
# THE SHOW MUST GO ON

The increased traffic in the record stores brought in the all-important adult demographic along with the kids. A&M/Interscope artist Sheryl Crow continued steady at #6, thanks in large part to a well-publicized performance at the Ground Zero memorial in NYC last weekend, along with that ubiquitous AmEx commercial featuring her hit single, "Soak Up the Sun."


Added Szzydlwizksi: "Sheryl Crow is showing some real staying power. Like me on Viagra."

# **WB High-Fives The Hives**

They're the hottest thing from Sweden since meatballs. Hate to say we told you so.

Punk-garage stalwarts The Hives are bringing back the good old days of speeded-up rock & roll, with an approach that has endeared them to critics and fans alike on their current album, Veni, Vidi, Vicious.

Originally put out in Scandinavia, the U.K. and Europe by the Swedish Burning Heart label in 1999, then picked up for U.S. distribution by L.A. punk indie Epitaph in late 2000, the album ended up re-released on Sire/Warner Bros. The activity has spurred a spirited major-label bidding war that has reportedly escalated to offers of \$3 million for a U.S.-only two-album deal or \$5 million worldwide, with at least a 20% royalty rate. Whoa.

The five-piece group, with such colorful aliases as lead singer Howlin' Pelle Almqvist, Vigilante Carlstroem, Dr. Matt Destruction, Chris Dangerous and Nicholaus Arson, formed in the tiny inclustrial burg of Fagersta, Sweden, back in the mid-'90s, announcing their playful aim of conquering the world of pop music.

The Hives' initial European release, the 1996 mini-CD Oh Lord! When? How?, was followed by their '97 album debut, Barely Legal, '98's I-D-I-O-T EP and the second album, Veni, Vidi, Vicious. The group was nominated for a Swedish Grammy Award, garnered serious airplay on Swedish National Radio and won the country's award as Best Live Act of 2000.

After playing an invitational concert at Poptones UK's London club radio4, The Hives caught the ear of Poptones boss Alan McGee, who licensed the U.K. rights to distribute Your New Favourite Band: Poptones Present the Hives, from Burning Heart. The LP, a compilation of album tracks and b-sides, came out in October 2001 and promptly climbed to the top of the English indie charts.

Currently on a month-long tour of the States, which got

underway in San Diego May 26 and ends with a show in Washington, DC, June 15, the group has elicited raves from the likes of the *L.A. Times* and *USA Today*.

The first single, "Hate to Say I Told You So," has been getting major spins at leading PoMo outlets like KROQ L.A., WHFS DC, WZZN Chicago, XTRA San Diego and KITS S.F., while notching huge airplay at MTV, MTV2 and MuchMusic Canada. It's also featured on the Columbia/Roadrunner/IDJ/Sony Music Soundtrax Spider-Man soundtrack.

Warner Bros. has launched a comprehensive marketing and promotional plan, including:

- TV appearances on Conan O'Brien (6/13) and MTV2's \$2 Bill Show in Baltimore last weekend (6/2); will tape Last Call with Carson Daly (6/10) for future airing.
- Major magazine features in Alternative Press, Details, GQ, Guitur World, Rolling Stone, Spin, Vogue, Revolver, Interview, Pulse, Stuff, Teen People, Time, Blender and Entertainment Weekly.
- Album re-release with enhanced-video content.
- TV spots running on MTV2, MTV.
- "Hate to Say I Told You So" to be included on samplers for Urban Outfitters and Café Music Network.
- Offering individual online trading cards for each band member and an animated flash desktop application that fans can download for their computer desktop.
- Street teams distributing full-length copies of the album and stickers to clothing stores, restaurants, bars, tattoo shops in N.Y., L.A., San Francisco, Chicago and Toronto.

# Lew Wasserman: Last of the Old-Time Movie Moguls

Lew Wasserman, the movie mogul who ruled Hollywood with an iron fist for more than half a century, has died at age 89.

Wasserman, who had recently suffered a stroke, died Monday (6/3) at his home in Beverly Hills.

As Chairman and Chief Executive, Wasserman was the undisputed ruler of MCA. the parent of Universal Studios. He owned 6.9% of the company's stock and, through trusts, controlled more than 15%. When MCA was sold in 1990 to Matsushita for \$6.6 billion, Wasserman's take was put at \$350 million, and he was retained as a manager. When Seagram took over the company five years later, Wasserman retired with the title of Chairman Emeritus. He remained on the board of directors until 1998.

