


R ^{obert} Zemeckis has become one of Hollywood's most consistent

hitmakers, thanks to such blockbusters as "Who Framed Roger Rabbit" and "Back To The Future," both of which earned \$350 million worldwide as well as "Romancing The Stone" and "Death Becomes Her."

Along the way, the Chicago-born, USC School of Cinema graduate has also gained a reputation for his inspired and imaginative use of highly innovative filmmaking techniques. Now, Zemeckis has had a chance to push the envelope even further with his new film, "Forrest Gump." Starring Tom Hanks as the slow-witted eponymous hero, the film, which also starts Robin Wright, Sally Field and Gary Sinise, follows the unlikely adventures of Gump across several decades and several key historical events including in-person meetings with the likes of Presidents JFK, LBJ and Nixon. Played out against a musical background of classic cuts that ranges from Elvis singing "Hound Dog" and Dylan's "All Along The Watchtower" performed by Jimi Hendrix, to "Get Down Tonight" by KC and The Sunshine Band and "On The Road Again" by Willie Nelson, both the movie and its Epic Soundtrax album have spent the summer near or at the top of their respective sales charts. HITS' Brit git lain "And Out Burger" Blair, whose own IO makes Gump seem like a Mensa. hopelessly attempts to match wits with the talented director.

How important is music in your films?

It's always been a vital component, and it was especially important in this movie because we were moving through so many different eras, so we used various songs and tracks to evoke those times. I think everyone relates to important events in their lives through a song or piece of music you remember from that time. **The soundtrack is prety eclectic, with everything from Hendrix to a classical composer like Edward Elgar.** The whole movie is really about the coming-ofage of a generation and a country, so when the movie starts, I wanted to have the contrast between a song like "Lovesick Blues" by Hank Williams and the '50s raucous rock & roll of Elvis belting out "Hound Dog." Then, when it moves



through the war in Vietnam and Kennedy's assassination and the moon landing, I wanted all the nostalgia of songs like "Aquarius/Let The Sunshine In," "San Francisco" and Bob Dylan's "Blowin' In The Wind." For me, the soundtrack really functions like another character in the film. **How involved were you in choosing individual songs?** I was executive producer of the soundtrack, along with Joel Sill and Glen Brunman, who are really great at putting these albums together. Between us, we came up with every choice. It was a lot of fun for me, because individual songs bring back so many memories. I think it's a really strong soundtrack.

Is every track in the movie soundtrack on the CD? No, it's slightly different, because of rights. The movie soundtrack includes some stuff like "Camelot" by Lerner and Loewe, and "Pomp And Circumstance" by Edward Elgar, that didn't really fit on the CD, which we decided to make a double album of classic American songs. In fact, we used so much music in the movie that you would have had to release a triple-CD to fit most of it in.

I notice that you collaborated with composer Alan Silvestri once again for the "Gump" score.

He's scored all my films since "Romancing The Stone" and we just work really well together. I like having a team around me of the same people. It saves so much time when they know the kind of thing you want.

You obviously get offered a lot of projects. What was the appeal of making a film like "Forrest Gump"? The technical aspect of any film I do is always secondary. I was just very impressed by Eric Roth's screenplay. I thought it was very compelling, very unconventional and I saw immediately in my mind how to make the movie. What were some of the technical challenges of putting Gump into the scenes with the former Presidents? The main one was, it's one thing to put a


character in a frame with someone else, but the scenes where he meets Kennedy, LBJ and Nixon called for actual interaction, both physical and verbal. So we had to figure all that out, and we found there are only two ways to do it. One is, you use look-alikes, which in my opinion don't have the weight, or two, you go with the way we chose and use the real people from newsreel footage. Then the question is, how do you do that? So the ILM [George Lucas' Industrial Light & Magic] people and Ken Ralston, my main guy, and myself all sat down and figured out what scenes we needed and then started looking for archival footage we could use. After wading through hours and hours of film, we'd find pieces that might work, and then we'd go back and revise the scene so that it would fit, but keep the same intent. Because, in the original script, there were all these fantastic scenes that were very funny but impossible to do, so it was like a balancing act where we'd keep tailoring the bits until they worked. And to match the original footage, we shot on 16mm hand-held, and then Ken Ralston and his team would isolate, say, Kennedy's image, and use the computer to blend it into our scenes. Tell us a bit about the new technology used in the movie

