## TAXATION HITS POST-WAR FINANCE

As the post-war era becomes more clarified to the average business man, there is a growing goneral demand that taxes be lowered to a point where once again good, oldfashioned American competitive free enterprise can come into being.

This was most noticeable in President Truman's statements the first week after he had taken office. The Treasury Department has agreed with him. And now thruout the various Government agencies there is a move to lower taxes.

Taxation came to this industry when it first began to expand in tho early thirties, and because of this national expansion, attracted the attention of various legislative bodies.

These law makers noted the rgowing popularity of coin operated equipment, and foresaw the possibility for taxing this industry for additional revenue. Sinco then licensing coin machines, whother slots, scales, juke boxes or merchendise venders, is a regular procedure of every village, city, county, state as well as the Federal Government.

With the need for taxes to produce more income growing greater in every community thruout the mation, especially in view of the fact that the men who are engaged in the war will soon be returning home from the European front at the rate of 50,000 per day, these communities foel that this is the time to prepare public works projects to take up any possible unemployment slack, so that the men who made possible peace will bo able to earn a living. This is highly commendable and completely in favor with every member of this coin operated machines industry.

Yet, there has come into being, in various legal bodies here and there thruout the country, one sort of legislator who feels that certain industries, because they lack the power of huge lobbies and cooperative action, should be taxed to a fare-theewell. And in the case of this industry this is today an outstanding fact. Not a week goes by but what some community, somewhere in the country, is seeking to cvertax and thereby hinder the growth of this business.

It was this reason which prompted The Cash Box to urge that a National Tax Council be created. So that the members of this business would at least have a board of appeals of their own, in their own inđustry, to which they could turn when their communities attempted to discriminately tax them.

Tho this suegestion has met with marvelous acclaim from all in the trade none have as yet stepped forth to help make this a possibility. And every day that goes by, as this post-war era goes deeper into its new horizons, brings about a greater and still greater need for a National Tax Council.

There is no one agency to which this industry can turn today to get expert tax advice to help prevent heavy taxation. There is no one source where complete data, files, information, precedents, procedure and former cases can be had. Oaly a National Tax Council staffed with, and guided by, men who have had tax experience, can help cure the present taxation situation of this industry, or at least hold the line where it now is.

As all the industry knows, there is a growing movement thruout the nation to bring about taxation which will obtain a percentage of tho gross income of this industry. Many states have already experienced these proposals in their legislatures.

Texas, Tennessee, OKlahoma, and other states, have heard legislators arise to demand that, not only a heavy annual license fee be placed on coin operated machines, but that in addition, a percentage of the gross income from these same machines bo paid to the state.

For example, the state of Texas demanded that phonos pay $\$ 50$ per year as well as $15 \%$ of their gross income. This same state wanted $\$ 100$ per yearly license fee from

pinball machines plus $15 \%$ of the gross income. Tho this bill is dormant at present, the general belief is that it will some day become fact.

This sort of legislative thought and action is spreading. Up to the present time, the men of this business have been sufficiently interested to holp provent such taxation from becoming a fact. But even theso men believe that eventually some of the politicians will be successful. After that the idoa will spread with as muoh speed as did the plan to tax coin machines when it was first broached. There is no doubt, too, that every coinman knows the effect such taxation will have on his income.

To help offset this sort of taxation, and the further fact that this industry is now being more highly taxed onch year. The Cash Box proposed that the members of this businoss arrango for a $75 \%-25 \%$ comission basis with their locations instoad of the present $50 \%-50 \%$ commission basis.

This $25 \%$ differential is necossary today because of overhead increase. It will surely be needed if machines will be much higher priced than they wore prowar, and doubly important if taxation grows greater.

Therefore, the suggestion that a now and better commission basis bo coine fact, that is, a $75 \%$ to the operator and a $25 \%$ to the location comission basis (at least in the average locations), is of growing import to the trade to help offset highor taxation drain of present income.

All this now leads back to the fact that because the nombers of this industry haven't as yet come together into a liational Tax Council, the various financiers who have become tremendously interested in this trade, are now boginning to plan the ir future loans on what taxes tho coinmen asking for the loan is paying.

In short, an operator of phonographs will now have to advise the firm from whom ho is making a loan just what taxes he pays each jear to his comunity, his county and state for the right to continue to operate.

This will be figured against the average net income from his machines as well as against the market price of equipment he buys. The loan will probably then be based on the differential which results. In short, many who formerly figured on obtaining large loans, might find their figures considerably cut down bocause of the hoavy taxes they pay.

With the finance organizations in this industry now recognizing the fact that taxation plays an ever more important part in the future coin machine picture, then surely this is the time for the mombers of this industry to decide whether or not they should urge tho immediate creation of a National Pax Council to help protoct this busincss and to keep legislators, who know nothing or very littlo of the earning power and prospects of this industry, from tossing obstacles in its path whereby growth will be tremendously curtailed.
sll are anxious to seo this industry rise to the highest possible peak. All aro eager to help make this business the most outstanding division of herica's entertainment industries. But this cannot become the case if some one organization does not come into being to help protect the operator fron bning overtaxed in his own commun ity. And only a lational Fax Council, with knowledge of what is happening thruout the country at its finger tips at all times, can do so.

The fact that the large financing firms are investicating taxation all over the nation, as far as this industry is concerned, is proof in itself that this is the time for this trade to make certain that the tax linc is at least held at its present point. It is extremely difficult to reduce taxes at this time in any community, and will continue to be difficult for many years after the war is over. But, at least the line can bo held at its present point, so that tho trade can continue with a more clear conscience as to its future possibilities.