During a 59-year career at MCA, he worked with everyone from Hitchcock to Spielberg, from James Stewart to Kevin Costner.

Wasserman worked for three years at Jules Stein's Music Corporation of America, starting in 1936, before moving to Hollywood to run the optometrist-turned-showbiz mogul's new motion picture unit.

From that point, back when MCA was primarily a band-booking agency, Wasserman expanded the movie business until his client list included such greats as Clark Gable, Bette Davis and Joan Crawford. Soon after, he pioneered the concept of "packaging" his agency's talent (long before Mike Ovitz) by making one deal for a movie's writers, director and lead actors, thus commissioning as much as possible per movie.

Wasserman also pioneered the now-routine practice of negotiating percentages of a movie's profits for his clients.

In the process of expanding his power beyond that of any movie mogul before or since (notably, he reanimated Ronald Reagan's acting career and maintained a close relationship with the future President), Wasserman also expanded into television and music, transforming MCA from agency to studio.

"I'm not sure people really appreciate that he dominated this industry in a way no one else has come close to since," MPAA chief Jack Valenti (whom Wasserman anointed in 1966) told a Washington Post reporter in 1995. "What you've got to understand is, if Hollywood is Mount Olympus, Lew Wasserman is Zeus."

After his retirement seven years ago, Wasserman and wife Edie remained active fundraisers and philanthropists, notably supporting the Democratic Party and UCLA, where they endowed scholarships and funded the Edie and Lew Wasserman Eye Research Center addition to the university's Jules Stein Eye Institute.





# NEAR TRUTHS BY I.B. BAD, LOS ANGELES

Last week's Phil Q departure, while surprising few, spurred speculation among some insiders as to whether the well-liked exec might remain with AOLTW in a non-music role. What role that might be remains a mystery for now-as does the reason Q's negotiations with Warner Bros. brass didn't work out. In any other climate, free agents like Q would have little trouble making a seque, but with cost-cutting the ongoing mantra of the Big Five, high-paying packages are harder to come by. That said, as the going gets tough, will the tough get entrepreneurial?... Latest out of RAC indicates Cooper, Azoff and Guerinot's talks with label reps have broken down. RAC is said to believe the Murray bill, due out of committee June 11, will be passed. Meanwhile, word of signature gathering inside California record companies to petition Sacramento that the bill would cost the state jobs... The appointment of Edgar Bronfman Jr. to co-chair Vivendi's new corporate governance committee likely underscoring concern within the Bronfman dynasty for the

value of the family business, now a 5.3% Vivendi stake commanding roughly 60% less cash than it did at the time of the Seagram sale... Insiders saying Larry Mestel will not be let out of his Arista/BMG contract. and that EMI has moved on to NY lawver Michael Guido as David Munns' pick for N.A. ops quy... Besides already-bandied vet Neil Portnow, NARAS trustees said to be pondering names including Bill Bennett and Hale Milgrim for the top job. Could industry ambasador Phil Q also be in the mix?... With the passing of Lew Wasserman, hushed voices speaking anew of the importance of Wasserman chronicler Dennis McDougal's The Last Mogul... Many observing the brewing indie-promotion squabble wondering aloud if there isn't a way to curb indie expenses without the labels pulling out altogether-while noting that the labels must avoid even the appearance of collusion. Could a scaling-back of indie business (as opposed to cessation) lessen the threat of legal action on antitrust grounds? Some chatter involves eliminating payments to indies representing stations where a toll-taking system has been institutionalized to see if records don't go on the air anyway. Word is the indies who simply buy tollbooths in the form of "access" to stations are not perceived to have influence on airplay. Reportedly, labels aren't necessarily averse to paying indies as long as they see some kind of actual lobbying/impact. That said, who'll jump first, and to what extent?... 

Badly Drawn Boy's Damon Gough composed and performed the original soundtrack music to About a Boy, released by ArtistDirect, his first major release since the U.K. Mercury Music Prize-winning Hour of the Bewilderbeast.

Devo's Mark Mothersbaugh composed the score for Wes Anderson's The Royal Tenenbaums and two previous Anderson films, Bottle Rocket and Rushmore. The soundtrack album is available on Hollywood Records.

