### On Broadway

Red-hot Social Distortion made rock & roll video history when their sold-out 9 p.m. set at C.B.G.B. was broadcast live and in stereo on the 23 x 28-foot Sony Jumbotron screen overlooking Times Square last Monday (24).

The hook-up was the brainchild of Epic VP Video and Alternative Promotion Steve Backer and Sony Music Director of Special Projects Bill Beatty. The 80minute set was transmitted live via three microwave links save for the "bleeping" of a few between-song remarks by singer **Mike** Ness. Tens of thousands of onlookers watched telecast in Times Square, with 33.7% of them reporting having their pockets picked during the performance.

### "Run" Walks

Rape charges were dropped in the case against Run DMC's Joseph "Run" Simmons, brother of Def Jam's Russell Simmons, for lack of evidence. Simmons' defense team discovered that the woman who lodged the complaint had made seven other similar false accusations over the last three years.

Commented Russell Simmons: "It is clear that Joe was brought to trial on the basis of his celebrity and the word of one unstable woman, and not on the basis of any known facts, which indicate no rape took place. We can only hope this exoneration is covered as widely as the indictment was."

Quick Lenny Beer -- The Tribute Pop Goes

MTV makes their move this week with adds on Social Distortion (Epic), Sugarcubes (Elektra), TLC (Arista), R.E.M. (WB) and Joe Public (Columbia). Social D. moves right into Buzz Bin, while Teenage Fanclub (DGC) is upped from Stress into the category. Also, Ugly Kid Joe (Mercury) receives a bump into Stress.

### U2 Island/PLG

This future classic from the multi-platinum LP picked early by programmers and has been receiving album cut play in most markets. Now out as a single, it has early reports at KIIS, KRBE, KEGL and KZZU and will score with tons more this week. The tour, beginning in April, will be among the year's biggest. Look for Johnny Barbis and team to score quick and big on this "One."



So impressed with our publication was Def American and their smash artist Sir Mix-A-Lot that they decided to pay tribute to us by placing a portrait of HITS Editor-In-Chief Lenny Beer atop a Rough Trade record outlet in San Francisco. Sir Mix-A-Lot is currently ruling with the single, "Baby Got Back (I Like Big Butts)."

### The Economy

If you want to know when the current recession is going to end, try listening to the Top 40. Columbia University research fellow Harold Zullow says popular songs are an exceptionally accurate predictor of the economy's direction. Pessimistic lyrics in hit songs indicate a recession, while optimistic songs suggest good times. Zullow published his findings in a recent edition of the "Journal of Economic Psychology" after studying lyrics of hits going back 40 years. Another theory is that a lousy charttopper indicates a recession, like Steam's "Na Na Hey Hey Kiss Him Goodbye" (December, 1969), Rupert Holmes' "Escape (The Pina Colada Song)" (January, 1980) or Air Supply's "The One That You Love" (July, 1981). Three weeks ago, the #1 song was Right Said Fred's "I'm Too Sexy," which must mean good times are right around the corner.



### **Crue Did It?**

Just five days after issuing a press release that Vince Neil was leaving Mötley **Crüe** to devote more time to auto-racing, Elektra sent out Neil's explanation, which indicated he wasn't fired for drinking nor did he split the group to pursue racing. "It is true, however, that I didn't share enthusiasm for the band's new musical direction," he said. "When I didn't agree with what they were doing, I was always shot down." 






What's the first song you ever played in a club?

t seems somewhat hard to imagine the frenzied masses of the motherland shaking it up across the dance floors to a Neil Young tune, but thanks to the London-based trio St. Etienne and their reconstructed version of "Only Love Can Break Your Heart," Uncle Neil raked in some healthy royalty checks during the summer of '91.

Bob Stanley and Peter Wiggs have been chums since childhood, and after a succession of vocalists (finally settling on Sarah Cracknell), are ready to leave their flat, "Fox Base Alpha" (also the name of their debut album), and take on the world. The band, named after a French soccer club, have enjoyed three huge hits in their homeland and are kicking up support both in Japan and here in the colonies.

