



Here are some of the latest developments in the Michael Jackson story:

- Friday (11/12), the superstar issued an audiotaped statement saying he was canceling his world-wide "Dangerous" tour, citing an addiction to pain-killing medication prescribed for his scalp, which underwent major reconstructive surgery after it was burned during the filming of a Pepsi commercial. He also cited the pressures of being the target of what he called "an extortion attempt... from these false allegations."
- Jackson immediately flew to Switzerland with Elizabeth Taylor and husband Larry Fortensky, then promptly disappeared.
- On Monday, (11/15), Jackson lawyers Bertram Fields and Howard Weitzman held a jampacked press conference at Century City in L.A. to announce their client was "barely able to function adequately on an intellectual level," due to his addiction to the pain-killers. They also insisted he will return to the U.S., but refused to reveal his present location.



GanGsta Ra on the Ra

The commercial growth of hardcore gangsta rap has been explosive over the past few years, with such artists as Dr. Dre, Snoop Dogg, Eazy E, 2Pac, Ice Cube, Ice-T, the Geto Boys and others selling just as well to white middle-class teenagers hooked on rebellion as they do in the urban markets themselves. The music's detractors claim the tales of drive-by shootings, denigration of women and homosexuals and glorification of drug use set a bad example for the community by glamorizing the gangsta lifestyle, while backers insist the music merely reflects the deteriorating conditions of society.

meanwhile, radio programmers and record company executives are caught in the middle. Should they pander to the masses with a sound that obviously has popular appeal or should they make their own attempt to "Stop the Violence"?

PGC Washington DC MD Albie Dee and his station have both been long-time supporters of hard-core hip-hop. In fact, the station has been #1 in its market for the past five years and has just broken into double digits with a 10+ share in the latest Arbitrons, 14.6 at night. But recently, Dee has declared enough is enough. His "Stop The Violence" movement is his attempt to give something back to the community by refusing to play those songs he feels glorify violence and killing. It is a gauntlet that is being picked up by other stations in other communities, and surprisingly, it is a

move supported by many of the rappers themselves. Hey, you know things are bad when Albie Dee is your voice of reason.

In this special three-part report, HITS' radio rubes "Little Head" Todd Hensley and Connie "C" Breeze, along with Sr. Editor Roy "DJ Joo" Trakin, get on the phone with Albie Dee. a variety of radio programmers and some prominent hip-hop artists about the backlash... and are promptly hung up on.

AN EXCLUSIVE HITS REPORT BY THE USUAL GANG OF BOZOS AND MISFITS

PART I **ALBIE DEE:**

Tell me how the "Stop The Violence" campaign started.

It was originally the brainchild of Dr. Dave Ferguson and Jerry Clifton. The concept was to choose Thanksgiving day as a day of moratorium on violence. From being just a one-day or a month-long event, we have taken it to the point where our benchmark in the community is WPGC, the "Stop The Violence" station. Once a month, we have a promotion called "Adopt A Corner," where we broadcast live from a violence-plagued neighborhood. It's a forum to bring out the people in that neighborhood to come listen to the politicians or the police or the air personalities and stimulate them to take back their own street.

How does WPGC's music fit into this?

We'd play all kinds of street records because they're selling, calling out, requesting. But after hearing the lyrics and reading how violent DC has become, I just thought, "We can't play this and be a 'Stop The Violence' radio station." We care about the community and don't want to be seen as encouraging the violence. Music has become very influential in younger minds. I just didn't feel right playing records with violent lyrics. The artists and la-bels will say, "We're just tellin' it like it is." That is cool, but if you are going to tell it like it is, tell them why not to do a drive-by, why not to take out the snitch, why you shouldn't put a gat in someone's mouth. Reinforce the positive side rather than the negative.

Where do the sex and drug records fit into this?

Teenage sexuality is a different situation. I would rather they sleep with each other with condoms than kill each other with guns. As for the drug records, I'm

not playing them, either. I have a problem with blunts & 40s; if we play them, we flip the words or edit it.

Will things change?

I don't know. I've talked to both the record companies and the artists about it. Violence is everywhere. We have to realize that we have an influence on young people's minds and must be aware what we do with that. It's our responsibility; it's in the contract. It comes with celebrity status. Being a role model is

part of the job.

Yes, there are problems, but why sing about them? I grew up in a neighborhood like that, but this is what I did to get out of it, instead of talking only about how bad it is. Every week I do a talk show called "Yo Listen Up." I went on the air and said, "I'm not here to have all the answers, because I don't have all of them. I am here to open your minds and make you question." My parents did that for me. If we can make even one person stop and think, then the job is done. The music is the same — does it offer a solution. make them stop and question or does it make things worse?