V2's Andy Gershon and Kate Hyman worked on the soundtrack to I Am Sam, a best-selling collection of Beatles covers, including Eddie Vedder's "You've Got to Hide Your Love Away" and The Vines' "I'm Only Sleeping," along with tracks from Nick Cave, Sheryl Crow, Ben Folds. Stereophonics, Sarah McLachlan and more.

I Am Sam director Jessie Nelson (with producer Richard Solomon) helped assemble the collection, which she produced with V2 A&R execs Hyman and John Sidel.

Randall Poster is the Music Supervisor for Wes Anderson's films, as well as Jesus' Son, Rounders, Velvet Goldmine, I Shot Andy Warhol, Kids and Meet the Parents.

Chris, why did you and your brother select Damon of Badly Drawn Boy for the About a Boy soundtrack?


Chris Weitz: A friend of mine turned me on to Badly Drawn Boy. For a year, I listened to the album somewhat compulsively, as you do when you think you've found the next great thing. His lyrics have a wonderful oblique quality that I just thought was very clever. Paul and I had become tired of the "compilation record" aspect of modern soundtracks. We were trying to emulate Simon & Garfunkel's music for The Graduate. We thought it would be better to have one person do it. I played Hour of the Bewilderbeast for my brother, and he fell in love with it, too. We just sorta got this idea in our heads that we would do this, and it was a bit of a pipe dream at the time, because we didn't think the studio would agree to it. Then we talked to [book author] Nick Hornby, and he kind of did a double take. He said, "That's bizarre, because I was going to go behind your back to try to get some songs from Badly Drawn Boy for the movie."

We met Damon's managerial people, then we went to see him at the Albert Hall in London. We had a few meetings with him, which were tenuous at first. I'm sure he wondered if we were just a couple of dickheads from Hollywood. He's an extraordinarily hard-working guy and very prolific. Anytime things didn't quite fit, he'd go back and write more. He'd get tapes of scenes in rough, and came down to the set a couple of times. It was a wonderful throwback to an earlier period in moviemaking, where you had these sort of collaborations.



Universal was faced with a soundtrack that was completely composed by this one guy. There was a little moment of hesitation about the whole thing. But we stuck to our guns. Damon Gough: I was touring the States and people kept mentioning the project. I had spoken to the Weitz brothers before I toured America. They called me at home and we had a conference call. I became too intrigued to pass on it. I'd read Nick Hornby's book...well, at least half of it. I was asked to get involved in the early stages to represent the story through the music. I started to get a good feeling about the project.

Randall, can you describe your Job as music supervisor for The Royal Tenenbaums.

Randall Poster: The music supervisor helps to establish a vocabulary that the primary participants can share in referencing music. And then, the other goal is to just help define the musical logic of the movie. Sometimes that can take place by connecting sounds; sometimes it can be by connecting a musical legacy; sometimes by drawing either contrast or confluence in a musical arrangement and style.

What do you make of the success of the O Brother, Where Art Thou? soundtrack?

Poster: I think every flat-picker in America will be signed to a major label by the end of the month. A movie like that, any time there is a new idea, I applaud it.

Andy Gershon: The role of the soundtrack has evolved. The O Brother, Where Art Thou? soundtrack is an example. If you care about bluegrass music, that's the record to buy. Forget about the fact that it happens to be the soundtrack to a great movie.

Jessie, when you began working on the screenplay for I Am Sam, did you already have specific Beatles' songs in mind? Jessie Nelson: I'd placed 12 songs in the script, and I was pretty naïve, to be honest, thinking all 12 would be sung by The Beatles, not realizing how sensitive it is to get the publishing to agree to allow me to use them, let alone have The Beatles singing them. Some of the songs shifted once we were in the cutting room. Different songs would replace what I had, or new ones worked perfectly. For me, the writing is about capturing the mood and the feeling you want to capture in a scene, and how a song can take it even further, or heighten it. Usually I do it more through the writing than the actor. Sean [Penn] suggested "You've Got to Hide Your Love Away" months before when we were thinking of The Beatles singing everything. It wasn't like it was premeditated that we'd end up with Eddie Vedder.

How were the songs selected for the film and the soundtrack?

Nelson: Most of the songs had been in the screenplay. We'd try some songs in editing, asking, "What would work here?" "The Two of Us" or "Across the Universe"? We would throw different songs up against the movie. And then once we had chosen the nine that seemed to resonate the most, some were obvious. Like Sean's baby—was she going to be called Julia, Lucy, Rita or Prudence?