I don't know exactly what new technology was developed during the shooting. I guess they just kept supercharging their computers and getting faster. I'm very impressed at the way the images are filmed now, because that's the key digitizing images to create that piece of negative. In addition to the scenes with dead Presidents, there are some great visual tricks, such as the opening and closing feather sequences and Tom's stunning pingpong abilities.

The ping-pong stuff was actually a mix of effects and real action, because Tom's a very good player, so I just mixed it all up. As for the feather, it was all digital, but the resolution is so incredible that it's impossible to tell.

How much of a new approach to visual effects does "Gump" represent?

Completely. For me, it's the first time I only had to get close, meaning for example, in the same

the production company that they wanted to use five Doors' songs in the movie 'Soul Kitchen,' 'Break On Through,' 'Hello, I Love You,' 'People Are Strange' and 'Love Her Madly.' And immediately, we went, 'Time out. We don't give five Doors' songs to anybody.



Maybe one or two, if the movie is really good.' So they invited us down to a screening. I went with [Doors drummer] John Densmore and a few other people and I thought the use of the songs in

the movie was so tastefully done or, as we said in the '60s, 'right on,' that we gave them the OK to use all five, even if they did use only excerpts. There's a wonderful sequence where Tom Hanks is

playing ping-pong and the click-clickclick of the ball against the paddle and the table segues into ohn playing the sidestick on his snare in 'Break On Through.' I saw that and thought, 'Brilliant.' That's the juxtaposition of

scene where Tom shakes Kennedy's hand, all he had to do was get near. By contrast, when I did "Roger Rabbit," such effects had to be perfect, because it was an optical. So when Bob Hoskins reached to where the rabbit had to be, he had to hit the mark absolutely perfectly and mime perfectly. But Tom never had to hit the mark or mime perfectly, because the computer can manipulate all that. And I think that's very liberating, because now you don't have to beat up the actor to get a shot like that. Poor Bob had a hell of a time doing "Roger" and if we'd had these computers then, it would have been a piece of cake.

And such new effects seem like they're only the tip of the digital iceberg.

Without a doubt. We're looking at the equivalent of the Model T Ford here. There's no way we can predict where this technology is going, and I don't think any of us realize how profound a change this is.

Most of your films have really pushed the technological envelope. Are you a tech-head?

[Laughs] You mean am I a tech-weenie? Yes and no. I'm interested in it enough to know how it all

generally works, and I think you should be like that. You should know how a car works and how the human body functions. But I don't want to learn enough to be able to perform open-heart surgery. What was your original inspiration to become a director?

Going to the cinema in Chicago as a kid and realizing they were manipulating my emotions. I thought, "This is some real power here." So it's a power trip for you?

[Laughs] It did start that way, and I guess you could boil it down to the fact that it's very satisfying to be able to communicate an idea and stimulate an emotion in a bunch of strangers in a dark room by just using shadows.

Who were your idols growing up?

All the classic American directors like Capra and Ford as well as Hitchcock and David Lean, although they're British. I was really inspired by all the classic American movies.

You've also worked in TV, recently producing and directing a pilot for a new CBS series, "Johnny Bago." Do you like to work in TV?

No, I hate it! I hate working in commercial TV, meaning the networks, because of the insane and arbitrary censorship. But I love doing "Tales From The Crypt" for HBO. I love being on cable. What's next for you?

