Tampa's Outlaw Rides Into The Sunset

Immediately following its broadcast of the Brickyard 400 from Indianapolis yesterday, Infinity's WYUU (Outlaw Country)/Tampa flipped to a Tropical-intensive contemporary format as "La Nueva FM 92.5 — El Sonido Latino de Tampa Bay." The Outlaw first rode on to the scene in November 2003.

Rico Blanco is WYUU's new PD, succeeding **Mike Culotta**, OM of Country WQYK-FM, WYUU, Sports WQYK-AM and the Buccaneers Radio Network. With the format change, WYUU middayer **Barbara Ann** has exited; the fate of the other Country personalities, including morning hosts **Cowhead** and **Brent**, is not known at this time.

Street Talk: Back at WYUU sister WQYK, look for its new morning show to be announced any day now. (You may recall the new Clear Channel Country outlet stole Skip Mahaffey and some of his cohorts a few months back. Mahaffey is still sitting out a noncompete.) And, if everything works out, the new show is going to *really*

surprise you. It might well feature not one, but *two* Nashville names.

Our weekly analysis of Country callout research is brought to you by Bullseye President **John Hart**. Here's a look at some of the biggest stories Hart looks at in next week's issue (Aug. 12):

"During the R&R chart week of June 21, Toby Keith had the No. 1-testing song at Callout America, both positive and passion, with 'As Good as I Once Was.' Since then this song has dominated the sample, and this week it's still the No. 1 song, both positive and passion. The battle for the No. 1 position on the R&R spin chart heats up, and both Sugarland's 'Something More' and Faith Hill's 'Mississippi Girl' are the likely heirs to the spot, showing strong research and ranking No. 2 and No. 4, respectively. Sara Evans' 'A Real Fine Place to Start' is the No. 3 song overall in this week's sample. Craig Morgan is new to the top ten this week, with 'Redneck Yacht Club' ranking No. 7, up from No. 13. Brad Paisley moves into the top 10 at Callout America, with 'Alcohol' up strong, from No. 17 to No. 8. Shedaisy are also new to the top 10, ranking at No. 9, up from No. 11."

R&R Country Daily, Friday, Aug. 5: Maurice Miner joined the RCA Label Group/ Nashville as Assoc. Director/Syndicated & Satellite Radio. Miner is a 20-year radio vet who recently started consulting for the label after a long stint with MJI Broadcasting and Premiere Radio Networks.

WSM-AM/Nashville has launched a talent search that will culminate in a Ryman Auditorium show celebrating the station's 80th anniversary. From Tootsie's to the Ryman invites hopefuls to submit CDs to be included in one of four qualifying nights at Tootsie's. The finals will be Sept. 21 at the Ford Theater in the Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum, with the winner performing at the Oct. 21 Ryman concert.

Rascal Flatts will headline their first Gaylord Entertainment Center show in Nashville on Sept. 24. The Here's to You tour stop is the band's first Nashville concert in five years.

RRCD, Thursday, Aug. 4: Wes Poe returns to KSON/San Diego as MD, filling the post left

vacant since John Marks' recent promotion to PD. Poe left KSON in May 2004 and has worked part-time on-air at KBEQ/Kansas City since August 2004. In addition to music he'll also handle the noon-3pm airshift, which had been covered on an interim basis by Bryan Dean after Marks went off-air.



RRCD, Wednesday, Aug. 3: ABC-TV's *CMA Music Festival: Country's Biggest Party* won last Tuesday night's 9-11pm ET timeslot with a 4.9 rating/8 share. For that same two-hour slot, Fox was second, with a 4.8/8; CBS third, with 4.6/8; and NBC was fourth, with 4.1/7. Among 18-49s, the show pulled a 2.4 rating/7 share vs. last year's 2.4/8 in that demo. The top-rated show for the entire three-hour 8-11pm primetime slot was CBS's *NCIS*, with a 6.5/12 share. *Law & Order* was second (5.6/9), *Big Brother* was third (5.4/9), and the CMA Fest special was fourth (4.9/8).

The show had an average of 7.6 million viewers tuned in at any point during the show. Early indications are that the figure will lead the 9-

11pm block. Last year's show — remember, it was on a different network (CBS) and a different night (a Wednesday in July) — had a 6.1 rating/11 share and drew 9.2 million viewers at any given time during the show.
