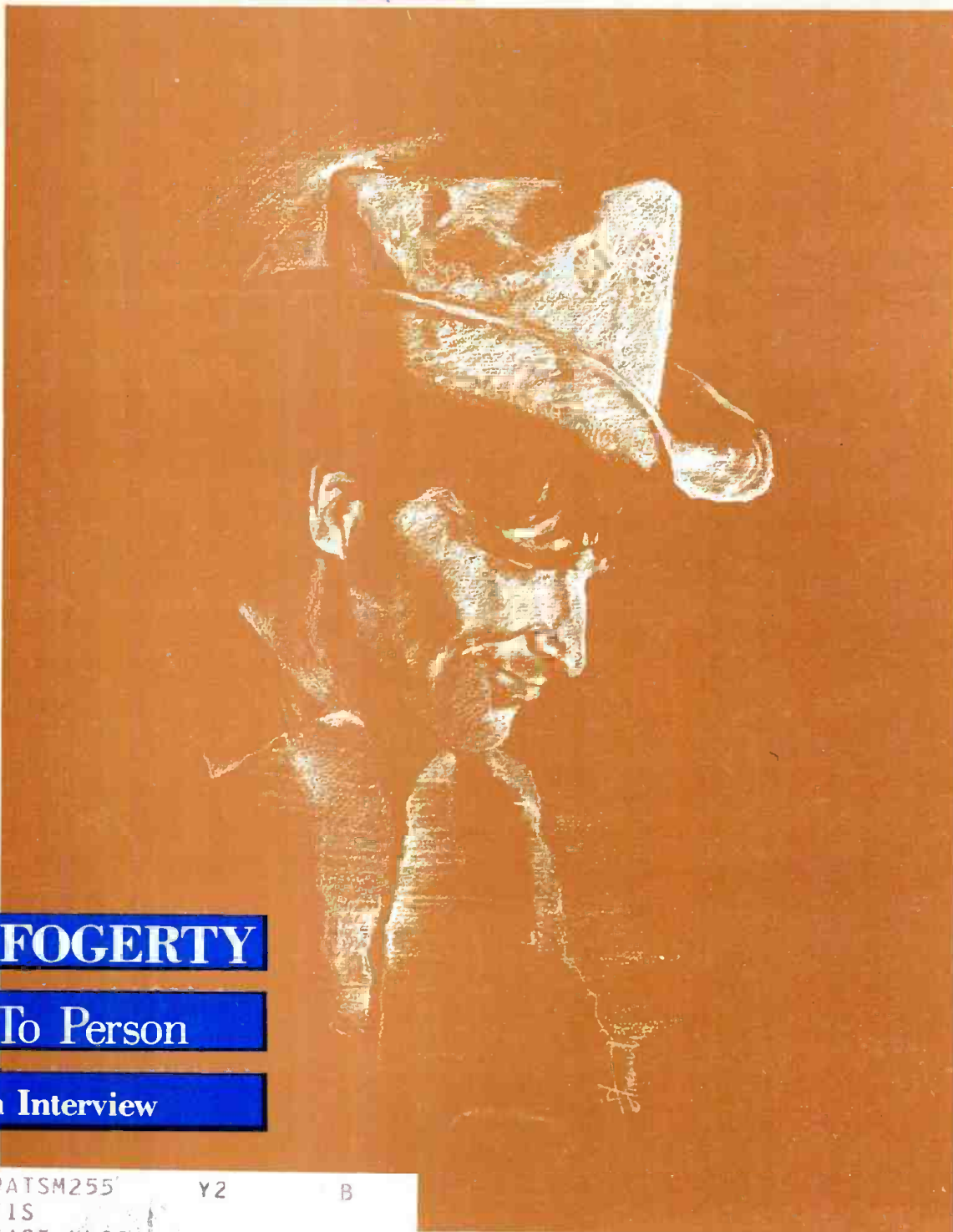

ANALYSIS

Underlines abound as nearly one-third of this week's chart is showing action strong enough to warrant continued growth. BAILEY & COLLINS break the five-week streak of MADONNA at number one. BILLY OCEAN and PRINCE both go over the 90% mark in "Hit Factor" with more than half of the stations playing these two listing them top ten or better. HALL & OATES and THE POINTER SISTERS move into the top ten, making it very tough for a lot of new titles to penetrate that special circle in the next week. STEVE PERRY's fourth single effort is doing much better than his previous release "Strung Out". This week's moves include G100-Mobile 24-16, Q100-Allentown 30-22, 22-15 KIST-Santa Barbara, 18-12 KCBN Reno, etc. Our Cover Story artist of the week, JOHN FOGERTY, defines the term explosive, coming on so fast it's scary. "Hit Factor" on this jumps from 10% to 47%...CYNDI LAUPER is well on the way to doing the nearly impossible... chalking up five hit singles from her debut LP. Step aside for DAVID LEE ROTH, far and away the week's biggest gainer as early indications are it may rival the original BEACH BOYS hit in terms of how fast it's taking off. SHEENA EASTON moves up eight places, helped by moves from

Steve Rivers, Q105 28-23, Tom Cuddy, WPRO/FM 30-25, Art Tiller, Z106-Philly 29-20, etc. Highest debuting record of the New Year is REO SPEEDWAGON, pulling in 233 total reports and close to half of those stations are already charting it Top 30. JOHN PARR, last week's "Record To Watch", goes over the 100 station mark, moves into "Chartbound" and most importantly, now has a "Hit Factor" of 10%. Canada leads the way on BRONSKI BEAT's "Smalltown Boy", this week's "Record To Watch". Charts number 3 at CHUM-Toronto, and #7 at crosstown rival CFTR, while CKOC-Hamilton has it at #6. Miami's I-95 moves it 23-16, 92KTU-New York 30-23, WXKS-Boston 23-19, KMEL-San Francisco 21-17, etc. Adds include WCCC, KSLY, WVSR and FM102. For those who haven't heard or read about it yet, I'm very pleased that Rolling Stone has chosen to use the Gavin Report's Top Ten listing from both Top 40 and Alternative Action formats. And as a native San Franciscan, I would be remiss if I didn't predict the outcome of the greatest Superbowl of 'em all this weekend at Stanford... ready? 49'ers 31 - Dolphins 21!!

