Shulman A Giant Again

Derek "And The Dominoes" Shulman will head a new, as yet unnamed record label under the auspices of the Warner Bros.-distributed Giant label, it was announced by notso-gentle Giant owner Irving Azoff, Warner Board Chairman Mo Ostin and Warner President Lenny Waronker.

Most recently Chairman of Atco Records, Shulman began his career as a member of the British band Simon Dupress & the Big Sound, known for their '67 Finnish hit single, "The Kvetching Game." Shulman went on to become lead singer and manager of groundbreaking progressive rock groups the Thamesmen, the New Thamesmen and Gentle Giant.

Shulman joined PolyGram in 1982, rising to Sr. VP of A&R, where he was instrumental in the signing of such acts as Bon Jovi, Cinderella, Tears for Fears, Kingdom Come and the Randy Roberts Skin Flute Orches-

tra. In 1988, Shulman moved to Atco, where he had success with AC/DC and new acts such as Michel'le, Enuff Z'Nuff, Pantera, Dream Theater and others.

Commented Azoff: "Derek is a man of vision, experi-

ence and boundless energy, three qualities you goodfor-nothing loafers would never understand."

Added Ostin: "Who's Derek Shulman? More importantly, who the hell is Irving Azoff?"

MCA/GRP 4 POP & A/C

MCA/GRP Records has been launched as a new label dedicated to pop, adult contemporary and urban artists, it was announced by GRP President Larry "The War of the" Rosen. GRP was co-founded by Rosen and composer Dave Grusin and was acquired by MCA in 1990.

MCA/GRP's first release will be the American debut of Latvian-born Russian super-



star Laima, slated for March 16. The singer's previous album sold over 20 million units in the former Soviet Union and Eastern Europe.

Some of the label's artists, such as **Patti Austin** and **Rob Wasserman**, will move over to the new venture.

Added MCA Records President Richard Palmese: "This new label will create opportunities for select new product to be worked by both GRP and MCA, opening up exciting new possibilities... and it gives me the perfect excuse to take an all-expenses-paid business trip to Moscow."

O Cara Mia

Irene Cara has been awarded \$1.5 million in royalties and damages, ending a tenyear battle against her former label, Network Records and Al Coury Inc. Cara claimed the two companies withheld royal-

ties earned from three albums, including the "Flashdance" soundtrack and her career was severely damaged in the process. After paying off her legal fees, Cara was left with \$1.76.





MCA vs. Curb

MCA Records, Inc., filed a complaint in L.A. Superior Court last Friday (19) for Declaratory Relief against the Curb Music Company regarding master recordings label artists Naomi and Wynonna Judd had previously made for RCA (now BMG) Records. The action also covers payment of artist royalties and promotion costs related to other MCA/Curb artists.

MCA has had an independent production and licensing agreement with Curb Music since 1983. In 1988, the agreement was amended to include the master recordings

of the Judds, who had previously been signed to RCA.

An MCA spokesperson insisted the action was "an attempt to clarify... [and] strengthen, not weaken, the joint efforts of MCA and Curb."

Added MCA attorney Don Engel: "A Complaint for Declaratory Relief is an expedited procedure to resolve disputes. MCA is making no request for damages and is making no attempt to terminate the existing agreement between MCA and Curb. That piece of information'll cost you \$2,500."







t's cold and snowy above the Mason-Dixon line, a fact that gives Mick Jagger much amusement. "I'm not even going to tell you where I am," the possessor of rock & roll's most famous set of lips teases. OK, he's in the West Indies, one of the many exotic climes he lists as occasional residences. But don't regard Jagger as some suntanned slacker - especially not this year when, in addition to turning 50, he's put out his third solo album, "Wandering Spirit," and already begun working on a new Rolling Stones album, with another of the group's blockbuster and record-setting tours planned for 1994.

Interestingly, "Wandering Spirit" is the first Jagger outing conceived and released in a peaceful environment; his previous releases sparked a feud between the singer/pop icon and his childhood friend Keith Richards, with the Glimmer Twins sniping at each other in the press before patching things up in late 1988. The calm shows in the new album, which was co-produced by Rick Rubin. Easily Jagger's best solo work, "Wandering Spirit" is a broad record that finds him shimmying through funk, R&B, country, gospel and some fire-one rockers that remind you this is the man who sang "Satisfaction" and "Jumping Jack Flash." The Mickster apparently feels the same way as he puts down his piña colada just long enough to chat with HITS' snowbound Motown man and misfiring Piston fan, Gary "Litho" Graff.

