#### CMA Honors Jo Walker-Meador

Former Country Music Association Exec. Director **Jo Walker-Meador** was honored Feb. 6 at a surprise unveiling of a bronze plaque and photograph commemorating her many achievements at CMA. The plaque is prominently placed in the CMA lobby between similar plaques honoring the contributions of WSM/Nashville executive and former CMA awards show Exec. Producer **Irving Waugh** and CMA Counsel Emeritus **Dick Frank**. The ceremony took place in the CMA's atrium lobby, with CMA Board members and other invited guests on hand. Walker-Meador commented, "I'm so honored and so overwhelmed that I hardly know how to express my love and my gratitude and my pride in how CMA has grown."

She joined CMA in its founding year of 1958 as Office Manager and became the organization's Exec. Director in 1962, a position she held until she retired in 1991. She was inducted into the Country Music Hall of Fame in 1995.

In fact, **Martina McBride's** twoweek No. 1 with "Blessed" last March was the only No. 1 Country song by a woman in 2002.

And, it bodes especially well for the state of the music when it happens twice in less than two months. #### R&R/Bulleye: Are Listeners Connected?

This week's **R&R** Country Callout America by Bullseye Callout question is a two-parter. We asked 350 Country radio listeners between the ages of 25 and 54 (50% Male, 50% Female) the following: "Do you have access to the Internet from home or work?" and "If so, aside

from work related activities, what is the primary reason you log onto the Internet?"

Of the total sample, 61% said they had access to the 'Net. The 35-44 crowd led the way with 69%, Country P1s were next at 65%, and Females and 25-34 adults were both at 63%. The lowest cell was 45-54 adults, at 56%.

As you might expect, e-mail is the No. 1 reason for logging on, with 41% of the total sample giving that as their answer. All of the cells, except for those 45-54, fell between 40%-44%. The 45-54s came in at 36% for e-mail.

To "get news, sports or other information was a distant second, scoring 41% of the total sample. The 35-44 cell led the way here with 10%, while Males and 45-54s were on the low end with 5%. All of the cells came in between 5-10%. "Visit a specific web site" was next, with 7% of the total sample. The responses across cells and demos were all between 6%-10%.

"Listen to or purchase music" was next, with just 5% of the total sample giving that as the reason they got on the 'Net. Responses across the board were between 4%-7%.

For complete breakouts — including Men and Women, 25-34, 35-44 and 45-54 — check out the Bullseye Callout research page in the Feb. 14 issue of **R&R**.

By the way, the callout page also contains R&R/Bullseye Callout research for the Top 35 titles on the R&R Country chart. You'll see percentages for "Like a Lot," "Total Positives," "Neutral," "Familiarity," "Dislike" and "Burn" based on a 400-person-per-week sample. Plus, there's a new password allowing you to access regional and demo break-outs of the callout music research at Bullseye's web page, www.bullsi.com. A reminder: When you go to the website, use your station call letters as the user name. Then enter the new password.