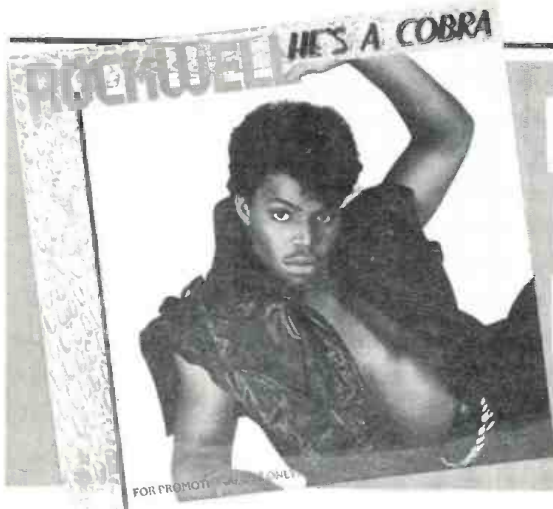

ANALYSIS

January 18, 1985

As many reporters found out this week The Gavin Report is now processing all A/C reports in our monster computer known affectionately here as GRIP. From GRIP's data base we can now see more information which can only make the A/C chart better and even more on target.

This week's chart finds Chicago with a huge lead in chart average and a small lead in total airplay over runner-ups Steve Perry, Foreigner, Ray Parker Jr. and Wham! Billy Joel in two weeks of research is already 15th in total airplay (143 reports). A minimum of four debuts next week, including: REO, The Pointer Sisters and Anne Murray. The new Julian Lennon with 62 new adds was followed by the Warwick & Jones single with 29 first week adds.

You'll notice that from now on I'll be quoting HIT FACTOR'S on A/C records. By definition A/C HIT FACTOR will be the ratio of all stations reporting a record in High or Moderate Rotation divided by the Total Reports on that record. Example 78 stations are reporting the Bailey & Collins single and 55 stations have it in either High or Moderate Rotation. Thus its HIT FACTOR is 70%.

John Fogerty: New Moon On The Rise



The Gavin Interview:
Part One



John Fogerty's return to the limelight was a slow and gradual, sometimes grueling process. First recording with **The Goliwogs**, he went on to form **Creedence Clearwater Revival**, one of America's proudest contributions to rock 'n' roll. CCR's rocket to the top endeared them all across the dial, both as a singles band and an act who pioneered the Album Radio airwaves. At one time, Creedence was easily one of the world's Top Five bands. Yet once Creedence finally ran its course, Fogerty's relationship with his label became strained. A bitter fight ensued. After signing a U.S. deal with Asylum (still represented on Fantasy outside the U.S.), things still weren't right. Feeling suspicious and angry, Fogerty withdrew before finally taking the bull by the horns for the next nine years (starting in 1974) in an effort to patch up the maze of legality behind the music. All that finally behind him, out of the blue comes Centerfield, his latest LP on Warner Brothers. Between Christmas and New Years, the three of us talked at John's Northern California offices, actually an old house, brown like his music, with a fallen down mailbox in front. If it weren't for the address etched on that mailbox with a nail, we would have driven right on by. Like the new crop of photos suggest, Fogerty looked lean, rested and healthy, speaking candidly about the past and anxiously excited about his future. More albums are planned, a tour is certainly possible, though whether he'll sing anything by Creedence is doubtful. As the man himself put it, "This boy ain't singing 'Rollin' on the river' no more."

KZ: Was there one moment in time that made you want to come back, or was it a series of events?

JF: I've been wanting to come back for twelve years! I've been working towards this goal all this time. It wasn't like I was walking around the beaches in the Bahamas and one day I saw a bluebird fly over and I said, 'Oh boy, I think I'll come back.' I was working every single day to get it together musically to make a record. There was no one pivotal decision.

KZ: So you've been playing and writing songs all this time?

JF: Weell, not the songwriting, but the playing. The songwriting didn't come until this year—1984.

KZ: How long has it really been? Was it '72 when you stopped making singles?

JF: Yeah, the last REAL stuff (laughter).

Blue Ridge Rangers, "Jambalaya" was late '72, early '73. Some of that stuff, (pause) I still like it. But the stuff after that, I don't think much of at all.

KZ: You mean the solo LP on *Asylum*.

JF: That's right. I mean, if it didn't exist, if there was some way to just make it go away, I'd be real happy. I'm embarrassed about it. It's not very good.

KZ: Is that album still in print?

JF: Oh, I'll bet it is overseas. It had a couple of nice songs on there, but I didn't do them very well. Someday I hope somebody does 'em good. I'm speaking of "Rockin' All Over The World" and "Almost Saturday Night," which were nice rock tunes.

KZ: Did it surprise you that at one time, all these people were covering "Almost Saturday Night"? **Rick Nelson** cut it, **Dave Edmunds** did it.

JF: Gee, yeah, I paid all those guys (laughter). No. It was weird that all that happened.