"Wandering Spirit" has such a broad range of styles, almost like a smorgasbord of what you've explored in the past. Is that by design? I don't know, really. I didn't really set out to say, "OK, I'm gonna do a broad piece." I think it's just how it comes out when you write. Also, maybe it's because I wrote a larger amount of songs for this record and had a bigger choice to pick from. Is it easier to get that breadth on your own albums than it is on a Rolling Stones record? Sometimes it can. But perhaps you don't always want to go for a very eclectic record. You might want to focus on one thing, rather like Charlie Watts doing Charlie Parker [laughs]. I'm not taking a piss at him. But that's one direcAN EXCLUSIVE HITS INTERVIEW WITH MICK JAGGER

tion that can appeal to you when you do a solo record. Mine didn't work out like that: I came up with a lot of other different styles and tried to hang them together. Do you worry about whether they will hang together in the end? You rehearse the tunes, and you can tell. You know if it's working or not. The way I could have done it was to use a lot more musicians, given the fact that there are so many different styles, I could have brought in country musicians to go one way, then R&B guys to go another way. I didn't really do that. I tried to work with a core group so it would stitch together a little.

It's not something I feel a little bit out on a

limb with. I'm familiar with the styles I'm doing, so even though they're stylistically different, it's not a particularly difficult task to switch from one to another. I'm happy within them.

Your main collaborators on "Wandering Spirit" are [producer] Rick Rubin and [guitarist] Jimmy Rip. How did you connect with them?

Jimmy I've known for a while. I met him when I was doing a Bette Midler video for her version of "Beast Of Burden" — I ended up getting custard pie in the mouth. He was in the backing band on the video and we got on well. It's nice to have someone to bounce ideas around with.

I first met Rick - I forget which year - but it

was around the same period, really. He'd just finished doing some LL Cool J record at that point, and I think he had done the first Beastie Boys record. I saw him in New York and he was just out of college. Then he went to Los Angeles and started getting more into rock & roll. He did the Chili Peppers record, some garage bands. I'd done some stuff on my own, some of which is on the album, then I thought, "Well, I think I want to work with someone as a producer," and I thought he might be a good person. It was tentative at the beginning. He's characterized the relationship as confrontational. [Laughs.] I don't know. Maybe. Maybe it's my long history [laughs]. I don't think that's true all the time. I prepare to work in a cooperative mode. You do have differences in any kind of creative process when you're working with someone else. I don't like confronting people with things: I tend to back away from it. But you have to occasionally say, "This is what I think, this is the way I think it should be" and so

on. Otherwise it could go on and on.

Were there particular points of contention in your relationship with Rick?

He tells this story where, in the end, he has me saying. "You're worse than Keith!" I didn't in fact say it that way. The context was, "You're worse than Keith in so far as you don't like any electronic instruments." He hated anything that was made after 1962. There are quite a few people now, still in their 20s, who have this very kind of purist view of rock & roll which I don't share. I find it touching but alarming. There are a lot of things on the record that don't fall into Rick's purview of music, so it was kind of a different experience for him as well. When people come

When people come into the studio to work with you, do they have preconceived notions about Mick Jagger?

I'm sure they have their own ideas they bring with them. I don't know what they are; I don't go around asking them that. I try to get the best I can and have the best time I can. Sometimes it's great and easy; sometimes it's

difficult. I don't know really what prejudices or what baggage people bring in.
They have a lot, that's for sure. I think a lot of times people try to play like the Rolling Stones, which is very difficult [laughs]. "Uh oh, he's doing that again. Don't do that like Charlie does, please. You don't have to."

So how is making a solo album different than doing a Stones record?

In a lot of ways, it's not really all that different. I am aware that I'm where the buck stops: if I say there's something I really don't want, then it doesn't happen. You can also say that about a Rolling Stones album; we're not going to do a song I really don't like or believe in. In the end, [the solo album] is not so much a cooperative event but in some ways it is. It's not just writing out a piece of music and typing it into a computer. There are other people there with opinions and they're not afraid to voice them vociferously. Are the Stones at

Are the Stones at peace with the notion of side projects and solo albums?

I don't know. Keith made a lot of noise about not doing solo projects and now he seems to do them all the

> time [laughs].

Ronnie has always done things outside the band. I think Charlie enjoys doing things very much; I think he gets bored if he only has Rolling Stones stuff to do. I think everyone is more or less, as you say, very at peace doing them.

How did you hook up

How did you hook up with Lenny Kravitz for "Use Me"?

