Over 10% increase in BDS spins...Early Disc Club buzz on PET SHOP BOYS' Go West, Speaking of LONNIE GORDON - Too bad she's so damn shy...She's new WKSS, PWR PIG, WFLY, and more checking in this week. This lady is multi-talented.

COLUMBIA getting even larger, as BILLY JOEL checks in as the #2 Most Added & Most Disc-overed this week. MARIAH CAREY's Hero also gaining intensity every week and sales thru the roof! XSCAPE once again demonstrating its Mainstream appeal, as sales are kicking in everywhere in a big way - WIOO, B94, PRO-FM, KJ103, and more climb on board this week. I was voted a runner-up for funniest person in high school, and that was a sore spot for me. I missed by about two votes, and I was so upset, I beat up the funniest guy, so I had to take over. It was just like the Miss America pageant, where if for any reason the primary person is unable to fulfill their duties, then I step in.

SO THIS GUY HAD A MYSTERIOUS INDUSTRIAL ACCIDENT?

Yeah, he lost one of his arms...His specialty was knock knock jokes, and he wasn't able to do those anymore... He was knockless...

WHAT KIND OF SCHOOL DID YOU GO TO?

I went to a Catholic, military high school.

THAT'S LIKE LAUGHING IN CHURCH ISN'T IT?

It's easy to be funny in that kind of environment. You stick out a little more if you're kind of goofy. Everybody else is in drab green uniforms.

HOW DID YOU MAKE THE TRANSITION FROM A STRICT MILITARY-CATHOLIC UPBRINGING TO THE DEVILMAY-CARE WORLD OF RADIO?

When I grew up in St. Paul, Minnesota it was very much the heyday of Top40 radio in the early seventies. I believe there were more Top40 AM personality radio stations in that market then anywhere in America at the time. There was KDWB, WDGY, KSTP, and U100, so it was great for a radio fan. After high school I went to Brown Institute, a radio broadcasting school in Minneapolis.

DO THOSE SCHOOLS REALLY WORK?

I don't know how it is now, but at the time it was pretty well-known in the Midwest. At my first station, about 80% of the people there had gone to Brown Institute. Maybe that's because that's the only station that they ever placed anybody at, I don't know

DID YOU FEEL RADIO WAS THE BEST WAY TO GET YOUR CREATIVITY OUT IN A MORE POSITIVE MANNER? I found that I could tell the same jokes on the radio station and I wouldn't be held after school, and there was no detention.

LET'S TALK ABOUT THE FIRST RADIO GIG AND BRING US UP TO SPEED FROM POINT 'A' TIL KZIO

WKBI was the radio station at Brown Institute. Their slogan was "We're That Brown Spot On Your Dial...." But my first real radio station was just about as funny, which was KORN.

KORN, JUST LIKE ON 'HEE HAW?'

Exactly, in Mitchell, South Dakota. It's a real station, and their big claim to fame is that's the station that Gary Owens of 'Laugh In' fame started at.

I CAN SEE BOTH OF YOUR CAREERS RUNNING ON A PARALLEL COURSE...

It's not as impressive, but when I'm on the air, I still cup my hand over my ear and say, "Live, from beautiful downtown Duluth!"

TAKE ME THROUGH SOME OF THE OTHER PITSTOPS ALONG YOUR ROAD OF LIFE.

IS IT A GOAL OF YOURS TO STAY IN THAT VICINITY?

Since I'm originally from the Minneapolis/St. Paul area, that would be a logical area to stay, just because I know the area, my family is there, it's a place I'm comfortable in. But no, I'm not locked into staying in the Midwest

IT'S GREAT TO STAY IN ONE PLACE AS LONG AS YOU HAVE, BUT DO YOU FIND THAT THE LONGER YOU STAY, THE MORE ROOTS YOU PUT DOWN, THE HARDER IT IS TO THINK ABOUT LEAVING?

It's tough, because my wife, Mary and I have a couple of kids who are growing up. You've got to think about a lot more things when your moving then just yourself, plus when you've been at a station for as long as I have, I think a lot of potential employers tend to overlook you because they think that you're going to stay there forever.

YOU'VE GOT SCHOOLS AND OTHER FACTORS TO CONSIDER NOW. THERE WAS A TIME WHEN YOU COULD JUST SELL EVERYTHING, JUMP IN THE CAR AND GO TO THE NEXT TOWN. YOU AND YOUR

And indeed they were pits and stops. After that I went to Mason City, Iowa; Eau Claire, Wisconsin; and then up here to beautiful downtown Duluth, where I've been for the last nine years or so.

WHAT'S KEPT YOU IN DULUTH SO LONG, 'HE ASKED KNOWINGLY?'