KZ: Was the publisher working those songs?

JF: That was an accident. It's funny you should say that. I'm the publisher of that particular song.

KZ: Do you think you'll ever gain control of your older stuff?

JF: Arf. Arf. . . Creedence worked. We had this group of four guys from El Cerrito. I mean, we would have happened on Music City Records in Berkeley, we would have happened on Red Fire Records out of Sierra Sound here in Berkeley. It wouldn't have mattered where we were. I guess I was tired of dragging this whole thing along with me . . . I owed a whole lot of records.

KZ: You had signed a contract?

JF: Oh, this was from the Creedence days. Basically it was 36 masters a year—that's 36 single tracks. Okay? Now an album might have eight or nine. I owed 36 a year but if I didn't do them this year, they slid over into the next

year.

KZ: So you were racking up obligations like pinball points.

JF: Yeah. I had a meeting to say I can't handle this . . . **David Geffen** was calling me right during that time and I had to put him off. I thought it was unethical to talk to anybody (laughs to himself). It wouldn't have changed anything, but I had this code. I told David, 'I can't talk to you right now, I'm in a conflict with the label.' After I left and went out the door, then I talked to him.

He paid a certain amount of money for me for four albums. So basically, I went along, trying to make music. (long pause)

"I had to buy my future with my past."

It's undecided in my head, really; I'm not really sure what would have happened if things had been different. I think I would have just organized a band and been like everybody else. Get out, get going. I was dyin' to get going. But, something was wrong. I couldn't figure it out. I was very suspicious and something was wrong. That's when I started asking myself, 'What am I working towards here?' I started really having a lot of trouble sleeping and the rest of it . . . I'd do my trip, but half of my brain told me this ain't logical.

KZ: So it took you all the way up to the eighties to get all that straightened out.

JF: I had to buy my future with my past.

KZ: Then you weren't like a **Howard Hughes** or a **Greta Garbo**—becoming a recluse. You were actually trying to clear all this up in hopes of beginning anew.

JF: I told (then Elektra Executive) **Joe Smith**, 'I don't wanna be the Howard Hughes of rock!' It's a little of both, though. I didn't want to be bleeding in front of everybody. You don't have a record to talk about, so what are you gonna talk about? So I stopped doing anything.

KZ: There was an unreleased album called VOODOO.

JF: HOODOO.

KZ: It was almost released. The Schwann catalog even listed a number on it. Yet it never came out. What was the story on that?

JF: That's probably the pivotal thing in my life. If it had been released, I probably wouldn't have been a recluse. I would have been just another used-to-be rock 'n' roller who puts out a record every year and a half or so, while everybody goes 'Ho-hum.' It wasn't very good. It was worse than the first one and Joe Smith had me come down. He was just being honest and said, 'John, this is not a good record. And we really don't want to put it out.' He said, 'If you want us to put it out, we will. And we'll take out a couple of ads in the San Francisco papers.' What he was saying was that so I could see them. He had no faith in it. It was great.

KZ: Working with someone like that must have blown you away as opposed to where you had been before.

JF: That meeting was the best thing that had happened to me in twenty years.

KZ: Did it renew your faith?

JF: He (Joe Smith) said, 'Look, you don't have to make a record.' All this time I'd felt pressure and turmoil. I'd gone to a new label. I felt they gotta have a record. They'd paid all this money. Blah blah blah. So I'd really given myself a lot of pressure. Yet at that meeting, what he said was, you don't have to do it now. Relax. I'm not demanding anything from you. You DON'T HAVE TO DO IT SO DON'T FEEL LIKE IT'S GOTTA BE NOW. Why don't you go back and fix up whatever it is that's bothering you *first*. Then make your record. What happened then was instead of all this rushing and rushing and having an armload of half-finished tunes, and just kind of a jumbled mess, I thought, 'Gee, I can go all the way back to the beginning and start over, and build it slowly to something I can understand. Instead of running down the street, tucking in your shirt . . .

KZ: With the coffee spilling . . .

JF: Right. So that's basically what I did. The first thing, I came back and started working on all the mess, the legal baloney.

KZ: You went from Elektra to Warners.

JF: That only happened about a year ago. **Lenny Waronker** and **Mo Ostin** both wanted me for a long time. They came and talked to me in 1974, but I went with David (Geffen) because he was the first guy that called and he was really helping me. Anyway, I remembered those guys. It's all part of WEA anyway so it was really easy. The first thing I said when I came there was 'Gee, it's nice to be wanted.'

KZ: This new record came out of nowhere, for me anyway.

JF: Good!



KZ: Was it a secret? It seemed like all of a sudden someone calls up (probably **Marc Ratner**) and announced the single, then we get an acetate. Next thing, everyone's crowding around the desk to hear it.

JF: It was a conscious effort on my part when I started recording.

KZ: To be secretive?

JF: All because I'd been there before. I mean, hey, what if this doesn't happen? When I met with those guys (Waronker and Ostin) I had a tape and all that, a finished album, it was about mid-September. It seemed the best way to handle it until—bomp—here was a new record.

KZ: I would hear rumblings that John Fogerty was at *The Plant* in Marin. Over what period of time? A couple of years?

JF: No, just this last summer—two months.

KZ: Were you a little nervous about being out, then hearing **Prince and Duran Duran** on the radio. Was there any doubt in your mind?

JF: Sure. By late August (of '84) I had heard these songs hundreds, if not thousands, of times. I was starting to burn out. I mean, remixed stuff three or four times. Anyway, three of the songs weren't ready, they weren't done. It's like you climb three-quarters of the way up a hill, you still gotta get to the top.

