## TRADE SEEKS MEANS TO MERCHANDISE OPERATORS

In keeping with the story which appeared in this past week's, New Year Special issue of The Cash Box, regarding the fact that this industry should mer chandise its operating, many inquiries have already been received asking for suggestions and ideas in this regard.

It is only natural to believe that if The Cash Box had, what it believed to be a solid, logical and substantial suggestion to make to the trade for an item, or medium, or method, which could be used to help merchandise its operating, it would have been more than happy to present this to the trade.

There are a sufficient number of intelligent and ingenious men engaged in this coin operated machines industry to bring into effect some sort of plan whereby the vast acquaintanceship, which the operators of this industry have made with the nation's retail trade, can be utilized to the mutual benefit of all concerned.

Cortainly, all will agree that whoever discovers the item which will allow the trade to merchandise its operating correctiy, that this person, as well as probably $a l l$ others in the trade, will tremendously profit.

There is also no doubt that the average storekeeper would today welcome any item that would assure him additional profit. The fact is that the average retailer is preparing himself for a severe drought of merchandise during ' 45 and is eagerly seeking for something which will assure him continued profit.

The members of this trade are just as anxious as the retailers to find the product. This will not only allow them to merchandise their operating but will also bring this industry to the forefront as an unusually fine and powerful merchandising source. This can be done without the industry having to neglectits regular operating. In fact, it will actually enhance the value of operating.

The moment this merchandising is started it will prove to all other industries the value and forceful power of this trade as a merchandising medium, because it is so intimately acquainted with many hundreds of thousands of the nation's retafl lacations.

It is stimulating to have recoived as many replies as have already arrived in regards to this editorial which appeared in the New Year Special issue. The average man in this industry seems to be very much enthused over the possibilities which this editarial presented to him regarding his own business. Many have already suggested ideas, but as yet none have come forth with the one sound and logical plan or product which would fit the needs of all.

The jobbers, distributors and manufacturers are just as anxious as are the operators to merchandise the operating of this industry. It means greater profits for all concerned. It also means tapping a tremendously profitable new business potential for the first time. It means placing this business in the unique position of gainins. for it the attention of the nation's leading merchandisers. This industry may become the new, better and fresher medium for them.

The music machines man, thinking just of his division of the field, and the huge number of retail outlets it controls and inhabits, becomes tremendously impressed with the possibility that may allow him to merchandise the operating he is now doing. When he stops to think of all the other automatic music machines men throuout the nation, and the number of their locations, he is actually amazed and somewhat nonplussed at the greatness of this possible merchandising field.

This year, more than ever, this industry needs something new and something which it con use to gain better reception from its locations. The average location, as formerly stated, expects to be severely cut on all of its regular merchendise. Therefore, should the operator be the one to act as the saving force, he would forever gain the respect and consideration of these locations. He would then be able to better con-

trol them for his own future welfare. And, at the same time, he would earn greater profits than ever before in his career.

Surely, then, if the average location is going to be greatly curtailed by a lack of manpower and merchandise this year, then the operators, too, are going to suffer. There are some rumors already current that many taverns, nite spots, etc., will probably be forced to close earlier than ever before, not only because of the lack of merchandise and manpower, but perhaps by national edict. Should this come about, profits are bound to drop.

To help cure this, and any other possible loss, prior to its happening, the trade should seek some means to merchandise its operating which would bring the additional profits necessary to itself as well as to its locations. Such extra profit can, this year especially, eliminate whatever loss may accrue, and will at the same time, open the path to greater industrial importance for this industry - for tomorrow.

## BUYINC AND SELLING EQUALIZINC

It is the belief of certain leaders that sometime during this year this industry may see the equalizing of buying and selling. This is construed to mean that instead of the general buyer's market, which has existed since the war started, there may be a complete turnabout which will find just as many sellers as buyers in the trade, tho this will not mean that a "Seller's market" is here.

Whether or not this will come about during 1945 is extremely difficult to fore cast under present conditions. Regardless of the belief of these men, many of whom have been with the industry for a number of years, there is no doubt that as each week goes by, it becomes ever more apparent that slowly, but surely, buying and selling is tending towards equalization.

Immediately after Pearl Harbor the trade created a seller's market. Selling seomed to be the way out for most firms at that time. All feared that this industry would not outla st the war.

