Guns N' Roses singer Axl Rose voluntarily turned himself over to St. Louis County authorities last Tuesday (14) after being arrested Sunday morning upon landing at New York's JFK Airport from Paris with his girlfriend Stephanie Seymour, her son and nanny after an eight week European tour. He was released at a hearing that evening on \$100,000 bail.

"I can't believe how cool the New York police are," commented Axl. "They don't hide behind their badges. They treat you like a human being. I think I'm going to write a song about them."

A warrant had been issued for Axl's arrest earlier this year by the St. Louis County Prosecutor over charges stemming from a melee after the band's concert at Riverport Amphitheater outside St. Louis last July '91. Rose faces four misdemeanor assault charges, one for property damage and one for having a model/actress girlfriend.

Manager Doug Goldstein said the matter will be resolved in time for Guns to kick off the 25-date American leg of their tour with Metallica and Faith No More this Friday at RFK Stadium in Washington, D.C.



HEY, BUD! THE BOX

An exclusive HITS interview with Les Garland, Vice President Programming, The Box By Dave Konjoyan


Les Garland has the Midas touch when it comes to programming. Everything he's touched has turned into solid-gold ratings. Starting at KICK in Springfield, MO (where producer David Kershenbaum was his newsman), Garland quickly made a successful run up the radio ladder, with stops at KYNO in Fresno, K100 in L.A. (where he worked with the legendary Bill Drake), and stints at WAVZ in New Haven, CKLW in Detroit and WRKO in Boston, where his colleague was Paul Drew. While at WRKO, he promoted an outdoor concert featuring Heart, Orleans and Burton Cummings, among others, which he convinced the mayor would draw


no more than 15,000 fans. When 100,000 showed up, the Red Sox game that day had to be postponed. "The city of Boston wanted me out of town," laughs Garland now. Of course, he was leaving anyway, in '76, to go to his dream job, San Francisco's KFRC, the #1 music station in the country at the time, which Garland was convinced he could push past the area's perennial ratings topper, news/talk KGO. He did. "I have to pay tribute to my partner [KFRC MD] Dave Sholin. He was brilliant and knew exactly what that market needed."

Feeling he'd reached a pinnacle in radio, Garland began looking for new avenues, entering the record business as West Coast GM for Atlantic Records under Doug Morris. Two years later, Bob Pittman approached him about a new project, a 24-hour music video cable channel. Between '81 and '87, Garland helped make modern programming history as VP of Programming at MTV. Now, he's doing it all over again, programming The Box, an interactive cable TV music channel that has already been given credit for breaking some of the hottest dance/rap acts of the '90s, including Vanilla Ice and Gerardo. The Box, formerly the Video Jukebox Network, plays videos that viewers call in to "request," aggressively taking chances with clips that MTV, VH-1 and BET pretend don't exist. The interactive channel has been gaining notoriety both inside and outside the industry lately, aided by new programming and image changes. Given the option of talking to HITS or going to the dentist, Garland took some time out to open his mouth and say, "Ahhh!," for this magazine's own torpor-inducing anesthesiologist Dave "Snooze" Konjoyan.

How did you end up at The Box?

When Viacom bought MTV, I didn't have an ownership position any longer. I wasn't sure what I wanted to do. After you've been an owner, I didn't know philosophically how the inner workings of Les Garland might react to being a hired gun. I made the decision it was probably time to go. Bob Pittman said, "Why don't you come to Quantum with me?" So, I became the Executive Vice President of Quantum and President of the Music Division. We put out a record that didn't do as well as I hoped it would. I started thinking maybe I had left MTV too soon. I sat down with Bob and said, "Let me out of this thing. I just wanna go play golf." In February of '90, a headhunting company called and asked if I'd be interested in getting back into music television. I said I'd already done that. They said, "We know, but we canvassed America and you're the guy." They said it was something called the Jukebox Network. I'd heard of it. I knew [former MTV executive] Andy Orgel was President. So I met with Andy and was totally intrigued by the idea. I went down to Florida, got a feel for the operation and suddenly woke up to the fact that this could be the next step beyond what we started in the '80s with MTV.

Tell me about the name and image changes and how they reflect some of the broader things you're doing at The Box.

The name Video Jukebox is owned by HBO, so we were prevented from calling ourselves that on the air. So we went through a lot of evolutions. We called it the Jukebox Network, and then we got negative about the word network. We felt it had the connotation of CBS, NBC, ABC — network is a strange word to a viewer. So we tried just Jukebox, but I personally felt jukebox was an elderly

consider going in there and remedying the problem.

How many markets are you in?