I would like to see more of a conscience coming from the record companies and the artists. I do not condone censorship. I'm talking about change. The only thing I can do is not put these records on my radio station. I will piss off a ton of label people and artists. I still believe in the First Amendment. You do have a right to put your shit out and sell it. But is this the money that I want, or you want? Don't get me wrong.

Some gangsta rap is positive. There is also a lot that is violent and negative. That is the stuff we will not play. I will be accused of censoring. Will it hurt my ratings? I don't think so. Having a transmitter, it's my responsibility. The message I want to get to any programmer reading this is that you have a responsibility to your audience. You have to give back to the community if you want them to give you loyalty. You can make a difference.

PART II PROGRAMMERS RESPOND:

Michelle Santosuosso, APD KKBT Los Angeles:

"It's a hard call for a station like ours because you don't want to play or have any part of anything that is demeaning to the community or to a particular ethnic group. At the same time, there is the issue of censorship. We don't want to not play something our audience loves. For example, 2Pac's 'Keep Ya Head Up' is one of the most positive rap records to come out by a male artist in 1 don't know how long. But 2Pac's personal life is a mess. It's a weird dichotomy because, even though the message in the records may be positive, their personal lives are not in accordance with

their personal lives are not in accordance with what they're saying. But we can't penalize an artist for what they do on their own time. We can, however, listen to the records with a little more scrutiny."

Greg Head, MD KBXX Houston:

"We have played some of these records in the past that would've been characterized as violent. There has been a backlash recently in that most of those records aren't working for us. Right now, we aren't playing any of them. Maybe it's the audience's way of saying they're tired of these kinds of records. We try to be careful with songs that push the line. Eazy-E, Dre, any of these could be considered violent in nature, but they are hits and we do play them if they get big enough.

We have been very involved with the community in 'Stop the Violence' campaigns that run all year long.

We go to schools and talk to the kids on-air about it. We get involved with church organizations. We have to live here, too."

Chet Buchanan, APD KUBE Seattle:

"It has to be taken on a case-by-case basis. You can't make everybody entirely happy. You have to do the best you can for your particular situation. What may work in one market might not work in another. We're involved in 'Stop the Violence' and we get complaints even about DRS's 'Gangsta Lean.' I'm afraid, to some listeners, that it puts the stamp of approval on the gang as a family unit. That's heavy! It's difficult. Sometimes you just have to take the phone calls, bite your lip and hope you're doing the right thing."

Tom Casey, PD KIMZ Dallas:

"We do not jump on those [gangsta rap] records. If we want to think about playing that type of record, we gauge the response of the audience. If it is huge, then we deal with it, but in an extremely day-parted manner. Most of that type of music doesn't get that big, or should I say, it never broadens its scope into the mass appeal. If we do play it and start to get negative phone calls, then we go back and re-evaluate and determine whether or not we can afford not to play it. Actually, the sexual lyrics have been more of an issue for us. We tested some of the harder 'chronic' raps and, in addition to the negative calls, we felt they didn't fit into the positive image the station is

PART III RAPPERS REACT:

Eazy-E:

"It's censor-shit. I don't agree with it, but you don't have to have all that violence, either. I haven't really heard a rap song that glorifies violence. I'm not telling people to go out and kill, rob or steal. My music can bypass radio, but airplay is good, too. I do two different versions if there's a problem, one with gunshots and one without. It's not that hard to do. I think WPGC is overreacting. I don't think the music makes the kids go out and do wrong. Take Dr. Dre. He's just a studio gangsta. That's all he is. Back when he was in the World Class Wrecking Crew, he wore lipstick, lace, biker shorts, eye shadow, eye liner and sequin dresses for songs like 'Rappin' Romance,' 'Cabbage Patch,' 'The Fly,' 'He's Bionic'... it was techno music. Until I took him away from that and he started doing the stuff I wanted him to do, like talking about Compton. He never was from the streets. He just rode on that whole image I gave him. He's no OG; he's a '93 G."

Bushwick Bill, THE GETO BOYS:

"If you just come out on a single note, how can it benefit anyone? If I start out a song killing from beginning to end, and the next song has killing from beginning to end and the next, it becomes redundant. It loses its flavor. One song as a shocker is cool. Six songs based on the same topic is ridiculous. I agree that violence in rap music shouldn't be overplayed to where it becomes boring. Everytime I've ever mentioned anything violent in my music, it has what Alfred Hitchcock would call a plot - a beginning, middle and end. It's not just showing killing without the causes behind it. 'Mind of a Lunatic' showed, if your life is going in this direction, these are the reasons why. Didn't people try to ban 'Psycho' when it first came out? Now it's considered a classic. Censorship is like a revolving door. When you're young, you rebel against your parents. When I become my parents' age, I have to treat my kids the way my parents treated me, so they rebel until they're old enough to do the same with their kids. I say, we have to break the muthaf***ing cycle."

