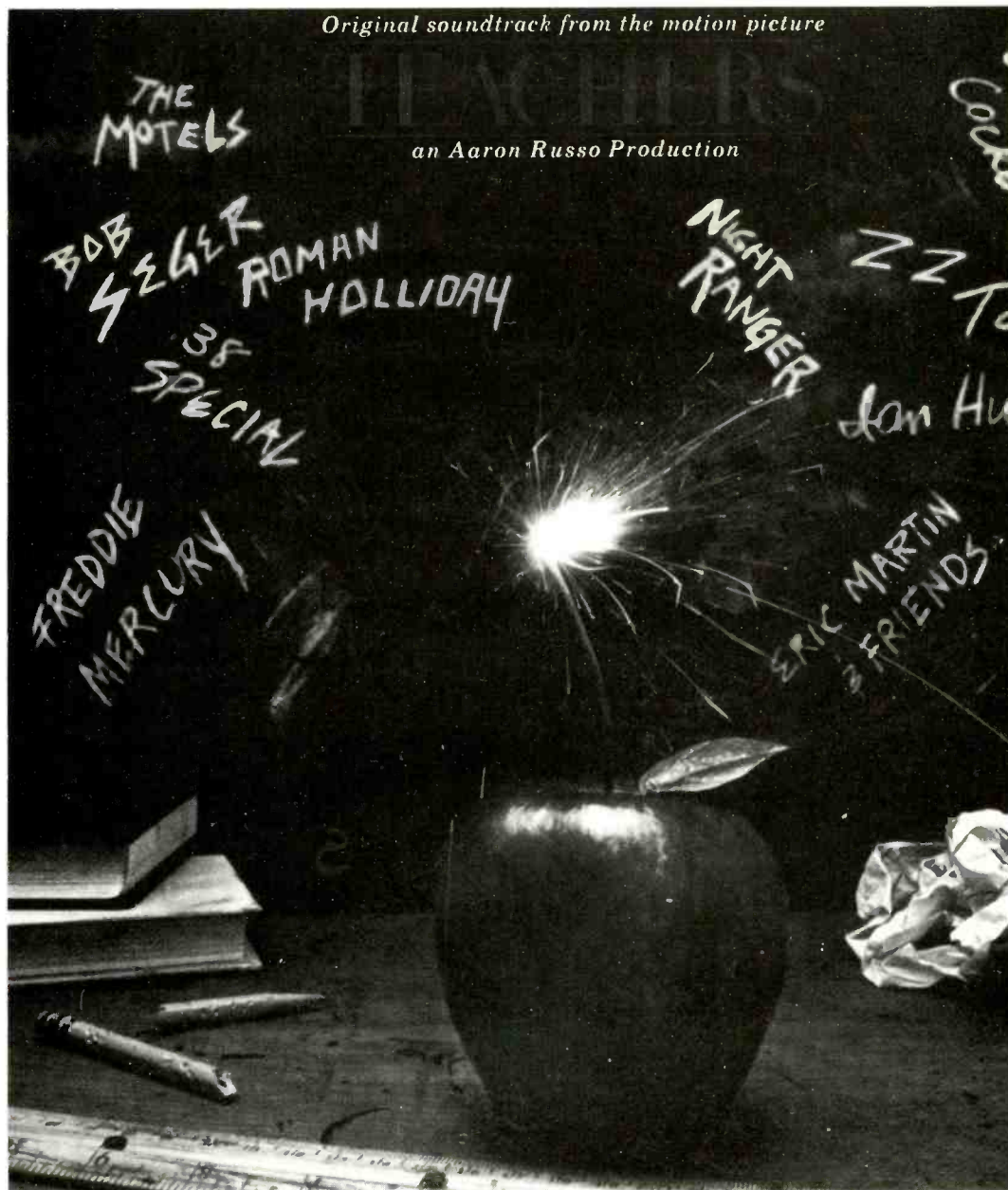

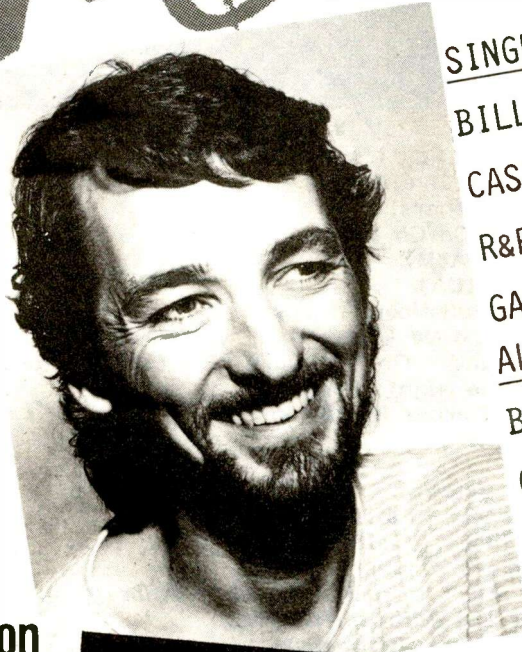

## ANALYSIS

It's never easy to get to number one, but it's becoming increasingly difficult to stay there more than one or two weeks. That fact says quite a bit about the high quality of music released this year. STEVIE WONDER maintains at number one for the third consecutive week. The last song that stayed on top for more than two weeks was the first PRINCE hit "When Doves Cry" back in July! Only a slight difference in chart points separates numbers two, three and four, all of which had no place to move this week. The closest call is between WHAM! and PRINCE, which are virtually tied. DeYOUNG reaches his highest "Hit Factor" at 93%. HALL & OATES and WHAM! are tied for the top spot in ranking of airplay only. Both were mentioned by 250 of this week's 258 reporters. TINA TURNER slips into the top 10 with no problem backed up by a "Hit Factor" of 87%. Tremendous week for CHAKA KHAN, showing a big gain in "Hit Factor" from 58% to 80%. Goes top five at KKHR-Los Angeles, KSTN-Stockton, WKTU-New York, KGOT-Anchorage, KUBE-Seattle, KQCR-Cedar Rapids, Q104-Gadsden, etc. HUEY LEWIS almost in the top ten airplaywise, with growth in reports from 197 to 220. COREY HART converting top twenty with a "Hit Factor" increase from 8% to 20%. Last week's "Most Added" record, PAT BENATAR, is the highest debut