We're in 34 states and just over 14 million homes.

Which have been your most successful markets and why have they worked best?

Well, it's where the people are. Big markets for us include Chicago, New Orleans, Milwaukee, Detroit, the whole New York area right on down to Philadelphia, St. Louis and Miami, where we started. Why do you think The Box has caught on most quickly with

rap and urban audiences?

That's the most interesting question we're asked. It speaks of the phenomenal success of rap music first, and I think our timing on this is perfect because if you read the Newsweek piece with Sister Souljah, I felt the author nailed the phenomenon of rap right on the nose — it is today's rock 'n' roll to that youth culture out there. White music consumers all over the world have been taken by the new music form, and consistently, in market after market after market, where our demo make-up is no different than the demo makeup of America, the most popular genre of music we play is rap. Now, why? Number one, it's phenomenally successful. Number two, they can't get it anywhere else. You can't see it in the mix on MTV — it's pigeon-holed to "Yo! MTV Raps," which has now been moved to midnight. Sir Mix-A-Lot isn't there anymore, you can't see Luther Campbell, Naughty By Nature, 2 Live Crew, Spice 1, DJ Quik or that sexy motherfucker, Carmen Electra. They're not on BET. This is the only place you can get 'em. So I think that has a lot to do with why they're so heavily requested on the channel, too.

word. I didn't know if it fit the '90s. If you couldn't put the word video with it, it didn't make a lot of sense. We went out to the viewers and discovered the hipsters out there called it "The Box." We decided 1992 is the year to zoom in on what the channel was going to become, so we went to Big Fat TV, the production company that had a lot to do with El's look, which I think has been really wellexecuted. So we unveiled a whole new look and bingo! There it was, "The Box." There was no question in our mind; we'd been talking about this one for a year and we said, "That's it, let's go with The Box." The response has been amazing. It's a different channel and it's caused more interest.

Each of your 170 outlets go through local cable operators and are individually programmed. Briefly, how exactly does The Box work?

Let me give you a hypothetical situation to make it more understandable. Let's say we did a deal in Sacramento, and that cable system had 125,000 homes. One computer system can't handle that because the response to the channel is far greater than that. So we go into that market with say, four systems. We divide those 125,000 homes into four groups. We have to be totally concerned with consumer satisfaction. The national wait time [between call and airing of videol is 20 minutes. And it's very easily manageable because we can watch it all from the central computer system here in Miami. If the wait time is consistently more than 30 minutes, we'll seriously

The Box is viewer-programmed, but obviously choices are made from a menu you provide. How do you put that menu together?

We try to locally customize the boxes for that specific market. The computer system can automatically detect the videos that are being requested, and there are certain criteria a video must receive to remain on the menu in each market. Now, the big hits are hits everywhere. We use the computer system to go through every market. We then go in and program each market. Let's say we add 20 videos on Tuesday; we'll usually add them into every market. Then, two weeks later, if it's only happening in 50% of the markets, we might take it out of the markets where it's not happening. That's how the testing process works. We've been adding consistently, for the last year, 20-25 videos a week; we have a very large playlist. Now, with over 2,500 videos available in any given box, we'll only scroll about 350 of them, mostly the currents. We also have a playlist we mail out. We're sending out about 150,000 a month so that viewers actually have a guide.

Do you think you'll eventually do away with the on-screen menu?

I doubt it, because all the research keeps telling us the way they get their music is off the menu, period. Some people have asked if it's too busy, is there too much going on on the screen. We've never seen anything in the research to indicate that to be the case. The

HITS July 20, 1992 39 viewing audience is accustomed to the channel. Maybe it has something to do with the Home Shopping Network — they're graphic crazy. We want not only to put the most entertaining programming on the channel, but to be informative. This is a brand-new idea to a lot of people. Getting people to watch is one thing; getting them to call is another. It's an educational process.

The one problem with the menu is that the station has some downtime built into it.

I believe that could be a problem. So far, the technology has not allowed us to fix that. We've gone out and specifically asked viewers that question, and they've resoundingly said it's not a problem. In fact, it's more of a positive, because when that full-screen menu comes up, they know, if they call, their video is going to play next. We have done some experimentation that we haven't talked much about publically, but we've played around with the idea. The system can automatically fire off videos. The last thing you'd want to let the audience know is that videos are playing when people aren't calling them in because I think you diffuse the gimmick. But we're pretty busy. We average 225-250 videos per day, so that pretty much takes up 24 hours. Which brings me to a point. A few years ago, a lot of people involved in the project believed it was a transaction business. But as ads come in, we're now firmly believe this is an advertising vehicle.

