# "The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round" by Bill Gersh 

## WHAT DOES YOUR DRUGGIST PAY FOR YOUR FAVORITE TOOTHPASTE ?

As the new machine ere approaches, many in this industry believe that the time has come for a more confidential inner industry businoss understanding. The belief that the members of this trade arrange now, and for all time, to come to be as completely secretive about the inner-workings of their business, is no different than what is but comonplace in all industries.

For example, there are only a very, very few, if any, in this industry who know what their druggist pays for their favorite toothpeste. There is no reason why outsiders to his business should know what this druggist pays for his toothpaste. This is one of the druggist's business secrets and should remain so. Only by complete secrecy in this regard can he protect himsolf as well as assure himsolf a legitimato profit on his investmont.

Ifkewise, the coin machine man likes to believe that the retailor in whose location he instails his equipment, does not know what the machines cost. At the present time, there are retailers who, tho they do not operate themselves, know just what the machines which are brought into their locations cost the operator and have, because of this, been able to chisel into the legitimate profits to which the operator is entitiod.

In a great number of cases this has reached the point where the retailer has purchased machines himself and cut out the operator. . It is a well knowin fact in this trade that when the storekeoper buys diroct it takes years to remove the machine from his location. The reason is that even if ho earns a lot less with tho mechine, as it becomes old and worn and loses much of its attraction for the player, whet he doos earn many times equals what he formerly roceived on a $50 \%-50 \%$ basis, or whetever other basis he worked with the operetor. This has always been one of the most irritating of 0.11 problems for the operator.

Sany times it takes years of hard work and promotional effort to get a location to the point where the take is such that even the storekeeper himself is surprised. Tc lose such a location by a direct sale to the storekeeper is a great heartache. But, to know that the storekeeper has as much information regarding the price (the inside price) of the machine as he has, mekes it extremely difficult for the operator to continue to obtain the sort of collections he should enjoy for the investment and work he puts into making the location a woll paying one.

It is high time, then, that this industry took stock of itself and called a halt to such proceedings. There will elways be those few chiselers on the outer fringe of the trade who will make it a business to sell direct to locations, earning a few dollers here and a few dollers there. There will also be one or two, or a few more firms, who will meke a business of mailing circulars to locetions to incite them to purchasc direct. But the average man in this industry today realizes that the volume of the sales in this businoss are to thoso mon who make operating a distinct and highly specialized profession.

Why, then, should the retailer know the inside prices of machines? The everage man in this industry doesn't know what the inside price of the suit he is wearing cost his clothier. Nor does he know what the inside prico of the tio or shirt he is wearing cost his haberdasher. Nor does he know what his druggist paid for his fevorite toothpaste. Yet, the everage storekocpor can tell the man in this business, who carns his livelihood operating, just what his machinos can be purchased for, where thoy can be purchasod, and even in what quantity.

In this now post-war ore thore is going to bo enough competition for the present coin mechine men from tho now blood that is already entcring into this inuustry to force him to keep his eyes wido open and be on his toes every second of his working day. Thorofore, ho should at loast be ablo to feol that tho locations won't bo efter him, too, as the new machines come into boing; when they do come into being.

Thare are many in this trade who, tho probably without giving it too mach sorious thought, are helping to, or directly promoting, tho further dissemination of such

price news to the retailer thruout the nation. The old story that such coverage will excite and bring new blood into this industry died long ago. It was proved a myth. It is a woll known fact that salesmen and distributors who were out to create new blood created it without using any medium that fell into the hands of the storekeopers. Nor did they advise the storekeepers of the prices of the oquipment they had for sale.

Surely everyone will agree that the mon engaged in this trade at the present time, thruout this country, and in many other parts of the globe, will use whatever equipmont tho manufacturers will produco for tho next two or maybo oven three years. There is, therefore, no need to convert storekeepers into operators by advising them of the inside prices of the new equipment which will appear on the market. Most important, such conversion means cutting down on the number of available locations. The best thing that can be done for this industry is to keep its prices its own trade socret, and to selfishly guard that secret. Only by such action will much future trouble be eliminated.

It is also wise for this trade to carefully and logically think of its own future welfare and, in so doing, arrange to keep location owners from knowing the inside facts of its busincss procciuro. The storekeeper, having this knowledge hes never before helped the men engaged in this coin machine busincss, and suroly will not help tomorrow. The men in this trade today have too much at stako to havo tho inside facts of thoir business made known to their locations. Their investmont is not only greater than it over was before, but the investmonts which they will havo to make will be many times greater than what thoy over boforo invested in new machines.

The men in this businoss must protoct their investments by withholding, in overy manner possible, information of their business and the inside price of their equipment from their locations. This protection will also prove necessary when they require a better commission basis for the future, bocause of incroased overhead and cost of equipment. If the storekeeper knows what costs are (the inside costs) it will be impossible for the operator to make any new comission basis arrangement with him.

It is, thoreforo, up to the men in the industry to climinate the dissemination of price ners to the storekecpers. It is up to the men who have made this busi ness their profession to arrange for a completc halt to any such further harm to thomsclves.