I don't know. I just like to do one project at a time. What's the best part and worst part of being a director? The best part is making the movies. The worst part is having to open them.

What's your philosophy of filmmaking?

It's about involving your audience in character and story and moving them emotionally, whether it's making them laugh or thrilling and scaring them. That's what it's all about to me.



Separated from Brit-pop by more than 15 years and an expanse of ocean, the music that emanates from Saratoga Springs' the Figgs contains the genetic material of Elvis Costello and the Undertones with an ample dose of good ol' yankee Replacementality. The result is an ingenious and individual update to the pure pop monster. Their debut album, "Lo-Fi At Society High" (Imago), with the errant and lusty "Wasted Pretty," the awkwardly elegant "Waltz For Bob" and the stop-and-go momentum of the first single, "Favorite Shirt," whisper

greatness for these hyperintelligent young men. Despite their youth, the four band members have been together as the Figgs for more than seven years, literally growing up together, musically and otherwise. When musical references are aired, along with more obvious allusions, to the aural tomes of Angry Young Men, bassist/singer Pete Donnelly, guitarist/singer Mike Gent, guitarist Guy Lyons and drummer Pete Hayes speak reverently of

"Lo-Fi At Society High" is your major label debut, but tell me about earlier Figgs work. PETE DONNELLY: We recorded a couple of albums ourselves that are on cassette only. [Indie label] Absolute A-Go-Go put out some 45s, too. Did you guys feel comfortable going to a major label after your DIY efforts? DONNELLY: Yeah. Because we're not sacrificing our music or anything. We didn't have to make any changes. We still do what we do. Now we have an actual budget to do it, the possibility of touring a lot more and maybe selling some records. How did you like working with Don Gehman in his legendary New Age studio environment?

PETE HAYES: It's funny because he's into the crystal thing, but he's not ridiculous about it. It was very cool, very interesting.

DONNELLY: He was into creating a vibe. I know this sounds far-out but, I'll put it as bluntly as I can. Spirit, or space, was comfortable for him. He had lights and a little wizard on the mic, lots of incense, oils... just things he associated with.

MIKE GENT: Incense and

peppermints... DONNELLY: We did the whole

thing on an analog 24-track, in a church. Everything was totally natural; the reverb on the drums was the room. What did you guys listen to when you

were growing up?

HAYES: A lot of Replacements. We liked a great deal of early '80s punkrock, but we also liked a lot of classic rock — Stones, Beatles, the Kinks, Black Sabbath. DONNELLY: Everything that's good. All kinds of rhythm & blues,

soul, Motown. GENT: Spanish music.

GUY LYONS: As soon as we started playing instruments, it was like, let's be in a band.

HAYES: We started with cover tunes. We did, like, the whole, entire Velvet Underground catalog. DONNELLY: We could do rock blocks of Ramones, Husker Du, Velvet Underground, Rolling Stones, Beatles and Kinks. We'd start playing it and we wouldn't remember the bridge, so we'd just start playing another one. HAYES: We still do some Kiss and Judas Priest live.

GENT: We're doing a Fuggs tune, "I Couldn't Get High."

Did you guys know that this is what you'd be doing for a living?

DONNELLY: To a large extent, yes. When Pete joined the band in '89, we were working a lot, so it was pretty serious.

HAYES: It's hard to really plan, because you really never know where you're going to be. DONNELLY: When we started, when we were all 13 and 14, all we did was play.

Guy, you left the band for awhile to join the army and even served in the Gulf War. What prompted that?

LYONS: It was really an experimental thing. Instead of watching things on the news, I sort of wanted to be involved. I was in Germany, and I didn't necessarily "THE MORE I SEE OF THE MUSIC BUSINESS, THE MORE I UNDERSTAND 'SPINAL TAP. EVERY DAY THERE'S ANOTHER EPISODE."

know I was going to be in a war. What are you guys listening to now? GENT: On the road, we listen to a lot of AM Spanish radio and sports. DONNELLY: A lot of blues, '80s punk.