I got to know Lenny in London a little bit on his last tour, and I did a duet with him onstage in Paris. When he came to Los Angeles, I don't know if it was Rick's idea or mine... We were looking to do something with "Use Me," and we thought it might be interesting to try a duet instead of just a straight single-voice piece. It was just one of those things; he wasn't like a complete stranger walking into the studio. We'd already heard how the voices were together. Fortunately, it worked. It's just a bit of a crap shoot, that duet stuff. It's interesting that you used Flea to play styles of bass that are very different from what he does in the Chili Peppers.

Definitely, and he seems to enjoy all that. The style he plays in is normally pretty hard, very different than this. He's technically, a very good bass player, a very

creative guy.

Are you planning your own solo tour?

I don't think I'm going to do any extensive touring at this point. I might do something, but nothing I want to impart right now. It's not going to be some big solo tour... I'll do some promotion for "Wandering Spirit," then go on and start writing the Stones' next album.

What are the Stones' plans right now?

It depends. Some of these Stones albums we work very much on our own before the record comes together. The last one, "Steel Wheels," was very much a songwriting collaboration, but usually we try to prepare a bunch of stuff so there are things to work on. Some of the songs are halfdone or maybe just ideas. I like to go in with something, then we just sit down to collaborate and write. Any thoughts on turn-

Any thoughts on turning 50 later this year?
You don't know if you're going to make it, do you? I don't really have a lot of thoughts on it. It's not something that occupies my every thought. I don't want to give you any big quotes or anything, but when I got to be around 35. I realized that I was going to be doing this for quite a long time.





BREAKING THE MOULD

Time for some sturm und drang with

SUGAR

Bob Mould is the master of sonic massages for the ear canals... walls of guitar fuzz and wail you can hum along to, perfected through his years in the '80s with underground indie heroes Hüsker Dü. He made a strategically acoustic-entrenched retreat with his 1987 solo album, "Workbook," then turned the volume back up for the bleak, bile-filled "Black Sheets Of Rain."

With his new trio, "Sugar," he moves one step back, two steps forward. Working with bassist Dave Barbe, formerly of Mercyland, and drummer Malcolm Travis, a vet of Boston's Human Sexual Response and the Zulus, who were produced by Mould, their Rykodisc debut, "Copper Blue," is rife with static-cling melodics and Mould's dizzy buzz-saw excursions. Though his recordings are often emotional implosions and then explosive releases, Mould is by nature a shy, soft-spoken man, thoughtful though sometimes circular in his answers. A self-confessed fan of manic-depressive distortopop, HITS' bellhop to the stars Darryl "Rigor" Morden awakened from his stupor long enough to chat up Mould about this new life chapter.

Though the response to Sugar has been very positive, did you worry about people saying you were just trying to go back to the trio thing?

Hopefully, everything since '87 has been moving forward, though some of the steps have been a bit of head scratching. Regarding the threepiece thing, the only time I haven't been in a three-piece was the "Black Sheets" tour and I guess some of the solo stuff. I guess this is a return to - if anything else working with friends... people whose time I enjoy as opposed to working with just back-up players. I think that was a problem. Those people had no real involvement in the music. I was showing them how and what to play. After a while, spiritually, that really doesn't go anywhere... it isn't very creative. I prefer people having a say in it. So you got tired of being

I don't mind being in charge; if people aren't lock-stepped, then there's really nothing defeating. But if you're in charge of nothing, it doesn't make any difference. Everybody's got input on this... Everybody's doing promotional work, too. It's a lot more fun that way.

What was the first song you wrote specifically for Sugar? "Helpless." That was one of the first ones that clicked out of the batch. Songs like "The Act We Act," "Hoover Damn" and "I Can't Change Your Mind" ended up fleshed out a lot more. I had a concept to see what would work... knowing what was good or bad and what would be shelved.

Are you still living in a countryside environment or are you more urban now?

I've been living in the New York area for the past couple of years. How does the environment

affect the way you write? For example, "Workbook" seemed to come out of living in the country.

To a degree. I think you get somewhat of a different perspective from living in the city, but I don't think it affects you as much as a rural environment.

What did you get out of doing those two solo albums before launching into a more cooperative band situation again?

I had a great many ideas that never got fleshed out. When Hüsker Dü ended, I had ideas within my own head I'd never had time to really think about. Without having reconciled whatever things I had and tak-


ing a good hard look at myself, the stuff I'm doing now couldn't have happened —all the changing, eliminating and adding... as it still goes through today.

You once told me about seeing Richard Thompson play, and just looking at your hands wondering what you were doing wrong. How do you rate your guitar playing now? [Laughs.] Probably less and getting worse.

You're still one of the loudest guitarists who can still carry a tune.

That's always been my style... my guitar playing is pretty recognizable by now.

Be thorough and concise in the beginning and you'll have more time to kill the competition. Later.
