WMTZ Hops To New Frequency, **Identity**

No. 1 12+-rated Country WMTZ/Johnstown, PA and No. 2 AC clustermate WKYE have switched frequencies, with WMTZ also shedding its "96.5 The Mountain" signature to adopt a new identity as "The All New Froggy 95." WMTZ has also changed calls. to WFGI.

The move takes WMTZ from 50,000 watts at 100 feet on 96.5 to 57,000 watts at 1,060 feet at 95.5. WMTZ has been No. 1 12+ in the last three Johnstown Arbitrons, posting a 16.9 (fall '03), 20.9 (spring '04) and 19.0 (fall '04). In those same three sweeps, WKYE has gone 12.3, 9.5 and 12.8.

Forever Broadcasting officially acquired the two stations from Clear Channel on Jan. 1, 2004, and rumors had swirled for quite a while that The Mountain would join other Forever Country stations in the Froggy pond. Interestingly, Forever's WFGY/Altoona, PA garnered 5.0, 5.4 and 4.7 12+ shares in the last three Arbitrons; the 4.7 is good for seventh place in Johnstown.

This should be a plus for both stations. Apparently the 96.5 signal has better penetration into downtown office buildings, more conducive to AC at-work listening, while the 95.5 frequency features a much bigger overall signal. In fact, one

Froggy insider feels there is "potential for truly stupendous" ratings numbers with its new coverage, which will provide a stronger signal in some key Country areas.

The WFGI jocks will retain their current identities, although in the grand tradition of all stations Froggy, new hires will become "Frogified," adopting the familiar amphibious monikers used at other stations, such as Ann Phibian, Polly Wogg, Commander Kermit, Hopalong Cassidy, etc., etc.

Lovett Named KFWR PD

KFWR/Ft. Worth, TX has tapped current KKBQ/ Houston middayer Rick Lovett as PD, replacing Billy Thorman, who becomes Director/Creative Services for the trimulcast Country signal. The move to KFWR (95.9, 106.9 and 107.1 The Ranch) marks a return to the area for Lovett, who spent seven years in the market, including work in imaging and production for KPLX (The Wolf)/ Dallas, before leaving for Houston in 2001. He starts at The Ranch in mid-February.