You're carrying a bunch of boulders and you're not sure how much gas you got left. It started to become really hard. I thought to myself, 'You're gettin' like before, back in '78 and '79. Don't do that!' I finally could separate it to those three songs, which were kind of spoiling my attitude about the rest of it. Six were done and were fine, as far as I knew.

KZ: And three you were struggling with. Which ones were they?

JF: I'm not going to say. I was having a rough time. So I said, 'Geez, I gotta find out if what I already have is okay.' The big worry was this ain't Prince. This doesn't have synthesizers. What if I'd gone through all this stuff and it's like the guy in *The Shining* (by writer Stephen King) who's writing over and over "All work and no play makes Jack a dull boy," over and over, page after page after page. What if that's what I'm doing? I had to go down there and find out. Maybe they're looking for synthesizers and he'll just listen once and say 'John, that's 1969. Forget it.' And if that's what he says, I don't know what I'm gonna do! I gotta make a determination. If he says it's good, then I'll finish the other three.

KZ: He being?

JF: Lenny Waronker or the company in general. I didn't really know. Up until that moment I hadn't thought about the company. It was all just me and a studio and my songs. It was pretty much self-centered focus. What I'm saying is that later, after everything was done, it turns out that that company (Warner Bros.) is a great company. I had no room for that before. I wasn't even aware that I would care. I'll make a record, it's a business, a company put it out, it could be anybody. Well, it turns out it's really a special place. It just blows me away how good they do what they do . . . the art department, the publicity, the people are cool. I'm just amazed. I've become a company man, I guess is what I'm saying.

KZ: What's your songwriting process?

JF: I've got a little book—a notebook.



Everytime I think of a cool title for a song I put it in there—doesn't always mean that's how I write every song, that's just one facet. Titles will help you get it. The starting is by fiddling around with music back there in my little studio. I'll get musical ideas, little riffs. Like "The Old Man Down The Road" is a perfect example. That came from a riff (hums the riff) that I'll put some drums to, which I'll put on a cassette that has a ton of other little riffs. After a month of driving in my car, it'll all go by. It's just a tape full of riffs or musical ideas without any structure.

So when it came time to write a song, I pulled out my little book and started looking through it and there was a title in there, "Somewhere Down The Road." I got the idea to make it about a guy who leaves home, goes through all these trips, kind of a negative song. Eventually he runs into a guy with a suitcase covered with rattlesnake hide. At the time, I think I thought of that guy as probably a lawyer or owner of a record company—it was kind of lame. But the phrase was cool. So I later, of course, rearranged it because I liked the central character, that seemed real strong. The rest of the song was just kind of a dumb biography, a weekly TV

show. There was nothing really extra about it, whereas when it changed to "Old Man Down The Road," that seemed to click it into that special category.

KZ: So it goes: titles in a book, a tape of riffs, turning into songs, adding the lyrics last.

JF: A title will help me get a handle on what I'm trying to say. A really obscure example would be "Searchlight." I had the phrase, 'Oh, the midnight, need a searchlight' for three months, but had no idea what the song was about. I had the music to it, got the groove goin', and knew what I wanted it to sound like, but . . . it made no sense to me. Later when I made it literal, and you could see the rocky beach, I thought, 'That works.'

KZ: Can we go through the song "I Saw It On TV"?

JF: Sure. That one was the exact opposite. That was one where I had the idea, no music, no nothing. I had the idea, as we used to say, in the sixties, 'I wanted to say something.' (laughter) I had an idea about it, but I didn't know what I'd call it or anything, I just wanted to talk about TV.

Our generation has grown up as the first one in front of the television set. I mean, what effect has that had on us? We people who are 38 or 39 years old were the first generation where TV appeared magically when we were children. We're different, I think, from the people born in, say, 1935. So I wanted to talk about that. I think I nailed it pretty good when I said, 'I know it's true, I SAW IT ON TV!' (laughter)

KZ: Were you a bright kid?

JF: I had a couple of seasons (laughter). I was always going back and forth—a couple of years I was real good, a lot of years I was a screw-up. Didn't like going to school. I stayed home in eighth grade to watch the World Series and stretched it out for a month (laughter).

KZ: I want to get back to this song. Is it about America or you or both? "Reaching the moon all too soon"—was that you?

JF: That wasn't me.

KZ: "The burglars with their torches, that are all rich and free." I assume that's Watergate.

JF: Those aren't personal, no. The old man may be personal. That's because it's always affected me. That whole stupid war, **Nixon**, and his haughty attitude. I mean people are fighting and dying and he's acting like nothing's wrong. Then Watergate, that whole business. All through that and ever since, I keep seeing in a very personal