HITS' own candidate for Saint of Impossible Causes, Brian "D.W." Griffith, recently chatted with Bob Stanley from his manager's office in London... collect, of course.

# WHEN THE SAINT COMES MARCHING IN

i read in your bio that the two of you met when you were two-and-half years-old.

Might have been younger really. Our mums met in the butcher shop. So we've known each other as far back as we remember, really. Not that we remember meeting... our mums told us. It seems you have somewhat stumbled into a music career...

We just booked some studio time to mess about. We hadn't done anything too seriously up to that point. We saved up a few pounds and went to the studio for a laugh. We wanted to do a Neil Young song, but we couldn't think of one to do. We wanted to do "Ambulance Blues" originally, from "On The Beach." It's like a nine-minute acoustical thing. [Laughs.] We figured, as a dance record, it would be quite strange, but it was too much hard work. We settled on "Only Love Can Break Your Heart," even though it was in 3/4 time, so we had to change that around a bit.

Why Nell Young?

We were listening to a lot of Neil Young, and we're big fans. It's a song that to me sounds half-finished. That's half the appeal of it. There was a lot we could do with it. The song is very repetitive. That's the best part about it. We emphasized the repetition a bit more than Neil did.

Have you heard from him?

No, I wish we had. Hopefully, he's heard it by now. We're on the same label, but as of now, no one has bothered to send him a copy. You're getting a lot of club play, yet you don't really consider yourself a "club act."

Not really. The way I look at it, we're just making modern pop records, which tend to be dance records. If it's gonna be a good record, it should end up appealing to a lot of different areas, like Nirvana, so we don't really see ourselves specifically as dance. I don't think the album sounds like a dance record.

We're big fans of the '60s girl group records — Lulu, Dusty Springfield, Marianne Faithfull — and the American stuff... Phil Spector, of course. We love the lushness of the string sound. "Wichita Lineman" is probably my favorite record ever. I never wanted to make records unless we could do string arrangements and, with the technology available now, of course, you don't actually need an orchestra. Just as well for us.


You seem to go through a lot of female vocalists.

[Laughs.] What exactly do you mean? When we did "Only Love," it was just for fun really. We had no intention of releasing it. So the singer we got that day was a friend of a friend. She was the only singer we happened to know. She already had a band, so we couldn't get a commitment or anything. For the second single, we used the singer from the band Dead Famous People. I just like to think our stuff is varied and it wasn't until Sarah came that we found our singer. She coped with it all quite admirably.

You've been quoted as saying you want people to remember what they were doing when they first heard one of your songs on the radio. What were you doing? [Laughs.] You got me. I can't remember actually.

There are some interesting sample effects on the album, most notably on the cut "Wilson." Where does that stuff come from?

It's from one of these decimal currency training records. When we switched to decimal currency over here 20 years ago, it was a really major thing. Nobody understood the totally different money and everyone got very confused by it, so they made these records — you know, like a scene in a pub, a scene in a cafe — to help explain it. That's where those samples came from.

#### TIME FOR A CUP OF JOE AND A DOUGHNUT WITH JAMES BY ERIN CULLEY

## HOME, JAMES

Way back in his early teens, bassist Jim Glennie decided to form a band when a friend bought a stolen guitar and convinced him to do the same with a bass. James was born in Manchester, U.K., and then proceeded to mutate over the next decade. Vocalist/lyricist Tim Booth was originally enlisted as dancer/songwriter before taking on vocals and three years ago, James went from a four-piece to a seven-piece when the drummer left and Booth and Glennie decided five new members were better than one, adding guitarist Larry Gott, drummer Dave Baynton-Power, trumpeter Andy Diagram, keyboardist Mark Hunter and guitarist/violinist Saul Davies.

