Censorship Bill KO'ed

Maybe the First Amendment isn't dead after all. Striking a blow for free speech and artistic freedom in the land of grunge-rock, Judge Mary Bruckner of the Superior Court of Washington in King County, Seattle, struck down the recently enacted Washington State Erotic Music Legislation as unconstitutional. Last June, the RIAA, the Washington Music Industry Coalition and the ACLU jointly filed a suit seeking a judicial ruling on the bill's constitutionality.

Said RIAA President Jason Berman: "I can only hope today's decision will send a warning to anyone who mistakenly believes the recording industry and judicial system will sit back and allow political grandstanders to create a censorship scenario by instilling fear of prosecution and producing a chilling effect on free speech."

Berman was then carted away by local authorities for having three Belle Barth albums and a Traci Lords video in his possession.

Industry Mourns Bruce Bird

Industry veteran Bruce Bird passed away suddenly last weekend (1) of a cerebral hemorrhage at the age of 44. Bird was head of his own Camel Management, where his clients included Damn Yankees, Vince Neil, Sass Jordan, Cameo and Kurt Howell. He is survived by his wife of 15 years, Nancy, three daughters and a son, and his brothers Eli and Gary.

Bruce began his career in 1966 at Liberty Records Distributing Co. of Ohio. He joined the Buddah label in 1974 as VP of Promotion, helping break Curtis Mayfield, Gladys Knight, Charlie Daniels and the Isley Bros. In '76, he joined Neil Bogart's Casablanca Records as VP of Promotion, then President, helping boost the careers of Donna Summer, Kiss and the Village People, among others. In 1982, he created Camel Records, where he launched the successful career of Night Ranger.

Because Bruce was instrumental in fund-raising efforts for **T.J. Martell/Neil Bogart** Foundation Memorial Labs, the family asks donations in his memory be sent there.

He will be missed.





According to LIFEbeat co-founder, EMIRG VP/GM Daniel Glass, "CounterAid" will serve as the launch for a much larger event to be staged early next year to raise public consciousness about the disease. Glass noted HMV's Ron Gold-

Glass insists activist Bob Caviano's recent death from AIDS has energized the organization and helped shed light on the social implications of the disease. LIFEbeat has allowed us to achieve a better level of individual understanding and enabled us to start to rid ourselves of the prejudices we have about this disease and the people who are afflicted with it.'





Of course, the fact that it's an oral history makes it convenient to open it up anywhere, read a "memory." and put it down. But this is a great story about a great man that you can't come away from without thinking, "Look what this guy went through... Who am I to say it's tough out there?" A party at Tower Books to celebrate the book's publication attracted a heavy outpouring of bizzers, including Delsener, Michael Klenfner, Ron Wood, Sunny Ralfini, Jerry Pompili, Joshua White, Erica Spellman Silverman of Wm. Morris who agented the book, and a very proud Jon Podell of that agency's music division, with New York colleagues Jonathan Levine and Steve Martin and new L.A. colleague, Triad's Brad Gelfond, over whom a great fuss was made as the crowd buzzed with details of William Morris' acquisition of Triad. On a more somber note, many who would otherwise have been at Tower that night were attending funeral services for Dee Anthony's father our sympathy to Dee on his loss... Iggy Pop gave a remarkable keynote speech at the CMJ convention. Accompanied by Virgin's John Boulos, Pop combined a realpolitik sensibility with true poetry, exhorting what he clearly considered to be an assemblage of future industry leaders to "think of yourselves as running a transportation system. You've got to know where you're going, and how to get other people there as well." The big-

tioneers were at CBGBs on the first night of showcasing to marvel at Quicksand, which gave me the same sort of thrill I remember on first hearing Megadeth and Metallica. Another trendy crowd packed the Irving Plaza for the excellent Ned's Atomic Dustbin, but all I could think of was the Happyland Social Club, so difficult was it to get in and then out. Why isn't the fire department coming down on that club, the way they certainly are harrassing our beloved Bitter End, a ground-floor establishment with easy and plentiful access? A fire inspector actually stormed in during last week's wonderful performance by Joan Baez in the '90s version of a '20s speakeasy raid, then stood in front of my table, blocking my view, presumably counting the house. Fans of Ms. Baez, many of whom are industry Vice Presidents and then some, were openly angered to see the street in front of the club crowded with fire department vehicles and loitering firemen. Hey, who's breaking what rules?... Things that make us go, hmmmm: Looking great at photog Bob Gruen's glamorous birthday party in the Village was Walter Yetnikoff, smiling, cleanshaven, gorgeously tailored, and accompanied by three extremely beautiful women.





