

different from us. I know we developed this one to tailor-fit Phoenix. We study, we do our homework every week and make sure that what we're playing is working. We look heavily at sales because this is a strong market for Modern Rock.

Clay: That's right. Indexed to the population, Phoenix is the second leading market in the U.S. for Modern Rock sales.

YOU MENTIONED EARLIER ABOUT STATION IMAGING. WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE TO YOU BETWEEN IMAGING A MODERN ROCK STATION AND IMAGING A TRADITIONAL MAINSTREAM TOP40?

Clay: My experience even to this day in listening to traditional Top40 stations is that here is a higher level than I'd like of production values, meaning lots of laser blasts and dramatic music and thunderous big pukey voices making stupid claims. And I believe that these days it puts listeners off. There are basically three elements to our imaging...First, we use Jerry Lentz as our voice. He's got exactly the right attitude and delivery. He gets it. He's in Dallas. Second, the level of production values on our breakers or sweepers is not as hypey as a typical Top40. And third, instead of lots of outrageous boasting ego-masturbatory cliche-ridden slogans, we are very self-effacing, self-deprecating. For you dumb people, that means we make fun of ourselves. For example, we're in a dumpy old building that has three trailer houses out back for office space, and there are three stations crammed in here, including the Edge, KZRX, and our AM Sports-Talk station. So we make fun of this...One of our basic slogans is "From a dumpy little building in the Modern Rock Trailer Park." I've turned into a drop junkie. When I watch TV at home, I always have a video tape rolling, to capture great drops from TV shows, movies, and commercials. I edit drops into all our imaging breakers

LET'S GO OVER THE AIRSTAFF.

Clay: Starting with mornings -Willobee wears two hats, he's morning personality and Music Director, he's juggling a lot of responsibilities. As Music Director, he has really excellent relationships with the record community. He's doing a great job in mornings. We're trying to contrast ourselves verses the other morning shows in town, who are all hyped-up and talking a lot. Yet Willobee is hitting the right balance and is very entertaining and has a lot of elements to his show, including comedy and relatable entertainment. His partner in the morning is Mary Ziehl, who also does news and feature material. She's bright and articulate and a perfect foil for Will. Also sharing the morning hours is Commander Bill, who is plugged-in and legendary in this market. He's done traffic here for a gazillion years, most recently with the dearly departed Y95.

IS THE MORNING SHOW PRETTY MUSIC INTENSIVE?

Clay: It's music intensive, yet it allows plenty of room for entertainment, features, and information. It's not dry. We do use Premiere and other comedy services, and try to keep the focus on what people of our target demo are thinking and talking about.

THE REST OF THE STAFF...

Clay: Allison Strong is on The Edge during middays. Allison came to us from KFMA, and before that KJQ in Salt Lake City. Even before we signed on I knew that I wanted her to be part of the team because I heard her on KFMA. Allison is the most knowledgeable person on our staff about Modern Rock artists and music happenings. She's very passionate and educated about our artists. Playing to her strengths, that's why she's the perfect person to produce a very important imaging feature, the 'New Rock News,' which runs in all dayparts. Allison and Will are our strongest personalites on the streets.

I do afternoons, under the name 'Edison.' Thomas Edison has always been my idol...the greatest "What if?" guy in history. Without his inventions, we wouldn't be doing what we do for a living.

NOT TO MENTION THE FACT YOU WENT TO HIGH SCHOOL WITH HIM...

Clay: Thanks a lot, Kevin. The day I was going to go on the air here for the first time, Larry Morgan called me that morning and pointed out that it was Edison's birthday...some sort of cosmic thing going on, so I had to use that name. Commander Bill does

station that fell through. I hired him to do overnights, and since then he's progressed and been promoted to Assistant Music Director. I believe he's a fast-rising star in music circles, he's someday going to be one of the best music directors in this business. He's very sharp and is developing very quickly. Plus he has the best tattoos in the building.

Our Promotions Director is Bob Newquist. He's been in this market since dirt was invented, and has worked at several great stations. He oversees promotions on both the Edge and our Z-Rock station. Between Bob and his assistant Greg Paul, they are responsible for the details and organization of everything we do, on the streets and contesting. He's ultimately responsible for making sure everything we do goes well...and it does!

Rounding out things are the parttime staff, including Arty Klein, who does overnights, Ryan, Shon White, Anthony, Tom Kelly, and Robin Nash. We have a great hardworking, dedicated staff.