on the Top 40 picking up another 64 adds this week, including CFTR and CHUM-Toronto, WGOL-Lynchburg, WJZR-Charlotte, Q105-Tampa, WPFM-Panama City, KPAT, KKRC-Sioux Falls, KILE-Galveston, KDON-Salinas, etc. JULIAN LENNON: nears the 200 mark in station reports, debuting inside the top thirty in a number of markets. Like LENNON last week, NEW EDITION bypasses "Chartbound" and jumps onto the Top 40 chart, helped by a "Hit Factor" close to 30%. Biggest gains at Atlanta's Z-93 15-9, KMEL-San Francisco 6-2, WQTU-Rome 23-15, B-97-New Orleans 21-16, WQBZ-Ft. Valley 24-17, Q107-Washington, DC 19-14, B104-Baltimore 25-19, etc. Last week's "Record To Watch", U2, has a spectacular week, almost doubling in total reports, especially hot in California, with adds at KITS, KKHR, KQXR, KS103, KSLY, KSTN and KWSS. KISS's "Heaven On Fire" now top twenty at WPFM-Terre Haute, KKXX-Bakersfield, KOZE-Lewiston, WRKR-Milwaukee, WCIL-Carbondale, etc. EUROGLIDERS gains "Record To Watch" status moving 30-25 for JOHN PURDY at OK95-Tri-Cities, WA., added by WDBR-Springfield, KFMN-Abilene, WHKW-Fayette, KNOE-Monroe, WRCK-Utica, WQQQ-Easton, and KYMO-East Prairie. Beginning to make its move.