Domino:

"I don't consider myself a gangsta rapper. That's not the way I chose to go. I'm a fun type guy. I'm from the 'hood and all that, but I'm a party person, so that's



what you're gonna get. At the same time, I give you a message, like with 'Raincoat,' where I tell the homies to protect themselves during sex. In some of the songs, I'm just stating, let's have a good time. Domino's album is for the ghetto. If you like it outside the ghetto, good luck to you. I can't agree or disagree with this 'Stop the Violence' movement. Freedom of speech says people should be able to say what they want to say. Heavy metallists talk about what they want to. Same with rap music. It's just a ghetto way of saying it. Gangsta rap is made for gangstas. People that listen to it outside the ghetto choose to do so. But Domino is really against the violence, as far as

shooting people up and stuff... you won't hear it from my mouth. People that rap like that should be telling people it's not the way to go. Don't put that kind of stuff out there because it costs people lives. Rap music does influence people. And I'm gonna be in a positive way for the people. But at the same time, I'm from the 'hood, so you're gonna hear cursing, but not the violence."

Hi-C:

"I'm not a gangsta rapper, but I grew up in the 'hood. I just chose to take a different route. I don't rap about shooting or killing. There has to be a point where you

draw the line. Certain records you have to listen to and think what effect they'll have on young kids. There has to be a limit, because people are living that lifestyle. But Dr. Dre sold three million records; if there were that many people doing the stuff he raps about, it would be chaos. I'm sick of all this kill you, gangsta this, gangsta that. What's next? I try to say positive things to my audience, but in a cool way. You can't just tell them to wear a condom during sex. To me, if rap wasn't as big as it is, there'd be no controversy. Blacks and Latins aren't the only ones listening to rap. White teenagers buy this music more than anybody."

007, FIFTH WARD BOYZ:

"Certainly every programmer has a right to look out for his community by keeping violent lyrics off the air in case kids are listening. A lot of songs glamorize drugs and violence. We have songs on our album that talk about drugs and stuff, but it teaches kids not to do 'em. We're trying to put out a positive message. Putting a song on an album and playing it on the radio are two different things. You have to be 18 years old to buy a Fifth Ward Boyz album and I think that sticker is necessary. I want to get played on the radio, but if it's their wish not to play violent rap, I can't dog 'em for it. People in the community should teach their kids better things. A lot of these gangsta rappers are just trying to show the bad parts of things. That's what rap is. Reality. About people. Things you see everyday. We're giving you the real deal and letting you make your own choice."

E-Rock, FIFTH WARD BOYZ:

"I feel programmers not playing the more violent rap songs is a pretty good idea. But if they're gonna cut out rap, they might as well do the same with R&B, which deals with sexual activities... lick me, suck this, suck that. We rap about reality in the streets. But we don't tell people to go out and kill somebody or smoke drugs. We don't promote that stuff. If kids wanna listen to this, they'll find a way to hear it. If they don't find out about this stuff in a song, they'll find out about it in another situation."





Gene Clark on the alleged LP closer (there are six "secret" tracks.) Strains of Brian Wilson permeate the sure-thing opener "Hold On" and the spooky "Ret Liv Dead." Get intimate with "Thirteen"—it wants to walk you home from school.

US 3 "Hand" (Blue Note/Capitol): Jazz enthusiast Geoff Wilkinson and gifted producer/engineer Mel Simpson have awakened sleeping giants and presided over the most impressive creative endeavor of the year. By bringing together brilliant, cutting-edge young rappers, Britain's top young jazz players and,



most importantly, culling samples from the ground-breaking Blue Note catalog, these two visionaries have created a cross-generational landmark that has united Hip-Hop with its seminal essence. Experience this masterwork in its entirety.



Blur, "Modern Life Is Rubbish" (Food/SBK/ERG): And how. Uninterested in technological tripe like virtual reality, data highways and musical frontiers, Blur deal in day-to-day experiences, while providing this dog's life with a soundtrack of shimmying guitars and infectious melodies. In a

way, Blur elected to make their first album second. While the previous "Leisure" featured Manchester rhythms and swirling psychedelia, the new album embraces classic British pop. If Thoreau were alive today, he'd be vacationing with Blur.

ses," the album's title track represents Bush's interpretation of another non-musical medium, Michael Powell's powerful film "The Red Shoes." In addition to the Alternative radio smash "Eat The Music" and the surprisingly pop "Rubberband Girl," the album shimmers with Bush's patented sensual beauty.






