# New & Improved: Using The 1998 Artist Roster Report

In past years, the **Artist Roster Report (ARR)** has focused on country music, including a handful of other-genre artists. This year, we have added the rosters of the area's thriving Christian record labels, increasing our coverage of Christian artists from seven to 133. This addition drives the total number of Gallery artists from last year's 233 to 365. Interestingly, amid talk of diminishing rosters on the country side, this year's 232 non-Christian artists is larger than last year's 226. Another prominent change is that where possible, an A&R contact is listed for each artist.

Those familiar with this reference guide know that its secret weapons are the appendices. This year, the **Label Appendix** has been expanded with a photo listing of A&R staffs, along with their submission policies. As always, the **Management, Booking** and **Publicity Appendices** are easy access listings of prominent artist team players.

Methodology: With a few notable exceptions, the artist Gallery is based on record company rosters provided by our friends in label publicity departments. Their tireless work, for which we are extremely appreciative, forms this book's foundation. Companies are included in an appendix only if they represent a Gallery artist. Also, each company's list of artists includes only those with an entry in the Gallery—they may have other clients.

An endeavor of this magnitude lends itself to omissions or mistakes, and we apologize in advance for those. In our ongoing quest to shape **ARR** into one of your most valuable reference materials, we invite your comments, corrections and suggestions.

Claudia Church was born in Lenoir, N.C. and spent most of her early childhood on her grandparents' farm because her father, an Army Green Beret, traveled to places too remote for his young family. "We were all huge country music fans," says Claudia, "and always had something playing, especially at dinner time." After graduating from high school in Colorado, Claudia went to college in Texas and began performing at various Oprys on the weekends, including the *Louisiana Hayride*. After graduation, she made her first trip to Nashville with demo tape in hand. The visit was eve-opening.

"I felt like I needed to live a little more to actually feel what I was singing about."

Claudia went back to Dallas and began modeling and was soon offered a job in Paris. "I decided this was my chance to really learn about life. What an experience it was!" After a year in Europe, she returned to the U.S. ready to perform.

In 1988, Claudia moved to Nashville and began singing on demos and acting in various country music videos. She also began searching for songs that would fit her as an artist. The results will be seen on her debut album coming in early 1999.