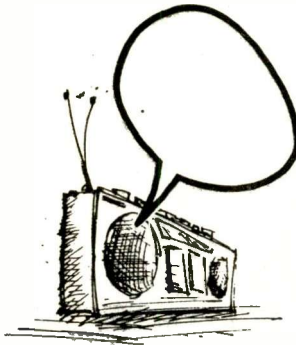

"When do you segue? What do you segue?"

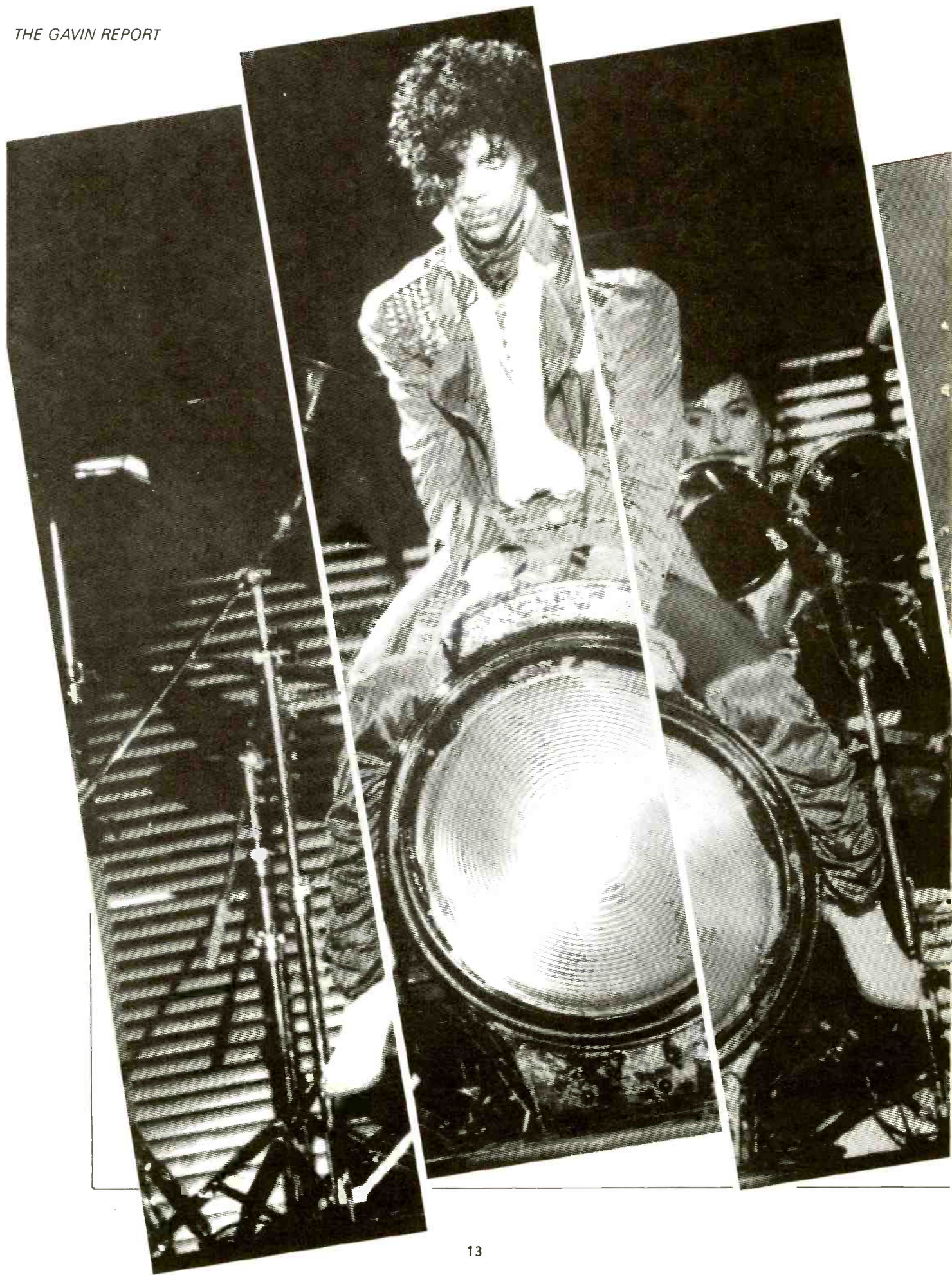
OH GOD, WAS THERE NO HOPE?

