



#### A&M Cuts 25 Jobs

In what is being termed a "consolidation" and "staff reduction," A&M has eliminated 25 jobs.


According to Sr. VP/General Manager Al Cafaro: "In an effort to ready ourselves for the competitive realities of the modern day record business, we made the very difficult decision to reduce the size of our staff. This has been the next step in a transition that has been ongoing for the past six months. It is certainly painful, but we are confident about the ultimate results."

The label retained the services of an outplacement service for displaced employees and workshops have been offered in reentering the job market. In addition, career counseling has been made available to long-term employees whose positions were eliminated.

An A&M spokesperson stressed that the company will remain a free-standing, full-service label and will not be integrated into parent company PolyGram.

The spokesperson noted that no further cuts are expected.

they were gonna take a bath. Added Coleman, "Of course, we still support the First Amendment and we wish **Luther Campbell** all the best in his future artistic and legal endeavors." In other words, this threatened to be the biggest pay-per-view bomb since female mudwrestling.

Among those on the ballot who didn't receive the necessary votes were Johnny Cash, Bobby "Blue" Bland, Elmore James, Gene Vincent, the Yardbirds, the Moonglows, Duane Eddy, Frankie Lyman & the Teenagers and GWAR.

#### Quick Interscope Goes East/West Paul Is Bored

Interscope Records. joint venture formed by entertainment industry vet Ted Field and producer Jimmy lovine has pacted with Atlantic Records to own and operate the company, which will be distributed through East/West America, a division of the Time Warner label. The announcement was made by Field and Atlantic Chief Operating Officer Doug Morris.

Field is chairman of Interscope Communications, a film and television production company which has produced such box office successes as "Three Men and A Baby" and "Cocktail." Iovine is the producer of multi-platinum albums by U2, Tom Petty & the Heartbreakers and others.

Said Steven J. Ross. Time Warner Inc. Chairman and co-CEO: "We want to build this label up to the point where we can sell it for some incredibly inflated price to the Japanese and make a healthy profit."

Atlantic's CEO Ahmet Ertegun and Doug Morris commented, "And if the Japanese don't want it, you know the Germans'll ante up."

"I've always wanted my own record company," said Field. "I sing in the shower all the time."

Interscope will have its own A&R, promotion and publicity departments. Its first release is scheduled for early 1991.



#### ON RECORDS By Lenny Beer

#### What? No Hits!!

**LEADING:** The dichotomy between the records Top 40 radio is airing and the records the public is buying has never been so clearly illustrated as in today's marketplace. Nearly half of the nation's Top 50 selling albums have no hit record leading the sales!! While Top 40 can create a mega-seller like SBK's Vanilla Ice, the public is obviously using different means than just Top 40 airplay to find their music, making a strong case for the power of labels' marketing departments, multi-format game plans and the exploitation of press, touring, and video play in the marketing mix.

INSIDE THE TOP TEN: Starting with the #4 seller, Atco's AC/DC, we will take a look at key factors contributing to today's rapidly changing sales environment. Credit AC/DC's success to video play, Album Radio play (yes, this band has been around long enough to join the classic mix and get real play), press and word-of-mouth, as well as night rotation play at many Top 40s on the elpee cut. Garth Brooks (Capitol) is now the biggest country sales star (while Randy Travis (WB), Reba McEntire (MCA) and more continue to sell up a storm), but is receiv-

HALF HAVE NO SINGLE ing absolutely no crossover attention. Paul Simon and ZZ Top, both just out on WB, are both selling Top Ten, based on press awareness, track record and video support, but neither has even released a single to date.

OUTSIDE THE TOP TEN: The Vaughan Bros. (Epic) has been selling extremely well for a month now, mainly on track record, video and press exposure to the Stevie Ray Vaughan tragedy. Radio (Top 40 and Adult), which has adopted a wait-and-see posture to date, is just now seriously coming to the party. Heavy metal winners by Queensrÿche (EMI) and Iron Maiden (Epic) lead a slew of headbanging chart sellers without singles exposure. On the rap front, Too Short (Jive/RCA), LL Cool J (Columbia) and (Priority) continue to do strong business without Top 40 aid. Add to this the incredible sales success of the new Led Zeppelin box set (Atlantic), the kinky stylings of the **Twin Peaks** soundtrack (WB) and the traditional folk sound of the Indigo Girls (Epic) and you've got an American public looking for far more diversity than they are receiving from today's Top 40 programmers.







President Hale Milgrim: "Jean is an inspiration, an extraordinary motivational force, and as soon as someone points her out to me, I'm gonna tell her that face to face."