A competitive market healthy for Top 40 radio!

# Dannyboy

An exclusive HITS dialogue with

Danny Goldberg, Sr. VP Atlantic Records, by Roy Trakin

The record industry's leading liberal light as Chair of the Southern California ACLU, Danny Goldberg started out in the business at Billboard, where he worked as a lowly clerk in the chart department for \$90 a week until he "talked them into letting me write because I loved seeing my name in print." His first cover story was on the Woodstock festival. Goldberg grew up in Westchester, where his father was in the textile business and his mother was a published poet. As a teen, he became enamored of the political folk of Phil Ochs. especially his "Love Me. Love Me. Love Me. I'm A Liberal." which he first heard when he was 13 and could well be the theme song to his life. He enrolled at UC Berkeley in '67 and dropped out after a week. "I was more interested in drugs than school at the time," he laughs. After his Billboard stint taught him he couldn't make any money writing, **Danny joined Solters & Roskin as** a publicist, ending up with Led Zeppelin as a client. "I became close to them almost immediately because I was the young kid with long hair, the house freak." A year later, the band hired him as VP of their fledgling, Atlanticdistributed imprint, Swan Song, which entailed him being the group publicist and serving as a liaison with the record company.

Upon being fired from Swan Song by manager Peter Grant in mid-'76, he started his own PR company with clients like KISS and ELO, then formed the Modern Records label with Bearsville's Paul Fishkin, to which they signed Fleetwood Mac star Stevie Nicks as a solo artist and inked an Atlantic Records distribution pact. In the mid-'80s, after selling his share of Modern, Danny launched Gold Mountain as a custom label and served as a soundtrack consultant to 20th

Century Fox. He eventually began a management company. **Gold Mountain Entertainment.** with partner Ron Stone, signing clients such as Bonnie Raitt and Belinda Carlisle before getting turned on to the PoMo scene by his wife, attorney Rosemary Carroll, former spouse of poet/rocker Jim Carroll. That led to him signing new acts like Sonic Youth, Nirvana and Hole, which revitalized his company. bringing it into the '90s. "I saw a real cultural divide in rock & roll." he says. "And I didn't want to be the equivalent of those old Tin Pan Allev guvs who grew their hair long and wore turtle-necks in the '60 to pretend to be hippies. I hired a manager who could relate and educate me to what was happening, so I could position myself as the business guy. That person was John Silva."

Earlier this year, he reunited with Atlantic boss Doug Morris when he accepted his offer to become a Sr. VP at the label, where he has provided instant credibility for the company's alternative roster, to which he's inked such up-and-comers as Eugenius and the Melvins as well as the North Carolina-based Mammoth Records, home of Juliana Hatfield and Machines of Loving Grace. Of course, nothing could prepare him for the abject horror of coming face-to-face with his much poorer doppelganger, Roy "Wishes He Had Danny Goldberg's Money" Trakin.

What was it like working for Led Zeppelin? Is it as decadent as has been written in "Hammer of the Gods" and the new Richard Cole book?

If you read those two books, you have a pretty good picture of the time I worked for them. I was the straight guy. That was my role. My own personal craziness occurred in high school and right after. Even though I had long hair, I was the anal compulsive person on the tour. It was an amazing time. They were just so big and the

feeling of unlimited resources was there, before the recession hit the record industry in the late '70s. I never had a budget at Swan Song. Whatever I thought was worth doing, we did. The idea was to be successful, and damn the costs. And it wasn't only Led Zeppelin. Bad Company's first record came out on Swan Song and went to the top of the charts, too.

What attracted you to manage Sonic Youth? My wife told me for years they were the best band in the world. She just insisted I listen to their albums and indoctrinated me to their music. Then I met them and just fell in love with them. They are just the most intelligent, erudite, politically knowledgable, well-read people and are very clever about how they handle their career. So it became a joy to work with such smart individuals. I became a tremendous enthusiast. But it was as a result of Rosemary just beating me over the head with the realization that there was a new chapter beginning in rock & roll and I better read it. Doesn't a great deal of this modern rock seem like a throwback to the idealism and sense of community engendered by '60s

There are certain similarities to the '60s I relate to very much. My political involvement resonates very strongly with some of these up-and-coming

pop culture?



bands. But most of its origins come from the '70s American punk movement epitomized by groups like Black Flag and Flipper, and I was not a part of that. I was working with Stevie Nicks at the time and doing "No Nukes." The worst thing I could do is lie and pretend I was a part of it. What I prefer to do is admit what I was doing back then was learning the music business. And now I can come to these bands as an expert in the music business and help them deal with it by protecting their integrity and identity. They can talk to some of the younger people we have here about obscure punk vinyl B-sides.

