

INSTRUCTIONS: READ BEFORE USING

In past years, the **Artist Roster Report** has focused on country music, including a handful of other-genre Nahsville-based artists. Last year we added the rosters of the area's thriving Christian record labels, and continue that inclusion this year. Both the Christian and country music industries have undergone some changes, but the total number of Gallery artists remains fairly constant; last year's

Gallery boasted 365 entries, this year, 353. Interestingly, amid talk of diminishing rosters on the country side, this year's total of 219 mainstream artists is not terribly shy of last year's 232. We've also again included an A&R contact for each artist where possible.

Those familiar with this reference guide know that its secret weapons are the appendices. The Label Appendix includes a listing of A&R staffs, along with their submission policies and photos when available. As always, the Management, Booking and Publicity Appendices are an easy access listing of prominent artist team players.

Methodology: With a few notable exceptions, the artist Gallery is based on record company rosters provided by the respective label publicity departments. Their tireless work, for which we are extremely appreciative, forms this book's foundation. Companies are included in an appendix only if they represent a Gallery artist. Also, each company's list of artists includes only those with an entry in the Gallery—they may have other clients.

An endeavor of this magnitude lends itself to omissions or mistakes, and we apologize for those in advance. In our ongoing quest to shape the **Artist Roster Report** into one of your most valuable reference materials, we invite your comments, corrections and suggestions.

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



Dixie Chicks have pecked their way to the top of the industry roost this past year with attendance records, sell-out shows and an enduring spot on top of the charts. Along with dates on the 1999 Lilith Fair tour, the Chicks also joined the two biggest road shows of the summer, The George Strait Festival and Tim McGraw's A Place In The Sun tour. They could also be found on the soundtrack to *Runaway Bride*, starring Richard Gere and Julia Roberts. Their sophomore album *Fly*, released in August, was shipped double platinum and sold an impressive 341,000 copies in its first week.