Jean Riggins: Does she like mosquitos?








"It's Brazilian rhythms, West African guitar stylings." That's how Paul Simon describes "The Rhythm of the Saints," his new album and, as the follow-up to the much-lauded 1986 release "Graceland," the latest entry in his log of World Beat travels. It's a long way from "Mrs. Robinson" and "The Sounds of Silence" — this time, Simon's explorations take him to South America, where he picks up a batch of eerie, haunting beats, over which he lays melodies that harken back to some of the material on "Graceland," only to discover new ground unlike anywhere he's traveled before. Will it sell, and will it win more Grammys for the veteran troubadour and erstwhile partner of Art Garfunkel? Who cares? It's good music, adventurous and bold, and Simon — who's still rhymin' on "Rhythm" was only too happy to trace his latest musical journey with HITS' own crazy-after-all-theseyears journeyman, Gary Graff.

The switch from the South African sound of "Graceland" to the Brazilian orientation of "Rhythm of the Saints" is a change of direction, but there are various cultural and musical connections between the two continents, aren't there? That's so. The connection between West African culture, Brazil, the Caribbean and the U.S. is something that started 400 years ago with the slaves and the African diaspora. But I got into it because of some collaborating I did with Milton Nascimento in the summer of '87. He asked me to sing with him on an album, he was recording in L.A., so I went out there and did the sessions, and afterwards we were just kind of standing around in the parking lot, late at night, and he said, "You have to come to Brazil." | told him, "I'd like to come down. I'd like to hear some drumming." Why drumming?

It was because of a few things. There was something Quincy Jones had said to me — that the

great singers come from South Africa, but the great drummers come from West Africa. Then I was working on a musical, and one of the musicians I was involved with was Eddie Palmieri. He told me that the drums from West Africa went to Brazil. then into the Caribbean and so forth. He told me the great polyrhythmic drumming society of the world is Cuba. That was his opinion. So I knew there was this route the drum had taken, so when Milton said to come down to Brazil, I knew I wanted to hear what traditional drums sounded like there, with Brazilian percussionists. A great deal of their drumming

has a religious connection.
That's right. That's why the album's called "The Rhythm of the Saints." Because the slaves were prohibited to worship in their own religions, they correlated their deities with Catholic saints. Their masters allowed them to

deity may have been. Those religions are still active and vital in Brazil, Puerto Rico and Cuba. How did you decide to combine the Brazilian rhythms with West African quitar?

Through a friend of musicians that Hugh Masekela knew, I was introduced to Vincent Nguini, a guitarist from Cameroon who was living in Washington, D.C. and we began to work together. I'd bring the drum tracks up from Brazil, Vincent would listen to them and put in his West African guitar style. Six months later, I'd go back down to Brazil and get some more drum tracks, This wasn't my main project at the time. I was working on a musical.

What's that about?

It's a Puerto Rican story, a true story that starts in Puerto Rico in the '40s and continues in New York in the '50s and '60s. I won't go into it any further, because I'm a good eight months away from picking it up again. The whole conception of the songs on "Rhythm of the

Saints" seems different from the normal way of doing things in pop and rock.

It's not a typical singer/songwriter mode of operation, but it's not an uncommon rock & roll approach. Many bands cut a groove track, then write a song over it. That's been going on for you used from Brazil?
Olodum comes from Salvador and Bahia in the north of Brazil. It's a group of 14 drummers — ten bass and four snare drums. There's no studio where they live; we recorded the group right in the streets with an eight-track we brought up. We had micro-

decades. I did the same thing, but with Brazilian drum tracks.

It's really not any harder than the other way. It took a little bit of practice to make it feel right, but now I'm more comfortable doing it that way than sitting down with a guitar and making up a song. When the rhythm track is right, I know if I write a good song over it, I'll have a decent record. The other way if I wrote the song first — you have to wonder if you're going to cut a really good track to go with it. It's very frustrating to write a song you like and not make a good track, I've done that.

Who are these drum groups

phones on telephone poles and the backs of chairs while the band played. The video I did with them [for the first single, "The Obvious Child"] was shot in the old square in Salvador where the record was made.