Though the band has released several EPs and four albums (one of them live), it wasn't until last year that James struck the mother lode with their "Sit Down" single. Fans went wild, "Sit Down" did the big leap-a-roo from the indie charts to the #2 Top 40 spot in the U.K., and the band found themselves swamped with gigs — including the headliner spot for the prestigious Reading Festival — right in the middle of trying to self-produce their current "Seven." Though they managed to get through about half of the album before the deluge, ex-Killing Joke member Youth had to be enlisted to help finish the disc.

With their fourth studio album under their belt and the entire continent of Britain at their feet, Morrissey's fave band has decided to set their sights upon recreating James-mania Stateside. HITS' own mania-inducing "Who'll Stop The" Erin Culley recently met up with Booth and Glennie to discuss battle strategies.



#### I remember seeing you guys headline last summer's Reading Festival in England and your fans were just going crazy. When you played "Sit Down," I thought there was going to be a riot!

**Tim Booth:** [Laughs.] That was quite restrained for us. We were trying to kind of play down "Sit Down" rather than play up to it. The reaction was actually kind of low-key for us. You should see the normal concerts — it's like trying to play in the middle of a cyclone!

#### How fun!

**Tim:** Yeah, it is. But if you try to play an acoustic song, then it becomes a really big challenge to see if you can pull off a slow song in the middle of a hurricane.

With all the hoopla surrounding you in the U.K., it must be kind of nice to come to America, sort of start over and conquer new territory. Jim Glennie: We're looking forward to it. You come over here and yeah, some people know James, but the rest of America is like, "OK, impress us." It's a challenge. It's great.

#### Tim, I read an article describing you as a "celibate, vegetarian Buddhist who shunned all rock's vices." What on earth?!

**Tim:** [Chuckles.] Well, I was celibate for about three-and-a-half years and I meditated a lot, but I was never a vegetarian nor a Buddhist. For a period of my life that was true, until about four years ago.

#### Do you still meditate?

**Tim:** Personally, yeah. I was part of a group and it was very intense.

**Jim:** We found a quite good Buddhist group that sort of left you alone and let you get on with your meditating. You take what you want from the Buddhism if you're interested.

**Tim:** We did it for three-and-a-half years, but the group wasn't right and the teacher wasn't right, so we ended up rejecting it all. Now, we just

meditate when we want to. We were very intense for awhile. We were meditating two hours a day, ten hours every weekend. There were long, long periods when we'd go for days. The longest I went for was five days — one meal a day and then the last few days, you don't sleep. You get into some very strange states.

#### Tell me about the inspiration behind "Live A Life Of Love" from the new album.

Tim: It's about the basic idea that what Christ is saying is "Live a life of love" and that has been completely lost and fought over by different people using religion for power. That's what happens to nearly all religions — they end up being fought over. It's like dogs mark out territories with scent and smell, but humans stake out territorial ideas: "God has a beard," "No he doesn't," "Well, then let's have a war about it." So it's that kind of thing. And the same thing has happened with the interpretation of the Bible — which is totally open to anybody's interpretation. "I speak in the

name of God" is a very arrogant kind of sentiment. But that's what "Live A Life Of Love" is about. It plays on the pun of the words "prophet" and "profit."

#### Were you raised religiously?

**Jim:** No, my mom was Christian, but it was kind of left up to us.

71m: I had it rammed down my throat. I was Protestant, and went to church six days a week.

#### That's a surefire way to turn somebody off religion.

Tim: When I was around 20, I really went looking for an alternative to religion — which really seemed dead — based on belief. I wanted to find some proof. That's why I got interested in meditation. Every single belief system I discovered was looking for proof that there was some intelligence behind life — that it wasn't all just kind of random chaos. For me, many of our lyrics over the last five years have been about the nature of change and trying to find answers to fairly difficult questions.

#### Are they unanswerable questions, though?

**Tim:** I found my own personal answers. I believe they're answerable for an individual, but it isn't, "I found this, so therefore it is true for everybody." It's more like, "I found this and it's true for me. This is what I believe in." I don't think you can find a big truth that everyone can believe in.