The best answer to anyono who tells you that such information doesn moan anything is to point to the various locations in their own communities where the storekeepers own their machines. Also to those other locations where they have been forced to a harsh commission basis because the location owner knows the cost of their machines.

In short, if you don't know what your druggist pays for your favorite toothpaste, why should your druggist know what you pay for the machines you operate in his place of business?

## JOBBER AND DISTRIBUTOR RECOCNITION

Exactly one year ago The Cash Box announced the results of a netional survey it had conducted to determine just what this industry wanted in the way of jobber and distributor recognition. This survey created a sencation at the time. It was most definitely pointed tovard the post-wer period.

That period is here today. And the trade is in deoper ferment than ever as regards just who should be recognized as a distributor and a jobber. This is impor tant to this industry for its members seok to respect thoso men who will be placed in the much desired wholesale division of the trade.
lany times, in the past pre-war era, operators wero found in a great many territorics who not only overshadowed the jobbers and distributors with whom they dealt, but who also were the largest users and buycrs, and in a few casos, even reasellers of the machincs handled by the wholesalers.

The trade has always desired that a distinction be made between an operator jobber and distributor. Therofore, as the postwar period rushea into rull boing vith the likelihood that the first now machines may be soen late in 1945 or cerly in 1946 , the mombers of this industry should roviow tho results of this surfey and adopt whet they belicro should be a dotcrmination factor for appointing distributors and jobbers.

The highlight results of this survey were as rollows:

1) $80 \%$ of thosc questioncd bcliovod thet jobbers skould havo financial assets of $\$ 25,000$ or morc.
2) $75 \%$ belicvod that distributors should hevo financial essets of $\$ 50,000$ or moro.

3) $72 \%$ agreed that jobbers or distributors in territorive of 25,000 population or more should cmploy at least 2 peoplo in thoir sorvice and repair force.
4) 6 4,0 agrood that jobbors or distributors in territorics of 50,000 population should ompley at lcast Jpcople in their servico and repair forcc.
5) $70 \%$ agreed that jobbers and distributors in territories of 100,000 population or more should employ at least 4 people in their service and repair force.
6) $46 \%$ agreed that jobbers and distributors should omploy a similer number of salesmen and trouble-shooters.
7) $81 \%$ acreed that a jobbor should have four, fivo or more yours of experience in this business.
8) $80 \%$ agroed that a iistributor should have five, ten or more yoars of experionce in this business.
9) $64 \%$ agreed that jobbers and distributors should issue semi-annual or annual financial statements.
10) $82 \%$ agreed thet jobbors and distributors should have warehouse facilities.
11) $82, j$ also agreod that jobbers and distributors should stock a minimum number of the machines they handle at all times.
12) $83 \%$ agreed that jobbers and distributors should carry a full line of perts, supplies and accessorics for the equipment thoy hanile.
13) $46 ; \%$ belfered that jobbers snould not be ellowed to operate.
14) $68 \%$ bolievod that distributors should not operate.
15) $78, \bar{\circ}$ agrood that jobbors and distributors should bo ellowed to docids who is and who is mot a vonafido operator.
16) $48 \%$ belisved that jobbers and distributors should be bonded for $\$ 5,000$ or $\$ 10,000$ to guarantce all shipments they made and all morchandise they sold.
17) 70,0 agroed that jobbers and distributors should be allowod to join operators oorganizations if they so desired.
18) $71 \%$ believed jobbers and distributors should not girc credit to operators without financial statements or collatoral from the operators.
19) $58 \%$ agroed that a jobbors' or aistributors' servico and ronicir facilitios should be medo public annucily.

From the rosults of this survey, coinmen will realize that there is a domond thruout the trade that those min who will be the wholeselers of this industry must be the sort of people whom the trade will look up to and respect.

Tr.ere his bion a movement afoot in this trade for sometino to croatc a neifional wholesalers council. Such a council is being thought about from tho standpoint of creating a code of ethics for all those who will be and cro wholesaling, is well as operatinj tho oquimont of tris incustry.

# MUSIC SALES INCREASE 

## Sudden Boom Attributed To Belief No New Machines Will Be Seen This Year. Prices Continue To Hold. PHILLY MUSIC MEN WANT TAX COUNCIL NEW YORK - A sudden boom i music machine sales has come t light and is attributed to the fa that the nation's juke box men do

equipment this y
Sales of routes, which seemed to fall off for a while, have picked up again and there are coinmen now complete routes once again.
Others have heen suddenly making offers to buy more music equipment. Late models are in big demand with most buyers paying present prices
and more than willing to take whatever quantity is available.
Some music machine buyers are also intent on getting telephone
music set-ups. They believe these music set-ups. They believe these
will outlast the regular juke boxes. These men also feel that wired music is in for a bigger boom, after
new equipment starts coming off the production lines, than ever before in its history. They point to the
tremendous success enjoyed by wired music during this wartime period.

