SHOOTOUT

Over in Stockton, KJOY's David Kraham, and his wife, parked their new Porche in front of a pet shop, intending to go into the restaurant next door. As they prepared to leave the car, a flock of police cars roared up and shots rang out. A gunman was holding two hostages in the pet shop. David said, "Let's get out of here." They jumped from the car and dashed away up the street. There were about 20 police cars plus three SWAT teams with their flak vests and machine guns. One of the SWAT teams took over the Kraham car. After an hour and a half of intermittent talking and shooting, the gunman ended it all by shooting himself. During the fracas, David was able to phone in three eyewitness actualities to his station.

P.D. Notebook

(by Eric Norberg, KEX-Portland)

Last week's column dealt with "lotteries". Prize, chance, and consideration are the three elements that define a lottery - which is illegal to publicize or promote on the air. (Thus even a PSA publicizing a "raffle" or event where "door prizes" are offered could get into big trouble with the FCC.) But, as mentioned last week, the FCC built such a mare's nest with the element of "consideration" - particularly when they began to include travel as consideration in many circumstances - that it became almost impossible to determine for sure whether a given contest was legal or not. Station lawyers became very cautious, ruling out contests and spot copy that could possibly run afoul of the rule, even if it most likely was completely acceptable. The FCC recognized the problem too, and last year, with no fanfare at all, they reversed themselves on the initial precedent by which it held that money paid, even if not to the promoter of a contest, was sufficient to define "consideration". Now, the money must be paid to the promoter. This appears to sweep away "travel as consideration" and the giant tangle that went with it! Of course, buying a newspaper to enter a contest is still consideration, and buying a postage stamp is not; and it's still necessary to allow people to send in the product name written on a piece of paper if they don't want to buy the product and tear off the boxtop. Anyway, it's simpler than it was.

The phrase "no purchase necessary" should be part of all copy promoting a drawing (if it's really true, of course, and if it isn't, you can't run the spot). But there's one more complexity involving "consideration" that we should touch upon: The chance of winning and the opportunity of entering must be the same for those who do pay and those who do not, or it's still a lottery. For example, if you enter with each cap of each soft drink bottle you buy, but can enter only once with one bottle cap you receive free at the same market, those who buy the bottles can have many more chances of winning, and it's a lottery. For another example, if the newspaper has a contest which requires that you read the paper, and offers those who don't want to buy a newspaper at a newsstand the chance to come to the newspaper office during office hours to read one of two or three posted copies at no charge, it's still a lottery because for those who buy a paper it's far more convenient to enter the contest than for those who have to travel to the main office, perhaps stand in line, and only do it during office hours.

You don't have to be a lawyer to be a program director, but these days it certainly doesn't hurt!

Elma Greer: It was a truly beautiful week in Nashville. Congratulations to the members of the CMA, who put a whole lot of heart and energy into making it a splendid week for all attending. It was great for me to be with friends from my checkered past and to meet more of the beautiful folks who support country music.

Greg Gavin: The one thing that impressed me most about Nashville was the sincerity of its people. From its bartenders to its country stars, there was an almost total lack of pretense. As an obscure musician, I was a little awed at the prospect of meeting the "big names" in the performing, publication, and production fields, but the feeling vanished as soon as I was introduced (or introduced myself). It was more like meeting long lost relatives. The family feeling in country music is something that I've not seen in any field, musical or otherwise. Another thing that impresses me is the increasing sophistication of the music itself. Audiences responded as enthusiastically to a melodically intricate ballad as they did to a rousing, foot stomping instrumental. The diversity in styles can pose no threat to country music as long as one central theme dominates the trend--that of sincerity. I feel that the "Nashville sound" is merely a communication of ideas coupled with a belief that those ideas are universal and should be treated with respect. I was pleased to meet and talk with some of the kindest, warmest, most talented people around.

Bill Gavin: This was the 20th Anniversary of the CMA Banquet and Show. I was fortunate to have attended the first one in 1958 as the guest of the late, great Steve Sholes. The feature performers on that occasion included Homer & Jethro, Grandpa Jones and Chet Atkins. I was happy that my son Greg could pay his first visit to Nashville, I've an idea that it won't be his last. We sincerely appreciate the friendship and hospitality of our friends in Music City.

Albums of the Week Reviewed by Ron Fell