#### **ANTHRAX**

ALMOST A DECADE's gone by since these moshin' metal maniacs first crawled from the streets of New York to bring their very singular brand of heavy music to the people. After six gold records and countless world tour-

ing, where they've amassed a legion of fans, this frantic fivesome continues to break the rules. Their last Island LP, "Persistence of Time," was a stunning examination of social and political angst; "Attack of the Killer B's", an EP of cool covers, featured the single, "Bring the Noize" (with Public Enemy), and sparked a groundbreaking tour that was lauded by critics and fans from rap to rock to metal.



Now, Anthrax is poised for the ascension to Platinum. They've just inked a three-record deal with Elektra worth \$7.5 million, although the contract contains incentives that could make the kitty spill over to as much as \$15 mil. Expect their label debut in October. Add to all that, last Sunday, they appeared as guest stars on the Top Ten-rated Fox program, "Married... With Children" (they signed their Elektra deal the final day of taping.) But the real reason they're spotlighted here is bassist Frank Bello's decision to wear his RIP sweatshirt on camera for 30 million to see. Frankie, you rule. Anthrax, you rule. For keepin' it in the family, here's to you, dudes....

## **PEDDLE PICKS**



Shotgun Messiah, "Second Coming" (Relativity): Their sophomore effort is both commercial 'n' cool. Like Skid Row, these Swedes have wide appeal: a sexy singer (bassist Tim Skold, new to the role) who appeals to both guys and girls, a guitar virtuoso (Harry Cody) who's technical, but warm and acces-

sible, and tunes that are both rebellious-aggressive and popcatchy. The irresistible "Heartbreak Blvd." is on the way to hitsville, while the ballad "Living Without You" is a winner. There's a cool cover of the Dolls' "Babylon," while another classic cut is "I Want More." My new motto is, "I would go insane if I had a brain," from "Nobody's Home." Great. (KT) MSG, "MSG" (Impact): Is it the Michael Schenker Group? McCauley-Schenker Group? Don't agonize, it's just plain old MSG. Former Scorpions/UFO guitarist Schenker's solo career is now six albums deep. There's a void left by bands such as Whitesnake, and MSG's latest is packed with



prime cuts to fill those shoes. This is commercial rock: big, bombastic, melodic, but not overblown, plus, it's got a stellar collection of players, among them Dokken's Jeff Pilson and Kingdom Come's James Kottak. "Crazy" is a clear frontrunner, while the ballsy "Eve" and the ballad "What Happens To Me" are also picks to click. (KT)



#### TAWN MASTREY, KQLZ -- PIRATE RADIO

Here in L.A., Tawn Mastrey is a legend. A true metal mover and shaker — known as *The Leather Nun* — her abrupt move from KNAC shocked her legion of dedicated fans and brought listeners to the flailing Pirate Radio. "I think I have changed the image quite a bit. Musically, I'd like to see the station get harder and crunchier."

Tawn has her evening show, the *Pirate Underground* and another with Westwood One, starting in April, called *RockZone*. What makes Tawn this week's Radio Knob is her insight & integrity in this industry — not to mention Lonn was impressed that **Vince** "I Need A Gig" **Neil** called her first about the breakup. 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Tr's ironic how this record started life as kind of an unwanted bastard child, and now all of a sudden everybody's telling

you how wonderful it is.

Yeah, that's a little mind-boggling. Mostly I'm just excited that it's come out at all. It seems like everything that's happened is the result of the record having some kind of life of its own. I was happy with my first two records when I made them, and I wouldn't want to disown them, but I was sure that this was the right approach for me, and to think that this was the record that wouldn't come out was real frustrating. The worst thing was just that I felt so good about it, and then I had to wait so long to find out if I was crazy for liking it so much.

It's an interesting reversal, that you started by playing around with the slick techno stuff on your early records and then returned to rock 'n' roll basics afterward.