Also interesting to the music men is the demand that is suddenly coming up from new blood to get into the juke box business. Some advise that they have never before had as many new men call on them to get
into the music business. They also state that these men are willing to get started with small routes of
present used equipment. "Prices don't halt their buying music", they report.
In buying routes, these men state, they are releasing the later models to the trade for rapid sales. Some are holding on to older models in
the belief that these will be the first the belief that these will be the first
units to be exported and will ohtain better prices overseas.
"The export market", one music leader stated, "is prohably going to
be the biggest we have ever had in this industry. I wouldn't be surprised if the English market alone can offer. I also expect that they will match the prices being paid London."
Also interesting to the trade in
this sudden boom is the fact that collections are reported to he holding up. In many communities they what was taken in this past Spring. Some coinmen can point to collec-
tions where the take is much higher than it has ever heen before.
Operators near resort locations re port that the demand from the resort spots is greater than it hais ever They also state that many new
taverns and small restaurants have taverns and small restaurants have that all of these seek automatic music. Some even offer bonuses to
get the latest type machines in their places.

This boom is expected to continue all this year with the climax arriving sometime at the end of the year.
The belief is that at that time the manufacturers will know when they will be able to get back into production. So far no manufacturer of duction. So far no manufacturer of

any statement as to when he expects any statement as to when he

Urge National Tax Council Be Created To Help Music Ops. Believe This Better Than Cleveland Phono Assn. Suggestion For National Phono Assn. Philly License Being Upped.

Cleveland phono association meeting report that the discussion on the floor of this meet in Cleveland was for the creation of a national phono ops association.
At the present time, Philadelphia's phono coinmen are of the belief that what is most needed by the music machine men thruout the country is a National Tax Council as urged on this industry by The Cash Box.
Charley Hannum, executive manager of the Philadelphia music association reports that the license increase from $\$ 5.00$ per year to $\$ 20.00$ per year seems to be going thru, regardless of the efforts that have organization to hold it at the $\$ 5$ mark.
"This alone", Hannum reports, is proof enough that all phonograph men thruout the country are desperately in need of a National Tax Council. This would mean more to the nation's phono operators than anything else which would be
"Our city isn't the only one that is facing increased license taxation. Other communities in the nation are faced with this taxation problem. This industry needs a national headquarters where we can get the corto fight off this sort of heavy taxing of our business. Let's get a National Tax Council into operation as soon

phono men also Tax cat the need for the National Iax Council, as outlined by Charles Hannum at the meetings of their week "Mrows greater each tates. And all this", one phono op ment claims that taxes should be brought down so that American free enterprise can continue on as it did prior to the war."

Some of the music ment here also point to the fact that when this $\$ 20.00$ per year license comes into being they will be forced to a different commission arrangement with their locations. They will smehow have to recorer this loss of revenue

And this, they explain, is going to prove a very tough procedure due to the independents now in existence in their city as well as the new blood that is being created to give them competition at this time.
The demand that a National Tax Council be created is sure to meet with the agreement of all othe music machine men in the country This is the general belief of all coinmen in this cits

FEDERAL SFECIAL TAX DECLARATION MUST BE MADE BEFORE JULY 31
LOS AVGELES, CALIF• - Samuel (Curley) Robinson of A.O. L. A.C., this city, reminds the trade that the Fedoral Special Tax Declarations must be made during suly, and before July 31. "Every operator should take it upon himself", ho writes, "to cooperate with his locations to see that no penalties are necessary and that declarations are made on and before(July 31)due date."
f.O.L.A.C., in its bulletin which is enclosed with Curley's letter, lists the Federal taxes. For coin operated amusement devices, such as pinballs, music machines, ray guns, etc. belong in the $\$ 10$ tax category. For coin operated gaming devices, such as slot machines, consoles, etc., machines involving the element of chance, belong in the 100 tax category. Bowling alleys are in tho $\$ 20$ tax category. A.O.L.A.C. also enclose a month by month tax broakdown for those ops who will be placing machines after the July 31 deadline.

N. Y. COMERCE ASSN. ENCOURAGES SMALL BUSIMESSES TO EXPORT

NEN YORK - A program designed to stimulate import and export business, and place this country in a preferred position for world trade, has been submitted by the Commerce and Industry Association of this city to Sonator Claude Pepper. EXPECT SHIPPING TO TIGHTEN UP
WASIINGTON - Prosident Truman's report to the nation that there was need of every bit of available transportation space to carry soldiers across country to the West Coast where they could be shipped on to the Pacific battlefronts, has caused convern among shippers that there may be a tightening up of all railroad shipping facilitios.

The resident has askod that all traveling be cut down to make way for the transfer of approximately $7,000,000$ men to the West Coast. If the public will not voluntarily cut down on traveling, he threatens to take matters into his own hands and ration all traveling accomodations. As it is the railroads have been asked to cut all sleeping accomodations 50 percont.

Coinmen will have to make allowance for slowness of all shipments while this transfering is going on, is the general belief among leaders. They will also be asked to order equipment far enough in advance of the time when they believe they will require it so that shipments will come thru as expected.

All war materials will naturally be given first preference and railroads are expected to be taxed to the limit to carry both men and equipment clear across the nation.
