"The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"

There were some, many months ago, who stated they would wait until every new machine would be presented to the market before they would ever commit themselves. These men, too, are now right in the heart of the battle to get the new machines first.

And this speed action increases in momentum almost every minute, as Government agency after agency notifies industry of more and still more restrictions being removed. Tax makers are advising the public that taxation will be cut. Government officials plead with industry to make room for the sudden jobless and go all out.

Everything is moving ahead with such speed that few have time to stop and think out what the effect has been on the average man in this business.

The used machine dealers seems to be momentarily caught in the midst of this dizzy whirl. He realizes, of course, that he will be selling used equipment even in the very midst of new machine production. He also realizes that his place in the future market is assured. He is necessary to the good and welfare of the trade.

But most important to everyone in the trade is the full speed ahead signal to which this industry has taken like a duck to water. And which it seems to be carrying out with ambition and purpose. The trade is actually rushing to its greatest heights.

There is also no doubt that as this speed continues to gain ever increasing momentum that it will bring to a head a great many problems which the industry will have to solve.

Will speedier buying and selling bring rise to many new methods of placement and operation?

Will a new commission basis have to come into being to take care of those men who realize that they cannot long continue under such speed sales action without the rapid change of equipment and therefore without that equipment being completely amortized?

As the trade competes within itself for leadership in its various divisions it will, of necessity, bring about greater growth.

New distributors and jobbers who are being created will be anxious to prove their worth and their mettle. They are going to drive very, very hard for big sales.

While there is a demand for all this speed from the trade itself, the more sober men in the industry should also take time to think about what all this can mean unless, as the new trade grows, someone is there to carefully nurture its growth and prune away from it that which is of no value to it.

The industry must work together as a unit while this speed action is under way. It must develop in uniformity with this rapid expansion.

What good is the coverage of those spots which are already there if no new placements are made? The trade must seek new outlets and make use of these while it revives the old outlets.

It must spread itself as far as it possibly can so that this speed production, speed selling and speed placing, will not come to a sudden halt too soon. This would find too many caught short.

Full speed ahead is a mighty fine thing for industry. It is a grand stimulant for every man in any industry. But speed, too, must always be in control of the driver. He must be ready to apply the brakes in plenty of time so that none will be hurt when the speed begins to slacken as the market coverage becomes greater.

GATHERING SPOT FOR TAX DATA

For many, many months The Cash Box has urged the creation of a National Tax Council for this industry. Coinmen everywhere have agreed that this is an absolute necessity. And tho agreement has been universal none have stepped forth to help in its creation.

Some weeks ago The Cash Box published the fact that a Douglas, Wyoming coinman was frantically appealing to the trade to help him overcome a proposed new license ordinance in this city of 2,500 population.

This new ordinance wanted coinmen to pay \$25.00 per year per phono or pin game license, and an additional \$1.00 per year license for each wall box. Tho this appeal of Bryan E. Edwards, the coinman in this case, was openly made, he received little help which proved of value to him.

Undaunted by this, for he realized that there was no central source where such information could be made available to him, or to anyone else for that matter, he prepared his own speech, his own brief and his own arguments, and appeared before his city council so armed.

And he won—the ordinance was repealed.

Immediately afterwards Mr. Edwards notified The Cash Box of the fact and, in addition, sent along a most complete folder of his efforts. Contained therein was a copy of the proposed ordinance, a copy of the speech and his brief.

He wrote, along with this material, that he felt this information should be at some central source where other coinmen could call for it, if the need ever arose. He is willing to help other coinmen, even tho he, himself, received very little help when he so sorely needed it.

This is also true of a great many other coinmen thruout the nation. These men have been faced time and again with demands for higher and higher license taxes. They have fought—have lost—and have won. They certainly would have been happy to give complete information to some source so that this could be filed away for future use for other coinmen who might ever require it.

The Cash Box long ago created a legal file of its own. Much of that file has now disappeared. Coinmen have called for parts of it for their immediate use, and have never returned what they borrowed. But the file has been continued and is always open to those who can make use of it.

Since there is no central source to which the members of this industry can go when the occasion arises, The Cash Box has decided to maintain such a source and asks now that each and every coinman in the nation report whatever taxes are now in effect in his territory as soon as possible to The Cash Box.

If any coinman has been thru a taxing ordinance attempt and has won, the trade sorely needs such data. This may eventually save some other coinman's business. This file will always remain the property of the members of this industry. It will be strictly confidential, so that only bonafide coinmen will be able to get this information.

There must, sooner or later, come into being a National Tax Council. But in the meantime The Cash Box offers the use of its files to the trade. And asks the trade to make its file most complete by giving data regarding taxes in every community in the nation so that all will know the exact situation.

If every coinman will act with as great generosity as has Bryan E. Edwards, it will require only a few short months before a most complete file of tax data of great value to all the industry will have been accumulated.