You'll eventually try to replace call-in revenue with ad revenue? Our real money in the future will be made selling advertising, and the cost of the videos will continually get lower. When the company ultimately turns a profit, it'll be because of advertising.

success of the videos we're playing on that label, and we get down to market specifics. That way they can take that data into their marketing meetings and focus on the markets where the videos are happening on The Box. They can go to radio PDs and say, "This thing's happening in your market" and get it played on the radio. There are very hip guys out there in radio who are watching the channel like you can't believe and adding records. Hosh Gureli up at KMEL in San Francisco, Jimmy Steele when he was still at the Eagle in Dallas, Steve Kingston at Z100 and Chuck Beck, the Fox in Detroit. They're calling us to see what's happening in their markets. If I had a large enough staff, I'd want to get even more tapped into radio.

How would you do that?

Exchange information with them. Find out what's happening on their radio station, tell them what's happening on this channel. Let 'em be privy to some of the information — in the end, it's to the benefit of us all. I'm not just running a TV station that's out to get ratings anyway I can. In our heart and soul, we believe in new music, we believe the lifeblood of the industry is the discovery of new artists. We have to explore new ways of taking music to people. We're in the '90s; things have changed. I see the day, not that far from now, when people will be buying music from their home. I want to be part of that; I think The Box can be part of that.

So you think the interactive nature of The Box is the future for cable TV music?

It could very well be the future of television. With the technology that's coming in TV, I don't think it's that far away — certainly within the next ten years — TV will almost be home-by-home specific.

Your programming challenge at MTV and radio was to put together a playlist and presentation that held and built an audience. Given that the viewer programs The Box, what's your programming challenge now?

The challenge here is to continue to give the channel a position in the mind of the viewers, to give it a look, to create a loyal audience, and to convert as many of those viewers as possible into callers. And day in, day out, to make the very best music available to give us that position. And it's a unique position. I was on a panel with Abbey Konowitch, and someone asked him why MTV did block programming last year. He tried to explain that there was so much fragmentation in music in the '90s, they didn't know how to get from U2 to a rap song. Then they threw the question to me and I said I thought that was a tactical programming mistake for MTV; you'll tune out a portion of your audience. One of the appeals of the old Top 40 concept was the surprise factor. You don't know what's gonna play next. And when it's a channel like The Box, you truly don't have a clue what's gonna play next. This channel might go from Jodeci to 2 Live Crew to Queen to Garth Brooks. No programmer in his right mind would do that, or would they?

With the interactive system, your research is built-in. I imagine that makes you attractive to the record companies.

Definitely. We issue a report every week to the labels that tracks the

Now that the record companies are getting an idea of what you can do for them, how are you working with them?

We're doing promotions. We're being as absolutely co-operative as possible, getting their videos on as quickly as possible, getting a read on them and getting that information back to the labels. The labels are buying a lot of advertising time. That's what it's all about — a music channel promoting music.

Certainly one of the things that really opened the door for The Box was its ability to break records.

Definitely. That gave us the credibility, the endorsement of the record companies.

What are some areas of the channel that have proved frustrating to you?

First thing that comes to mind is I wish we were having more success with alternative music. I think there's some really cool music being done out there that's not really getting a shot at exposure. Stuff like Cracker and Material Issue. I think it has a place here — I wish I could get the viewers to request it more. It's also frustrating that we're not live television. In order to change something on this channel, it takes a week and you lose that immediacy.

TIME FOR A CUP OF JOE AND A DOUGHNUT WITH DEL AMITRI BY SEAN O'NEILL



Del Amitri is an anomaly, an aberration on the U.K. PoMo scene. They're not especially pretty, they're less than tremendously hip, and they prefer to present themselves with their songs front and center, rather than buying into the trendy philosophy of letting your compositions hide behind great white waves of sound, ala Blur, Ride or My Bloody Valentine.

Del Amitri was formed in Glasgow in late 1983. Spurred on by the do-it-yourself spirit of punk, they pressed an album at their own expense, a rootsy, self-titled record that led to a fan-booked, fan-promoted tour of the U.S. On their return to Scotland, the band promptly broke up. After working day jobs for a while, singer Justin Currie and guitarist lain Harvey reformed the group (adding guitarist David Cummings and drummer Brian McDermott) with a newfound sense of passion. Their 1990 release, "Waking Hours," went platinum in England and Australia. Their latest, "Change Everything," promises to expand on the solid fan base they've built to date. Del Amitri singer/bassist/lyricist Justin Currie has seen some decidedly twisted scenes in his treks about the globe, but even he was visibly shaken when forced to spend 45 minutes with HITS' one-man toxic waste dump, Sean "Greasy" O'Neill.

