## R&R/Bullseye: Where They Listen, And The Top Dayparts

This week **R&R**/Bullseye CallOut America asked Country radio listeners about their listening habits. This gives a 500-person sample for this two-part question: "Where do you most frequently listen to the radio?" and "What time of day do you most frequently listen to the radio?"

Of course "In the Car" listening outpaced "At Home" and "At Work" by a two-to-one margin. Of the total sample, 48% said they listened to radio most often in the car, while 22% said at home and 24% said at work.

There is a bit of divergence between P1s and P2s as to where they listen. While 48% of P1s said they listened in the car, 21% said at home and 25% said at work. Among P2s, where 48% said they listen most in the car, 25% said at home and 21% said at work.

More males listen at work (27%) than they do at home (20%). On the other hand, more females (25%) listen at home than at work (22%).

Across the age demos, 22% of 25-34s, 21% of 35-44s and 24% of 45-54s listen at home, while 26% of 25-34s, 23% of 35-44s and 25% of 45-54s listen at work.

As for when they listen, 46% of the total sample say mornings, 27% middays, 17% afternoons, 8% nights and 2% overnights.