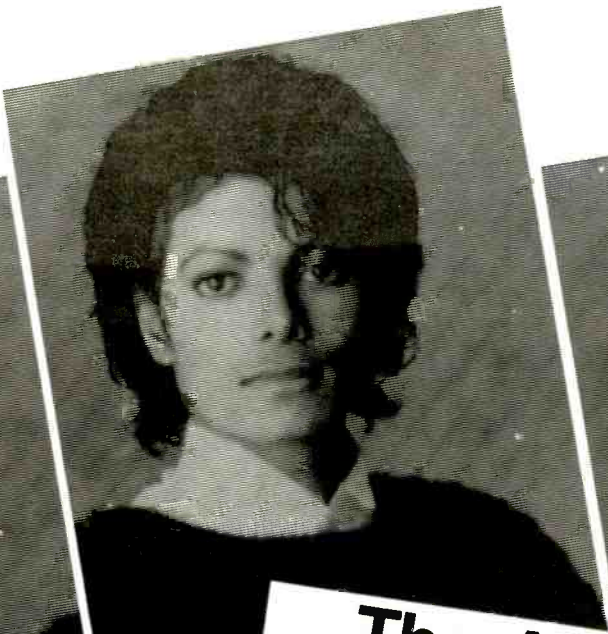

## The Androgynous Strain

*Superstar status is too often bestowed on those who haven't truly achieved enough to deserve it. Nowadays, no one can deny the title to two exceptional talents, Michael Jackson & Prince. Their musical contributions have gone beyond simply racking up a string of hits... they are influencing the style and performance of other contemporary artists. But that fact alone does not a superstar make. Prince and Michael possess what only an elite few who've preceded them can lay claim to... personage that is so original, millions are not only captivated by it, they emulate it. But while so many characteristics of earlier rock idols are similar, one chief difference emerges... sexuality.*

Rock's first acknowledged superstar, **Elvis Presley**, was much more than his music. The outrageously sexual overtones of his performances enraged parents, which, in turn, endeared him to his fans all the more. When Mom and Dad embraced **Pat Boone**, Elvis became even more popular with their offspring. And the King's machismo set the standard for his counterparts to follow. When the sixties ushered in the era of the **Beatles**, raw, earthy, manly sexuality was replaced with a cutesy innocence imported by the four "Mop Tops." This time around, even parents loved the new teen idols. But two very different camps developed... one backing the lads from Liverpool and another that championed a band whose name

said a great deal about their personality: **The Rolling Stones**. The Stones were anything but innocent, with a lead singer, whose appeal, much like that of Elvis, was explicitly sexual and anti-establishment... Mick Jagger, Stations held the proverbial "battles" of who was number one: Beatles or Stones? It was much more than the music that determined listeners' responses. It was what each represented through their fans that made a significant difference.

Jagger, and later **David Bowie**, set a new course with a sexual persona quite unlike the "macho men" of the fifties and early sixties. **Michael Jackson** and **Prince** are the eighties equivalent of this Androgynous Strain. The dictionary defines "androgynous" as "having the characteristics or nature of both male and female." Indeed that is, in part, the appeal of both Prince and Michael. Knowingly or unknowingly, they're making a lasting impression on the sexual consciousness of all of us, but most of all, on their younger fans. But interestingly enough, the differences between both are much like those of the Beatles and The Rolling Stones twenty years ago. Beyond musical originality and creativity, Prince and *The Thriller* are projecting two very different images. Watching and studying their fiercely devoted following may well be one measurement by which we can gauge the ever shifting patterns of taste among our many audiences. □

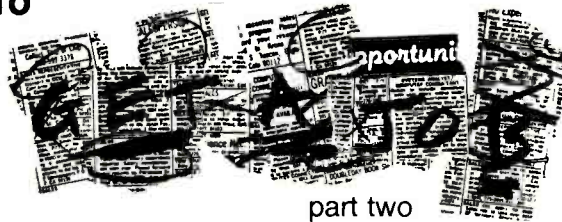

# RESUMES

## WRITING YOUR RESUME

Continuing the theme of last week's column about applying for a job, I repeat: Since your written presentation is half of what you'll be judged on (the tape is the other half), you may write yourself right out of a job.