Gold Mountain appeared to be taking off at the precise time you took this Atlantic job.

It was very difficult to just walk away from a company like that. I'm continuing as an outside consultant and co-manager of Nirvana, Bonnie Raitt and Hole. In my opinion, managers are some of the most knowledgeable people in the music business because they have to deal with every aspect of the industry. For years, the top managers have been sought after as record executives when they reach a certain point of maturity. Look at David Geffen, Irving Azoff, Tommy Mottola, etc. Each of them has had to deal with their residual relationships and obligations in a responsible way. Otherwise, you end up undermining the very thing you've built up, which is your own image and credibility.

Not to compare my success with theirs, but each person, when they make a transition, has to responsibly stay faithful to previous commitments. On the other hand, as an Atlantic executive, the fact that I still have close relationships with two of the best-selling artists of the year in Bonnie Raitt and Nirvana gives me some personal credibility. There's a certain aura I get from having those relationships which helps me in my job here. Particularly my relationship with Nirvana, who have become such a symbol of a new era in rock. Believe me, when bands come up here I'm trying to sign, and see the kind of intimacy I have with that band, it doesn't hurt.

#### Why did you decide to go to Atlantic?

When you're a manager, you're working for someone else anyway — the artist. So the idea that running your own business means you're some king is just not true. The number one reason I came here is because I believe Doug Morris is one of the most brilliant and special people in the business, and the chance to work with him on a high level was too good to pass up. I've known him for more than a decade, so it's a real comfortable thing. This is a unique window of opportunity for me. And those windows don't open all the time.

Secondly, I've always felt the time to make a change in your career is when you're doing well, not when you're doing poorly. Inevitably, cycles go up and down, and you want to make a deal when you're on an up cycle because you'll make a better deal. Thirdly, I didn't particularly care for personally administering and running a small company. I was spending half my time as a business affairs person and not as a manager. Being an entrepreneur doesn't interest me at all. Here, I can do what I'm good at — working with artists and trying to help people make and sell records — rather than worrying about the rent and the employee health insurance plan.

What part of your new job do you like best? The personal relationships with the artists and the media. The most intelligent people you meet are members of the press. You really feel as if you're part of the process by which musical culture is established. I like interacting with the artists as they deal with the dilemmas of having a career in the pop music business. I'm not musical, so I can't help them with a guitar part or a drum sound, but I can offer my input on the philosophical issues of having a pop music career. I love those kinds of conversations.

#### What has been your advice to Courtney Love?

What Courtney needs to do is make a great record, and I have absolute, 100% confidence she will. She is one of the most intelligent people

I've ever met in my life and very talented people often go through crises in their lives. I just wish I'd come to Atlantic about six months earlier, so maybe I could have signed her here.

#### How have you found working within a corporate structure at Atlantic?

I've really been surprised at the lack of problems. Doug runs a very well-organized company. He creates an atmosphere where the people who work feel an intimacy with their colleagues. Even though it's a big company, there is no bureaucracy that interferes with common sense or personal judgements about how to do business. I haven't been here very long, so I have the anxiety of hoping the acts I bring in sell a lot of records. The majority of my time is being spent in the A&R area. I'm the West Coast head of A&R and I also work closely with Jason Flom in New York shaping the label's future A&R policy for the rock & roll part of the company. I'm also working closely in the marketing area with Val Azzoli, the GM of the label. I feel we're brothers in the sense that we both came out of the management area. Andrea Ganis and Danny Buch, who run the promotion department, are both very old personal friends of mine. It's like doing business with members of my own family.

Doug has a vision to make the Atlantic Group one of the major entertainment companies in the world. It's so exciting to see the changes he's made over the last few years bearing fruit, breaking new acts like Mr. Big, Saigon Kick, Marc Cohn and Tori Amos over the past year alone. EastWest, under the brilliant leadership of Sylvia Rhone, has broken Pantera, Das EFX and Da Lench Mob. Interscope's broken Primus and Helmet and Atlantic Nashville, under Rick Blackburn's tremendous leadership, has scored with new artists like Tracy Lawrence and Confederate Railroad. What other label can say that?