The need for a intional Tax Council grows grater cach day. Even the finance firms now believe thet such a council should como into being. The trado neods great financing during this now cra. It must, then, stop the growing tax menace so that it will be rble to proceod on so much more smoothly than ever before in its history. It must have the combind cooperation of all iactors in this trade to assure tho creation of a iational Tax Council. All will benoíit fron such a Council.

There are advertisements alroady prepared which will appear in such publications as: The Saturday Evening Post, Life, Look, Fortunc, Cood Housekeeping, Ladies Home Journal, and many others of like import.

There is no doubt that advertising in such publications will tend to give greater prestigo to this industry and, at the same time, gain for it groater recognition.

As more and more coin machine manufacturers enter into such campaipns the products of this trade, probably tho automatic phonographs and many types of merchandisers, will gain greater patronage as woll ns acclaim from the public gonerally.

Such outstanding advertising is sure to place this businoss on a higher plane than than it has ever bofore enjoyed. It will assure more rapid growth. It will also assure the sort of recognition needed for future expansion plans.

The trado must realize that as this national advertising comes into being that compctition will also increase. This, too, will prove of good benefit and value to all concerned with this business.

Competitive manufacturing, distributing and operating is necossary to raise the level of this business. Only from keen, competitive action do the best products and methods result. Therefore, without this comptition, many new and important discoveries of great value to this business would never come to light.

As national advertising becomes fact, this trade can look forward to an era without former equal in its history. It can be certain that more and more people thruout the nation will look upon this business with greater favor.

This industry will grow great only when it urges its basic buyer to buy its services so that a perpetuating sales will result and high income will continue to be assured.

## ON THE RECORDS

It seems that at last the entire industry (from manufacturer down to the smallest automatic phono operator) has come to realize that some sort of arrangements will have to be made with the recording concerns so that records will be available to coinmen in greater quantity.

There are a great many unanswered questions in the rocord field. There does not seem to as yet bo eny one of these recording organizations which will agreo to a plan for making distribution to the present music machine operator a greater certainty.

For example, in the May 15 issue of The Cash Box there was the suggestion that the record firms use their same label but in a different color exclusively for the coinmen. This was proposed on the theory that the record manufacturor was definitoly giving coinmen a fair and equitable quota of the present number of records he produces and which he claims he is doing.

Surely, then, since he claims that he is giving coinmen the fair and equitable shere to which thoy are entitled, he will not hesitate to prevent his sources of distribution from making use of part of that quota to sell to uther than coinmen.

That is why Tho Cash Box urged that the color of the paper used for the label be changed, and that this color label become an exclusive coin machine record, even tho the manufacturer won't be changing the wording that appears on his regular labols.

In such fashion, if these records suddonly appear anywhere but in coin machines, the man'ufacturcr will quickly learn where the leaks have existed which have forcod coinnen to purchase from $75 \%$ to $90 \%$ of their records at retail prices from sources scattercd all over the nation.

Since then, tho, the slump ha eased off and husiness is again get ting under way in the usual manner
since most coinmen learn that they since most coinmen learn that they
will probably not see any new equipment this year.
In addition, some of the distribs. preparing for the entrance of new machines sometime early' in ' 46 , are Already from here and there thruout the nation come reports of small routes of machines being set up by returned soldiers who have wanted o enter into this business.
From all reports this seems to he gaining headway and the belief now is that there will he a tremendous increase in new blood for this in-
dustry even before the new are announced.
Many also believe that even after the first announcements from the manufacturers regarding their new equipment that it will still be months before the equipment will actually

All this, leaders predict, is preparing for a return boom for the used machines sales market which hey feel, will not only return forme husiness action but will find the acholding up and marbe even going higher than at present.
They attribute the price increase to the fact that the ners hlood will outhid present coinmen for the They also predict that British coin men will also som be coming over to make bids for the used machines.
In the meantime, a check of the used machine prices in the past few issues of "The C.M.I. Blue Book" seem to hear out these statements and predictions. Prices have dropped somewhat on some of the older model pin-tables and one-balls hut all other equipment has held up very well. In fact, the phono field tends to show even higher prices than before.

Present coinmen are out to cover as many locations as they possibly An with used equipment in an effort forestall competition from this tw hlood in their territories.

## WPB TIGHTENS UP ON LUMBER

## With Output $11 \%$ Below 1944, WPB Cuts U.S. Allotments Subject to Review in Mid-July. Supply Remains Tight.

WASHINGTON - Even more disheartening to the cointrade come the statement from the War Produc tion Board that the present lumber supply remains tight and that due to the fact that present output is approximately $11 \%$ below $19+4$ all allotments for the ['.S. will remain tight for sometime to come with a possible reviell of this subject sometime in mid-July.
WPPB reported, "Lumber is in more critically short supply than almost any other item in common we for both military and civilian purposes.'
With the fact that copper, lead, tin, zinc, nickel, plastic, steel, rubber and chromic acid cannot yet be used in the manufacture of coin machines, this announcement that lumber is in wh critically short supply, convinces most coinmen that the actual manufacture of coin operated equipment is as yet a long way off from realization.

It is hoped by WPB that this situation will be remedied when further cutbacks of military needs come thru. But in the meantime coinmen cannot foresee how cabinets will be manufactured for this industry with the lumber supply remaining so tight everywhere in the nation.

POPULATION SHIFTS