Actually, it's the parole board...You see, I have this bracelet around my ankle.

WHICH PREVENTS YOU FROM WORKING IN A LARGER MARKET?

Exactly...it beeps whenever I even think about going to Minneapolis.

WIFE MAKE FRIENDS...IT'S A HUGE PICTURE NOW.

Thanks...Just when I thought I could leave, now you've talked me out of it again.

WHAT KIND OF CHANGES HAVE YOU SEEN IN THE PAST NINE YEARS.

It sounds like you're talking to some grizzled World War II veteran..."So, Grandpa, tell us about the old days..."

WELL, IT DOES FEEL LIKE WE'RE HAVING A BEER DOWN AT THE VFW HALL...

Actually, when I started here this station was still in black and white. I came here in 1984 as the afternoon guy.



IS KZIO YOUR FIRST ACTUAL PROGRAMMING OPPORTUNITY?

Exactly. About six months after I got here, I was moved to mornings and a few months after that, the previous Program Director left and I was boosted into that office, which is right near the ladies room by the way.

KZIO has always been pretty much a Mainstream radio station. We can play some rock stuff, some dance stuff, and some ACstuff, taking the best of all worlds. In a market this size we haven't had to niche as people have in the larger markets. Although I feel that creeping down into smaller and smaller markets, because everything else is so niched, their cable TV is so niched, their magazines are, everything is...you know exactly what your going to get when you go to it. You buy a certain kind of magazine, you can flip to any of 89 cable channels that are tightly formatted and niched to a specific viewer. People are now expecting the same thing from their radio stations. So, where stations in smaller markets used to get away with being a bit more broad in the past, we're now finding ourselves trying to focus a little more in one direction or another so that we can live up to our listeners' expectations.

THE MIDWEST USED TO BE CATEGORIZED STRICTLY AS A ROCK AREA. DO YOU NOW SEE MORE DANCE AND ALTERNATIVE MUSIC CREEPING INTO REQUESTS AND SALES?

Absolutely. There are some people that are successful with rock-leaning stations in the Midwest, but I don't think you can make a blanket statement anymore that the Midwest is a rock area.

YOU JUST CAN'T DO THOSE REO SPEEDWAGON WEEKENDS ANYMORE.

No, and I really miss that...

THE FORMAT HAS CHANGED SO MUCH OVER THE LAST COUPLE OF YEARS. YOU JUST HAVE TO CHANGE WITH IT OR ELSE YOU'RE OUT OF THE LOOP.

We don't subscribe to Arbitron, so I'm not allowed to say anything about that, but I hear we took a little hit in our 12+ numbers this last time. I feel it was kind of a wake-up call for us. Just because we've done it this way for the last eight years doesn't mean that's the way it is now. We've got to grow with our listeners and keep up with the active people in the audience. I've got the feeling that a lot of radio stations were following the upper end of the demo into the next demo up and the next demo up after that and trying to age with their audience instead of...

TRYING TO GROW NEW LISTENERS.

Exactly.

THAT THEY STOPPED BEING TRUE TO THE FORMAT AND ENDED UP SOUNDING LIKE FAKE AC'S.

Yeah that's true. We have a very strong AC station here, and we realized we can't out AC the AC station. We have to be a Top40 station that plays current music, and that's always been our main focus. We're about the only format left that plays current hit music. The AC and AOR stations in this market are very goldbased. We tried to reposition the other stations as being the old timers playing the old music, and position ourselves as the station that plays the new music, the now music, the stuff you hear on MTV, the stuff that you read about in your magazine. That's what you're going to hear on KZIO.

AS A MORNING GUY, DO YOU FIND TODAY'S LISTENERS ARE MORE SOPHISTICATED IN THEIR HUMOR REQUIREMENTS? THEY SEEM TO WANT THE LETTERMAN-TYPE APPROACH WHERE YOU LET THEM IN ON THE RIT.

I think there's more reality humor instead of too many preproduced bits and wacky neighbors at the door...Our morning show uses a certain amount of that kind of thing, but the stuff we hear most about later, and the stuff works the best, is the stuff where one of the morning show guys comes in and is talking about a bad haircut that he got, and they go off for five minutes doing stuff on bad haircuts. That's the kind of thing that seems to touch people and that's the stuff that we hear back about.

HOW ABOUT A QUICK CHUNK OF PHILOSOPHY?

There are three big things I wanted to mention: Promotions, Music, and Staff. P.M.S. What does it mean? This is John Michaels' P.M.S. Theory: "Take care of your 'P' and your 'M,' and your S will follow..."

I'LL CHERISH THIS MOMENT ALWAYS.

You know that place in the interview where you put a quote in bold letters?...The PMS thing, that'll be mine...