And then we have this A*Vision home video business, led by Stuart Hirsch, which has the rights to the Jane Fonda exercise tapes and the *Penthouse* videos and has become a profit center, too. It's a real interesting expansion, with some new executives coming in to make a fascinating blend.

My current task is to establish the company's credibility in the alternative area. I've just taken the Lemonheads under my wing. Our head of alternative promotion, Todd Elmore, and his team has their record doing well on all the college, Post-Modern and New Rock charts. This album is going to do at least 150,000 while the last record did 13,000, so that's exciting.

I'm working closely with the A&R staff. Steve Greenberg was very early on Eugenius and he and Craig Kallman and I were able to sign them. Al Smith worked with me on getting the Melvins. Tom Carolan, who A&R'ed the Lemonheads' album, has found a great new band in Stone Temple Pilots. Kevin Williamson, who worked closely on the Mr. Big and new Foreigner albums, helps remind us that there still is such a thing as mainstream rock & roll. Tim Sommer

has joined the department as my right-hand in dealing with a number of the key alternative rock projects. And it's been cool working closely with Jason, who has signed such diverse artists as Skid Row and Tori Amos.

One of the first deals I made was a joint venture with Mammoth Records in North Carolina, one of the leading indie labels. Their roster has artists like Juliana Hatfield, Machines of Loving Grace and Chainsaw Kittens. And Doug has made other deals with Interscope, Delicious Vinyl and Rhino.

### What do you see happening economically in the record business over the next decade?

I think there's a lot of growth left internationally. The Pacific Rim is growing very rapidly. Eastern Europe eventually will become an important market as their economy stabilizes. For some time, the people who have been most successful in this business are the ones who are conscious of the numbers and fiscally responsible.

Musically, I think rock & roll has made a great comeback over the last year. You've got some acts that've broken over the past year who are going to be around for five, 10, 15 years. Like Nirvana, Pearl Jam, Soundgarden, the Chili Peppers, Nine Inch Nails... These are not one-hit wonders. These are bands who have played hundreds of shows with intelligent songwriting in terms of image. To me, these are the bands who are going to be the next generation's Police and U2, Aerosmith and the Rolling Stones.

On the other hand, a national adult audience is emerging for country music like never before. The best songwriting in country achieves a level of sophistication and intelligence that rivals any other pop genre. Someone like Garth Brooks is as valid an artist as Bonnie Raitt. He'll be around 20 years from now. The baby boomers have rediscovered this music in a big way, and that's an exciting development. But just because country is popular doesn't mean rock or rap or R&B is dead.

You have a high profile as a leading liberal light in the industry through your involvement in the ACLU and Democratic


#### party politics. What are your own political ambitions?

I love being Chair of the Southern California ACLU. I feel their agenda is very close to my own views, as much as any organization can be. I'm very proud of the work they do year in and year out. I'm committed to the long haul. It gives me a tremendous window into Southern California politics. I love writing the occasional Op. Ed., or appearing on the occasional public TV show. It's fun for me after a lifetime of being on the side of the stage. It's ego-gratifying. But I want to maintain the balance I have now. I've always said Norman Lear is one of my real role models in the way he balanced this incredibly successful career in television and movies with a continuing presence as a political activist. Of course, if I ever ran for public office, my wife would divorce me.

#### You've been accused by Dave Marsh of being a Tipper Gore apologist.

Look, I disagree with a lot of what Tipper Gore has done in the past and I dislike her book, but there is no question she is much more moderate and sensitive to First Amendment issues than someone like Marilyn Quayle. I would say I'm an extreme liberal and progressive on the issue of free speech, Quayle and Bush are extreme conservatives, even reactionaries and Tipper Gore is a moderate. The differences I have with Tipper Gore don't mask the fact we agree on 90% of the other issues, as opposed to the radical differences I have with Bush and Quayle. And while Tipper Gore said a lot of things I was offended by, you have to give her credit for opposing legislation whenever there have been attempts by politicians to make laws regulating record sales. She's always stayed faithful to her promise to oppose that. She's much more progressive than Dan Quayle, even though she's not as progressive as the ACLU. And a rational person can see that difference.


