Cincinnati's Riverbend Music Center over the weekend. WYGY PD **Stephen Giuttari** was there and put together this "mini-review" and insider's look at what you can expect when the tour comes to your town.

"Some 90 minutes before showtime, concertgoers were greeted with thunderstorms moving through the area. The storms passed, but the 'thunder' stayed around all night. The **Warren Brothers** entertained the early-arriving crowd with a rockin' performance highlighted by 'Sell a Lot of Beer.'

"**Big & Rich** treated the crowd to another great performance and showed why they're one of country's hottest new acts. They wowed the crowd with their hits, and the capacity crowd went wild when **Cowboy Troy** hit the stage and the band performed 'Rollin: The Ballad of Big and Rich.' Gone are the days of anonymity for Big & Rich, as the backstage area was jam-packed with more than 100 fans there to meet and greet them before they hit the stage.

"By 9pm, after Brooks & Dunn had taken time to personally meet and greet over 150 fans backstage, it was time for country music's No. 1 duo of all time to take the stage, and take the stage they did. Brooks & Dunn really elevated their stage show from the last time I saw them. A number of people commented on that. The staging was incredible — complete with a 576-square-foot LED projection screen that accompanied their live performance and showed video segments during the performances. They also had a gigantic balloon — lit up inside — with the logo for the tour.

"Backstage, it was very cool to see Kix and Ronnie take a *lot* of time to personally speak to, take photos with and spend time with their fans. You don't see many superstars doing that nowadays. Brooks & Dunn were also very loose — they looked like they were having a great time both backstage and onstage."

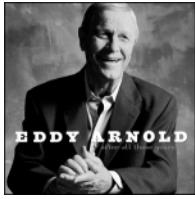

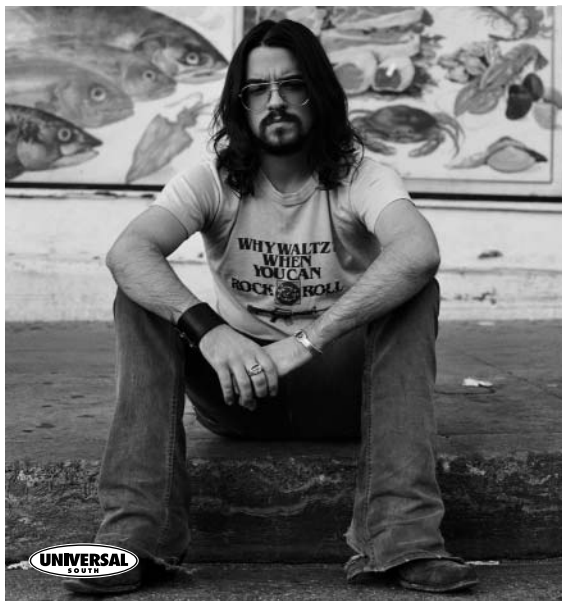