Kate Hyman: The agenda was for each of us to call our favorite artists. Andy and I both love Nick Cave, so that's why he's on the record.

Gershon: We tried to come up with artists we loved and cast the songs that would be appropriate for those particular artists, and kept our fingers crossed. The managers and artists were incredibly supportive once they saw the movie and found out what it was about. No's turned very quickly into yeses.

Hyman: With the bigger artists, sometimes the hardest part is getting it by the record label that has that artist. But the artists we used seem to be big enough that they and their management had enough clout to get their labels to agree.

How did you decide which songs heard in the movie *I Am Sam* wouldn't make the soundtrack? And vice versa? Hyman: With this album, so many people got excited and involved that we had several artists we had to tell, "You can do a song, and if it's not in the movie, it'll be on the record.' Several did not end up on the record, so that was real difficult.

Nelson: It's a really tricky dance directors have to do between the record company needs and their needs as filmmakers. Sometimes you're lucky enough to have somebody like Andy who says the movie is the priority, and we'll make the soundtrack around the movie. And then

sometimes you have other people who say, "Look, if you want the soundtrack, you have to make these specific compromises." It's a dance you do, and hopefully you don't have to give up too much to get what you need.

Damon, did you wonder how your fans might react to you writing songs for a movie?

Gough: Hopefully, most of them will see it as a huge video promo for my music. I've always set my own agenda and made my own decisions. From the early part of my career, I was always pissing someone off, whether it be a live show that was too long, or messing around onstage. I'm just having fun. I just thought, "Well, someone is spending a hell of a lot of money to put out my music here in this film." The Weitz brothers were completely supportive. It was a long shot for them to think I could do the soundtrack, but I immediately understood why they'd asked me. It's less about the music that I write and more about the way that I approach it. There's a song in the soundtrack, "Something to Talk About," which I knew everybody would be happy with because it used the phrase "about a boy." I managed to sneak in a line unobtrusively, which I quite like. I'm a big fan of subtlety. Sequencing the soundtrack album was the hardest bit. Like the first track, "Exit Stage Right," is my favorite moment.

What's the best way for the composer to work with a director and music supervisor?

Mark Mothersbaugh: I've always looked at music supervisors as being unnecessary, meddlesome and overcredited. You have to try to understand everybody's motivations. The most important thing for me is helping a director achieve his vision.

Randall, as a music supervisor, how did you go about dealing with getting music from the estates of Nico and Nick Drake for *The Royal Tenebaums* soundtrack?

Randall Poster: There's no hard and fast rule. Sometimes [getting songs from artists who have passed away] makes it more complicated, sometimes simpler. There are all sorts of complications. Sometimes the artists don't have any control of the process at all. We've licensed from some of the most notoriously difficult people. That's why we really try to get in there early, so we know where we stand, and we're relentless.

Have there been situations where labels lean for the inclusion of their own artists on the soundtrack?

Poster: As for as the *Rushmore* and *Tenenbaums* soundtracks, I had plenty of interaction with the label who put them out. They really responded to the material; I don't think they would try to force something in that didn't make sense.

Is it more complicated in 2002 to secure songs for movies and soundtracks?

Poster: Yes. Conglomerations. Fewer owners. The proliferation of songs in commercials. It raises people's expectations as far as money goes. And there's more competition for songs. [More producers] see the opportunity, tying in with music to promote their movie, or music being an ancillary form of income. With certain pop artists, there's a lot of competition, so that raises the price.

What kind of marketing initiatives did V2 undertake to bring I Am Sam to the attention of consumers?

Gershon: We did screenings with radio stations, retail and press. New Line was incredibly supportive, from booking theaters to making sure prints were there for us to screen the movie to set up the album. Because we felt that if people reacted to the movie the same way that we did and the same way the artists did that, again it comes back to that's our strongest marketing tool.