PEDDLE METAL

The dissolution of Dali/Chameleon leaves Kyuss and My Sister's Machine in limbo. Kyuss' new one was already creating a buzz and slated for a late January '94 release. And while it seems like they have their share of fans at Elektra, this one is playing itself out as we write. Important to consider whether or not this is the type of band that fares better for all concerned at a smaller label, where lots of attention can be given to the street. My Sister's Machine, who made a questionable move from Caroline to Chameleon last year, were forced to pull themselves off a national tour this past weekend and will probably watch their work track at commercial radio disappear... We're

stumped why Warners made the move to hold back the Hendrix "Stone Free" to metal. Were they afraid stations were going to jump on Belly early? We'll forgive those at the Bunny who seem to have forgotten that Hendrix evolved and exploded in a time when the airwaves were liberated, similar to what now exists at metal radio today. Moments of brilliance on this from Clapton, M.A.C.C., Pretenders and Seal/Jeff Beck. We'll also forgive

them as someone had the insight to include Nigel Kennedy. Finally, you now know where Donna Karan got the inspiration for her trendy winter jacket and vest... November 22, 1963. Where were you?... Retail debuts from Hendrix tribute at lucky 13, Revco and Unleashed. "Ten" moves back into the Top 10, giving the Pearl Jammers two up there on top. 83 stations reported this week for spins with airplay debuts from Atheist and Eleven. Sepultura and Fight continue to dominate the top two positions for spins and phones. Carcass brings 44 stations on board with their first track from "Heartwork".... What band will be making a management change in '94, only management doesn't know it yet, while which now-platinum act will be paying elephant bucks to the manager they tried to get rid of after she nailed a major support slot for them?... What's Atlantic's Mike Gitter got up his sleeve?... 



"I used to be more awkward and self-conscious until I got in a dress."

lthough L.A. rock group Greta call their debut Stardog/Mercury album "No Biting," the music rips right down to your funny bone with inspirations that range from Frank Sinatra, the Beatles and the Kinks to the Ramones and Jane's Addiction. The first track. "Fathom," however, displays the band's more serious side. Says the band's Josh Gordon about the song: "I thought one of the freest ways you could kill vourself would be to go out into the ocean and just let the tide take you." Of course, that was before he spent some time with a woman who gave him a new perspective on oxygen deprivation, HITS' own oral version of the Bermuda Triangle, Joan "Deep Throat" Tarshis.

OK, I'll bite. Why do you perform in a dress?

PAUL PLAGENS: I wore a dress on Halloween two years ago because I was dressing as a woman, and it felt good. On this tour, sometimes I haven't even worn one. I really don't want people to say, "Oh, that's the band with the guy in the dress." It helped a lot in the beginning when you're playing around clubs and you need anything that you have to get people's attention. First they'd notice the dress and then they'd listen to the music, which is really what we wanted. It's also like an alter ego... When I'm the Greta guy in a dress, it frees me as far as being able to perform. I used to be more awkward and self-conscious until I got in a dress. It was like, "I'm in a dress anyways... so nothing matters up here."

When you say, "It's only fear," in "Jesus Crux," what kind of fear do you mean?

PAUL: I was specifically writing about Christianity. There are a lot of

people driven to religion who cling to it out of fear. People are scared of saying there actually is nothing after death. Even if that's true, it doesn't take away the importance or magic of your own life. You can still be magical without necessarily having to believe in something that tells you where you go after you die.

Do you think anything really happens after you die?

JOSH GORDON: I would like to think there's something else, like in "Defending Your Life." I would love to think that happens. But I can also see it as, once you're dead, you're dead and that's pretty much the end of it. At the same time, that seems ridiculous. I guess it's possible that everything's completely random and that things happen by chance. But it just seems there's an energy to human beings that's too silly to mean nothing.

PAUL: That energy could just be life. We don't have anything to compare it to. If we were to just die and there was nothing, what would it feel like?

Then you don't believe in fate?

PAUL: Actually, I believe very much. I have to explain this to people because I am pretty much an atheist. But on the other hand, I've always gone on intuition. I'm very concerned about karma. There must be a reason why karma works — just by the force of the Universe. Maybe in thousands and thousands of years, scientists will even be able to put a name to it. All these things could be just part of the plan. A natural law.