LETS TALK ABOUT YOUR ESTEEMED AIRSTAFF.

In the mornings, it's me...'Michaels In The Morning,' along with Ray Higgins and Ken Buehler, who's the news guy. We use a certain amount of produced humor, but the most successful stuff is the reality-based humor, whatever the topic of the day happens to be, whether it's local politics or local entertainment or whatever is topical. It sounds cliche, but that's still what gets people talking about your morning show. The topical stuff, the local stuff, and if it's local and topical, that's a bonus.

HOW ABOUT MIDDAYS?

Middays are hosted by Christine Dean, who was for many years the overnight voice of KZIO. A few

LET'S TALK ABOUT THE REST OF THE STAFF MEMBERS.

Tommy B., who's my Music Director and afternoon drive jock has just resigned to go to KBOZ in Bozeman, Montana, so that position is currently open. Tommy had been with us for over five years, and his shoes will be tough to fill. They're size 13 DD's!

HOW ABOUT NIGHTS?

Our night jock is Jimi Jamm, who's been with us almost a year now. He sounds great on the air, he's a very energetic night guy and he's young, so he gives us that youthful edge that we need, especially at night. He also gives us ideas off the phones and the streets of music that we should be playing, especially for the younger demos. He's also our Promotion Director, and has done some great things in the past year keeping KZIO on the streets, and in the eyes and ears of our listeners.

THERE'S THE 'P' WE WERE TALKING ABOUT.

Promotion has always been very important to this radio station. Actually, in this market, most of the other radio stations, even the leaders, are not heavily promotion-oriented radio stations.

THAT'S THE ELEMENT WHERE TOP40 HAS NO

months ago she moved to middays and has done a great job. We look for good things in our midday numbers and in-office listening because she has a very nice, very soothing voice without sounding too AC. She's still doing a Top40 delivery, but she does it in a nice adult female-friendly way.

SHE ALSO HOSTS YOUR SUNDAY ALTERNATIVE SHOW?

That's right. 'The Edge' has been on the air for about two years, and it's currently a one hour show at eleven o'clock on Sunday nights.

Christine had an interest in this type of music because of her background in college and Alternative radio and wanted to put something like this together, so she put together a couple of mock shows to see what it would sound like. We put it on the air, and it's been very successful, it sells records. Christine is really passionate about this music and these artists, and I think it really shows on the air.

COMPETITION. AS FAR AS ESTABLISHING STREET PRESENCE AND SELF-PROMOTION, NO OTHER FORMAT CAN COMPETE WITH TOP40.

We find that if we only do a little bit, we are doing much more than anybody else is. We try to take it beyond that, so that our presence is known and seen everywhere. We sponsor things that you wouldn't normally expect with a Top40 station. Every summer we sponsor a Folk Music Festival in one of the local parks. We sponsor a Fourth Of July festival because it's a family-oriented event. The live music has traditionally been Oldies bands, but they don't go to the Oldies station for sponsorship, they don't go to the AOR station, they don't go to the AC station. They go to the station that is the promotional leader, the one that can give it the promotional support that this festival needs. They come to KZIO for that, even if we're up there introducing Three Dog Night...

TELL ME ABOUT YOUR STAND-UP COMEDY CAREER. DIDN'T YOU HONE YOUR CONSIDERABLE COMEDIC SKILLS FOR A WHILE AT THE LOCAL COMEDY CLUBS.

It started with me hosting the comedy nights, and it evolved from just introducing comedians to telling a couple of jokes and then a few more, and then a few more. It's nothing I've ever taken on the road or anything, but it's something I enjoy doing that's totally different from the kind of humor that I do on the morning show.

It's hell, but it's a good way to test material that you would want to use on the air or vice versa, you can recycle some of the stuff you used on the air into the stand-up routine.

LIKE THE WEATHER BREAKS AND STUFF?

Yeah, and the PSA's.

THROW IN A COUPLE OF EBS TESTS.

They go ape for that stuff.

IS THERE ANYTHING THAT WE HAVEN'T COVERED THAT YOU WANTED TO TOUCH ON?

I would be remiss if I didn't talk about an important part of the success and the sound of the radio station, which is Craig Hunt, the guy who voices our promos and sweepers. Craig is the afternoon guy at STAR94 in Atlanta. We've been using him for the last couple of years because it seems the growling, "Listen to this station or I'll bite your head off"- kind of voices are going by the wayside. We didn't want an AC-sounding voice, but something in the middle that's exciting and brings out the passion in the station, but doesn't anger people or demand that they listen. That's what we found in Craig and we've been very happy with him.


HOW ABOUT YOUR PLANS FOR THE FUTURE AFTER NINE YEARS OF SUCCESS AT KZIO?