Not by not being "brilliant" enough—by appearing ignorant. Assuming that you are not, in fact, ignorant, the cause of such a misleading impression is the way you write, and how it looks. For one thing, TYPE your letter and resume. Second, put some thought into it. Some people who are reasonably adept at expressing themselves verbally are unwilling to exert the mental effort to form their thought before writing it down—or the physical effort of looking a word up in the dictionary if they aren't sure how it's spelled. I could argue that people with such sloppy habits don't deserve to get a job, but if I've just described you, and you deserve a job, make the effort to show it in what you write.

Make the layout of the resume on the page neat, with regular margins and spacing. And keep it all on one page. When a resume goes over a page, it almost always means that it is being padded, and the longest resumes I've ever seen are from students seeking their first job in radio. When they try to show you by listing all the duties they had as a weekend counterperson at McDonald's, they are not ready for radio! Actually, the more experienced an applicant is, I've noticed, the shorter the resume tends to be. I certainly don't recommend it be incomplete, but there is no need to pad it. Just list the experience and background that is material to the job you're applying for.

And by the way, the usual format for listing job experience is to list the most recent or current one first, and then travel back in time as you go down the page. List about three references, and avoid listing relatives! Make them references in the business, if possible.

Incidentally, include your name, address, and phone number. I've seen resumes that left one or more of these out. If you use an airname on the tape that is different from your real name, put your real name on the letter and resume, and your airname in parentheses after it. (I've received applications where the real name was on the resume and the airname was on the tape, and have not been able to put the two together once they disappeared into a pile of applications!)

The letter that goes with your tape and resume—and there should always be a letter—should be neatly typed in a businesslike fashion, and if at all possible should be typed individually. Some PD's and Managers won't consider an application that includes a xerox'ed letter. And since you're writing it individually, and if there is a reason why you are interested in that particular station, why not say so? Keep it short, but anything in the letter which indicates an interest in that particular station, should make a positive impression, certainly much more of one than a letter that is clearly mass produced.

But if letter and resume do not show thought and some care in preparation, they may do you no good at all.

Now, how should the tape be made? More, next week. ■

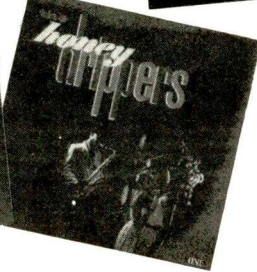

This is the kind of record that radio will support rather than risk a conspicuous absence. JULIAN, with his clear and simple style, turns a potentially difficult legacy into a winning formula. The depth of the material stands tall and separate from the obvious shadows he'll be ducking the first few LP's. After that, JL will be enjoying multi-media success based on the quality paved by this stunning debut. It's funny, but this album magnifies Album Radio's limitations with ballads all the more glaring and tragic.

What I See/What I See II/This Perfect Place/The Stranger/Behind The Barrier/Letter From The Shelter-PLANET P (MCA) I've been an admirer of MR. CAREY because within the realms of strict Album Radio, his work in the studio is technically superb. Not to be confused with a TONY CAREY LP, PLANET P takes a double LP excursion into territory well covered by PINK FLOYD, and THE WHO. Like THE WALL, TOMMY, and QUADROPHENIA, PINK WORLD contains both primary hit airplay trax that will fit well into heavy rotation plus secondary trax that will well complement the primary action trax as well as the album's concept. Four trax will be isolated on a pink 12", now shipping. But don't be lazy. There's more where these trax came from.

The Boys Of Summer-DON HENLEY (Geffen) DON HENLEY concocts strong memories and images of love and summer just as midwest America enters what looks like another ballbuster winter. Yet a couple of spins should thaw out the coldest of the cold hearted. This record should part the ways on both the Album Radio and Top Forty charts.