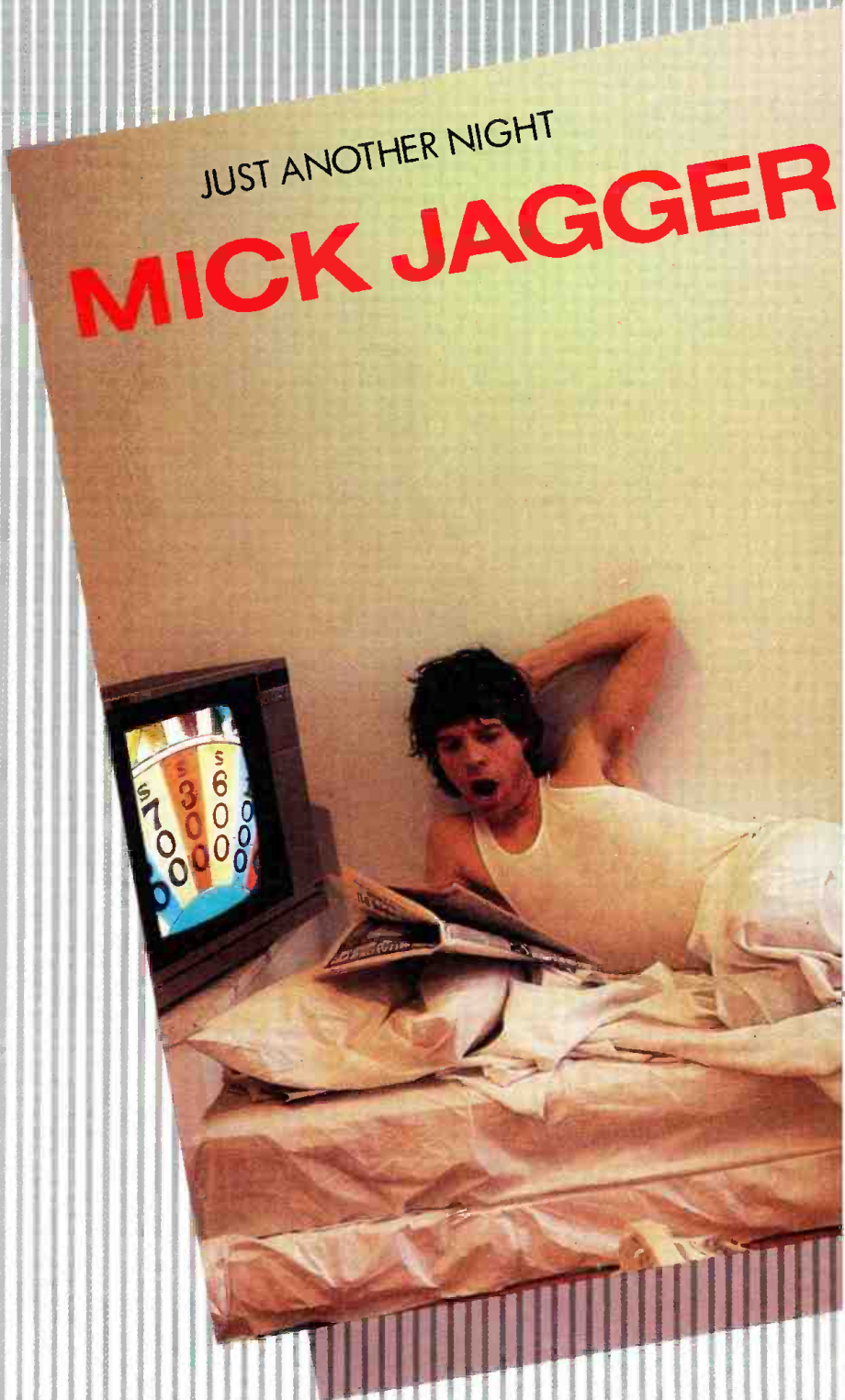

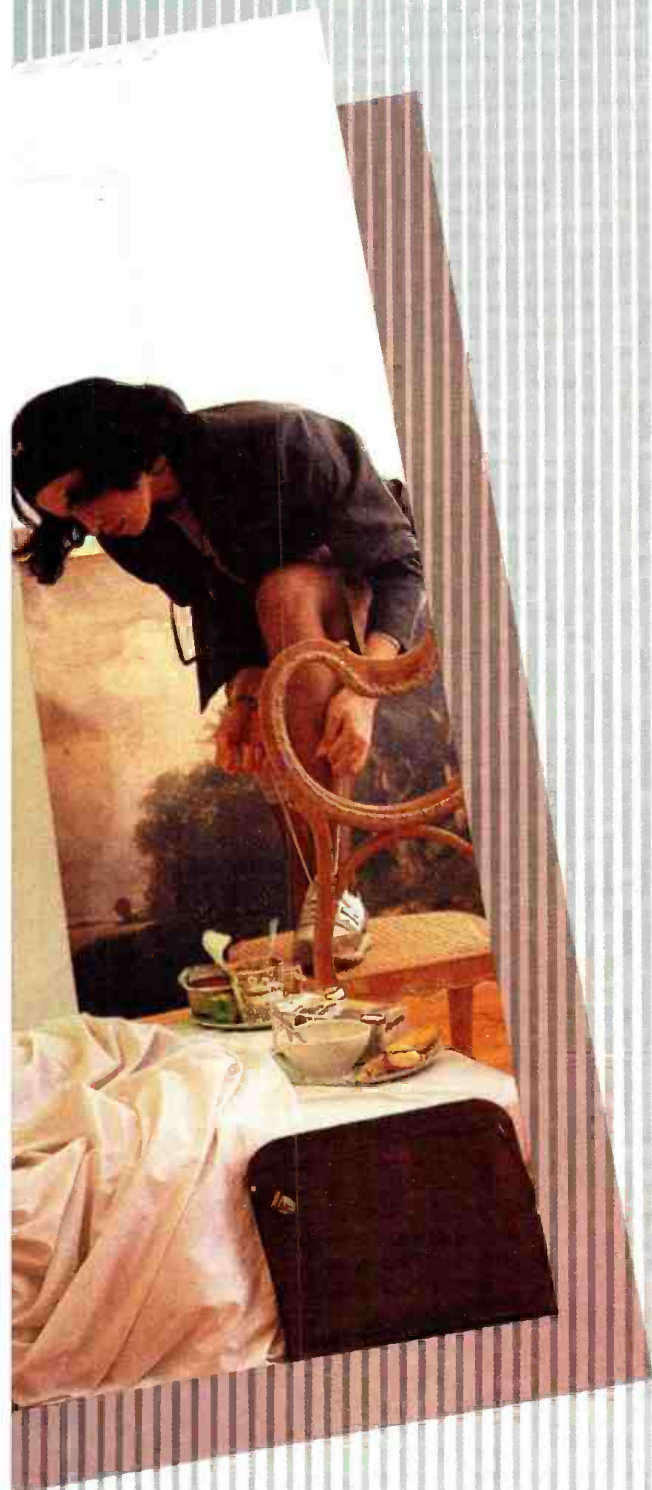

INTERESTING EQUIPMENT

One of the most inventive minds in engineering, *Donn Werrbach*, who has created a variety of exceptional audio processing equipment, has found an outlet for one of his latest- -the respected Apex Systems company in North Hollywood. It's called THE COMPELLOR, and it replaces any number of limiters and compressors. Imagine a level control device that takes whatever comes into it, and turns it out perfect. No pumping, no squeezing, no distortion on the attack, no suck-up of hiss...and all without any real requirement for input level (within reason).

Donn explains that the gain control is determined by the characteristics of the program entering it; in this way its action is largely "transparent". It preserves dynamics while allowing high average program density. Its action is unique, resembling only aspects of the Frese Audio Pilot, about which I've written before. It's hard to make it make a mistake, and makes any board operator sound good. THE COMPELLOR can be used for the feeding program to a line or STL; even providing all necessary gain control at the transmitter. It can be used as a mike compressor, a recording leveller- -or any other use you might put a limiter or compressor. It's also easy to adjust. The other equipment under review this week is a fascinating line of AM transmitters by a Canadian company called Nautical Electronic Laboratories Ltd.; Their American sales arm is Nautel Maine Inc. They started making all-solid-state low-frequency AM aeronautical beacon transmitters a number of years ago, and designed them so well they never failed. They wound up making commercial AM transmitters, all of them all solid state; those who have compared their 5 kw model to other

all-solid-state transmitters tell me Nautel is the best. However they leave the pack behind with their higher power transmitters; they are the only manufacturer turning out an all-solid-state 10 kw unit (the best the competition has been able to do is reduce the tubes to one in such units), and they now have 15 kw, 25 kw, and lo and behold, 50 kw models. They've just put in their first all-solid-state 50 kw transmitter in Nova Scotia! The whole thing isn't much bigger than the older 5 kw tube transmitters.

In addition to reliability and lack of deterioration with operation, solid state transmitters draw much less power from the electric lines- -increasingly important as the power level rises- -and eliminates tube costs, which are expensive in 1 kw transmitters and are phenomenally so in 50 kw jobs. Thus the advent of really high power solid-state transmitters is exciting.