JOSH: With natural law, you're dealing with actual matter. Wind is something you can feel and it is composed of actual matter — neutrons, electrons and even some bacteria. You might not want to call karma supernatural, but it's a lot more abstract than air. It's something that you wouldn't necessarily be able to put under a microscope to analyze.

PAUL: A thousand years ago, air was perhaps just as supernatural as the way we look at karma now.

What's the closest you've ever come to setting the school on fire?

PAUL: I told this teacher to get her

dirty paws off me.

SCOTT CARNEGHI: I put an M-80 down a toilet and blew it up. And they had to send for a plumber. My dad's a plumber, so he fixed the toilet and got paid for it. It was a total "Beavis & Butt-Head" thing.

PAUL: I was really a good student. I'm a more passive-aggressive personality type, so that's why I ended up writing a song about how I really felt. I ended up leaving school anyway in the middle of the 11th grade; I just couldn't stand it. Sometimes I regret not going to college, but I had other things to do.

In "Off The Slug," you write about a guy who is going to make girls "pay for what his mother done." How?

JOSH: That's one of my favorite lyrics that Paul's ever written. It just sums it up. That's exactly what Ted Bundy and Henry Lee Lucas are doing. Everything their mothers did to them brought them to the place they are today. Every woman becomes their mother.

PAUL: The guy in the song isn't a serial killer; he's just out to screw, to show his peacock feathers and display his dominant male power. I confront

some of my own demons in that song. You can't really point a finger—the thing that I'm talking about is in a lot of men... to a smaller or larger degree. It's not that I think I'm without blame, but again there are guys I know who are really macho... the way they look and treat women is so backwards. Nothing's going to go forward with that kind of attitude. When you see this kind of attitude in humans, you suddenly realize why civilizations keep repeating their mistakes.





better when you're on-air. However, that is not to say that one must never, ever exceed: 10 seconds in a backsell, or that something is inherently wrong with using recorded drops, sound effects, etc. There's nothing wrong with the aforementioned. What's wrong is overuse to the point where the essential "you" is diminished. If you were a serious painter, you wouldn't necessarily use every color on your pallette. You'd use only the ones required to put across a particular artistic point. It's the same with your on-air presentation. Use only what you need in a given situation. Avoid possible listener confusion and potential punch-out. Think generally in terms of one thought/image per talk set beyond established formatics and leave it at that. Later.



Don't close the books yet on the EAS anti-theft source tagging issue. Things are just starting to heat up! Things looked settled last March when NARM had endorsed the Sensormatic System for the manufacturers to use in tagging jewelboxes and cassettes before they leave the pressing plants. But, according to an RIAA press release last week, it looks as though we might be back to the drawing board. "The first criteria for an EAS system," says the release, "is that there be no adverse affect on either audio or video product. Unfortunately (Ed. note: Uh-oh), the consensus of the companies is that acoustomagnetic technology degrades the sound quality of the cassette product to an unacceptable degree. Specifically, the 'toaster' deactivator and the 'wand' activator created problems." So, does this put us back to square one? "I don't think so," says NARM's Jim Donio, "We have no hard copy of their data. So until we see the facts, it's premature to say anything other than we'll look at it." Donio would not comment on whether or not NARM's endorsement of Sensomatic's systems could be in jeopardy. The distributors are definitely open to looking at other systems. "If NARM wants to propose... that the [record] com-

panies test alternative EAS technologies," says RIAA's statement, "the companies stand ready to respond immediately." mediately? It has taken the Big Six a full eight months to get back to NARM on the Sensormatic systems. "This has been a very cumbersome process from the get-go," says Donio, "but we're confident that the distributors have done their testing as quickly as was possible. Would we have liked it to be faster? Sure, but it wasn't. No one is taking this lightly. We will look at their test results and make a recommendation." Stay tuned... National Record Mart has signed a definitive agreement to acquire a nine-store chain of mall-based music stores from Leonard Smith Inc. of Albany, N.Y. The stores are operating under the names of Music For You, One-Stop Entertainment Center and Merle's Record Rack. NRM's Bill Teitelbaum confirms that the stores will be undergoing an immediate name change to NRM Music. Look for more action to follow as NRM is currently in negotiations to acquire several more small chains... OK, OK!! For all those who called in rebuking us (and rightly so) for giving the incorrect title last week of White Zombie's CD. The correct title is, of course, "La Sexorcisto: Devil Music Volume I." But please, people, you are not supposed to be reading this column. NO ONE READS RERAP. It's got a silly name and it's buried in the back of the mag. Please don't embarrass yourself by admitting to reading it. While we're at it, did we mention that "La Sexorcisto: Devil Music Volume I" is past gold and looking for platinum status? 