The Uakti group was from Milton Nascimento's state. They're classically trained. There are four in the group. They studied at the University of Salvador and two of them were members of the philharmonic in Bahia. They were minimalists, more influenced by Philip Glass than by African music. They combined folkloric textures with minimalist thinking.

success of "Graceland," did you feel any pressure making "The Rhythm of the Saints"? No. I never feel that pressure. I didn't feel any intimidation because of "Graceland." That record made things easier — the Brazilian musicians were eager to record and everybody thought, "Oh, great, it'll be like made them much more accepting to work with me.
Is the satisfaction of projects like this and "Graceland" in the artistic accomplishment rather than the commercial fortunes?

Graceland." I had to hasten to tell them, not necessarily. You never know how it's going to turn out. But everyone had heard of "Graceland," which flop, but it's not influencing the musical decisions I'm making. I'm just not going to be making music in the mainstream of pop right now. That's not the kind of music I want to make. I don't really care to program a drum track and sing over it. It's not that I think those records are bad—but I wouldn't feel comfortable with it. I did it once with "Cars are Cars," and I didn't like it. It felt weird to me not to have a drummer back there.

So what is it you're after now? Essentially, I'm looking for elements I was familiar with and enjoyed listening to when I was a kid — the grooves, the guitar sounds. South African guitar sounds like early r&b records to me. These percussion sounds from Brazil are like something strange from Louisiana — my brain goes to Louisiana when I hear them, and that's because Louisiana was influenced by the Caribbean.

You've commented before this is an album that takes some time and repeated listenings to fully appreciate.

Well, when people first heard "Graceland," they thought it was odd, too. When I was first making this record and playing it for people, they liked it, but they weren't really sure. There's often a resistance to something that's new, that feels strange. Then it seeps in and you love it.

I would hope people would be attracted to "The Rhythm of the Saints" on the first listen. I wouldn't expect you to get it that quickly, but it's not like I intended it to be a challenge or an obstacle for people. I hope it's intellectually stimulating without being essentially American rhythms. I anticipate that this record will do better around the world. I'm hoping it's got enough on the first listen so that people like it, but when you go back, you get it even more Part of the difference in that there's a different type of dynamic at work here, even different from the stuff on "Graceland." It's different than a trap drum set, that's true. It definitely had an effect on the way I wrote. There's a hypnotic quality to this kind of drumming that made the songs more dreamlike and less linear, musically and lyrically. That was

coming, anyway. That was happening on "Graceland." I tried to make this album a really southern hemisphere record. It's less urban. It's got more nature in it. You can feel the heat, the drums, the wood and the skin, that acoustic of sound.

In the lyrics, there's much more

playing with the language rather than presenting direct thoughts, which can make things intriguing, but also difficult to grasp.

I'm always talking about something. If we're talking about a reasonably intelligent person who listens to the song and says, "I don't know what he's talking about," then I haven't done my job. That's not what I intended. But there should be enough pleasure to be gotten from the music — the rhythm of the drums or the sound of the words — even if the meaning isn't perfectly clear.

You're planning to tour for this album.

I am. I'm going to go out with a big band, about 17 musicians. There will be four percussionists from Brazil, Vincent Nguini, some musicians from the "Graceland" tour, and some American musicians, like Richard Tee and Steve Gadd. The material will be the whole spectrum — from Simon & Garfunkel up to "The Rhythm of the Saints."

Do the new methods of working you've adopted on "Graceland" and "The Rhythm of the Saints" change the way you look at or perform the older songs?

Sometimes you can find a different way to do them that makes them feel right. There are a great many songs I haven't done in a long time, so I'll see. I enjoyed singing "Still Crazy After All These Years," on the 15th anniversary of "Saturday Night Live." Mostly, I try not to be judgmental about the stuff in the past, which I can't change anyway. I'm a critical person, and I'd rather be a little forgiving about stuff I did when I was young. \*\*

Pylon, "Chain" (Sky): After a series of showcase gigs, Pylon pleased many fans distressed at their untimely demise by recording their first album in almost eight years. Longtime a fixture on the Athens, GA. scene, Pylon's quirky rhythm based songs were critically regarded as innovative, with Vanessa

Briscoe Hay's vocals soaring above the groove. The new album serves as a testimony to Pylon's influence on many a band and with "Sugarpop," produced by Scott Litt, they will hopefully get the recognition and success they've long deserved.

Sisters of Mercy, "Vision Thing" (Elektra): Does anybody besides me think it's hysterical that Jim Steinman produced the lead track, "More," from the Sister's latest? Since the other Sister, Patricia Morrison left the band, could that be Karla Devito on backing vocals? "Vision Thing" is a calculated attempt



at mining the ground broken by the Cult, etc. but to Andrew Eldritch's credit, the Sisters of Mercy launched the HITS PoMo section, and you can expect "Vision Thing" to launch the band into the nether reaches of fame and fortune.