Why do you sing with an American accent?

So many people in the States inquire about this, but I just sing in the same accent that all the people I listen to sing in. The Beatles didn't really sing in a Liverpool accent. There's never been a Scottish band that have sung in a Scottish accent, except the Proclaimers, who are quite strange that way. I really like the Proclaimers, but I couldn't stand to sing in a Scottish accent. The Scottish accent has very short, clipped vowel sounds, and you can't sing like that. You have to drawl if you're going to sing notes. I used to sing in an incredibly English accent. It was just the way I sang, and it's slowly changed over the years. I'm sure by the time I'm 40, I'll be singing in some kind of Spanish accent.

Richard Thompson told me that many U.K. musicians believe you have to sing with an American accent to do rock & roll.

That's true. I think it would sound really silly singing "Can't Buy Me Love" in a Scottish accent.

It might work — Scots have such a rep as penny pinchers.

[Laughs.] Yeah, it might make a good novelty record. Unfortunately, we're trying not to make novelty records.

Tell me about the song "The Ones That You Love." That song came from the title. The ones that you love lead you nowhere. Which is true.

You really believe that?

The things that you invest in most in life are the things that are going to screw you up most. All things come to an end and everything eventually falls apart and becomes chaotic. If you invest an awful lot of your heart in something, then it's ultimately going to lead you nowhere. That's not a reason to not fall in love, but it is one of the real dangers.

Sounds like you've been hanging out with the wrong people.

[Laughs.] The wrong people or the right people, that's who I see.

Do you have a strategy for dealing with the British press?

Not really. On our last album, our strategy was, don't talk to 'em. We're a tremendously unhip band and we thought we would be badly received, so we thought, "Fuck it." Although in the end, we got really great reviews in all the music papers. God knows how that happened. There's a few people who work for the music papers who like what we do and we talk to them — fine, that's publicity, great — but we're really not all that interested in people perceiving us through what's written about us. We'd much rather be perceived through being played on the radio because that's what we are — music.

As opposed to U.K. critical darlings like My Bloody Valentine, you guys could play any of

your songs on a beach with an acoustic guitar.

We're certainly not breaking any boundaries, and what we do doesn't have much to do with originality. I don't think that's a bad thing, but there's an awful lot to be said for it in these days of blandness and sameness from continent to continent.


You still live in Glasgow. Why?

This is corny, but our roots are there, our friends are there, and I think, if you achieve a little bit of success, which we have in Britain and Australia, then it's easy to start believing you're a fucking pop star. But if you live in Glasgow, it's very difficult to feel like a pop star, 'cause people will just say you're a complete dick. I think we'd really lose the plot if we moved to London or anywhere else.

American pop stars like Prince or Madonna might as well be from another planet.

There is a theory that movie stars and pop stars in America get turned into their own kind of royal family. They become kind of semi-deities. Certainly that's true with people like Prince, Michael Jackson and Madonna; they become Gods and stop being singers. Which is kind of strange. It happens a bit as well in Britain, but it doesn't really happen in Australia. People see you on the TV, they recognize you, they get an autograph, but basically they just don't give a shit. They know you're just Joe Average.

commitment at all" to buy any of the other "Sounds of the '70s" compilations. A second compilation CD is also available at only \$8.49, 'that's half off your regular low price!" Another letter told me of my "pre-approved" membership in the Columbia House Compact Disc Club, which entitles me to "seven CDs free when you become a member," including Kris Kross and R. Kelly & Public Announcement. In addition, the club offers the opportunity to purchase the first CD at \$6.95 and get two more bonus CDs. From a retail perspective, these offers do two main things - take away retail sales (hey, I'm within biking distance of all four major chains and at least three indie retailers, killing the argument that record clubs reach only those consumers not in metropolitan areas) and create the perception that retailers sell hit music at high prices (I was involved in a conversation this weekend with someone who showed me one of the offers and complained how he felt he was getting "screwed" whenever he walked into a record store). Retailers may understand compilations and catalog being sold through the mail, but not current hits... With the Democratic Convention in full swing, September has been designated 'Rock The Vote" month by NARM, with over 50 member companies with a combined total of 8,000 retail outlets supporting the campaign. The primary P.O.P. piece is a counter display with tear-off pads bearing an 800 number which will be in operation during the month. Callers will receive geographicallyspecific voter registration info. All materials will be available by August 15 through NARM, or call Rock The Vote at 310-276-8364.