### BEAT'S ME







When it comes to produced spots and promos unlike this snake pit of a 'zine — glaring flaws are not happening! After the copy is written (see last week's 411), and the music and/or sound effects are chosen, and you've decided on the delivery (intimate, mellow, big, dynamic, etc.), you're ready to put this thing together. How many times have you heard a station air produced material with mistakes included? This does not make sense because: A) It's preventable and B) Everything that airs tells a listener what kind of station you are. Do you want listeners to think of your station as flawed? I don't think so. Make certain your delivery is right and correct, down to each inflection, pause and syllable. Go for perfection. Are your sound effects and music

the best for this spot/promo? Sometimes a particular choice sounds good in your mind, but not on a speaker. In this case, find something else to use. Now, are your levels right? Are your edits smooth and indiscernible? OK, proceed. Please cart properly. Even a perfect spot or promo will come off as flawed if it's carted improperly. If it's loose (too much dead-roll), the station loses momentum. If it's too tight (upcut), it just sounds sloppy. Take your time and get it right... Check it out: En Vogue is on the way with "Give It Up..." (Atco/EW) and Boyz II Men have a dynamite version of "In The Still Of The Night" on "The Jacksons: An American Dream" soundtrack (Motown). Later.





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### NAKED AS A AYHAWK

Time for some franks and beans with the Jayhawks

BY JON LEVY

"Now we're starting to do something instead of sitting around waiting and being bitter and bored."

It's been a long, hard road for the Jayhawks. The Minneapolis quartet encountered plenty of potholes on the trail leading up to "Hollywood Town Hall," their first album for Rick Rubin's Def American Records. Two previous indie releases (their self-titled 1985 debut on Bunkhouse Records and '89's "Blue Earth" on Twin Tone) won the band critical acclaim, but didn't exactly make the Jayhawks a household word. By capturing the group's compellingly rootsy sound, "Hollywood Town Hall" seems bound to open a lot of new (and better paved) avenues. Lead singer Mark Olson, drummer Ken Callahan, bassist Marc Perlman and guitarist Gary Louris recently nested in the Def American rumpus room, where they were subjected to a grilling from HITS' Shirley Temple stunt double Jon Levy "501 Buttowndown Jeans."

#### What's it like having your new album on a major label after two indie releases?

MARK OLSON: I love it. It's better. The indie thing, you go in and do this record, and it's almost like a joke — there is no way anybody is going to hear the darn thing other than the 10,000 people who are clued into the indie scene. A few people do, sure, but the odds are so stacked against you, it's an exercise in futility.

Previously you sounded burnt-out on record labels and the whole industry thing. Have you changed your tune?

GARY LOURIS: Yes, a little bit. Now we're starting to do something instead of sitting around waiting and being bitter and bored. I still don't like the music business — I just don't like business in general. I don't want to say anything negative about the people in the music business, but I am saying something about the workings and requirements of the business, and what they have to do to sell a band.

MARC PERLMAN: He's the controversial one...

LOURIS: But I tell you — and I really don't mean to be sucking up — George Drakoulias is the guy. As long as he's with us, we feel we've got somebody who will always go to bat for us. I've known other people at other labels, but I don't know many people like George, who sincerely love music.

OLSON: "Don't embarrass me" — that's George's favorite thing to say. We don't want to be George's folly. He told us we are his swan song.

How did you guys first meet him?

OLSON: Our friend at Twin Tone is a good buddy of his. He forced George to listen to a song, and he said, "Who is that? I want them." So he had you?

OLSON: He had us his way.

**PERLMAN:** George is a throwback to the old days — the A&R guy who is also producer, writes the songs, wardrobe, caterer. He likes to take a rough piece of wood and whittle it into something.

LOURIS: He actually did that one day — he came in with a huge stick of wood and whittled it into a staff. It was a total metaphor.

#### Whose couch is that on the album cover?

PERLMAN: The couch was George's vision, wasn't it? OLSON: It was 20 below zero. We hauled the couch out, we sat on the couch, we shivered, they took the picture, we said, "This is the album cover," and we went home. It's not really a concept. Musicians are just so into their little cult things.

What's the the Jayhawks' cult like?

OLSON: I hope there is none. We're into cabins in the north woods, and as soon as we make enough dough, we're gonna be up there. I'm into a cabin with a full sun deck, a pool, cable TV, bumper pool — I'm into having a nice cabin. A dirt road leading up to it, but once you get there...

How about the Def American staff? How do you like working with Phil Costello?

KEN CALLAHAN: He's a helluva dresser. LOURIS: Definitely a candidate for a Gap ad. CALLAHAN: Do you think his sport coats are too loud?
PERLMAN: When Phil Costello says, "Jump!," the Jayhawks say,
"How high?"

CALLAHAN: A lot of people are telling us to jump lately. I'm getting tired of asking, "How high?"