I Will Dare/Black Diamond/Unsatisfied-THE REPLACEMENTS (Twin Tone) As abrasive as THE REPLACEMENTS can be, they do maintain a steady strain of humor throughout their past works (remember their LP, THE REPLACEMENTS STINK?). Next to WHAT'S-HIS-NAME, THE REPLACEMENTS give MINN-EAPOLIS more cause for pride. LET IT BE is as diverse an LP as Alternative Radio is ever gonna hear as THE REPLACEMENTS wax their way through pop, metal, jangly acoustic ballads, and more hardcore raunch. This album is one of those trick cans of peanut brittle with quite a few surprises for THE REPLACEMENT'S loyal Alternative following.

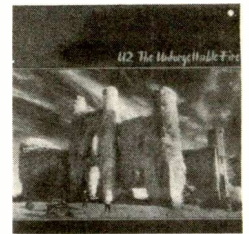

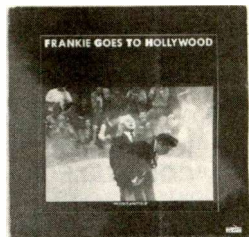

and just celebrated his 100th birthday? NIPPER, the RCA pup. ...What's this about JOHN WAITE doing a TV drama/performance guest slot on a show called "PAPER DOLLS"? And why is BRENDA VACCARO trying to kill him off? Never underestimate the power of the Tube. Ask RICK SPRINGFIELD, CHRISTOPHER CROSS, PATTI AUSTIN/JAMES INGRAM, or GENERAL HOSPITAL's JACK WAGNER. Better yet, read your GAVIN in a few weeks and you'll get all the info...Had a nice chat with JULIAN LENNON, which we'll also let you in on word for word real soon...a few scattered reports on request action on "Jump" by AZTEC CAMERA, not VAN HALEN. 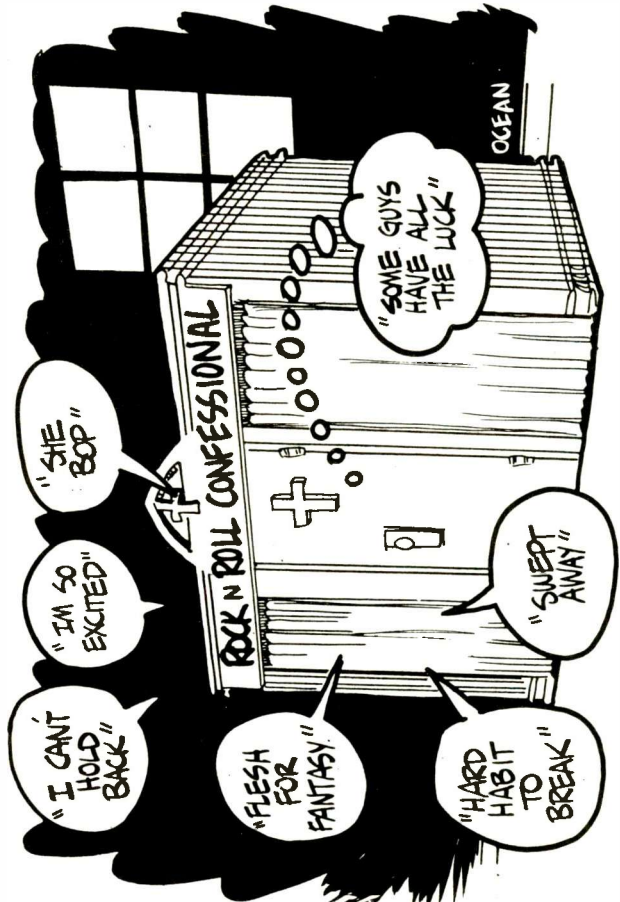

BRUCE SPRINGSTEEN-Born In The USA (Col.)

At this writing, it's been nearly 72 hours since I saw his show and like most everyone there, I haven't come down yet. For my money, "The Boss" is simply number one right now and there ain't a number two. Bruce isn't one to forget his roots, the basis for much of his music. This title track was the show opener the other night and once again explains why he is the USA's premier rock poet.

