Sony Takes Promotion Back To The Future

Seventeen months after Sony/Nashville restructured its promotion department to create a more centralized national structure over its Epic and Columbia imprints, another reorganization is underway that will create national staffs for the individual labels.

Under the new alignment, Sony/Nashville Sr. VP/ Promotion Larry Pareigis will become Sr. VP/ Promotion for Columbia/Nashville. The label's new Director/National Promotion is Tom Moran, who in August joined Columbia for Midwest promotion duties. Leading Epic/Nashville's promotion department is Sony/Nashville VP/Promotion Bill Macky. Epic's Director/National Promotion is Buffy Rockhill, who has served in that capacity for Sony/Nashville. Pareigis, Macky and Rockhill previously served in their respective capacities for both Epic and Columbia.

Sony/Nashville President **John Grady** explained the situation to **R&R**, saying, "I'm the guy who created it the way it was, and I'm the guy who's going to change it back because the two labels need to compete. There was way too much duplication; we were running into ourselves on the street. Regional promotion staffs need to have clear-cut priorities and a dedicated national promotion staff to back them up. Priorities were getting muddied and I wanted each label to have a

Speaking of Tucker and Wagner, RCA/Nashville VP/Promotion **Mike Wilson** told **R&R Country Hot Fax**, "Suzette has put a lot of heart and soul into this company and we really hate to see her go. She is such a wonderful person and she'll be dearly missed. And we're delighted to have Ted back. It's really great for us to have someone with his background, passion for the music and knowledge of the format."

CMA has updated criteria in the Single, Album and Musician of the Year awards categories. Single of the Year, previously based on release date, now qualifies by being on the charts during the eligibility period. Criteria in the Album of the Year category has removed reference to when the work was mastered, saying, "At least 60% of the product in the album must have been first released domestically during the eligibility period." Finally, the musician criteria eliminates the requirement to name the product for which the musician is being nominated. Contact CMA for details.