ISN'T IT ABOUT TIME FOR SOME GRATUITOUS BUTT-KISSING?

Clay: OK, but I'll need to blow my nose when I'm done. Our General Manager is Kathy Lawrence. She was promoted to this position in December, and she's probably the best GM I've ever worked with. She's Superwoman...managing three radio stations, and she's made an amazing difference in both the attitude in the hallways and the forward momentum of our company. Plus she's a snappy dresser. She's also Vice President of our company. Between Kathy and our

afternoon traffic too, and gives me someone to bounce off of. I love being on the air here...the most intelligent, well-educated, hippest people I've ever experienced calling in to a radio station. I go home and bring my dog Buddy back with me before going on the air every day...He's a real radio dog, a gift from KYNO when I was there. He actually gets faxes and mail.

On the air at night is "Dead Air Dave." We hired him as Production Director...He's another Fresno Edge alumni. When Whipping Boy went to KROQ, Dave asked for nights, because his passion is for being on the air. He's out in left field in another dimension somewhere. His show is a very strange and cool experience every night. Dave continues to produce most of our promos.

After that, 10 p.m. to 2 a.m., it's Christopher "The Minister Of Modern Rock." He also used to work KJQ. The week that we started this station Chris showed up on my doorstep with a tape, out of work, had used a one-way bus ticket to get here under the promise of a job at another

CFO/Business Manager Bijen Dyrek, those two ladies have really turned this place into a winning entity. With them at the helm, it's great to work in an environment that isn't a testosterone-laden jock farm. They're building an outstanding sales staff, who are bright, articulate, and understand what we're all about. Programming and sales at our station enjoy a great interactive, supportive relationship. Our owner, Steven Taslitz in Chicago, is involved, supportive, accessible, and into the station as much as all of us. When he's in town, he's as likely to hang out with a part-timer late at night in the control room as he is to hang out with anyone else. He sometimes goes on sales calls too. Plus, we get to call him in the winter and make fun of how cold it is where he lives. Also, we've recently hired a real engineer...John Baker, who I worked with at KKLQ in San Diego. He's that rare kind of engineer that actually cares and fixes stuff!

Hey, anybody got a kleenex?

WHAT'S THE FUTURE OF THIS

FORMAT?

Clay: It can't help but grow, because there's a continuing widening acceptance of this format. The barriers are starting to break down. So many managers and owners thought that this kind of music only appeals to kids with green hair, nose and nipple rings, and lots of tattoos. The truth couldn't be farther from that.

We target 18-34, but we're getting great spillage on both sides of that cell. If I could give a message to anybody doubting that this is a viable format, I'd invite them to one of our station events, and then ask them if they weren't seeing people that they'd like to deliver to their advertisers. You just need to look at the MediaBase on our listeners...They make more than average money, drive high-end cars, shop in the better malls and stores, and buy records and go to concerts. And we have the college kids. It's the best audience out there. Even most of the record promoters for Modern Rock are more aware, passionate, and involved with the music. They actually care about the music they are promoting.

ANY FINAL THOUGHTS OR PLANS FOR THE FUTURE?

Clay: I think I've been very fortunate in my career to have worked at some very great radio stations, and to have had the opportunity to work with and learn from some of the best people in this business, like Larry Morgan, Guy Zapoleon, Garry Wall, Dan Vallie, and Mark S. Allen.

As far as plans go, my goals include becoming a writer. I work on it all the time at home. Radio has exposed me to such a diverse group of people and situations, that gives me lots of material. And, of course, I'm going to continue to use my position to shamelessly promote the best band on the planet, Crowded House! They kicked off their North American tour here a few weeks ago, and dropped by the station. As I stood there listening to Neil Finn sing Nails In My Feet live during my show, I just kept telling myself, "This is as good as it gets."

Let me just say that this format and this staff and this city have made radio fun and passionate and exciting again. How often these days do most people get excited about a Fed Ex package with a new record, and literally run down the hallway to get it on the air? How many PDs can say that they actually crank up their own station for entertainment? On St. Patrick's Day we broadcast on location all day from Houlihan's, the premiere spot to be on St. Pats day. It broke all records for previous year's business there. You know your station has arrived when all three local network TV affiliates do a stand-up or their weather at 6 and 10 from your promotion. You can see stars at night in Phoenix, the city is dynamic and growing, we have professional basketball, football, and soon baseball...The air smells clean and sweet at night. This is a rare place, the kind of place I've spent 16 years in radio hoping to get to be a part of. Like I said, this is as good as it gets.