DON HENLEY-The Boys Of Summer (Geffen)

Here's a release so powerful it just may stay on the charts till next summer. As both singer and songwriter, Henley has always been in a league all his own and this effort is certain to make his solo star shine even brighter. Lead guitarist Mike Campbell (from Tom Petty's band) turns in a superb performance. Lyrically I'd rate this as one of the year's best.

BOB SEGER & SILVER BULLET BD.-Understanding

(Capitol) "Teachers" has been the number one film, based on box office receipts, for the past three weeks, insuring that the soundtrack is getting plenty of exposure. Single number three is Seger true to form and should help satisfy the withdrawal his millions of fans have been suffering through for well over a year. Should help carry 'em over until the next LP.

SHALAMAR-Amnesia (Solar) Transformation time

for this group. New members include DeLisa Davis (keyboard/vocals) who won her spot by winning a nationwide talent search, and Micki Free on lead guitar and backup vocals. Free played on "Dancing In The Sheets" and instantly became an integral part of Shalamar's overall sound. Unlike its title, this killer becomes unforgettable the first time around.

Z-ROCKS-The Teacher's A Punk (Red Hot Richy)

Houston based label has been getting local airplay over the past year. Local area response has forced a release nationally. Clay Gish at Z92 played it to me over the phone a few months ago and it caught my attention real fast. This re-cut version is even better.

"You're Gettin' Even While I'm Gettin' Odd"-J.GEILS

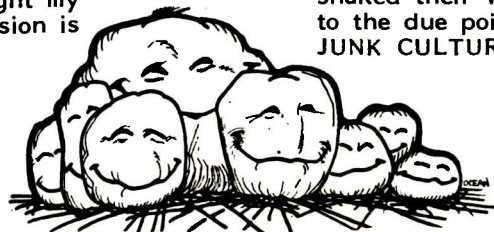
BAND (EMI) Peter Wolf took the R&B bag with him when he cleaned out his locker. Seth Justman is left to carry the new tunes, most of which are pop rockers which quite often contain a mixture of horns, reeds, and synths. (Not your usual combination). Leave it to J.Geils to tug on Superman's cape and spit into the wind. Conventional thinking would have ruined this band a decade ago, but they've been persistently inconsistent and quixotic. This ain't no quiche and white wine band. More like a ham & cheese with a Bud. Peter Wolf, this one's for you! Now, let's talk REUNION!!

"I Can Dream About You"-DAN HARTMAN (MCA)

To those who sit for hours in front of their television sets watching music videos, Dan Hartman is this cool black dude who has a hit with his first record. Wrong on all counts, bunky. His color and credentials are quite to the contrary. Dan's had at least three other solo LP's (on Blue Sky) and spent years playing in bands with both Johnny and Edgar Winter. The video that broke his career wide open was Dan's music all right, but it was a film clip from the movie "Streets Of Fire" and featured some finger poppin', lip synchin' vocal group in place of our hero. Now...finally a Dan Hartman LP which will benefit from the success of "I Can Dream About You", and simultaneously expose his versatility and virtuosity. Dan plays nearly all instruments, co-produces, writes, sings, and engineers. WE ARE THE YOUNG/ I CAN DREAM ABOUT YOU/NAME OF THE GAME/SHY HEARTS.

"Junk Culture"-ORCHESTRAL MANOEUVRES IN THE

DARK (Virgin/A&M) I've been avoiding the temptation of reviewing the eccentric bands like OMD in favor of the mainstream acts - figuring page 24 has more than its share each week. But there's something about these sultans of synths which gives their music just a hint of warmth and humor. Their robotic tone tunes and their supporting rhythm mastered pulses underscore the occasionally strong melody. Any one remember SOUVENIR from their 1980 debut? It may have been one of that year's most overlooked and underrated songs. Since then, OMD has snaked their way through the studio jungle to the due point. Check out the title track, JUNK CULTURE. Strange but true!