It's worth noting, by the way, that with the microelectronics the Space program first developed and now constantly being refined by the computer industry, today's consumer electronic products usually outperform the best broadcast equipment of a few years ago, and they cost less too. In the last fifteen years, in which inflation has multiplied several times the cost of virtually everything we buy, only consumer electronics has constantly gotten cheaper....and it's gotten better while it has. ■

Just Another Night-MICK JAGGER (Columbia-single) Mick Jagger finally releases his first solo single and sets a tremendous new standard for ROLLING STONE oriented product. Producer BILL LASWELL and JAGGER have created what will be the first of a long line of across-the-board SMASHES from 1985's biggest entry. GUITAR SOLOS are abound by JEFF BECK and PETE TOWNSHEND alongside a host of illustrious sidepeople. This single will fly into all your hands by week's end, we promise. This is MICK's first and only official solo project. The LP version clocks in a tad over five minutes while the single will carry an edit. Album due February with a possible simultaneous CD release.

Radioactive-THE FIRM (Atlantic-12") The closest track (so I'm told) to a single on THE FIRM's debut LP is the first song serviced to radio and the press. "Radioactive" sounds closer to the YARDBIRDS than LED ZEP (vaguely a la "Heart Full Of Soul"). About the only thing mainstream about this song is the vocal track. JIMMY PAGE's glassy eyed solo guitar and bassist TONY FRANKLYN's stickwork are a little ONE STEP BEYOND / TWILIGHT ZONEISH. As it stands now, THE FIRM have more in common with KING CRIMSON than BAD CO. or ZEP. Thumbs up.

Don't You-SIMPLE MINDS (A&M-12") SIMPLE MINDS, matched up with producer KEITH FORSEY may have their first clear shot at a hit single. Vocalist JIM KERR isn't competing with a barrage of cavernous drums. Instead, the mix is cozy, intimate, and repetitive enough to be considered catchy. This side will be featured on another soundtrack from a movie entitled THE BREAKFAST CLUB, hopefully not another flashdance aerobics flick.

This Is Not America-DAVID BOWIE/PAT METHENY (EMI AMERICA) An astounding match-up made in heaven blows away most everything off of BOWIE's TONIGHT LP (except maybe "Loving The Alien"). This collaboration feeds off of some fine musicianship by PAT METHENY's superb GROUP coupled with DAVID BOWIE's international intermedium appeal. You'll be hard pressed to hear a more expert recording job. Just for kicks, flip this over and check out the track minus BOWIE's vocal track.

Skin Deep-THE STRANGLERS (Epic-UK 12") THE STRANGLERS return with a clutching performance more in tune with their earlier selves. Still HUGH CORNWALL and company retain some of the transcendental mystique of FELINE, their last excellent effort. Producer LAURIE LATHAM, known for his work with PAUL YOUNG, illuminates both the jagged and soft edges of the STRANGLERS' music. Both a fine alternative record and an ominous warning, take heed. The upcoming album is just as good, if not better.

