as yet been installed.

Here, then, lies a sleeping giant. A great force for the future good and welfare of this business, and perhaps for all American industry. Here is something which is of great moment to all engaged in this trade. Here is an important factor for tomorrow. This is a great power which this industry should try, with all might and main, to get into action as rapidly as possible. It can become the moving force to bring to this trade the leadership it has so long sought. This can become a great and respected industry because of this close acquaintanceship, this understanding, this constant contact with so many of the retail trades of this nation.

Just as all good advertisers merchandise their advertising, so should this trade now merchandise its operating business. There is needed some product, which can be given or sold or consigned to the operator by the jobber and distributor, and manufactured for him by the manufacturers of this industry, which will be acceptable to every type of location the operator controls, regardless whether the location is a gas station, drug store, tavern, general store, beauty shop, health club, or whatever it is.

Here is a possibility that overshadows all others for the future of this industry. Whatever that product is, or will be, is as yet unknown. It must be something that will meet with the approval of every location.

It may be an advertising display which the operator can give or consign to the location and service at each collection, and for which servicing he receives a certain sum each week. He can share this income with the location owner. Here is an extra profit for him and for his location. Here is something, should his territory close down, which will remain as income insurance to him and will, at the same time, allow him to continue contact with his locations. Of course this product may be something else besides an advertising display.

What is most important is the fact that here is an industry with intimate entry to many hundreds of thousands of retail locations, with personal and close acquaintanceship with those locations. This can, in one sudden sweep, popularize some product and maintain close, constant contact for that product. (The closest to any product yet conceived for this gigantic market has been the Salesboard.)

The years of contact and friendship which the operators have built with the nation's locations should be taken advantage of by the better minds in this industry to help benefit the trade. At the same time it opens a vast and potential industry within an industry. Perhaps many coinmen have been too close to the forest to see this one tree.

In former years many feeble stabs were made at this powerful, potential merchandising market by various promoters. One promoter brought forth the unique plan of giving outstanding hit records away free to phonograph operators who would be contracted to place these in their machines. At the end of each record's music was a short advertising talk of twenty words or so for some product or other, as for example any of the popular brand cigarettes. This plan, tho somewhat logical in its construction, failed of its own force. When the promoters began to note the power and extent of the market, they realized that this was not just a little, quibbling business plan they had conceived, but one that required many, many thousands of dollars, cooperation of the large record manufacturers, and that would possibly run into millions of records when in complete action. The wild statements this caused them to make drove many interested advertisers away, and created suspicion among the men in this industry.

For years one novelty manufacturer after another has been after the members of this industry to sell his products while they travel about their locations. Some operators have been successful with this plan.

One of the most ingenious and successful plans ever evolved was in the early days of neon signs. One such sign salesman arranged to give the signs away to storekeepers, financing them from his own capital, and ob-

tain payment from the location's share of the collections from the coin machine in the place. This met with the instant and wholehearted approval of the storekeepers. Many hundreds of signs were sold on this basis by this man thru the fact that some operator had a machine in the location. The operator never shared in these profits. Almost every tavern in his territory bought neon signs from this salesman. He even went to the extent of placing machines in locations where he found none, first to just sell the sign, and then continued operating the machines after the sign was paid for.

This large and potential merchandising force contained within this industry makes possible a better understanding and contact between the manufacturer of some consumer item and the public generally. By using the operator as his medium, the manufacturer of some general item can rapidly gain national acceptance for his product. Surely the phonograph record manufacturers will agree to this for their industry was taken out of the dump of despair and placed into a most enviable leading position by the members of this trade.

The operator, tho, must be able to practically give that product away, or to consign it. At the same time the operator can collect for an item that brings profit to the location from the income of the equipment on the location. This means that he becomes more closely cemented to the location, for as long as that product remains his equipment must remain, too. At the same time he is bringing extra profits and probably more and better business to the location owner. This surely helps foster a better business relationship between himself and the location owner, and also brings about a generally finer mutual understanding of each other's importance as merchandisers.

Someone, somewhere in the nation will one day come along with the product which will meet with the approval of practically everyone of the locations now controlled by the members of this industry. Whoever he is, it will certainly mean vast riches for him. It will mean more income for all engaged in this industry. It will then be truly merchandising the operating of this business. It will more closely cement this industry to its locations. It will assure members of this trade that regardless of what may happen in their territory they will still have income and still maintain their locations. All this will be in addition to income from the machines operating they are doing.

This vast, untapped, gigantic merchandising force is bound to make someone extremely rich, overnight. It will also make a lot of other people rich. It will bring jobbers and distributors, and surely the manufacturers, a new business potential. It will first be most important to the operator for he is the basic force of this entire movement. It is his control of the locations in his territory, the friendship he has built with these locations, the years of constant contact he has made with them, that makes possible this great merchandising factor for this industry.

In the post-war era, a great many new items will come forth which will require speedier merchandising and distribution, as well as better contact. Manufacturers will seek for new means and new methods to arrange for such merchandising. Here is an industry which holds forth a great merchandising medium to such manufacturers. This industry offers the possibility of being able to overnight introducing a great merchandising force to American industry.

For years, this industry, because of its enthusiasm, ingenuity, ambition and youthfulness, has continued on ahead, daringly doing many things thought impossible, working hard on the fundamentals which have won much praise and comment for this trade, but in all that time building for this great day when it will be accepted for what it actually is-one of the greatest merchandising forces in the history of this nation.