#### People keep mentioning the Black Crowes when discussing your band. What's the connection?

LOURIS: George Drakoulias and Def, I guess. That's about it. OLSON: I like those guys a lot. In fact, I just saw that "Thorn In My Side" video...

LOURIS: "Thorn In My Pride" ...

PERLMAN: "Thorn In My Foot" — that's a really good song. We were up in their dressing room right after a show in Chicago — we had just met 'em. The first thing they're listening to is [the Band's] "Big Pink." Those guys are alright.

#### Did you swap any fashion tips?

LOURIS: I know that Chris [Robinson] was less than impressed with our clothes when we first met. They're a good role model for us in a way, because they had to wait a long time for their record to come out; they went through a lot of the same stuff we did. They worked real hard, and they're great players. [Laughs.] Think we've sucked up to 'em enough now?

So hard work is a key factor in the Jayhawks' journey?

olson: To come up the hard way — riding in vans, sleeping on floors — is the best way to do it, because you really learn some things about yourself. But there's a limit to sleeping on floors — you can only take that for so long. If you have any self esteem, you can't do that forever.

If you have any self esteem, why would you want to be in HITS Magazine?

OLSON: Did I say I have any self esteem? ■



#### Time to peel some grapes with Angelique Kidjo by Elizabeth Glazner

ngelique Kidjo's personal parable occurred at age six when, performing with her mother's theatre troupe in her native Benin, West Africa, she played the princess called upon

to sing for the king. Kidjo says her music has always been about politics and love. At home, she listened to her brother's western records - James Brown, Aretha Franklin and the Rolling Stones - and though she couldn't understand a word of them, it didn't matter. She was relating emotionally to the music; she was feeling it. She is hoping that Americans can feel it, too.

"Logozo" (Mango) is Kidjo's first U.S. release, sung entirely in the African languages of Swahili, Yoruba, Mina and Fon, and produced by Miami Sound Machine's Joe Galdo, with cameos by saxophonists Branford Marsalis and Manu Dibango. Most of its tracks were written with her husband, French bassist Jean Habrail. The album is a staple on the World Beat charts, an Afro-pop, Euro-disco, American-funk, jazz-folk foray, what Kidjo likes to call "melting pop music."

In her dressing room at NBC studios, minutes before the taping of an appearance on the "Tonight Show," the Paris-based singer plucks a handful of grapes, one at a time, into her mouth. Her passionate speech ascends many subjects, as if she's practicing the scales, all of which goes right over the head of HITS' resident radical bisexual, the passive/aggressive Elizabeth Glazner "Doughnut."

### "Voodoo is the power of our life, our society, and if you want, God."

The songs are all sung in African languages, so what is this English stuff in the liner notes? Are they a translation or a synopsis of the lyrics?

A synopsis. I wrote them like poetry. Can you tell me about the title track. It's my favorite.

"Logozo" is the song of the turtle, who is inviting the human being to learn again how to communicate. "Listen to the song of the tortoise: she lives alone, folded up in her shell with no one to confide in." I found in the rich countries of the West, there is no communication between people. There are no deep relationships because nobody wants to be involved in the problem of the neighbor, of the friend, because that asks a lot of time, a lot of love and a lot of power. It's easier than being involved in somebody's life.

#### How would you describe your music?

I don't like categories. Unfortunately, when you go to buy a record, there are categories of everything. If it was me, I'd put everything together and you come and choose.

#### How was New York?

I love it! I was not expecting the American public to get into something they didn't know and then just give me the proof that it doesn't matter what category—they get the message, they get the vibe and they go for it. Do you mind the comparisons people are always trying to make between you and Grace Jones? [Laughs.] Because of the hair? I



don't think this is Grace Jones' hair. We are very different.

#### What do you think of the U.S.? Your lyrics certainly speak to us, especially in an election year.

It's a beautiful country, but they mistreat people here. They don't have respect for people. They don't have respect for life. All they can go down on their knees for is money. They use the fact that they believe in God to put people in a kind of cage. When the American people voted for

Ronald Reagan, I said, "This country is going down..."

#### A lot of us felt that way.

And then when I saw Bush, I said, "Oh man, this is gonna be worse!" He doesn't talk to me - I feel him very empty, very light, nothing inside -- no truths, no love. This country needs deep change. Black people are on the street killing themselves and using drugs - which is exactly what the politicians want.

Can you highlight some of the

#### lyrics which reiterate what you just said?

In "Tché-Tché," I'm asking myself if money is gonna take the place of human beings. Because in the name of money today, people are killing their mother, their father, their whole family. Today, I'm very curious to see people who can give only time and love to help somebody. It's very rare to find. I'm not afraid to die if everybody's dying. But if we could stop it... I don't know if I could live in the United States.