Nelson: When we were doing the soundtrack, everyday we would have a conference call between my producer, Erin Cully at New Line, myself and Andy and his team, John Sidel and Kate Hyman. We would say, "OK. We've got 'You Got to Hide Your Love Away.' What voice can knock it out of the ballpark?" "Eddie Vedder." "OK." "How do we get to Eddie Vedder?" It was literally that way song by song. We would make a list of our first few choices, and they never forced us to use anyone we didn't want to use. V2 was so supportive in getting people, and fought just as hard for those people on other labels as for the artists on the V2 label. So they were really committed to doing what was right for the movie. Sean [Penn] got a beautiful letter from Paul McCartney after he saw the movie telling Sean that he was angry at Sean because he'd given his girlfriend a sinus

infection because she was crying so hard when she saw the movie and how much they loved it. How deeply they were moved by it. And the same thing with Yoko Ono's camp.

How do you go about collaborating with record companies in constructing soundtrack albums?

Poster: I'm always open to working with the label and the A&R person. There are certain labels and executives that don't want to see one of their bands, if they're working a record, or a single, to have a distraction, or have it available anywhere else. Then, there are other people who feel any exposure that they can get for this artist they're going to take. So I'm not going to be that precious about it. The growing trend is that there are very few career artists. They need every opportunity to expose the band to whatever audience that might not be reached otherwise through a movie.

Weitz: About a Boy was a dream. We had a great time working with the music supervisors. We were completely in league with the artist and the artists' label, and we made it under the radar; otherwise it's a very tricky and frustrating

process. Because the record label views your movie as an ad for their record, I'm inclined to view the record as an advertisement for the movie. You've got two completely different agendas. And it comes down to what Faustian bargain you work out.

The problem is, the movie people don't understand anything about the music industry, and that's true of me—I have no idea what is going on. It's an entirely different set of jargon and standards, and I hope we get to keep on doing what we did on this film, which is to work with single artists, people who know exactly what to do from the beginning. If I have to do a compilation album again, I'm gonna have to educate myself about the way the music industry works. Gershon: The problem with soundtracks is that they take up a tremendous amount of time, resources and money. And to me, that money and time is much better spent developing an artist that could have a really long career, rather than developing an album that you hope the movie studio doesn't screw up. If the movie tanks the first weekend, your soundtrack is history.

this week!... Congrats yet again to PD Scott Arbough and Team KBCO on another spectacular trend, 6.8-7.9 (!!), ranking them once again #1 in Denver 12+!!! In a related story, KBCO owner Clear Channel has arranged for Santa Fe APM KBAC to swap signals with Classic Rocker KLSK. The new stick, according to PD Ira Gordon, "is one of the 10 strongest signals in America"

and will give them full Albuquerque coverage. Clearly the nation's biggest radio company is beginning to recognize the value of having

Plant, under the guidance of Universal's Suzanne Perl, picked up WXRT, KINK, WDET, KGSR, WXRV and others... Badly Drawn Boy's Amoeba Records in-store was the new Hollywood outlet's biggest event yet. Jay Bennett & Edward Burch The Palace at 4am (Pt.1) (Undertow): Unlike most neoclassic popsters, multi-instrumentalist/studio geek Bennett understands the importance of layering his hooky elements atop propulsive grooves, and this visceral aspect causes the heady arrangements to come alive on his first post-Wilco project. The LP is an explosion of ear candy, starting with

the impossibly dense "Puzzle Heart," in which Bennett's smoky baritone meshes with new partner Burch's sweet tenor amid Tijuana brass and Badfinger-like dual slide guitars. At nearly 70 minutes, the LP's as broad as it is deep—apparently, Bennett had a lot to get off his chest—but catharsis never sounded any more appealing than it does on this gloriously excessive record. (B.S)

Bryan Ferry, Frantic (Virgin): Energized by last summer's Roxy Music reunion, the stylish crooner revisits his past as a solo artist and lead vocalist for the art-rock pioneers. His two Dylan covers, "It's All Over Now, Baby Blue" and the piano-and-vocal "Don't Think Twice," would sound at home on These Foolish Things and 1999's As Time Goes By, respectively. Old cohort Eno



joins in on the ode to Marilyn Monroe, "Goddess of Love," evoking Avalon and Duran Duran's "Hungry Like a Wolf," Radiohead's Jonny Greenwood contributes to "Hiroshima," a tribute to director Alain Resnais' art film, while "San Simeon" is a sequel to the Orson Welles homage, "In Every Dream Home a Heartache." (R.T.)