After some months had gone by and the industry not only remained intact, but also proved that it could even profit during the war period, the reversal became current and everyone switched to buying. These first buyers believed that they had best grab all they could to insure their continuance in case the war lasted longer than was at first forecast.

Soon this stage passed and the trade began to buy and sell as the economic law of supply and demend came into force. As supplies disappeared, demand became greater and prices zoomed. As prices continued their way upward, buying be came even greater. Profits kept pace with prices.

The result was that the trade passed peak after price peak, that it at first believed it would never reach. It has now become accustomed to seeing price peaks passed with great regularity. At this writing the trade may be possibly entering into its first buying and selling equalization era in many of its categories.

In the past few meeks there seem to have been as many sellers as buyers in a great many sections of the nation. Routes have changed hands more rapidly than for many past months. Many types of machines have been much more easily obtainable, tho prices seem to have held up. In fact, in one or two fields, prices are begining to show the first indicetions of a downward trend. Whether this will or will not continue depends, more or less, on the various national edicts now being issued by the Federal Government.

There is every possibility, therefore, that these leaders may be right in their prediction that this industry may see the first equalization of buying and selling sometime this year. Should this happen it may prove to be the first, definite indication of a downward price trend.

There is no doubt, tho, that at the prosent time this seems to be a far distant eventuality. But should the business of present locations be so curtailed that they will not be able to continue as during 1944, much more selling is bound to come about and this will naturally prove to be the first tendency toward an equalization process and perhaps - a seller's market.

## DEMAND GROWS FOR TAX COUNCIL <br> Each week the demand for a National Tax Council, as proposed for more than two

 years now by The Cash Box, grows greater. The trade has now come to the viewpoint that without some such agency within this industry to help control the inequitable taxation methods used by Federal, State, City, town and village revenue seekers, that it will eventually find itself in a most unprofitable, as well as an extremely unhealthy condition.At this time, while collections, on an average thruout the nation, are as great if not greater than ever before enjoyed in the history of this industry, and this backed by the fact that no new equipment is being purchased, it can carry this heavier tax load wi thout too much hurt to itself.

In fact, some are even of the belief that by state, county and city cutting in for part of the collections, via taxation, that so much less will have to be paid in income tax to the Federal Government. This is true. It once again demonstrates how the Federal Government loses direct revenue because of a lack of a consistent, equalized national tax program.

But what about tomorrow when this ideal operating situation is cone? What about the time when competition becomes extremely keen, when more and still more men enter into the field, and when new machines begin to come off the production lines with even greater speed and in larger volume than ever before in the history of this business? Can these machines be amortized in time, taxes paid and profit earned? That is the problem confronting this and in fact, every other industry, today.

President Roosevelt, in his "State of the Union" message to Congress and the nation, stated that the most important consideration and first duty for post-war would be cutting down present high taxation to help business. The members of this industry, and of all other industries, realize that once a tax is set, it is like pulling teeth to get that tax down to a penny less than it is.

For example, Savannah, Ga. has just been forced to pay $50 \%$ more for its pinball license than ever before. Formerly this license was $\$ 50$ per year. This year it has been increased to $\$ 75$. The coinmen of this city found themselvos in an emberrassing predicanent justbefore starting their fight in the city council to hold the licenso fee at its former rate. A drive against juvenile delinquency which had started in this city began to mention pinball as a contributing factor. Rather than go into the open in such case, they were forced to accept this increased license. But, Savannah's coinmen claim, they believe that when the time comes this license will be reduced down to normal. Other Sevannah coinmen believe that this promise is another "fairy tale" and look forward to this new license fee continuing from now on.

The "Confidential Survey" conducted by The Cash Box brought forth the fact that this trade realizes today that its greatest battle is inequitable taxation. Taxes are being increased everywhere. In this survey the taxation problem was voluntarily introduced by coinmen, many of whom stated, "Unless some sort of organization is imm mediately put into operation for this ospecial purpose we are going to be taxed out of
business."

It has long been known that the tax maker can ruin any industry, especially an industry he does not understand. Only a National Tax Council, paid indirectly by volun. tary agreement of all the trade, can carry on the necessary work to help bring about better understanding between the revenue seekers and this industry.

There is also no doubt that the tax makers themselves would much prefer to discuss possible increases or new licensing arrangements with responsible members of a national council that would have the complete facts to help them better understand this business at its fingertips.