HAYES: The Verlaines. I just bought a Soft Boys record, Five-Eight, the Breeders. The Prisonshake album is great. DONNELLY: I tend to listen to things that are more than 50 years old. Like turn-of-the-century stuff, the roots of American music, ragtime, early jazz. You can hear the origins of all these blues tunes that everybody knows. I mean, if you like music, you just keep going back. Speaking for myself, I love Bach, Beethoven and Mozart. And James Brown.

Being from Saratoga Springs, one of the most important Revolutionary War cites, have you ever thought of composing any songs based on the war?

HAYES: We'd be getting into the "Spinal Tap" area there, I'm afraid. Is that so wrong?

HAYES: It's funny, the more I see of the music business, the more I understand "Spinal Tap." Every day there's another episode. •

Never seeming contrived, this major label debut ranges from crunchy, powerful hooks ("Broken Eyes") to mesmerizing grooves ("Pull The Plug"). Though guitarist Bo Taylor's vocal ied under thundering guitars. Mitch Faster's pro-

delivery is sometimes buried under thundering guitars. Mitch Easter's production continues to give new emphasis to the definition of the term "power trio." Simply put, "Stay Loaded" is punk rock circa 1974, reinterpreted for 1994. Listen to Chapel Hill's neighbors and learn. (William Dunavant)

Giant Sand, "Glum" (Imago): For years. Howe Gelb has been creating a blend of desert sun-baked, psychedelic country/folk songs. ranging from Crazy Horse-style rockers to traditional country. Gelb's unconventional guitar wanderings are the central force behind this revolving door band, but occasional band member Victoria Williams adds her own spin to "Painted Bird" and



"Spun," while their late friend Pappy Allen croons the Hank Williams classic "I'm So Lonesome I Could Cry." Lisa Germano and Peter Holsapple also make guest appearances. On this major label debut, Giant Sand continues to explore new musical terrain. (Chris Carey)



Daniel Johnston, "Fun" (Atlantic/AG): Daniel's major label debut is also his first release in three years. Since moving to Austin in the early '80s, his songs have been covered by artists as varied as the Dead Milkmen and the Velvet Underground's Moe Tucker. "Fun," recorded with the musical help of the Butthole Surfers' Paul Leary and King Coffey, contains 18 tracks ranging from

the amusing cello and voice combination of "Happy Time," to the wonderful fuzz-fest of "Psycho Nightmare." A view of the world from Johnston's perpective is something not to be missed. He really understands what it takes to write and perform songs from the heart. (Cmdr. Dickie Winn)

Sloan, "Twice Removed" (DGC): From the fertile, rolling hills of Halifax, Nova Scotia, the Canadian province that birthed Jale, Eric's Trip and Hardship Post, comes this sparkling document of eccentric pop. Strains of the late '60s San Francisco sound pervade the LP's opener "Pen Pals," composed of brilliantly strung together letters from non-native English speaking fans, as well as



the melancholy chorus hook of the radio-ready "Coax Me," while Association-like harmonies propel the sloe-eyed jangle of "People Of The Sky." Producer Jim Rondinelli provides seamless production in linking the disparate yet complementary ideas of four individual songwriters and musicians.

RADIO: I cannot overemphasize this: Be yourself! Between the airchecks I receive and the stations I hear while on hold, I get to listen to a lotta jocks. The most common flaw: A contrived sound. The cause, as I see it: An attempt to sound "sexy." This can, and usually does, take you over the top and into the realm of the unreal. Listeners can hear this and, though they can't identify what's wrong, they know this ain't quite right. If you have no direct competition or a competitor who is similarly contrived, you're fairly safe. But, all things being equal, "real" wins out over "unreal" every time. To the listener, "real" *is* sexy. It's a natural thing. You don't have to try. Aircheck yourself regularly. Do you believe that person? More next week. Later.