The Waxwings Shadows of... (Bobsled): Like any '60s-fixated indie-pop band, the Detroit-based Waxwings have the requisite moves—the jangle, the drone, the psychedelic phasing, the clattering Ringo drums—down cold. Happily, these guys don't stop there, favoring snowballing momentum (most compellingly exemplified by the whisper-to-scream "Almost All Day") while adorn-

ing their Nuggets lifts with genteel strings and emphatic horns. Their skill at mixing and matching results in some surprising hybrids, like the Simon & Garfunkelon-mushrooms "Look Down Darkly" and the high-contrast "Fractured," which sounds like a battle of the bands between Iron Butterfly and the Association. Kull. Props to Chicago-based indie Bobsled (Chamber Strings, Velvet Crush, etc.), whose logo has become an earmark of smart-pop quality. (B.S.)

Tommy Lee, Never a Dull Moment (MCA): Back when Crue shows had upside-down drum solos and a quart of Mickey's cost \$1.50, most rockers were saying stuff like, "Damn, that dummer's rad." Now that the man inside all those tattoos is producing his own material, some are saying stuff like, "as a singer, he makes a good drummer." But don't listen to them. Listen to the



grind and drive of tracks like "Hold Me Down" and "Body Architects," twitching with otherworldly syntheticism. Noteworthy detail: Lee dedicates the album to his two sons while also getting off a little shotski on mom Pamela by thanking Kid Rock "for taking '@#\$%^' off my hands." It's still rock 'n' roll, dude. (J.O.)





God, he is a fine man. They killed it, of course... Saturday afternoon, went to a birthday brunch at the Beverly Hills Hotel for Kathy Hughes. It was a really good time. Highlights? Eating lunch next to Smokey Robinson and James Ingram; Tank's fine ass wanting to know my name; a performance by new RCA artist Heather Healey, which basically blew the entire audience away; and, of course, Derrick, who escorted me and was everything a girl could ever ask for in a date. Thanks, Jodi Williams, for the invite... Sunday was back to the Lakers at Belly again, where Amon Parker was determined to get himself and everyone around him drunk and silly. Gary Marella showed up looking fabulous after spending a couple of days working in Hawaii (nice tan, hon). And, of course, Derrick came through with his fine ass. I directed most of my excitement at him when the Lakers wiped Sacramento's butt. All in all, a cute weekend... Records? Do we have to? Lots of big gains at Crossover this week...and thankfully so. We need the action. Biggest gainers? Truth Hurts, Cam'ron, Nelly, Big Tymers, Eminem, Diddy and Tweet. Let's start with Joe and Cord at Elektra, who are killing it with Tweet. How can you not see the Verizon commercial with "Call Me" all in it? It's everywhere. A brilliant job on the label's part. The single is entertaining consistent gains every week and should be Top 10 in no time. They also have something with this Angie Martinez track, which is already huge

at WZMX, PWR 96, WXYV, HOT 97, WWKX, KXJM and KBOS. Watch this grow and spread fast... Motown's on a roll, specifically with new artist Jene (pronounced "Jenny"). The single, "Get Into Something," is already pulling Top 10 phones at KSFM after three days and immediate phones at WLLD. This is a reactive record! You will deal with this. I'm confident. Look for Jene at the Crossover panel during the R&R convention. Kedar plans to have damn near his whole roster at an event he's hosting that week... Arista's on fire with Clipse. "Grindin'" is already huge in N.Y., Baltimore, Philly, Charlotte, Greensboro, Atlanta and San Francisco. This is one of the hottest street/mix records out right now and it is translating into regular rotation... Speaking of,

Amerie is becoming a monster. Look at the airplay on this baby: WXYV 46x, WCHH 46x, KMEL 43x, WPHI 40x, KSFM 40x, WPGC 38x, HOT 97 25x, KBMB 25x, WERQ 25x and I can go on, but I'll run out of space. You get the picture, though. Lisa and staff at Columbia are juggling alotta shit right now, and it looks like they could get them all. Wyclef's a slow build, but will be solid when it gets there. Mary Mary is developing at Urban mainstream. And two of my favorite records are already setting up nicely: Lil' Flip's "The Way We Ball" is growing in the South and Beyonce's "Work It Out" is piquing just about everyone's curiosity... J Records will deliver this Mario record. I was a little concerned at first because I didn't feel or see enough of him. But now that they've secured a solid rotation at BET (#7 on the playlist and #1 at 106 and Park) and a commitment from MTV, I'm already feeling the heat. Just look at the airplay gains. This is directly correlated to the video getting bumped. "Just a Friend 2002" will be big. Side note—doesn't he look like a mini-Chris Rock? Ron Gillyard sent me a couple of upcoming projects that will be hot for them: Monica's "All Eyez On Me," which samples MJ's "PYT"; Lyric's "Young and Sexy," which features Loon; and Joi Cambell's "Keeping it Movin'," which is so my anthem. All should be big for the company... Marella is on fire with Big Tymers. Look for a huge record from Lil' Wayne coming soon. And I just heard a Tank single that I actually love... Epic's making more ground with B2K's smash "Gots Ta Be." If you're not playing this record yet, you're an absolute idiot... And Coppola's sitting on a time bomb with new artist Yasmeen. "Blue Jeans" sounds like a hit. Already on at KXJM, KBMB, HOT 97 and Z90... K... SINGLE: Best Man's "I See You." ALBUM: DJ Rogers. VIDEO: Irv Gotti Presents. PERSON: Derrick Taylor. LOVE: Me. Hit me at eliz0315@aol.com. Never forget.