Midnight Man/Communication Breakdown-FLASH & THE PAN (Epic) Something THE ROAD WARRIOR might cruise to on a Sunday night out on the outback. Every other FLASH & THE PAN LP has carried along a crude charm. EARLY MORNING WAKE UP CALL is clearly recorded, finally up to modern methods. Programming F&TP isn't easy. All ten songs combined flows like an eighties novella interspliced poetically with futuristic slang and image jargon. After four LP's, the approach is still fresh and original. The mid-tempo groove cuts ("Barking At The Moon" and "On The Road") are BUNKER favorites.

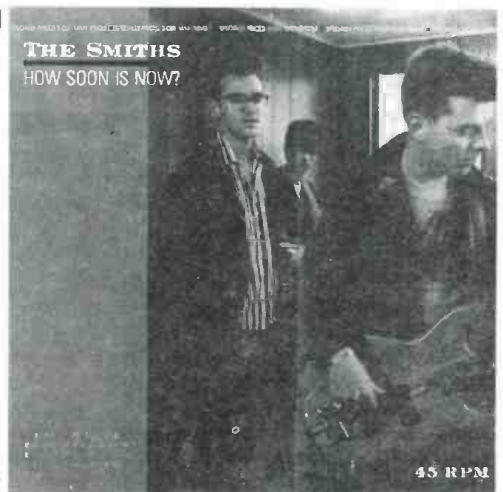

THIRD DEGREE BURNOUT

It's your first job in radio. As you sit in front of a microphone searching for words, what does come out sounds stiff and strained. But there is *one* outstanding quality that landed you this job in the first place. Enthusiasm.

It is now your fourth year in radio. There are half-a-dozen stations under your belt. You take command of the console with that "seasoned performer air of confidence" that only experience can bring. Even the way you snap on the headphones echoes your superiority. You have finally put it all together—timing, personality, excitement. Yet, sometimes, as a cart is whirring around, your mind seems to shift into limbo. A song begins to fade-out, and you hastily start another, not quite sure of where you are at the moment. There is one element creeping into your work you never counted on. Boredom.

Year five. You are a drivetime jock at a great station. So how come you find yourself staring out the window

while a record is playing? How come everything you say in between the "set breaks" sounds the same? Why do you get to the studio just in time for your airshift, and leave before the last record is over? Where did that negative cloud following you around come from? Stagnation.

Year six. How dare the program director get on your case? He's always been out to get you. It's not your fault the ratings are down. It's the music and the format! There is no reason for you to be put into this trick-bag.

Actually, there are two reasons. The last two ingredients of "third degree burnout." Frustration and Apathy.

Burnout is inevitable—it happens to the best of us. The type of person who usually suffers from burnout is invariably a "success story." An energetic, dynamic individual who often sets unrealistic goals for himself. They try to be all things to all people, and have an attitude that "nobody can do it better." For a while, they are right—at least until they run the gamut between enthusiasm and apathy.

So, how can you help combat "third degree burnout?" Obviously, during a period of "enthusiasm" you are on a

roll. However, somewhere between "boredom" and "stagnation" there is a point in your cycle that cries out for stimulation. You must find a diversion. Some excitement in your life. Perhaps a trip to a far-off exotic place, like a nude beach in Puerto Rico. I'm sure you'll think of something.

Spotting "burnout" in others is a wonderful way to pass the time of day. A station manager harping on your losing 1.5 in the ratings, when it happened two books ago, is a dead giveaway. A program director fast asleep at his desk, mumbling "research-research," and then waking up in a cold sweat, is a sure sign. The janitor standing in front of the urinal in the men's room, flushing it repeatedly, leaves little room for doubt.

People aren't the only victims of "burnout." Records suffer the same fate every day. Finding the right time to bannish a song to the dead cart rack is easy, you just have to know what to look for.

When the top stations in the country add it to their playlist, you're getting close. When Chicago adds it ... *that's* when you know! ■

sense, somebody's just got their legs shot off six years after that thing could have been done and over with. Peace with honor, remember that one? The worst tragedy of all is a father losing his son. Or maybe the father is the son. Maybe he's sitting there on the porch because he lost his legs, maybe it's a previous war, or maybe it's the next war. To me, I guess, I keep seeing the tragedy. His life was changed, meanwhile Nixon goes—Oh, pardon me. It's irreconcilable to my mind. In a very real sense I saw people who have died and there's their loved ones who are left with that memory and yet the guy (Nixon) is running free. It blows my mind still. That's why that image is there.

KZ: *You're probably going to find a lot of people who will go through these lyrics with a fine-toothed comb because it's been so long since you've put a record out. What I do want to comment on is that your work has always had a strong sense of Americana, even in context to what we were just talking about.*

JF: Other people have told me that. I don't think I consciously ever ... let's

just say it isn't a mantle I put on in the morning. Since we are a product of our environment I think it's just natural.

Everyone has their own concept of what Americana is. It's great that I got to write a song about baseball, with baseball images.

KZ: *Are you a big baseball fan?*

JF: Yeah, love it.

KZ: *Are you an Oakland A's fan?*

JF: Weelll, they just traded my guy (Rickey Henderson) to the New York Yankees. My number is 35. My lucky number is 35. I collect 35's. There's a lot of different 35's in my life.