#### Have you met Jay Leno yet?

Not yet. But everybody's been very nice. They gave me this fruit. I'm excited about doing the show. If watching me can change a second of one person's day, I will be very happy. I know most of the band... Branford, of course,

#### What is your connection to the **Neville Brothers?**

I met them in Paris. I spent time talking about voodoo with Charles Neville. Voodoo comes mainly from Benin.

#### Tell me something about voodoo that I can understand.

Voodoo is the power of our life, our society, and if you want, God.

#### Is it a positive or negative force? It's not exactly about sticking pins into a George Bush doll.

It is normally positive. It is something that can be used to keep the country together. You don't need dolls. It's something you believe in deeply. Like God. You don't see God. You don't know why you believe in God, but you do.

# KING LOZ

No Time To Get A Word In Edgewise with Kingmaker's Loz Hardy

### It seems like so many Brits are one-hit wonders. Do you see yourself as a career artist?

I think our career will keep going as long as we're properly motivated to write songs. And at this moment, I personally am motivated to communicate things through the music. I don't know why particularly, but I am. We do have an immense lack of self-confidence as individuals, but in the band, we have a sense of belonging. The reason me and Myles formed the band is because we were left stranded. All our friends had gone on to university, came back, and were very patronizing towards us. We were on the dole, and a lot of people had given up on us and written us off as failures.

#### Some critics have called you arrogant.

I have no bones being arrogant about the music, no bones about the immense sort of feeling I get about the whole thing, because I really feel as though we've sort of built a life for each other in the band. And the people that went off to university are now in their final years and they're not satisfied with their lives.

In England, if you don't want to go to university when you come out of college — the equivalent of your high school — then you don't get any help or direction from anyone. Mums and dads are not going to see, obviously, any hopes of a career playing music in a band. But it's a really amazing thing to create something, to write a song, perform it and then see people react to it. It's amazing how the whole thing works. This band is something I'm immensely proud of, and I feel, as a 21-year-old, I've achieved an awful lot already and it's still only a pathetic amount of what I want to achieve. Not just in a band, but as a person.

#### You told NME you could have written both "Use Your Illusions" in one day.

That's part of being young, just shouting off about things and not caring for the consequences because that's the way you feel. Flying into L.A., you realize how pathetic and insignificant anyone must feel in such a big place, never mind the world. So that's not a thing you like accepting when you're young.

### Young people seem to focus on the dark side of life. When you get a little bit older, you realize the world is an ugly place but you stop beating yourself up about it.

I know what you're saying. There's some sort of musical analogy in the way the Sex Pistols came along. They weren't in any way constructive to anybody's lives. They were completely destructive, basically telling everyone to fuck off. But something like the Pistols spawned the Clash, who didn't offer any solutions, either, but had a more positive message.

Whether you like it or not, I have a lot of optimism in my work. I don't just focus on the dark side. It's just that those are the motivations at the moment. The things you can get pessimistic about outnumber the optimistic things about a million to one. All the time.

Anyone who values life preciously, on the flip side of the coin, has to value death as well. You can't have one without the other. My whole life, my mood has flipped from being desperately sad to being desperately happy. But dark moments translate a lot better in music because you can become a lot more passionate about them.

#### What's up next?

We've already written the second album. The first album's going to seem pathetic when the second one comes out. And that's not just arrogance. I've written it, so I know how much it means and I know what a step we've taken. It's more what we're trying to achieve, and that's a funny thing to say, because we don't know what we're trying to achieve. When we're not motivated to write the next song, it'll be over. The next song we write might be the last, but we've still got so many good songs and so many good live performances in us that I really don't see that happening.


alk about your easy interviews. Put a ✓ tape recorder in front of Laurence "Loz" Hardy, the creative mainstay of Britain's Kingmaker, say just about anything to him, and he's off and running at the mouth. He's only 21, as he'll be sure to tell you several times during the course of an interview, and this kid is brimming over with energy and youthful hubris. He's bright, sincere and a little longwinded, with a passion that sometimes slips over into arrogance. Like the majority of 21-year-olds, he's got the world figured out, and he wonders why nobody in history has seen things his way. Unlike the majority of 21-year-olds, Hardy has a vehicle for expressing his passion and angst in his band Kingmaker.