This is a great necessity. As state legislatures reconvene they will be seeking revenue for the many public works projects they have in mind to help benefit the unemployed as well as the returning servicemen. As each city council comes into session it, too, will begin to seek revenue. As coin machines once again become prominent, with more men entering into the business, rest assured that all this will not escape the eagle eyes of the tax bugs.

The tax bugs will know when more licenses are being issued and also how many more men have entered into the coin machine business in their communities. And as usual their first move will be an attempt to tax this unorganized business to a fare-thee-well.

At such time it will prove of tremendous value to the trade to have a central source where tax data can be obtained. Legal talent, which coinmen hire at such times, will then have available former decisions, precedents, etc.

The Cash Box realizes that in undertaking this work great expense will have to be undergone. Copies will have to be made of all decisions and all favorable ordinances. Much mail and other matter will have to be attended to and usually with great speed. But this one central source can be of great value to all the trade if everyone will cooperate to obtain the most complete information.

Once again The Cash Box urges every coinman in the nation to send in a completely detailed letter regarding the taxes now in effect in his community. To also enclose copies of any license ordinances. He can obtain these very easily. To also send in any reports regarding tax information or tax data which he may have. To let The Cash Box know the moment any tax bills are proposed and to keep tab on these until they are either defeated or are passed. To give The Cash Box, at that time, a complete report of all the efforts that went into fighting this tax bill. Also information as to whether present taxation in his community has cut down on the number of machines. If any speeches have been made, or any newspaper comment—to also send this in, too. Send everything relative to taxes direct to The Cash Box today.



TRADE WANTS CONVENTION

LIFTING OF CONVENTION RESTRICTIONS OCT. 1 STIMULATES MOVE FOR MEET. OPS EAGER TO SEE EQUIPMENT AT ONE CENTRAL POINT. URGE MFRS. TO RECONSIDER NEGATIVE VOTE

NEW YORK—Operators, Jobbers and Distributors from everywhere in the nation were keenly disappointed this past week at the news released that the manufacturers at their first post-war meeting, had voted not to hold a convention during 1946.

Wires, letters and phone calls have been flooding both the New York City and Chicago offices of The Cash Box, asking for further information concerning this decision, and asking whether the manufacturers would reconsider their action and hold a convention in 1946.

With the news issued by the Office of War Mobilization and Reconversion on Wednesday, September 12, that conventions would again be allowed, the trade was stimulated into the hope that the manufacturers would reconsider this vote, and would arrange to hold a convention early in 1946.

Thruout Canada, as well as in every state in this country, there is a general hope that a convention will be held. Operators, jobbers and distributors are of the belief that a meet would be the best way to get the trade into correct post-war action.

Setting a date for a convention, since it is wanted so much by these members of the industry, would allow these men the necessary time to arrange for complete clearance of equipment and the stabilization of their routes.

Tho the vote at the last CMI meet was very definitely against holding a convention, it is now reported that some manufacturers have had a change of heart. This, coupled with the news that the government officially has okayed the holding of conventions, may bring about reconsideration at the next CMI meeting.

What is considered of utmost importance is the fact that the operators, jobbers and distributors want and favor a convention to help them get started correctly into the post-war period.

Some of the manufacturers, who may have made a late start, it is believed, may not be ready with their equipment in time for an early meeting. Therefore, the concensus is that if the meet is held sometime around March 1946, it is sure to find everyone of the manufacturers ready to show new machines.

There is also a general belief that many manufacturers may possibly present or announce their new equipment prior to March '46. It is agreed that even if such new machine announcements are forthcoming, prior to a March meeting, actual volume deliveries will not get started much before this time anyway.

The disappointment was apparent thruout the industry when the announcement came thru that the manufacturers at their CMI meet had voted against holding a convention in 1946, and many operators are openly critical of this decision, as they had looked forward to such a meet prior to making any commitments.

Many jobbers and distributors were also much downhearted. They feel that the lack of a convention would hinder, rather than help, to get speed action for sales of new machines. The general belief is that a convention stimulates the entire industry and starts sales action moving rapidly. At the same time it permits the trade to completely prepare itself for the arrival of the new machines.

The operators are looking to the manufacturers in the hope that at the next meeting of the CMI, there will be action taken to reconsider the "no convention" vote.



TIN RESTRICTIONS CONTINUED BY WPB

WASHINGTON, D.C. - Until tin becomes more accessible, restrictions will be continued by WPB, thru amendments to the tin conservation order, M-43. Altho moderate reductions in tin quotas were made for the fourth quarter of 1945, the amended order prohibits the use of tin in many products where manufacturers can use manganese and silicon as adequate substitutes.

Moderate reductions for the fourth quarter of 1945 for tin plate, solders, babbitts and permissible uses for bronzes and cast alloys were made for the purpose of setting up reserves for miscellaneous adjustments.