KZ: *Why 35?*

JF: Just a number. I think it's because I started playing roulette about fourteen years ago on one of those toy things at home with a little BB. It seemed to land on 35 a lot and the odds are 35 to 1 in that game. It's black and it says 35. When I sit on the end of a roulette table, it just sticks out more than the other numbers to me. Calvin Hill was 35, Randy Jones was 35, a bunch of 35's. Rickey was my guy—Henderson. And the day my record came out, they traded him to the New York Yankees to play centerfield! Just blew my mind. For seven or eight years, I've been a Rickey fan, in fact (to his brother Bob) we got to get that poster before it becomes obsolete ... 119 (stolen bases) and

counting.

KZ: *Do you think free agents are ruining the game?*

JF: I am old-fashioned. You know what's so weird. The guys deserve it. Half of me was sayin', all through those years (of lawsuits), 'I know just how you feel.' Gettin' paid peanuts while the game was exploding. The other half of me is going, 'Gee, you can't root for one team like the Yanks for ten years with all those guys staying in place, because they keep shuffleboarding all over. Every year the Yanks are a different team—well, the A's stayed pretty constant. We just got six new guys!

KZ: *So you ARE still an A's fan even though they traded your guy.*

JF: I'm an A's fan, yeah. You got your up-years and your down-years. The Giants have a much better team at this moment, but I'm not really behind them. Bob (Fogerty) is more of a fan. That's his team. He sticks with them.

KZ: *Are you an American League type hustle and finesse or National League power?*

JF: I'm not for all the baloney. BRING BACK THE ORGAN. ■

ANALYSIS

When you take a quick look at our "Chartbusters" and "Certified" listings, you'll see artists you've never seen there before. Not that SHEENA EASTON is an unknown artist, but somewhat unfamiliar to our format in this case here. As mentioned last week, the "prince" behind the production lends a lot to the sound to make it fit this format. The other two, UTFO and ROCKMASTER SCOTT AND THE DYNAMIC THREE are somewhat new and definitely new to "Certified" headlines. An aside to the UTFO's "Roxanne Roxanne" success is an "answer" tune released this week by ROXANNE SHANTE called "Roxanne's Revenge" on Pop Art Records. TINA TURNER's at it again, and "Private Dancer" will chart high next week. Another "Pop Crossover" that's doing well is the WHAM! "Careless Whisper", probably enhancing to our stations because of the wailing saxophone and the BOZ SKAGGS similarity in the sound. It should have

no problem charting big next week. We have three groups this week that have back-to-back hits with similar crossover situations: TIME has "Jungle Love" going Top 40 while "The Bird" is big with R&B; ASHFORD & SIMPSON's "Solid" is crossing Top 40 while "Outta The World" kicks in with us; and MIDNIGHT STAR's "Operator" is charting pop while "Scientific Love" starts getting airplay with R&B. COMMODORES increases in airplay and gets into some chart its second week out. The WILTON FELDER single is actually a duet with BOBBY WOMACK and features a new female vocalist, ALLTRINA GRAYSON, who does a nice job for them. Look for lots of adds next week on REBBIE, STEPHANIE MILLS and the WHISPERS - they look good this week and should do better next.

Whether or not the movie "Voyage Of The Rock Aliens" - in which the song is featured - makes it big at the box office, this dynamite duet is a winner!

THE FIRM-Radioactive (Atlantic) Rock 'n' roll never sounded better. This new group is fronted by the great Jimmy Page (his first band since Led Zeppelin) and ex Free/Bad Company leader Paul Rodgers. Expect an album out next month, followed by a major US tour.

JIM DIAMOND-I Should Have Known Better (A&M) Heard it first last year as an import, shook my head and said no way! But I was too quick to sell this record short. Several listenings later, I'm a believer. Records of this type can become very big (went to number one in Britain) so beware.

NARADA MICHAEL WALDEN-Gimme, Gimme, Gimme (Warner Bros.) Master producer Walden has demonstrated his production expertise with female vocalists like Sister Sledge, Angela Bofill, and Stacy Lattisaw. It's about time he had a hit on his own, and with a little help from Patti Austin and a great hook, this just might be the one to do the trick.

PAUL HARDCASTLE-Rain Forest (Profile) Got alerted to this first by our esteemed R&B editor Betty Hollars, who mentioned it a few months back. Instrumentals always face resistance from programmers, but one that's as unusual and haunting as this stands out among the rest. Easy to hear why it's this week's number one R&B entry.

"Warming Up To The Ice Age"- John Hiatt (Geffen) No stranger to the Ice Age, John has been shutout' by radio despite being the perennial "Critic's Choice". If he had received airplay in proportion to his ink he'd be in Fat City. Hiatt is a clever lyricist, which is what gets him the ear of the long-winded, esoteric newspaper pencil pushers. But it's when melody can merit equal billing that the people's ears will notice. Hiatt's time is now and he'll make many a new fan with tracks like WHEN WE RAN, SHE SAID THE SAME THING TO ME, ZERO HOUSE, LIVING A LITTLE LAUGHING A LITTLE, and THE CRUSH.

"Early Morning Wake Up Call"-Flash And The Pan (Epic) Certainly no flash in the pan if they're still kickin' after five years of recording experiences. The band has been on the cusp of "happening" a couple of times in that span, but I think they've been gored by the picket fence they straddle. On one side is the synth-sational electric of their instruments. On the other side of the fence is their other image of faceless, vocally and lyrically quirky studio supermen. On this, their third or fourth LP, they round off some edges by leaning more blatantly into the pop world. Still the vocals sound like they've been enhanced or modified by some sort of electric megaphone. A peculiar band with no particular place to go but up, and this LP answers the call before it's too late. EARLY MORNING WAKE UP CALL, DOWNTOWN TOO LONG, MIDNIGHT MAN, ON THE ROAD.