These tax seekers realize, as now does Uncle Sam by his experience in the fur and jewelry fields, that by overtaxing they not only harm industry but gain themselves less rovenue in the long run. By raising the cigarette machines license in Hutchinson, Kans. the operators there simply stored their machines for the duration. That lost the city revenue. In short, by overtaxing, the revenue seeker can actually eliminate good industry from his community and by so doing bring on hardship instad of betterment for

## MUSIC OPS BOIL AT RECORD MFRS.

## COMPLAINTS POUR IN FROM ALL OVER NATION OF MISTREATMENT, BLACK MARKET TACTICS, LACK OF SALES, DISCOURTESIES, FORCED SELLING, ETC.

NEW YORK-From all over the nation complaints continue to pour in regarding the fact that the leading manufacturers of records are not giving the music machines operators any consideration.

One coinman from St. Louis reports the case of a representative for one of the leading record manufacturers charging from 65 c to $\$ 1.00$ for each record, and who turns most of these over to a furniture store in that town which never before purchased phono records. Tho this St. Louis' music coinman has written to the Chicago and New York offices of this firm he hasn't as yet received so much as an answer.

From Savannah, as reported last week, comes the story that because music ops returned lamps sent to them without any order by the new branch manager of a leading record manufacturer, they haven't, since last November, been able to obtain any of the popular tunes. The only records that are sold to them are what they can't use. They, too, have complained and as yet haven't been answered.

From Providence, R. I., comes a complaint by the music men there that they find the latest numbers of the leading record firms in retail stores all over the city but when they ask for these same numbers are told that there simply aren't any around. They can buy what they want from these retail stores.

From Boston, Mass., comes complaints that the men feel themselves extremely lucky if they can obtain any records of any leading number, but that they see them in stock at leading retail outlets in their city. They have been forced to pay the retail price to obtain the quantity they need.

From every city comes the same story. Week after week, many music machine coinmen have tried everything they know to get together with the record firms branches in their territories, so that they will be given some sort of quota and thereby be able to work accordingly.

Instead, many report, they are lucky if they even get one or two of a hot number and, in most cases, wait weeks before they get even that many.

These music ops feel that the trade should get together in this matter and meet with the record manufacturers so that some sort of quota will be set for them for the duration.

Others propose that all the music trade get together and arrange to create a record firm of its own that will press exclusively for the men in this business. These men claim that they are not only willing to invest their own cash but feel that every music operator in the country will invest money in such a company.

Others bitterly point to the days when the record firms actually sent them sample recordings free of charge of each new number so that they could test them before placing an order. Some tell of how they even helped get records of not too much value popular. And how hard they worked to make others extremely popular.

One coinman, who owns three retail record outlets, claims that the only way he can get the latest releases is thru his retail stores. When he orders direct as a music op, he reports, he gets one or two of a number. But when he orders thru his retail record outlets he gets at least 25 of a number. As yet, he states, asking that his name not be publicized, these record manufacturers distributors in his city do not know that he owns these stores.

One leading music operator insists that the trade start some sort of boycott action against those record manufacturers who have been pushing them around. He also suggests that the trade back the smaller firms by contracting with them for all the records they can produce.

The result, as one coinman puts it, is that almost every operator is buying records anywhere he can get them, and from firms he never before knew existed.

The general consensus seems to be that some sort of a meet be arranged whereby the record manufacturers will give the men in this trade a definite quota.

## BIG TAX BITE IN LITTLE TOWN

Rosiclare, III. - For those operators in large cities, and fairly large communities, who are worrying about increased taxes, here's a bit of news that brings the tax situation to the fore more than ever, and shows what the trend is regardless of location, size or paying capacity of operator. In the town of Rosiclare, III., population 400 , the tax effertive April 1 , 1945 will be increased from $\$ 3.00$ a machine per year to $\$ 30.00$ per year on pins and music marhines, an increase of $900 \%$.

## TRADE SEEKS GREATER WAR ROLE

NEW YORK - The many coinmen thruout the nation realize today that hey are in a position to increase their war efforts, thus fulfilling their responsibilities as citizens, and at the same time bringing greater prestige to all in our industry. The employment of the returning veteran is only one of the many duties acknowledged by the men in he coin machines industry.