I'm really glad that I explored technology early and got it out of my system. It was a natural thing for me at the time. When I made "Inside," I was way too shy to sit around with people and sing my songs for them, so I would do it all on my own with machines. Also, I was kind of reacting to having been in Athens, Georgia, around a lot of people who really frowned on machines. "Earth" was much more of a guitar record, but it still had programmed drums and the song structures were still too rigid.

What happened with "Girlfriend" was that I owned a drum kit and set it up in my living room, and started playing real drums on my demos rather than programming them. Even though I'm a terrible drummer, the drums instantly made the songs feel really cool and different for me, and that was a real liberating feeling. I was also really poor at the time, so within a month I sold my computer and my keyboards and was just doing guitar, bass and drums stuff, and having more fun than I'd had in years.

If there's anything I want to steal from old rock records, it's the feel and the spontaneity with which people played on them. I'm not anti-technology. I just found out that it was easier and more fun to slam it down organically, and that it somehow yields a better feeling on the record. And even when I hear this record now, it sounds pretty tame and together to me. I'd love to push it further and make it more extreme next time.

A lot has been made of the autobiographical aspects of "Girlfriend" 's lyrics.

## How Sweet It Is

Esture this: you're a critically-acclaimed pop-rock prodigy with a pair of much-praised but low-selling major-label solo albums (and a couple of respectable indie projects) under your belt. You've made a third album that you consider a major artistic advance, but your label won't release the damn thing. That was the position in which Nebraska-bred Matthew Sweet found himself a year ago, after finishing a 15-song effort that saw him abandoning the high-tech sound of his prior solo albums, "Inside" and "Earth," for a more organic approach combining quietly profound lyrics (at least partially inspired by a painful divorce and a subsequent new romance) with hook-laden garage-rock arrangements featuring such esteemed players as guitarists Richard Lloyd and Robert Quine and subtler acoustic shadings. After an extended period of labelessness, the fledgling Zoo picked up the album (now titled "Girlfriend") and guess what? — the sucker's turning into a hit! A former Jerseyite himself, HITS' resident Hawkwind authority Harold "A, B and C Come Before" DeMuir, got to grips with the Princeton-based popster on the eve of his recent national tour with former A&M labelmate Robyn Hitchcock and wouldn't let go.

I guess I went through some growing stages, and a lot of that's in there, but it makes me a little worried how much that's been played up. I always wrote lyrics that were personal, but I suppose the stripped-down production on "Girlfriend" really played a big part in making them come across that way.

get saddled with this pop-craftsman thing a lot, but I don't think it's very accurate, because I generally try to keep the lyrics from being forced or thought-out. I tend to blurt a lot of stuff out, and the best things seem to float to the top and end up on my records. It's interesting that the God stuff in several of "Girlfriend"'s lyrics ("Divine Intervention," "Evangeline," "Nothing Lasts") has been inspired by vastly different ways. Yeah, it's weird. I always thought of those references as being sort of negative, or at least questioning. But then I started hearing from really religious people interpreting "Divine Intervention" as a faith song. The line was originally, "I cannot understand my girl," but I just thought it was so terrible that I changed it to "God." And "Evangeline" has

nothing whatsoever to do with any crisis of faith. It's totally based on a comic book about this space nun and the guy who lusts after her, but can never have her because she's pledged her love to God.

So how's your current success affecting your life? Inever felt a crushing disappointment when my other records didn't sell, because I always kind of felt like I was getting away with something by making them. Now I've been forced to think about things much more, just because other people are actually thinking about this record and wanting to know about it. That's kind of a new thing for me, and I don't know if it's too healthy, because then you start wanting to know things like how much it's selling. There's something that sickens me about the whole concept of fome and self-exploitation. It's not that I don't want to sell tons and tons of records, but... I felt so alienated when nothing was happening for me, and I still feel alienated now that things are happening for me. I'm just trying to revel in the horrendous truth of life. \*