Kingmaker was formed in 1990, in a small town in the north of England called Hull. By 1991, they were voted "Best Band" by the readers of NME. With Hardy on vocals and guitar, Myles Howell on bass and John Andrew on drums, Kingmaker produces a dark, muscular strain of indie pop, something like the Wonder Stuff on steroids. "Eat Yourself Whole," their Stateside debut, is a sometimes stunning collection that just may break these guys big time. At least now there's a chance, for Loz has survived the unsavory experience of a close encounter with HITS' own avatar of avarice, Sean O' "07" Neill.

should appeal to those who like challenge and adventure in life. Each song has its own unique and interesting quality, however, I'd recommend for the On-U Sound-influenced, the Adrian Sherwood remix of "Bulletproof" first! (Meredith Chinn)

These Immortal Souls, "I'm Never Gonna Die Again" (Mute/Elektra): Although the Birthday Party/Swell Maps lineage guarantees jagged guitar and a bit of debauchery, the cinematic scope found here may come as a surprise. All arrangements are splashed with a cacophonous stain that seems to zip into



strident crescendos at every turn. But mastermind Rowland S. Howard is an astonaut with his feet on the ground (wrestling anathema throughout) and while matters often verge on sonic brinkmanship, ultimately, it's his twisted vision that pushes These Immortal Souls right over the edge. (Robb Moore)




### What's the point of the lawsuit? Do you want to be in Motley Crue again?

Lonn Friend is a fucking asshole. There's something fucking wrong with that fucking guy. I have no idea why he said that. He's like the guy that starts these fucking rumors. I don't want anything more than my fair share. To have been in something for 12 years and to have it suddenly taken away from you — it's like saying, "Thanks for the 12 years, see you later." That just doesn't work.

# Have you been offered any settlement?

Yeah, it was a slap in the face. It was very insult-

ing. And I gave them time to come up with something that both of us could agree on. It's like they just don't want to hear about it. I had to file a lawsuit. It's amazing to think these guys were friends for 12 years and now it's come down to getting lawyers. Sometimes that has to happen. It's like, when there's money around, they're not friends anymore. I regret this. I just want to get on with my life and with my new band.

### What now?


The ball's really in their court now. If they want to come to the table, then that's the way it will be settled. If not, then I have to go through with everything.

# RERAP

By Mitch Perliss

Get ready for a new format, Not MD or DCC, both of which are scheduled to debut this holiday season, but CD-I (Compact Disc Interactive), the ultimate mass market home multimedia delivery system. What is it? A compact disc standard designed for interactive viewing of audiovisual CDs using a TV set and a CD-I player. You've probably seen the recent TV spots for the Imagination Machine, Philips' CD-I player now available for under \$600. While the ads feature advanced video games, much more will be available shortly, with over 80 titles now on sale and over 300 new programs in production. In addition, both Sony and Matsushita are also producing CD-I players, ensuring there won't be a hardware battle a la VHS/BETA or MD/DCC, and all CD-I players play both standard CDs and CD-I discs. While at this time the storage capacity of a CD is around 74 minutes, Sony has new technology which almost triples the capacity of the disk to about three hours and allows for full motion video (FMV). According to Andrew Davidson, Mgr. Adv. Dev. of Philips Interactive Media of America (PIMA), this new technology is the most

significant milestone vet for the CD-I format. During the recent CD-I Two confab in L.A., Davidson said this technological breakthrough will add the following to existing CDs: 1) Feature Films, with quality better than VHS and virtually identical to an existing laserdisc, 2) Video Collections, which use an on-screen menu, i.e. an exercise disc where the consumer could choose from a complete program only those exercises which pertain to parts of the body they want to work on. Other examples include allowing a customer to choose which cartoons they want to see from a complete program or to pick only the songs they want to see from a greatest hits music video, and 3) CD-I Music Video, i.e. a standard CD with bonus video tracks available only on CD-I. U2 made extensive use of CD-I technology on their current tour and are working on a disc tentatively scheduled for release next summer, and a Bob Marley "Legend" disc is now in development in Europe. Emile Petrone, PIMA Sr. VP Sales & Mktg., said he presented the technology to NARM two weeks ago and it was looked upon by board members as "the next big opportunity." In addition, Petrone has personally met with all the major labels and has reported positive reactions.... While the basic premise is that CD-I software-driven, software is only available now from retailers who either sell or rent the hardware, with 110 Blockbuster stores in SoCal being the only dealers renting both hardware and software. No stores carry software titles at this time, but look for Tower to enter the business soon. Anyone interested in further information should contact PIMA Dir. of Sales Phil Alexander.





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