Soho, "Goddess" (Atco): There was no way of escaping Soho's PoMo crossover smash "Hippychick." Regardless of where you were, the opening riff, borrowed from the Smith's "How Soon Is Now" was everywhere. For those who relegated Soho to the school of one hit wonders, guess again. Fronted by

Jacqueline and Pauline, twin sisters from the UK, this is the most intelligent, anti-racist, anti-sexist and enjoyable dance/pop record since Neneh Cherry's debut. "Freaky" is a great place to start, but there are a zillion other treats to be found.

Various Artists, "Red, Hot + Blue" (Chrysalis): The selection of Cole Porter songs recorded for this album reflects the elegance and poignancy of the human condition; a dignity that can't be taken away, regardless of AIDS. Some of the best loved PoMo artists have contributed to this 20 track



Chrysalis album, who will donate all of the proceeds to AIDS charities. Particularly unforgettable is U2's "Night And Day," Annie Lennox' "Ev'ry Time We Say Goodbye, and k.d. Lang's "So In Love." Cole Porter would be proud that his songs can make such an impact.





The battle of **Arbitron** vs. **Birch** will probably continue forever. However, Birch seems to be kinder to Black Radio. In the recent August/September survey of the top 10 radio markets, Urban radio was #1 in five and #2 in three. NOT BAD! While I'm not suggesting that all you programmers run out and buy brand new Porsches, a glass of champagne is definitely in order. (Ed. note: Our research goddess Kandace just loooves champagne.).... The big news in the survey comes from L.A., where KKBT's Mike Stradford, Liz Kiley, Frank Miniaci, and their crew soar from 5.9 to 6.5 in the July/August monthlies! The Beat is the toast of La La Land, which is amazing when you consider that the station is still building, but has had such an amazing



impact on a wide cross-section of listeners. Many industry observers feel that they're playing it TOO SAFE. That remains to be seen. The proof should come when their competitors make their programming adjustments in the coming weeks. **KJLH** (1.3 - 1.5) is in a regrouping mode, restructuring their air staff and their music mix, which will feature more Rap than before, perhaps to attract KDAY's listeners now that it is going down. **KACE** (.6 - .7) and **KGFJ** (.9 -1.4) are going for the adults, but all three are at a serious power disadvantage when compared to KKBT. This puts them at a serious disadvantage, but you've got to think that Stradford & Co. are gunning for larger fish (KIIS & KPWR). We wish them all the luck in the world. Later.

K.T Oslin, "Love In A Small Town" (RCA): "Come Next Monday" and "Cornell Crawford" are obvious country hits, while "Mary and Willie" is the state of the day-to-day "'80s Ladies" sequel about love on everyone's own terms fames have waited for. Still, the songs that show

Oslin's depth as a writer are the reflective "New Way Home" and "Still On My Mind," dealing with loves that are gone, but refuse to die. Sung with deep knowing, Oslin's insignt serves as a comfort to us all.

Traveling Wilburys, "Traveling Wilburys, Vol. 3" (Wilbury/Warner): With the Kentucky Headhunters plying their roughshod country-rock, there's plenty of room for Muddy, Boo, Clayton and Spike here in Hollyville. They play deep-pocketed grooves loose and greazy, sing like they mean it and have the kinds good to



they mean it and have the kinda good times most never find. Check out the gently chuggling "Inside Out" or the obvious "Hillbilly Rock"- sequel, "Wilbury Twist." Any of these tracks should appeal to Neobillies everywhere.



Wild Rose, "Straight and Marrow" (Capitol): Producer James Stroud understands bands, consequently gender's not an issue listening to the five women of Wild Rose. Steamy grooves and rock-solid playing are the rule on their second LP. The lazy harmonies that hang above "Forever Ir. Love,"

the painfully pretty "Right Between The Lies" and the percolating "Straight and Narrow" sounds like hits, as the hyperspeed "Hit The Highway" shows multi-instrumental **Wanda Vick** to be a picker's picker.

Reba McEntire, "Rumor Has It" (MCA): Reba McEntire's vocal chops are legend. She can twist, twirl and curl notes with an ease that's earned her acclaim far beyond Nashville, and with "Rumor Has It," McEntire's crafted a work that will touch the masses. "You Lie" is a soaring tour-de-force



that knows no format, ditto for the love-too-late "Now You Tell Me" and the slightly dark "This Picture," while **Jesse Winchester**'s "You Remember Me" shows artistic understatement.


