And I was only 27 when I came to WAMZ. I had no idea this stop was going to be a whole career. However, I'm really glad it's turned out this way."

The news wasn't quite as good about his conversation with Keith. "There was a malfunction with the tape machine, and not one bit of it got recorded," he moaned. "I thought he was calling about his new chain of bars. Needless to say, I enjoyed the news he gave me more."

- **Jan. 3, 2005:** The first reporting day of the new year. Adds from Mediabase-monitored stations and reports from R&R Indicator stations will be taken until 3pm ET, as usual. You will get an **R&R Country HotFax** on the morning of Tuesday, Jan. 4 with this music information.

R&R/Bullseye:

This week's R&R Country Callout America by Bullseye question asked 325 Country listeners if they'll be traveling this holiday season, how and how far they will be going. As for distance, 13% were traveling 100 miles or less, 15% said they'd traverse between 100 and 500 miles, and 10% said they'd venture beyond 500 miles.

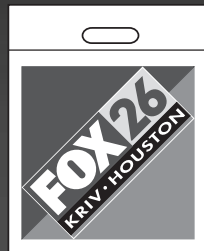