This is the time to awaken this sleeping, giant force. This is the time for this industry to take complete advantage of all of its power, and use that power for its own future good, as well as for the future good and welfare of all American industry.
New fields will be needed when the war is won. New methods will have to be placed into effect. New means for merchandising. In fact, entire new industries to accommodate the millions in the armed forces who will return asking for the opportunity to win a place for themselves in this nation. These men and women of the armed services must be protected from the spectre of apple sellers on street corners and from the soup kitchen trucks that roamed the large cities after the last war.

Just by getting mad and gritting your teeth and saying, "It won't happen", won't stop it from happening. But, by thinking hard, by courage of conviction, by faith, by plunging in now, by using every working force within you, by taking advantage of the fact that this industry has within itself one of the greatest merchandising forces in the history of this nation, you can create a new, great merchandising industry.

By so doing you will open a new profit path to many of the millions of young men who will return from fighting this war. They will work hard for you and help you to build your industry to a point where it will obtain the prestige, respect and thanks of all American industry.
This is the job and the plan The Cash Box proposes for you for " 45 . This is what The Cash Box believes will help bring this industry to that point of success where it will definitely link itself with the leading industries of this country. This is what The Cash Box believes is part and parcel of the future of this coin operated machines industry. It means greater success for you, as well as for all in this nation. # TALKING DUT LDUD 

# INDUSTRY URGED TO GO ALL OUT 

Back Up War Effort By Complete Concentration Of All Facilities And Manpower. Pool Mechanics. Cut Down Servicing To Conserve Gas And Tires. Stay Out Of Public's Eyes. "It's Now Or Never," Leaders Believe.

NEW YORK-Appeals from many leaders of the trade that this industry go all out were received this week. This is construed to be the result of the President's speech covering the state of the Union, and the grave all out war effort now facing this nation.

Many of these coinmen believe that this industry can conserve by concentrating its facilities and manpower. "Of what use is it at this time," one coinman writes, "for more than one service man to cover a location. We know that the cigarette and other vending machine people are now entering into the very same locations that we amusement machine men cover. Why can't we eliminate this wasted effort by getting only one or two service men to cover these spots for all of us at one time. We should get together among ourselves to conserve whatever we can at this time, and this is surely one way to do it."

Others have for long pooled mechanics in various areas where mechanical help is scarce. Once again this comes to the fore especially in view of the present national manpower situation. One noted leader writes, "About two years or more ago you wrote about pooling mechanics. Why not tell this to the trade once again? This is something that should most assuredly be done at this time when there is every possibility that manpower will be taken away from all entertainment industries to further help the war effort. The men should get together in every city, town and village and pool their mechanics so that they will not be caught short when this man-power situation strikes them."

Beyond these facts is that of cutting down even more on servicing than is being done at the present time. There is no doubt, one man writes, that by cutting to servicing only once every two weeks on the average location, that this will greatly conserve gas and tires. Tires are almost as scarce as hen's teeth, he writes, and with gas becoming more and ever more important for our boys on the fighting fronts, we should help by cutting our servicing and collecting to the absolute minimum.

Also suggested at this time is to keep out of the public's eye. Keep away from all flash. Stay away from anything that will be seen by the public regarding this industry. "This is the time", one coinman writes, "when we should adopt everything you wrote in your article 'Quiet' just a few issues ago. This

NEW YORK—First batch of returns from the "Confidential Survey" now being conducte by The Cash Box show an overwhelming demand for a National Tax Council and a Publi Relations Bureau.

will get us too much publicity or even have the public's gaze swing our way in the very slightest degree. We've all seen what too much publicity did to horse racing.

In conclusion can be taken the statement of the man who wrote to The Cash Box this week urging this all out aid to the war effort by everyone in this industry and which was, "It's now or never"

Many believe that unless this trade will go all out to help the war effort at this time that this business is liable to be seriously curtailed. This is not the time to let things ride. But to hurriedly complete programs so that when any investigations are made only compliments will be forthcoming for the help this industry is giving to win the war.

## IDEAS WANTED

NEW YORK-In keeping with the spirit of many noted trade leader who wrote The Cash Box regarding all out effort to help win the war, ideas are now called for from everyone in the industry.

If you believe that you have an idea that would be useful to all the industry to help everyone engaged in this business to go all out to help win the war, rush that idea to us for publication under your name.

A great many have stated in this survey, "Unless we get a Natione Tax Council of some kind in operation as soon as possible this industr is going to be taxed out of business."
Almost every answer to this survey has something to say about th present unreasonable tax situation existent in a great many state counties and cities thruout the nation.
These men report that this has reached the point where they ca foresee they will have to seriously curtail a great many operatior during the post-war period when they expect a return to more norma expenditure, and when they also believe a great many of the preser war industries will be cut back to former production.
The demand for a Public Relations Bureau is just as great as fc a tax council. The men feel that these will work together and wi need each other in all cases where taxes and adverse publicity wi come up. They feel that noted figures should staff the Public Relatior Bureau. Some stated that if such a bureau were now in existence th it would have gathered together a great deal of good material whic would be of tremendous help in the months to come.

DALLAS REP. ASKS PHONO TAX HIKE

DALLAS, TEX. - Rep. Dallas A.
Blankenship of this city is reported to be drafting a bill to introduce to the coming state legislature session asking that the annual license fee on phonos be increased from $\$ 2.50$ to $\$ 50.00$.
Rep. Blankenship estimates that this increase would help bring the state about a $\$ 2,000,000.00$ yearly revenue which, he reported, could be applied to raising the salaries of public school teachers in Texas.

This report now brings truth to the prediction of many Texas coinmen who wrote The Cash Box some months ago that they feared license fee increases. This unusually large increase is reported to have already gathered together many of the music men in the state for an all out fight.
As one Texas music man writes,
"There is no doubt any more that we are going to take a really deep bite from the tax bug.'