Prior to shifting the focus of our weekly MVP spotlight to those expe-

riencing good Spring ARBs, we've got one last congratulatory look back at a huge success from the recently completed Winter book. After all, it doesn't get much bigger than being #1, and that's exactly the market position inhabited by PD Erik Johnson and KQCH in Omaha. For P12+, the station moves 6.0 to 7.2 while enjoying Top 5 W25-54 numbers AND maintaining it's #1 rank with W18-34, as well—a ranking Channel 977 has enjoyed non-stop since the Fall book of 2000. "The station stays true to its female target and is positioned as 'Omaha's Hit Music.' This allows us to not be pigeonholed as an outlet playing strictly Hip-Hop and R&B, and permits the audience to define us for themselves" said Johnson while reflecting on the station's continuing success. "That way, we have some flexibility to move the station one way or another depending on the music out at the moment. And right now, the music is really working for us." Conversely, at HITS, we're really tired of working in general right now, so this week's MVP shout ends immediately....

Been catching up on some music listening, and have to tell you that my current favorite album is definitely this Remy Shand record on Motown. It's great mood music that you really don't fully appreciate until you can sit down

Hit, hit, hit... Very alarmed to see that the FCC is now handing out indecency fines to radio stations regardless of whether or not the person or entity filing the complaint has any actual proof of what they claim to have heard. That's a complete turnaround from the position they've held for my entire career in this business. So, did I just start living in another country, or is the American system now based on the premise of quilty until proven innocent??... A note to Pop-leaning Rhythm stations: Please check out how Columbia's Marc Anthony album did not fall apart in its second week out as most of you had predicted. Rather, it remains firmly entrenched in the Top 10 on this week's sales chart, clearly indicating that the "I Got You" single is having a significant impact in the marketplace. Remember how big "I Need to Know" was for you previously? This could be the same kind of thing. Also, Lisa Ellis' Wyclef record picks up an add at VH1 this week that can only help the project along as well... Another record I've recently heard that sounds pretty good is Epic's "I See You" by Best Man. It's some nice Urban-flavored tempo for the season. Meanwhile, Klaiman, Pokora, Lieberman and Prince Ice also continue to artfully deliver B2K to the masses via new adds on "Gots ta Be" this week at WNVZ and WDHT. Kudos to all on a job well-done with this talented group... Also wanna congratulate Rick Sackheim and the Arista crew for the great head of steam they're building behind Lady May, including adds last week at WLLD, WNVZ, KPRR, WZBZ and WOCQ and an add this week at WQSL. Then, factor into the mix the Top 5 phones story coming out of WHZT, and it's starting to look like this might be one, for sure. And, oh yeah, can I tell you how psyched I am that "Can U Help Me" is the next Usher single? It's long been my ultimate pick off the CD and is certain to be another #1. Just remember—SKIN TO WIN in the video, guys... Finally, while I'm handing out congratulations, I can't overlook Capitol and what they're doing with Dirty Vegas. It's having a great run (including being the #1 song currently on the dance chart), and the group now scores a booking on The Tonight Show June 12—just over a week after the full-length hits the streets. Hmmmm... Think the combination of a smash single and Leno will move some CDs? Bet on it... And finally, props to KOHT/KRQQ PD Mark Medina for scoring the KZZP PD gig—once again demonstrating that the best career move he ever made was deciding not to work for me back in the day at KISV in Bakersfield. I do have to credit Mark, though, for making me understand the critical nature of having a dance music component in the overall sound of a Rhythm station in California's San Joaquin Valley. That insight gleaned during his interview was key to the station's ultra-successful launch in the late '90s..., And that's another edition of random thoughts. Until next week—C-ya!

With a really strong add week, Larry Khan and Craig Davis are off to a great start with this record. Jive is also doing very well with "Automatic,"

I'm happy to see that it's still possible for records to do those kinds of numbers! As if having the #1 album weren't enough, Interscope also has the #1 single with Truth Hurts. Can you say HOT?... Another artist making some very interesting videos is Cee-Lo. I thought "Closet Freak" was an amazing video and "Gettin' Grown" is a great follow-up. The single is in rotation at WPEG and WFXE and is generating some strong interest. Arista has some great records out right now! The Isyss single "Day & Night" has been growing steadily across the country. WAJZ, WERO, WBLK, WBLS, WUSL, WPHR, WIIZ, WWWZ, WWDM. WPWX, KPRS, WEAS, KBXX, WJMI and KIPR are just some of the stations rotating this record in double digits. The Clipse is flying up the chart with their single, "Grindin" but can we expect anything less from the Neptunes? Not to mention CC's plate is also piled high with P. Diddy's "I Need A Girl" (Part Two), featuring Loon, Mario Winans, and Tammy Rugieri, as well as "You Know That I Love You" by Donnell Jones. You go, girl!... I saw the Jerzee Monet video this weekend, too, and it made me like the song even more. She looks great and she has a great message. This song is so positive, and it has a great sound for summer. Garnett March is doing a great job, getting over 800 spins and growing. DreamWorks also has a real shot with this Swizz Beatz single, "Guilty"... Ruff Endz, "Someone To Love You." After I don't know how many months I still love this song! Epic has done such an incredible job with this record—they have over 1300 spins and it's still growing in a lot of markets. FYI, the album's hot, too. Dave McPherson has put out some great music over there. 5.) Cam'ron, "Oh Boy." What can I say? This record is another slam-dunk for the Roc-A-Fella/Def Jam machine. Oops—wait a minute. I know I said five, but I have six: 6.) Black Coffey, "Hard To Get." I told Michael Johnson that I think this record is a sleeper summer hit for Motown... That's all for me! I want to send a special thank you to Caroline Almeida, Myeshi Adams, Carol Dorsey and Erica at F-Filmz and definitely Aaron Courseault. Hi Lauren Wirtzer and Gita Williams!




Every major U.S. retail account is applauding Interscope's Candace Berry and staff for their nimble reaction to the rampant downloading of Eminem's new album by twice changing the release date, then handling street-date violations with common sense rather than finger-pointing and accusations. Trans World's Jerry Kamiler echoes the feelings of many in the industry who believe that moving the street date was the right thing to do: "We're at war with piracy. It's a unique time that calls for a unique set of circumstances. And as much frustration as it caused at the store level. it was worth it." Most retailers concede that this was an extraordinary circumstance, with Eminem the most downloaded record in history. Should the upcoming Korn release have also been moved? Downloading is said to be rampant, and at least one retailer complained to us off the record. "This should have been out a month ago." Kamiler agrees the downloading problem could be costing him sales. But there is a big difference

between moving a street date and breaking it. He cautions: "It's taken years to educate the industry itself, not just the consumer, that street dates are to be taken seriously. If every record becomes a special circumstance, it's a prototype for anarchy"... Insiders tell us UMVD is sending a letter to one-stops next week listing a new set of requirements to stay in business with the marketshare leader. Last year, UMVD stopped doing business with some 20 onestops and added another dozen to that list last month. The new caveats include honoring all UMVD policies, particularly in relation to returns on defective product. Finally, there will be new "enhanced" credit requirements to be met. UMVD currently does business with around 50 onestops, half of them Latin wholesalers... Virgin Entertainment's Vince Szydlowski is expanding his purchasing department in the company's HQ with the hiring of highly regarded Jerry Suarez as Sr. Product Mgr. Jerry is bestknown for working under Ron Phillips at Valley Media. He replaces Dave Carlin, who takes over as Dir. of Inventory Mgmt. Szydlowski says they should be naming Urban, Classical, Jazz & Rock/Pop Product Managers within the next two weeks, all reporting to Suarez.






